

### SNOW RIDGE RETIRED

Overbrook Farm's **Snow Ridge** (Tabasco Cat--Snow Forest, by Woodman), who stamped himself one of the leaders of this year's sprint division, has been retired due to an injured sesamoid likely suffered during a recent workout at Churchill Downs. The injury will not require surgical repair. Bred in Kentucky by the Mt. Brilliant Farm LLC, the chestnut broke his maiden at first asking at two and went on to be a neck second in the GIII Sapling S. at Monmouth Park before finishing the year with a 10th in the GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile. A solid five for 11 as a sophomore, Snow Ridge recorded his most important victory of 2001 when he defeated City Zip in the GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint, but really blossomed this season for trainer D. Wayne Lukas. The \$420,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase reeled off three consecutive victories to begin the year, culminating in a 1 1/2-length success in the GI San Carlos H. in March at Santa Anita. First under the line in the GII Churchill Downs H. on Derby Day, he was subsequently demoted to second, but rebounded from that disappointment to register a 7 3/4-length victory in the GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H. at Pimlico May 18. Snow Ridge remains in Lukas' stable at Churchill Downs, but is soon to be moved to Overbrook, where he will enter stud next season. "I think if he is priced right, he will be a very attractive stallion," said Overbrook stallion manager Ric Waldman. "He's very attractive and well conformed. We paid quite a bit of money for him as a yearling, something that we don't usually do, and they [prospective yearlings] have to pass the scrutiny of D. Wayne Lukas and Dr. Robert Copelan. He's from the Storm Cat line and it's just a matter of time before breeders are all over grandsons of Storm Cat." Snow Ridge compiled a record of 21-10-4-1 and earnings of \$711,989.

### STREET CRY, CONGAREE CLASH IN FOSTER

For the third time in five years, the winner of the G1 Dubai World Cup will line up for Saturday's Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs. The next horse to complete the double will be the first. Silver Charm was foiled in his Foster attempt by Awesome Again in 1998 while 2001 World Cup hero Captain Steve had to settle for second last year behind Guided Tour, but Godolphin's **Street Cry (Ire)** (Machiavellian) will try to reverse that trend this time around. A two-year-old of infinite promise in 2000, the dark bay colt came to Churchill Downs last spring as Godolphin's best hope for a Kentucky Derby victory, but was forced to miss the race with an injury. Sheikh Mohammed's homebred has erased the memory of that disappointment this year, punctuated by his much-the-best victory at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23. "We are very happy with the horse at the moment," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford told *Daily Racing Form*. "He takes his training and racing pretty well. We expect him to run well Saturday." Jerry Bailey, who rode the colt in the World Cup, is in from New York for the ride. Stonerside Stables' **Congaree** (Arazi) is expected to vie for race favoritism with Street Cry. Third in the 2001 Kentucky Derby, the chestnut went on to win the GI Swaps S., but was injured in the GI Jim Dandy S. in early August. He hopes to add to his comeback success in the GIII Lone Star Park H. May 27. The race lost one of its prospective runners when trainer Todd Pletcher opted to keep last year's Derby runner-up **Invisible Ink** (Thunder Gulch) in New York for Saturday's GII Brooklyn H.

**NO POCKET AT ASCOT** *Jungle Pocket* (Jpn) (Tony Bin {Ire}) will miss the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 27 after suffering a setback in training, it was announced yesterday. Although it was expected that the G1 Japan Cup and G1 Japan Derby winner would contest the mile-and-a-half event, owner Yomoji Saito and trainer Sakae Watanabe issued a joint statement: "We found that his physical condition was very bad after training. He should rest this summer to recover his condition. Now he will miss the Takarazuka Kinen next week and we will cancel his trip to the UK." Ascot's clerk of the course Nick Cheyne told *PA Sport* yesterday: "I am very, very sorry for the connections of *Jungle Pocket* who were extremely enthusiastic about their trip. We were very excited about *Jungle Pocket* coming to Ascot as he is a top-class turf horse. It is very, very sad and I hope he will be able to come next year."

**OUTOFTHEBOX RETIRED** **GISW** **Outofthebox** (Montbrook--Cricket Box, by Notebook) has been retired from racing after suffering an ankle injury, according to *Thoroughbred Times*. The four-year-old, runner-up in last year's GI Fountain of Youth, was second behind subsequent Kentucky Derby winner Monarchos in the GI Florida Derby before a foot injury knocked him off the Triple Crown trail. He captured the GI Super Derby last September. In his only start this year, Outofthebox ran third in a May 4 allowance contest at Churchill Downs. On the board in 12 of 16 starts, the dark bay won five races and earned \$734,008. Outofthebox will begin his stud career next year at a farm still to be determined, according to owner Richard Klein. "We're basically soliciting right now," Klein told the *Times*. "He's probably more marketable in Florida, due to the fact that he's a Florida-bred and a son of Montbrook. His resume looks good and he should be very marketable. We just want to find the best fit for him and the farm."

**BELMONT RATINGS HIGHEST IN 13 YEARS**  
NBC Sports' coverage of last Saturday's Belmont S. was given a final rating of 7.6 and attracted 21 percent of the viewing audience. This marked the highest rating since the 1989 Belmont, which featured the match up between Sunday Silence and Easy Goer. The collective rating for the entire Triple Crown series was 6.8 with an 18-percent market share. The figures were 11 percent better than last year's 6.1/17 share. "These numbers underscore the continuing re-emergence of Thoroughbred horse racing and the VISA Triple Crown," Ken Schanzer, president of NBC Sports told the *Blood-Horse*. "Obviously having a Triple Crown contender was critically important for the rating in the Belmont, but that shouldn't obscure the fact that the Triple Crown has demonstrated significant increases over the last two years. We're excited about the Thoroughbred racing prospects in the future."

Two for four in France last year, Volga notched consecutive wins in the Listed Prix de Bagatelle last May and the G3 Prix de Royaumont in early June, both at Saint-Cloud. She was outgamed for second in the G2 Prix de Malleret a month later before shipping across the pond, where she was again second in the GI E P Taylor at Woodbine in late September. She closed out her sophomore campaign with a non-threatening fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf over this course in October. On vacation since, the dark bay returned here as the prohibitive favorite against four rivals. Relaxed off the pace by jockey Jose Santos, Volga rated back in fourth through three-quarters, ranged up to take the lead through the stretch and scored with ease under a hand ride.



**Weekend Madness Dies While Giving Birth:**

Adena Springs broodmare **Weekend Madness (Ire)** (Dance Of Life--Spring Break {Ire}, by Cure the Blues) died June 8 while foaling a colt by Swain (Ire). Stakes placed in Ireland at three, she won nine of her 24 starts in the U.S., including back-to-back runnings of the GIII Saratoga Breeders' Cup in 1994 and 1995 as well as the 1994 GIII Keeneland Breeders' Cup. She proved a popular item in the sales ring following her retirement from racing, selling for \$550,000 in foal to Nureyev at the 1998 Keeneland November Sale and sold to Frank Stronach for \$150,000 at the 2000 November Sale carrying a Red Ransom foal which ultimately aborted.

Trainer Paolo Lobo reported yesterday that GI Kentucky Oaks heroine **Farda Amiga** (Broad Brush) has recovered from a fever she contracted following that May 3 event, but that her summer campaign may have to be augmented. Original plans called for the bay to make her next start in the \$500,000 American Oaks at Hollywood Park July 6, but Lobo admitted yesterday that time is running short to make that race. The conditioner indicated that she will probably be pointed for races later in the summer, including the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga Aug. 17 or the GI Del Mar Oaks on the turf Aug. 24.

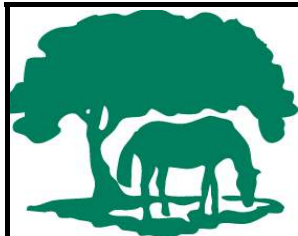
