

KHALKEVI WINS IN PARIS

Khalkevi (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}), sent off the 5-2 second favourite, arrived fast and late to deny the 6-5 market-leader **Shaanmer (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) to win the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp yesterday in dramatic fashion. Settled in fourth early as **Foreign Accent (GB)** (Machiavellian) was sent into a clear lead, Christophe Soumillon seemed to have the favourite's run covered until his colt lost his footing on the turn into the 'false' straight. That allowed Shaanmer and Olivier Peslier first run and the duo passed the long-time leader with 500 yards remaining. Khalkevi was left with three lengths to make up, but he closed to head his rival in the shade of the post. Winning trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre was relieved afterwards, saying, "I was very happy with the way things went, as he can really quicken off a fast pace and that's what he got today, although I was very worried when he stumbled on the downhill run before the final bend." Khalkevi, a disappointing ninth last time after a troubled trip in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 2, beat Louveteau in the May 8 G2 Prix Hocquart. De Royer-Dupre left open a possible American campaign for his sophomore star. **Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West) was withdrawn after returning negative blood counts.

Jockey Chris McCarron ended his Hall of Fame career in grand style yesterday, piloting **Came Home** (Gone West) to an easy win in the GIII Affirmed H. at Hollywood Park. McCarron won two races on yesterday's card, bringing his career total to 7,141 victories and earnings of \$264,351,579. With family, friends and adoring fans cheering him on, McCarron guided **Came Home** under the wire first as track announcer Vic Stauffeur emotionally declared, "Twenty eight years of class and excellence, ladies and gentlemen, Chris McCarron."

QUEEN'S PLATE SHOCKER

A maiden win last month did little to impress the Canadian bettors much, but, with a 3/4-length win in yesterday's Queen's Plate at Woodbine, 82-1 longshot **T J's Lucky Moon** (Tejabo) proved it's not where you start, it's where you finish that counts. The dark bay gelding, who stumbled at the break, pressed the pace, outdueled **Forever Grand** (War Deputy) in the stretch and then held 11-1 shot **Anglian Prince** (Tejano Run) safe to the wire. Of his pre-race instructions from trainer Vito Armata, jockey Steve Bahen said, "Just let him be where he wants to be. And when you want him, just pick him up and call on him and he'll come running for you." The \$166 win payoff is second largest in Queen's Plate history. Maternal Pride's 1924 win in the race produced a \$193.35 payoff. **cont. p. 5**

The well-travelled Nuclear Debate, Europe's top sprinter in 2000, ran third in the Apr. 21 GIII San Simeon H. before finding his way to an American winner's circle for the first time with a one-length tally in the May 27 Beck Auto Group Turf Sprint H. at Lone Star Park last time out. Favored in the field of 14 sprinters, the gelding was allowed to settle off the early pace. He rallied between foes into the stretch and forged to the front as front-running Joe's Son Joey jumped a shadow. Nuclear Debate was drawing clear at the wire. "I was very much confident," said winning jockey David Flores. "He ran very impressive last time and I was expecting the same thing today. It got a little tight around the turn but when we came to the stretch, I was just waiting for a place to go. Then it kind of spread at the top of the stretch. I saw his [Nick Santagata] horse jump by the eighth pole. My horse was good enough to beat the other horse, but it made it easier."

Came Home began his sophomore campaign with three straight graded stakes victories, culminating with a 2 1/4-length win in the GI Santa Anita Derby, but tired to sixth in the Kentucky Derby and had been off since. Carrying jockey Chris McCarron in the Hall of Famer's final race, the colt was sent off the prohibitive 2-5 favorite. The pair raced with the early leaders, took charge on the backstretch and pulled clear down the stretch. "There is always pressure on the races," said winning trainer Paco Gonzalez. "I know that today was the last race for Chris, so I was a little more nervous. I run horses in million dollar races and today I was more nervous than any other race, believe me. I wanted Chris to go winning." The win was McCarron's 285th stakes win at Hollywood Park, tying him with Laffit Pincay for most stakes wins in track history. Of his final ride, McCarron said, "When Came Home wanted to go down the backside I allowed him to rock along. I wasn't going to sit there and try to be cute and hold him today. I just wanted to let him run his race. He felt the pressure and said, 'see ya.'" Click [here](#) to view the brisnet.com chart.

War Zone produced an impressive turn of acceleration under Olivier Peslier to win this competitive affair with ease. Last year he was pitched into the deep end in only his third start in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville in August, where he found Johannesburg too strong, finishing a respectable fifth. Making light work of the Listed Prix Zeddaan at Maisons-Laffitte the following month, he found a slowly run G3 Prix Eclipse against him when third at the track in early October before finishing second to the highly impressive Captain Rio (GB) in the G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte later in the month. Here he was held up in fourth early as Danger Over (GB) (Warning {GB}) cut out the running. Asked to quicken inside the final 1 1/2 furlongs, his response was immediate as he swept past Cayoke and Vincent Vion in the final 50 yards for a comfortable score. "It was pleasing to see this horse win like that on his return," said Teddy Beckett, racing manager for owner Khalid Abdullah. "It is too early to say when he will run again, but he could well be a horse for some of the top races at Deauville in August."

Morozov and Olivier Peslier got the better of Suleiman and Jimmy Fortune in a thrilling finish, giving Sadler's Wells his 200th stakes winner in the process. Tracking Suleiman in second early, Morozov looked set for a convincing score as Peslier asked him to quicken to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. Suleiman found more and dug deep, however, and although he never got back in front from there, he stayed locked to Morozov all the way to the line as the pair quickened away from the staying-on Swing Wing. Previously, Morozov had followed a creditable third in the Listed Prix de Suresnes here Apr. 25 by finishing fifth behind G1 Grand Prix de Paris winner Khalkevi (Ire) in the G2 Prix Hocquart here May 8, before being promoted to fourth. He showed the benefit of that experience last time when winning a conditions event at Saint-Cloud 13 days previously. Roar of the Tiger (Storm Cat), trained by Aidan O'Brien, was withdrawn after returning negative blood counts.

War Blade tasted stakes success for the first time since his win on the dirt in the Listed Deutsches Sand Classic at Neuss in November 2000. Last year, his best efforts came when finishing fourth in the G2 Preis des Bankhaus Salem Oppenheim at Cologne in September and fifth in the G3 Grosser Preis von Dusseldorf the following month. Having finished fifth in the G3 Badener Meile at Baden Baden May 26, he bounced back to winning ways here under a determined ride from Lennart Hammer-Hansen. Racing in second early as Zollner (Ger) (Dashing Blade {GB}) cut out the running, he took command with a quarter of a mile remaining. Driven out from there, he had enough in reserve to hold the late challenge of Gorlor and Norman Richter and Pardus and Eduardo Pedroza in a tight three-way finish.

KING GEORGE PICTURE CLEARING

Grandera (Ire) (Grand Lodge) looks set to be Godolphin's representative in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 27 after his impressive success in Wednesday's G1 Prince of Wales S. at Royal Ascot. Although Godolphin have **Sakhee** (Bahri) in the 1 1/2-mile contest, he is only likely to run if the ground comes up soft at Ascot. "He [Grandera] has come out of the race and he will most likely make his next start in the King George, provided the ground is right," trainer Saeed bin Suroor told *Gulf News*. "He's entered in most of the big middle-distance races and the King George is one of them. But, it's still a month away and we'll have to wait and see what happens. The main concern is to ensure he stays fit and healthy, and happy." Meanwhile, Saturday's G2 Hardwicke S. winner **Zindabad (Fr)** (Shirley Heights {GB}) has been trimmed to 14-1 from 20-1 for the King George after support with William Hill yesterday.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

June 24, 1893...The field for the American Derby at Washington Park was held at the post for 1 hour and 40 minutes, the **longest pre-race delay in history**. Boundless, with "Snapper" Garrison aboard, won the \$49,500 race, which was witnessed by a crowd of 48,000. Garrison and three other riders were each fined \$250 for bad conduct at the start.

June 24, 1952...Jockey **Eddie Arcaro** rode his 3000th career winner at Arlington Park, becoming the first American-born rider to reach the mark.

June 24, 1973...**Charlie Whittingham** swept the top three spots in the Hollywood Gold Cup Invitational Handicap when his trainees Kennedy Road, Quack and Cougar II finished first, second and third, respectively.

June 24, 1977...**Alydar**, at odds of 2.10-1, broke his maiden by 6 3/4-lengths at Belmont Park.

June 24, 1979...**Affirmed**, ridden by Laffit Pincay Jr., became the first horse to top \$2 million in earnings after he won the Hollywood Gold Cup.

T J's Lucky Moon failed to hit the board in four sprints, but he graduated when stretched out to 1 1/16 miles for a May 25 Woodbine maiden race. Looking to go two-for-two in two-turn races, the gelding turned back the challenge of Forever Grand at midstretch and then held off the late-closing Anglian Prince for a 3/4-length victory. "I had the freshest horse in the bunch," commented winning trainer Vito Armata, who added that T J's Lucky Moon will likely start next in the second leg of Canada's Triple Crown, the July 21 Prince of Wales S. "Anything can happen. That's why it's horse racing," Armata added.
