FRANKEL STAGES THREE-PRONGED ATTACK

Hollywood Park's Barn 70 North once housed the horses trained by Charlie Whittingham. The barn is now home to trainer Bobby Frankel, who has a trio of runners entered in the GI Charles Whittingham H. at Hollywood this afternoon. Juddmonte Farms homebred **Skipping (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), winner of the 1 1/2-mile Jim Murray Memorial H. over the Hollywood turf last time out May 19, heads

the triad. The five-year-old started his career in France, where he counted a Listed stakes at 10 furlongs among his victories. The bay made his U.S. bow in April and, after breaking a step slowly, closed to be second in a Santa Anita allowance Apr. 17. Frankel, who was second and third in the Whittingham last year, also saddles 2001 GI Hollywood Derby winner **Denon** (Plesant Colony). The four-year-old, a troubled fifth in the Feb. 16 GII San Luis Obispo H., was fifth again in his most recent start, finishing 4 1/2 lengths behind **Continental Red** (Flying Continental) in the GII San Luis Rey H. Mar. 16. Continental Red was in turn third to **Ringaskiddy** (Slewvescent) in the GI San Juan Capistrano H. last time out Apr. 21.

Parade Leader looks for a better pace scenario than he has experienced in each of his last two starts. The off-the-pace winner of the GII New Orleans H. at the Fair Grounds Mar. 3, the bay was a distant second to loose-on-the-lead Duckhorn in the GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland Apr. 21 and fell victim to front-running Hail The Chief in the May 18 GII Hawthorne Gold Cup. **Congaree** impressed in his first start in almost nine months when leading the GIII Lone Star Park H. field from gate to wire May 27, but he could face serious pressure on the front end from GIII W.D. Schaefer H. winner **Tenpins**. Never out of the top three in 10 career starts, **Street Cry** has come into his own in two starts this season. The 8 1/2-length winner of Round 3 of the G2 Maktoum Challenge series Feb. 28 at Nad al Sheba, the four-year-old shot through an opening along the rail and pulled clear to account for the Mar. 23 G1 Dubai World Cup by an impressive 4 1/4 lengths.

Bosque Redondo, first or second in 10 of his 14 starts, captured the one-mile Tokyo City H. Mar. 9 and the nine-furlong GII San Bernardino H. Apr. 6, both at Santa Anita. The chestnut comes off a second-place finish in the May 12 GII Mervyn LeRoy H. The winner of the GI Eddie Read H. on the turf last season, **Redattore** became a graded-stakes winner on the dirt in his 2002 debut, taking the Feb. 3 GII San Antonio H. at a mile and an eighth. The seven-year-old returned to the turf for his last two outings, finishing second in the May 5 GIII Inglewood H. and in the May 27 GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile. **Milwaukee Brew**, on the board in all four starts at this distance, makes his first start since capturing the Mar. 2 GI Santa Anita H. by four lengths. He has been working sharply for his return.

Last year's Queen's Plate victress, **Dancethruthedawn** cruised to a 5 1/2-length victory in Keeneland's Doubledogdare S. Apr. 18 to kick off her four-year-old campaign and followed that up with a nose loss to Summer Colony in the GIII Pimlico Breeders' Cup Distaff H. May 17. She paired up Beyer Speed Figures of 110 in those two starts and has Jerry Bailey in the irons, subbing for the injured Robby Albarado. Five-year-old **Spain** became the leading distaff earner with a win in the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup Distaff H. May 3 before heading to the breeding shed for a date with Storm Cat. Currently in foal to that stallion, the bay mare will remain in training for now. "At this point, it has no bearing on her racing, but at some point we're going to have to address that," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I would say that she would get this race and at least one more." Spain had her biggest payday when she upset the 2000 \$2 million GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at 50-1. "She loves this track and I think she's going to run a huge, huge race [today]," Lukas added. "She's tough and she runs hard and she gets into the race. She doesn't need a pace scenario, a perfect track or anything--she just gets out there and competes every time."

After a number of promising efforts last year, **Free of Love** added blinkers and finally earned his first graded-stakes victory last out in the GIII Westchester H. May 8 going a flat mile over this track. The bay colt has come back with a pair of bullet drills at Aqueduct and should be able to get a stalking trip. Godolphin's **E Dubai**, a \$1.35 million Keeneland September purchase, captured the GII Dwyer S. over a sloppy Belmont strip last July and finished second to Point Given in the GI Travers. The bay colt followed that up with a half-length loss in the GI Super Derby Sept. 23, but has been sidelined since then with cracked heels. "His heels finally started to look better once we brought him back here [from Dubai]," said assistant trainer Tom Albertrani. "It seems like he's ready to run and he looks stronger than he did last year. We're hoping he continues to mature as he gets older." **Bowman's Band** finished second in the GI Oaklawn H. Apr. 6 and had a troubled trip when second in the GIII W.D. Schaefer H. at Pimlico Preakness day.

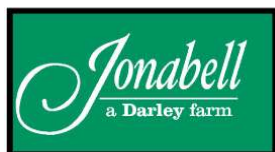

DENALI MAKES A DIFFERENCE



MCGAUGHEY UNDERGOES HEART SURGERY

Trainer Shug McGaughey underwent triple bypass surgery at New York Presbyterian Hospital in Manhattan Thursday. The Eclipse Award-winning horseman, who has been the private trainer for the Phipps family since 1985, was recovering well from the operation yesterday. Doctors discovered during an examination Tuesday that McGaughey had three blocked valves. "[The doctor] said if he didn't get this done, he was going to have a heart attack sooner or later," McGaughey's assistant, Buzzy Tenney, told the *Daily Racing Form*. The 51-year-old trainer is expected to be hospitalized through the weekend, and could return to work by mid-July. McGaughey has trained seven champions, including undefeated Personal Ensign and GI Belmont S. winner Easy Goer.

BUDDHA TO AIM FOR DWYER Buddha (Unbridled's Song), back on track after suffering a bruised right front foot that knocked him off the Triple Crown trail, could make his next start in the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont Park July 7. The gray, who is stabled with the Jim Bond string at Saratoga, worked five furlongs in 1:02 2/5 over the Oklahoma training track last Saturday. "Buddha is coming along," Bond said. "We've worked him and we're going to try and get him ready for the Dwyer."

CEEBAND RETIRED GSW Ceeband (Cee's Tizzy--Miss Sonrisa {Chi}, by Domineau) has been retired after injuring a sesamoid during a five-furlong workout at Hollywood Park Tuesday morning. The five-year-old, who bested subsequent sprint champion Squirtle Squirt in the 2001 GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H., picked up his final victory in the Cal Cup Sprint H. last November. In his most recent start, the former claimer was fifth in the GII Churchill Downs H. May 4. The Cal-bred retires with seven wins, six seconds and nine thirds from his 32 career starts for \$636,265 in earnings.

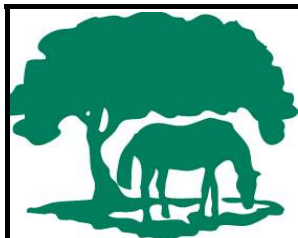
