VAL ROYAL; NEXT STOP, AUSTRALIA

Last year's GI Breeders' Cup Mile champion **Val Royal (Fr)** (Royal Academy--Vadlava {Fr}, by Bikala {Ire}) has changed course and will now stand in Australia for the upcoming Southern Hemisphere season instead of South Africa as was originally planned. The six-year-old

stallion is scheduled to arrive at Eliza Park Stud near Kerrie in central Victoria at the end of this month where he will stand for A\$17,600, GST included. Eliza Park also announced that the stallion may shuttle to Britain for the 2003 Northern Hemisphere season. Purchased

Anyone who has ever watched a documentary about wild horses will know that the right to breed is won only by those stallions capable of overcoming the challenges of all the other contenders. To do so, the stallion requires a combination of speed, endurance, great physical strength and an indomitable spirit--pretty much the same qualities, you would think, that it takes for any colt to become a Grade I winner.

However, one has to wonder whether racing still represents a process of survival of the fittest. Because of developments in veterinary science, a horse can have its crooked limbs corrected by such methods as transphyseal bridging or periosteal stripping; it can have its respiratory problems remedied by surgery; and, in some regions, physical problems can be masked by medicating the horse with Bute and Lasix.

Owners can hardly be blamed for resorting to such methods when they are perfectly legal. After all, why write off an expensively produced commodity if its defects can be rectified? The problem arises when horses, which have become major winners with the help of veterinary intervention, are retired to stud.

Craig Bendoroff, asked to comment on transphyseal bridging and periosteal stripping in *The Blood-Horse* a few years ago: "It's cosmetic surgery to make them sell better. But there are two sides to the coin. We're also doing it to make them sounder racehorses. Without it, a lot of times their chances would be nil. We also do these procedures on horses that we know aren't going to the sales ring to enhance their athletic careers.

"In my mind, the only question that could arise involves genetics. People might not know what they are getting genetically with a filly they want to breed or a horse they want to stand as a stallion. We're fooling with the gene pool. It's an argument people can use, and it's a valid one."

Unfortunately, it could be in the interests of a stallion's owners to keep quiet about any past problems suffered by their major winner and this is a potential minefield for the breeder. I'm pleased to say that this accusation can't be levelled at the connections of the four-year-old Malhub, who sprang a 16-1 surprise in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. on the final day of Royal Ascot.

Even after Malhub had made a winning debut at Newmarket at two, his trainer John Gosden commented enigmatically that, "I'm very pleased he's won, as life hasn't been that easy for him."

The Kingmambo colt has reportedly had two wind operations, but his record now stands at four wins from seven starts and his connections are reaping the rewards of their decision to try him over six furlongs this year after concentrating on seven furlongs and a mile in previous seasons. Malhub was having his first race for nearly eight months when he broke Yarmouth's six-furlong record on June 13, and now he has become his sire's seventh Group 1 winner from five crops aged three or over.

If Malhub continues in this type of form, breeders will have to decide how much importance to attach to his wind problem, weighing it against his considerable speed and his excellent bloodlines. While a wind problem may not be desirable in a stallion prospect, there have been some highly successful stallions which had question-marks hanging over their wind.

There were certainly no doubts about Kingmambo's soundness of wind. He had a busy season by European standards as a two-year-old, racing seven times, and was again given a thorough testing at three, when he won three Group 1 events (and twice came out on top in three-way photo finishes).

I guess that Malhub's dam, Arjuzah, was also clear-winded, because she started her broodmare career with consecutive visits to Dayjur, a horse who showed his brilliant best only after he had had the *Hobday* wind operation.

Arjuzah was a seven-furlong specialist by the high-class sprinter Ahonoora, so it isn't so surprising that Malhub--a grandson of Mr. Prospector--is proving so well suited by six furlongs. Malhub's third dam, Fair Darling, was bred in Europe, but has made her mark on American racing through her daughter Affaire d'Amour, who produced the Grade I winners Mourjane, winner of the Arlington H. and Sword Dancer H. victress Anka Germania. Anka Germania in turn became the dam of the very talented Deputy Commander.

Malhub is very fashionably bred, but the same couldn't be said of his fourth dam, Fair Astronomer. This Irish-bred daughter of Star Gazer appeared to have so little going for her as a yearling that she failed to find a buyer at the sales. There must have been a few people kicking themselves after Fair Astronomer had won six of nine juvenile starts, all over five furlongs. A change of trainers led to a change of distance at three, when Fair Astronomer won twice over 1 1/4 miles before running out an impressive winner of the Rous Memorial S. over a mile at the 1963 Royal Ascot meeting. She was a very, very good filly and she has passed on a good measure of her talent to many of her descendants, despite her working-class background.
