

### NO JUBILATION FOR JOHANNESBURG

"It's very possible he won't run again." Those were part of the post-race comments from Ballydoyle trainer Aidan O'Brien after **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) finished a well-beaten ninth in yesterday's G1 Golden Jubilee S. on the closing program of the Royal Ascot meeting.

Sheikh Hamdan's **Malhub** (Kingmambo), a huge 16-1 shot, caused the upset beneath jockey Kevin Darley to beat **Danehurst (GB)** (Danehill) by 1½ lengths, but clearly all eyes were on last year's superhorse and his inability to discover his past glory. The champ was making his first start since finishing an up-the-track eighth in the Kentucky

Derby, but disappointed yesterday as the 3-1 favorite. "The reality of it is that at the moment the horse has no more to give," O'Brien continued. "We'll take him home and see how he is and if he ever has a chance of making it back to where he used to be." (*cont p2*)

### GERALD LEIGH DIES

Gerald Leigh, one of the most prominent British owner/breeders, died yesterday morning after a long battle with cancer. Famed for having bred 1994 G1 Breeders' Cup Mile hero **Barathea (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and his sister **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), winner of this year's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, Leigh built a formidable broodmare band at his 600-acre Eydon Hall Farm Stud over the last two decades. He began as a breeder at Cayton Park Stud 30 years ago before moving to Eydon in Northamptonshire. From that base he bred **Brocade (GB)** (Habitat), a Group 1 winner in France who would go on to produce Barathea and Gossamer. Others to carry Leigh's brown and beige silks to success included **Infamy (GB)** (Shirley Heights {GB}), who took the G1 Rothmans International at Woodbine in 1988; and **Markofdistinction (GB)** (Known Fact), winner of the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. in 1990. That pair was trained by Luca Cumani, with whom Leigh enjoyed a close and successful relationship over the last two decades.

Cumani also handled two of Brocade's progeny in **Brocatelle (GB)** (Green Desert) and **Zibilene (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), who proved a marker of their breeder's reputation when reaching 1.7 million guineas and 1.3 million guineas, respectively, at the Tattersalls December Sales in 2000 and 2001. He also bred multiple Group 1 scorer **Bosra Sham** (Woodman), who sold for 530,000 guineas at the Tattersalls Houghton Sales in 1994. Leigh also campaigned **Act One (GB)** (In The Wings {GB}), winner last year of the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in November and runner-up to Sulamani (Ire) in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 2 for trainer Jonathan Pease. Leigh, who was awarded the honour of flat breeder of the year by the Thoroughbred Breeders' Association at the end of last season, donated all prizemoney from those horses and others to the charity CancerBACUP, a support organisation for sufferers of the disease. "It's terribly sad," Cumani told *PA Sport*. "He was a very, very close friend, and a great and loyal supporter for many years. He was a great man in every walk of life. My thoughts go out to his wife and children, and his manager Terry [Campbell] too, for whom Gerald was a father figure. We'll all miss him terribly."

**MALHUB MAKES THE GRADE** Winner of the Listed King Charles II S. over seven furlongs at Newmarket last June, **Malhub** (Kingmambo) was ninth in the G1 St James's Palace S. at this meeting before getting a break. Not spotted again until the fall, he was fifth in the Listed Joel S. and seventh in the G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket in October, but showed that he had overcome a well-documented wind problem when returning to break the Yarmouth track record in a conditions event nine days ago. Malhub had things practically his own way up front as he raced alone in the centre of the track in the early stages before passing **Three Points (Ire)** (Bering {GB}) at the halfway maker. Asserting from there, he always had the call over that rival and kept quickening all the way to the line to hold off the staying-on **Danehurst (GB)** (Danehill). "I felt the mile was too far so decided to drop him in trip and give him one really smart entry over six, and last time he broke the track record at Yarmouth," said winning trainer John Gosden. "He's had two wind operations so he's a testament to Sheikh Hamdan whose faith has been rewarded. The G1 July Cup [at Newmarket July 11] would be an obvious place to go as he wants six and fast ground--that's got to be his target. You wouldn't see him in the G1 Nunthorpe S. [at York Aug. 22] as that's for specialist sprinters and one place you won't see him is in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye [at Longchamp Oct. 6] in a bog. He could go to Arlington [for the BC Sprint] and personally I think he'll go on the dirt, but we might want to leave that one as it's a long way off." Should he line up in the Newmarket sprint, he is likely to face the runner-up and third, but one who may miss that race now is **Johannesburg** (Hennessy), who looks on the brink of retirement. That colt broke well and raced prominently in third overall until the halfway at which point he came under pressure to close. Jockey Michael Kinane was not hard on him when he failed to respond with his customary dash and he soon faded from contention. "We gave him a break after Kentucky, but when he came back ready to start working again, our ground was so bad I was afraid to risk working him," trainer Aidan O'Brien said. "I'm being realistic. When you bottom a horse like him, it's hard to get him back. Why would you ask him to go and do that again when he's just not the horse he was last year? If I ever get another Johannesburg, hopefully I won't mess him up again!"

Zindabad made all under jockey Kevin Darley to provide trainer Mark Johnston with his third renewal after Fruits of Love's dual successes in 1999 and 2000, respectively. A game and tough campaigner from the front, he beat St Exedit (GB) in the G3 John Porter S. at Newbury Apr. 20 and Boreas (GB) in the G2 Yorkshire Cup at York May 16. Most recently, he was a creditable third in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 7 on soft ground, after Johnston had considered withdrawing him on the morning due to the state of the ground. Obviously relishing the fast ground this time, he was taken over to the rail from his wide draw to head Potemkin (Ire) (Ashkalani {Ire}) and travelled well until Darley upped the tempo with five furlongs remaining. That move proved decisive as Storming Home moved wide to challenge. Sticking to his guns, he warded off that pressure and was firmly on top at the line. "He's so uncomplicated that you can make the running on him and if they are going quicker than him, they are going too fast," said Darley. Johnston added, "I've said all along this horse can win the Canadian International. I've shirked the G1 Irish St Leger [at The Curragh Sept. 14] with this horse because we have worried about the ground, but at Epsom last time he showed that if the worse comes to the worst he will handle the ground."

The last time Raging Fever tried a mile and a sixteenth, she finished off the board for the only time in her career, running sixth in the 2000 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. The dark bay, who had also avoided Grade I company since that test, demonstrated that she could handle the trip when she captured the GI Frizette S. as a two-year-old and proved up to the task once again here. First or second in all five prior starts this term, the bay won the Mar. 30 GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. going seven furlongs and the Apr. 20 GIII Bed o' Roses Breeders' Cup H. at a mile, then was caught after cutting out the fractions in the eight-furlong GII Shuvee H. May 18. The 2-1 choice to get back to her winning ways this time, she tracked Shuvee winner Shiny Band (Dixieland Band) through a half in :46 1/5 and took over after six furlongs in 1:10 2/5. Raging Fever opened up a 3 1/2-length lead at midstretch and dug in during the final furlong to stave off the late bid of Transcendental. The win brought the filly's earnings over the \$1 million mark. "She's been very special for us," trainer Mark Hennig said. "I think she can sprint with the best of them." The winner will be pointed for the GI Ballerina H. at Saratoga Aug. 25. Second choice Shiny Band stopped after six furlongs and finished last. The 'A' Train just keeps on rolling with a fourth consecutive Grade I victory, cementing her status at the head of the distaff class. Handed her only defeat when second in the GII La Canada S. in February, the Paulson homebred's newest winning streak commenced with a win in the GI Santa Margarita H. in March followed by her success in the GI Apple Blossom H. the following month. The chestnut came into this a resounding 3 1/2-length winner over Affluent in the GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. May 25 and was the prohibitive favorite to make it seven for eight in her career. Azeri, carrying a career-high 125 pounds, dueled for the early lead along the inside with Collect Call, but always had that one's number and easily disposed of her approaching the far turn. Affluent, as usual, rallied late, but was no match for the winner while Collect Call dead heated for third with Starrer. "I've run out of words to describe her," commented winning rider Mike Smith. "I never moved. It was an amazing performance. I'd say I've probably ridden two of the best mares in the world [Breeders' Cup Distaff winners Ajina and Inside Information] and I'd rank her right up there with them, and she is getting better. Today, well, I've never been on anything like that. She was just phenomenal."

Del Mar Show and regular rider Jerry Bailey took a weekend trip up to picturesque New Hampshire and walked away with yet another graded-stakes victory. The bay horse returned from a seven-month absence to win the GIII Ft. Lauderdale H. in late January, then traveled to Dubai, where he finished a dismal tenth in the G2 Dubai Duty Free S. Mar. 23. He rebounded nicely after the long trip home, running a respectable second to Strut the Stage in the GII Dixie S. at Pimlico May 18. Bailey kept Del Mar Show just off longshot Ben Speedin (Belong to Me) through six furlongs, then asked his mount for run as they rounded the far turn. The heavy favorite responded by kicking clear from the pack with ease, and the two cruised confidently through the lane to notch the open-length score. "It doesn't come any easier than that," said Bailey after the race. "The race went exactly as we would have wanted," said Leanna Willaford, an assistant to trainer Bill Mott. "Have a little bit of speed on the lead, with no trouble, with no problems, then swing out in the stretch, and if we've got enough left, we win. And that's exactly how it happened." A definitive spot for Del Mar Show's next test has yet to be determined. Mus-If, winner of four straight coming into the race, held off Dr. Kashnikow for the place spot. The well-travelled Voodoo Dancer sandwiched a fourth-place finish in last year's GI Del Mar Oaks in between wins in the GIII Lake George S. at Saratoga and the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Park. But the bay ended the campaign with a lackluster seventh-place showing as the 17-10 favorite in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland and was given nearly seven months off. She returned to take the May 5 GIII Beaugay H. at Aqueduct, then shipped west again and was third to Astra in the May 27 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood Park. Trying the Churchill turf for the first time, the odds-on choice was tucked in while rating off moderate splits, then moved up from between horses on the final bend. Voodoo Dancer swung five-wide as they hit the stretch and came running, taking over inside the final furlong and outfinishing Blue Moon for the score. The final time for the race clipped two-fifths off the stakes record. "I thought we would break and she would lay third at the worst," said wining jockey Jose Santos. "Half of the field was searching for the lead after the break, so I just laid back. When I pulled my mare to the outside at the five-sixteenths pole, I had plenty of horse. I knew by the quarter pole I was going to win the race...there was no doubt in my mind." Second choice Snow Dance (Forest Wildcat) pressed the pace, but weakened to be fifth. "I needed her to kick on to get clear of the horses in front of me, but she wasn't helping me," jockey Pat Day said. "She was just going through the motions late. **Grand Prix de Paris cont.**

Traditionally, this contest has been an ideal chance for those that failed in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly to bounce back. In the last decade, five winners of this had contested that Classic with only Peintre Celebre having scored at Chantilly in 1997. That bodes well for **Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West), **Khalkevi (Ire)** (Kahyasi {Ire}) and **Without Connexion (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest), who finished sixth, ninth and 11<sup>th</sup>, respectively, at Chantilly last time. However, both the fifth-placed Black Sam Bellamy (Ire) and Diaghilev (Ire), who was seventh behind Sulamani (Ire) that day, have subsequently let the form down at Royal Ascot this week. Khalkevi defeated Black Sam Bellamy by 3/4 of a length in the G2 Prix Hocquart over this course May 8, but he may not have as much improvement as Castle Gandolfo, who bids to add another Group 1 success to trainer Aidan O'Brien's tally. The latter may have found the French Classic coming too soon after his unplaced effort in the G1 Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs May 4, and will find this 10-furlong trip more suitable. Trainer Andre Fabre practically owns this race, having sent out eight winners since 1989, and he saddles the favourite **Shaanmer (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) this time. Unbeaten at two, he was prominent in the ante-post lists for the Epsom Derby over the winter, but did not come to hand in time for that event. He was an encouraging fifth, before being promoted to fourth, in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) over an inadequate mile at Longchamp May 12 before dead-heating for second behind Rouvres (Fr) in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly June 2.

In what will be remembered as the last race of jockey Chris McCarron's storied career, sophomore star **Came Home** will try to give the only man who's ridden him in a race a proper departure in front of the home crowd at Hollywood. The multiple Grade 1-winning speedster came into the GI Kentucky Derby off a sparkling performance in the GI Santa Anita Derby, but the dark bay found the 1 1/4 miles too much and could manage only sixth. He's been off since, but trainer Paco Gonzalez is cautiously optimistic about his return. "He's ready," the trainer said Friday. "He just breezed a half mile in :47 2/5 Tuesday with Chris. But this race will not be easy... especially when he is giving so much weight to some other good horses." Gonzalez also expressed his feelings on losing his hall-of-fame regular rider, who'll be honored with a ceremony between races at Hollywood. "It feels sad to know this is his last race," says Gonzalez. "He rides everything for us and helped me a lot. It will be very hard to find a rider to replace him. It would be nice if everything goes right on Sunday." **Came Home's** main opposition will most likely come from the blossoming **Tracemark**, who scored by a neck in the California Derby in April before finishing second to Wiseman's Ferry in the Lone Star Derby May 11.

## MCCARRON TAKES JOCKEY CHAMPIONSHIP

Just two days before his final professional ride aboard **Came Home** (Gone West) in today's Gill Affirmed H. at Hollywood Park, jockey Chris McCarron came flying down the Lone Star Park stretch Friday night to win not only the race, but also the sixth annual NTRA All-Star Jockey Championship. "There's no way you can even dream it's going to work out this good—that would be awfully greedy," the 47-year-old rider said. McCarron was aboard **Yoto Speakes** (Zuppardo's Love) in the \$55,000 allowance test; it looked like the 7-1 shot had little chance as he came into the final furlong with five still in front of him, but the eight-year-old gelding poured it on late to win by 1 1/4 lengths. "When there were only two or three horses to get by, I realized I had a chance," McCarron said. "The adrenaline was unbelievable." McCarron had also taken the first event in the four-race Championship, guiding favored **Prized Amberpro** (Aspro) to a neck victory. Overall, he earned 24 points and the first-place bonus of \$22,000. Edgar Prado was second with 18 points and Mike Smith was third with 12 points. The 12 riders in the event were guaranteed a minimum bonus of \$14,000. The sentimental choice of the crowd, McCarron was the slight 7-2 favorite in the All-Star Wager. The Hall of Famer, who retires as the leading money-winning jockey of all time, admitted he had mixed feelings about his Championship success. "I think this will make it more difficult for me on Sunday," McCarron said. "But I've made up my mind and I'm satisfied with my decision."

**MURTAGH HANGS ON FOR TROPHY**

Jockey Johnny Murtagh was not present at Royal Ascot yesterday, but he had done enough in the three days riding there to retain the London Clubs Trophy for leading rider at the meeting. Having won the G2 Queen Anne S. on **No Excuse Needed (GB)** (Machiavellian {USA}) on Tuesday, he picked up a four-day whip ban for his winning ride on **Royal Rebel (GB)** (Robellino {USA}) in Thursday's G1 Ascot Gold Cup. That decision created much furore as Murtagh will miss Sunday's G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh, but he recovered quickly by taking the G2 King Edward VII S. with **Balakheri (Ire)** (Theatrical {Ire}) and Windsor Castle S. with **Revenue (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) on Friday. Despite finishing level with Richard Hughes on four winners for the meeting, he had the edge at the end of yesterday's racing with one more fourth-placing than his rival.

**ASCOT RIDING HIGH INTO FINAL DAY**

Ascot yesterday recorded a final day attendance of 57,700, taking the week's attendance beyond the 300,000 barrier. Chief executive Douglas Erskine-Crum said yesterday: "The additional day of the meeting to celebrate the Golden Jubilee has produced our biggest-ever Saturday crowd at Ascot by far. We broke the regular four-day Royal Ascot record for attendances on the first four days, including record crowds for the Tuesday and Friday." The Tote's overall on-course cash turnover for the week was £8,298,032, compared to £7,640,012 last year.

Held up in sixth early as Yorkshire (Ire) (Generous {Ire}) and First Ballot (Ire) (Perugino {USA}) played cat-and-mouse in front, he was always travelling best of all and had closed on to the heels of the leaders on the turn into the straight. Looking for a gap between First Ballot and San Sebastian (GB) (Niniski {USA}) at the top of the straight, he was forced to move to the inner, had to quicken to catch Archduke Ferdinand, who had gone clear, but responded late to wear down that rival in the final strides. Sir Michael Stoute said of Cover Up: "He's in the Northumberland Plate [at Newcastle June 29] and I wouldn't rule that out. Two miles is a minimum trip for him."
