

### KINANE ON THE ROCK IN ST JAMES

Jockey Michael Kinane yesterday decided to partner **Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill) over stable companion **Landseer (GB)** (Danehill) in the G1 St James' Palace S. on opening day at Royal Ascot. Kinane had ridden the "Rock" in all of his starts prior to the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas, but missed the winning mount in that Classic due to a suspension. He was back aboard the colt for his victory in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, and also took the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains with Landseer. Johnny Murtagh, who picked up the mount on the "Rock" at Newmarket, will pilot Landseer this time. Nick Cheyne, Ascot's clerk of the course, yesterday gave the official going as good to soft on the straight course, good to soft, soft in places on the round course. He told *PA Sport*, "We've had two drying days...and I can see it drying still quite a bit more between now and Tuesday providing we miss the rain--there's a bit tomorrow evening I think. I'd say it will still be on the slow side, but it's certainly not going to be far away." William Hill installed Rock of Gibraltar as the 1-2 favourite, with Landseer at 9-2. Godolphin's **Imtiyaz** (Woodman), the most notable withdrawal, will instead go for Sunday's G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp.

### FALBRAV FANTASTIC IN MILAN

**Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) and jockey Dario Vargiu cut down **Narrative (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and Frankie Dettori in a thrilling finale to yesterday's G1 Gran Premio di Milano, recording a time only a tick slower than the course record set by Lando (Ger) in the 1995 renewal of the same race. As he did last time when beating Narrative's stable companion Ekraar in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica in Rome May 12, Falbrav left it late, but proved too strong in the finish for Godolphin's colt. During a light campaign last year, Falbrav was beaten 2 3/4 lengths by Morshdi (GB) in the G1 Derby Italiano at Rome in May. In beating Ekraar by 1 1/4 lengths, he showed that the policy of waiting on a high-profile four-year-old campaign had paid off and he consolidated his position as Italy's best older horse yesterday. Held up in fourth on the rail as Narrative dominated the early stages, Falbrav made stealthy progress past struggling rivals at the top of the straight. He gradually cut into the frontrunner's advantage, getting on top with 125 yards remaining. "I never had any problems, as he travelled so well off the fast pace which suited him very well," said Vargiu. "He showed today that he is high class."

Next Desert produced a highly impressive display to quash stamina doubts and ensure his place in the lineup in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 7. Last time he found Dupont (GB) two lengths too strong when losing his unbeaten record in the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) at Cologne May 20. Previously he had beaten subsequent Derby trial winner Orf시오 (Ger) by four lengths in the G3 Preis des Gestuts Wiesenhof-Dr Busch-Memorial at Krefeld Apr. 21. Here he raced in second early as Kieren Fallon took Nicaragua (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}) to the front. As that rival came under pressure at the top of the straight, Terence Hellier asked the favourite to quicken and he produced an emphatic turn of foot to settle the outcome in a matter of strides. Striding out well on the sound surface, he left Warren O'Connor and Levirat and Mick Kinane and Auenteufel in his wake. Next Desert is out of Night Petticoat (Petoski {GB}), winner of the G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) in 1996, and runner-up in the G2 Deutsches St Leger. Petoski is a son of the major staying influence Niniski out of a dam line that is packed with stamina and has always worked well with sires from the Northern Dancer line.

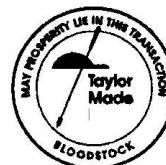

**HONG KONG SEES DROP IN HANDLE**

Hong Kong's 2001-2002 racing season ended yesterday with news that betting turnover had dropped about 4 percent from the season that closed a year ago. A total of HK\$78.1 billion was wagered; daily attendance averaged 30,135, a decrease of 13 percent. One factor in the decline was the World Cup--five of the 78 Hong Kong meetings went head-to-head with World Cup games, and those meets saw attendance fall 26 percent and handle drop by HK\$600 million. Lawrence Wong, the chief executive of the Hong Kong Jockey Club, also attributed the waning business to "the sluggish performance of the economy and the effects of illegal gambling, particularly the upsurge in sports gambling with illegal and offshore bookmakers." Wong added that, while the 4-percent drop was a cause for concern, "it could have been worse if the performance of other sectors of the economy is an indication."

**AUSSIE TRAINER TOPS HONG KONG STANDINGS**

Australian horseman John Size, enjoying a stellar first season in Hong Kong, was crowned champion trainer with 58 wins during the 2001-2002 meet. "It has been hard work, but I am absolutely delighted to be champion," Size said. "The reception I got today was overwhelming--you don't expect something like that. The fans here get very involved in what we do and it is great to see how much they appreciate our efforts." For the second straight year, the jockey championship went to South African Douglas Whyte. Whyte had three winners on yesterday's closing-day card at Sha Tin to end the season with 77 victories. Two riders, Way Leung and Vincent Sit, shared the apprentice jockey title with 13 wins apiece. Hong Kong's 2002-2003 meet starts Sept. 1 at Sha Tin.
