

SOPHISTICATED LADY

Sophisticat (Storm Cat), sent off an 11-2 chance, took a diverse route to victory in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot, but was quick enough to pass **Zenda (GB)** (Zamindar) in the final strides to provide trainer Aidan O'Brien with his first victory in the event. Sophisticat was coming off a third-place finish behind Zenda in the G1 Pouliches at Longchamp May 12, where her need for cover resulted in her losing vital ground. That "tricky" trait, as jockey Michael Kinane called it afterwards, meant more heart-stopping moments for connections at Royal Ascot, but her rider was convinced that she could reverse the French Classic form. "Richard [Hughes] got an easy enough lead in France and got away from me," Kinane explained. "After France, I said bring her straight here and she got fast ground, which was really going to suit her." Always prominent, Zenda took over with a little over a furlong to run and looked a winner. Sophisticat and Kinane found themselves with a wall of horses to their left and the one-paced **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) to their outside. Choosing to switch to the inner, they were soon in trouble as the gaps closed. Kinane swung his filly outside at the furlong marker; Sophisticat had four lengths to find on Zenda, but cut that rival down with a telling turn of acceleration and was firmly on top at the finish. "The plan today was to make sure there was a good honest pace and ride a waiting race on her and put her into every pocket possible, but I nearly over-did it," Kinane said. "She can be there too soon and if she's there 50 yards down, it's probably way too early. She's tricky--you can't really hit her, but she has loads of talent." Gossamer, the 6-4 favourite after her win on much softer going in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, failed to act on the very fast ground and finished last in the 11-horse field.

Like Mother, Like Daughter...

Sophisticat seems to have inherited the constitution of her dam, champion *Serena's Song*, having progressed off a heavy juvenile campaign in which she maintained a high level of consistency at the top level. She was second to last year's champion juvenile filly *Queen's Logic* (Ire) in three straight Group races, including the G1 Cheveley Park S. in October, and ended the year with a fifth-place finish in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. If there were any doubts as to whether she had trained on at three, they were dispelled by her impressive win in the G3 Prix de la Grotte Apr. 14 and her fine effort in the Classic itself. "She was very convincing, but during the race I was saying to myself she had nowhere to go," said winning co-owner Michael Tabor. "She's a bit of a madam, but a fabulous filly and we always knew she had a big race in her. She's a tough filly--her dam was extremely tough."

☆ ROYAL ASCOT HEADLINES ☆

INFECTION KOS CALLER ONE Caller One (Phone Trick) will miss today's G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot due to an infection. Nick Smith, head of public relations at Ascot, told *PA Sport* yesterday evening, "He was examined by a vet today and found to have a throat infection. It's a terrible shame. These things happen, but obviously everyone was very excited by the prospect of him running here--we were looking forward to seeing a big American challenger."

MURTAGH HITS BACK Jockey Johnny Murtagh, who picked up a whip ban Thursday on G1 Ascot Gold Cup winner Royal Rebel (GB), yesterday rode a double at Royal Ascot, partnering Balakheri (Ire) in the G2 King Edward VII S. and Revenue (Ire) in the Windsor Castle S. He also spoke of his frustration over the ban. "When everybody tells you it was a great ride and you do everything right and win in a tight finish, you come out and you really feel on top of the world," Murtagh said. "Yesterday I was like a fighter leaving the ring. I was very disappointed, but I woke up this morning and went for a walk and I had a good chat with myself. No lives were lost. I got done for excessive force and excessive frequency, but I don't lift it above shoulder height and it's something I've worked on a lot." Sir Michael Stoute, trainer of Balakheri, added, "I think we are too severe--he gave it a great ride and then gets penalised to a very severe extent." Murtagh closed his spell at Royal Ascot on level terms with Richard Hughes for the London Clubs Trophy for leading rider with four winners. The pair edged ahead of Mick Kinane, who was quoted as the 4-11 favourite at the start of the meet. The Irish rider took his tally to three yesterday on Sophisticat in the G1 Coronation S.

THE HIT PARADE

The reign of Serena's Song as leading distaff earner was recently ended by Spain, but the bay mare is off to a stellar start as a broodmare. Her first foal Serena's Tune, a \$1 million Keeneland July yearling, earned \$337,260 as a solid stakes-winning sprinter. Still to come are Arbitrate, a two-year-old colt by Deputy Minister; a yearling full brother to Sophisticat and a 2002 colt by Unbridled. She is currently back in foal to Storm Cat. Serena's Song will be inducted to the National Museum of Racing's Hall of Fame Aug. 5.

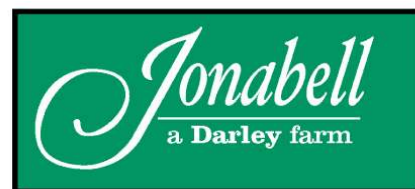

TDN "Dark Horse" Balakheri needed every yard of this trip to reverse the form of his staying-on third behind Bollin Eric in the G2 Dante S. at York May 15. Showing his appreciation for the step up in distance, he quickened past Bollin Eric before stretching away for an impressive score. Balakheri has a pedigree steeped in middle-distance promise, being out of Balanka, who was third in the G2 Prix de l'Opera in 1995 and is a half-sister to the dam of Bering (GB). A maiden winner at Nottingham on his third start as a juvenile, he returned this season to take a competitive Newmarket handicap Apr. 18 before his Dante run. Rated in fourth early as Sparkling Water (Woodman) cut out the running this time, the winner was tapped for speed on the turn into the straight and responded to close on Kaieteur, who had grabbed the lead travelling strongly. As soon as Balakheri hit top gear, he swept to the front before striding away under hands and heels. "I think he's mainly impervious to ground conditions, but it's fast enough for a heavy-topped horse like him and as a result he took a little time to get into a good rhythm," said winning trainer Sir Michael Stoute. "I'm thrilled because he's been working really well and I felt he was our best chance of the meeting. He's in the G1 Irish Derby [June 30], but we'll take him home and see how he is as he's run on some pretty fast ground."

Frankie Dettori chose aggression aboard Mamool and that tactic paid dividends as Godolphin's colt stayed on all the way to the line to deny Mr Dinos. Racing in second early behind Muhareb (Thunder Gulch), he took command from the tiring long-time leader with three furlongs remaining. Applying the pressure from the front, Dettori had too many guns in the closing stages as Mr Dinos, his only realistic threat, closed fast but too late. Mamool was fourth to Bandari (Ire) in the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial S. May 11 last time out. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor explained the decision to step him up to this two-mile trip. "When he was fourth at Lingfield, we could see that he needed extra distance, and in the mornings, when he is a bit keen, he shows he definitely needs a trip," he said. "He has improved both mentally and physically and muscled up a lot. He was relaxed in the race--he has learned, and we have a staying horse for the future. He is a possibility for the G1 St Leger [at Doncaster Sept. 14], but we will see--if he stays sound and healthy he can be a horse for next year's G1 Ascot Gold Cup." Dettori added, "He was very relaxed hroughout the race and the further he went, the better he was underneath me. We got to the front and he was two or three lengths clear. He was idling a bit in front, but I always felt he would hold on. To be honest, he would not mind some more cut in the ground--he's got a round action. He's getting better and better."

Johannesburg completes the unorthodox journey from Louisville to Royal Ascot in a bid to re-establish himself as one of the top performers of his generation. Last year, he was a two-year-old phenomenon, starting the ball rolling with a smooth success in the five-furlong G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot. He proved imperious over six furlongs in the G3 Anglesey S. at The Curragh, the G1 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown, the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville and the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket before taking the step up in trip for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile in his stride. Johannesburg's Belmont experience prompted connections to try a daring raid on the GI Kentucky Derby at Churchill May 4 with a prep in the G3 Gladness S. at The Curragh Apr. 7. Beaten a short head in that seven-furlong turf event by the subsequent G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup winner Rebelline (Ire), he failed to make an impact in the Derby, finishing eighth, but as the fastest horse at Ballydoyle, he will be back in his comfort zone here. **Danehurst** returns to the scene of her disappointing effort when ninth in last year's G2 King's Stand S., but the fact that her trainer decided to sidestep that five-furlong sprint this time speaks volumes. She took three Listed events thereafter and her dismal effort when unplaced in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in October remains a mystery. Her handler readied Pivotal (GB) to win the King's Stand in 1996 first time out and he is sure to have worked his magic on this filly.

Trainer Mark Johnston is two-handed with **Yavana's Pace** and **Zindabad** in his attempt at collecting a third Hardwicke after the exploits of Fruits of Love in 1999 and 2000. Yavana's Pace, who was runner-up in the 2000 event, would be a popular winner, but although that career-best effort came on similar ground, he gives the impression that a fast surface is unsuitable in his advancing years. Zindabad, however, bounces off the top of the ground and showed how effective he is on this surface in beating **Boreas** in the G2 Yorkshire Cup at York May 16. Previously he had outbattled St Expedit (GB) in the G3 John Porter S. at Newbury Apr. 20 in similar conditions and it is commendable that he managed to finish third in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 7 on soft ground last time. **Millenary** finished in front of Zindabad when second in the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 3, where **Storming Home** was third. Storming Home has subsequently reversed that form with Zindabad when second in the Coronation Cup.

The defending champion of this event, **Critical Eye** has yet to find her best form this season, but should get a strong pace to run at this afternoon. A sharp allowance winner at a flat mile May 19, the New York-bred mare was most recently sixth in the GII Sheepshead Bay H. on the turf June 1. **Raging Fever** should be favored in an attempt to score her first Grade I victory since Belmont's Frizette S. in 2000. The dark bay typically does her best running on the front end, but fell victim to **Shiny Band** when that one rallied from well back to score a 17-1 upset in the GII Shuvee H. May 18. **Mystic Lady**, a four-time graded-stakes winner last year at three, wired the field in the Apr. 5 Banshee Breeze H. at Gulfstream before coming from midpack to be second in the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H. May 3. She needs to rebound from an uncharacteristic last-place effort in the Nastique S. at Delaware June 1.

BLACK-TYPE MINIMUM GOES TO \$35,000 Members of the Society of International Thoroughbred Auctioneers, which represents sales companies in the U.S. as well as Australia, Britain, Canada, France, Ireland, New Zealand and South Africa, have voted to raise the minimum purse necessary to earn a stakes race black type to \$35,000, *The Blood-Horse* reports. Members of the organization decided on the new minimum during a meeting in London last week. The new standard goes into effect Jan. 1, 2003. The minimum was raised from \$25,000 to \$30,000 this past Jan. 1.

SHARP PERFORMANCE EUTHANIZED Sharp Performance (Kris S.), who suffered injuries to both forelegs near the finish of the Gill Fort Marcy H. at Aqueduct Apr. 27, was euthanized June 9 at Belmont Park after an infection developed in his left foreleg. One of the leading three-year-old turf performers in 2001, the bay colt scored victories in the Gill Lexington S. and Gill Lawrence Realization S. at Belmont Park and was also an excellent third by a length in the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Park. "There was no question that he had the potential to be my best horse," trainer David Donk told *Daily Racing Form*. It was hoped that the four-year-old could be saved for stud duties despite the fact that his racing career was over. "Dr. [Stephen] Selway performed the autopsy and said he had no chance," the trainer continued. "Surprisingly he was doing quite well, but that was because he was such a good patient and he made it possible to last that long. It was the first time in 43 days [since the Fort Marcy] that his leg became inflamed. When we went to redress the bandages, his leg had blown up to the knee." Bred in Kentucky by Twin Hopes Farm, Sharp Performance had compiled a record of 7-4-0-2 and earnings of \$279,780.



This horse improves all the time and the G1 Eclipse S. [at Sandown July 6] or the G1 International S. [at York Aug. 20] could be next and the Arc is also on the agenda. I'll sort out plans for him in the next couple of weeks." **Altieri (GB)** (Selkirk {USA}), who was second to Domedriver (Ire) in the G3 Prix Chemin de Fer du Nord at Chantilly June 9, is due to travel to France again shortly. Trainer Vittorio Caruso said of the four-year-old: "Altieri came out of the Chantilly race in top form and I'm really happy with him.
