ROCK LIKELY TO MISS JULY CUP

Trainer Aidan O'Brien has virtually ruled out a drop back in trip for **Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill) in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 11. Despite his quote of 5-2 for the six-furlong sprint by Coral Eurobet, the colt will make his next start in the G1 Sussex S. July 31. O'Brien yesterday confirmed to *Irish Racing online* that Rock Of Gibraltar's attempt at a

record-equalling sixth successive Group 1 success would take place at the Glorious Goodwood meeting. The three-year-old followed his wins in the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas with a 1 3/4-length score in the June 18 G1 St. James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot. Overall, he has won eight of his 10 career starts.

100 GROUP/GRADED WINNERS FOR DANZIG

Sunday, June 23 marked the turn of a century. Leading active sire **Danzig** (Northern Dancer--Pas De Nom, by Admiral's Voyage) was represented by his 100th career group/graded stakes winner when **War Zone** captured the G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot at Longchamp. Just three days earlier, on Thursday at Royal Ascot, the 25-year-old Claiborne stallion was represented by his 170th career black-type winner when **Burning Sun** captured the Listed Hampton Court S.

BALAKHERI GIVEN GREEN LIGHT

Friday's impressive G2 King Edward VII S. winner **Balakheri (Ire)** (Theatrical {Ire}) will take on **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in Sunday's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh. Trainer Sir Michael Stoute has confirmed that the Royal Ascot scorer will make a quick re-appearance alongside **Princely Venture (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}). Paddy Power have introduced Balakheri, who will be partnered by jockey Pat Eddery in the absence of the suspended Johnny Murtagh, as the 13-2 joint second favourite alongside the Dermot Weld-trained **In Time's Eye (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}).

Walzerkoenigin sprang the surprise as she was delivered with a stirring late flourish at Chantilly yesterday. The filly had entered the Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) at Dusseldorf at May 12 with bright prospects, having taken the Listed Dusseldorfer Stutenpreis over that course Apr. 13, but disappointed when last of 15 on the testing ground. She rebounded next time, finishing second by a short head by La Dane (Ire) in the Listed IDEE-Festa-Rennen at Baden-Baden June 2 when back on her preferred fast surface and found those conditions in her favour again this time. Held up in fifth on the rail early as Cozy Maria (Cozzene) went to the front, she was short of room in the straight, causing her to switch wide at the quarter-mile marker. She took a while to reach top gear from there, but kept responding to her jockey's urging to wear down the long-time leader with 150 yards remaining. Pushed out from there, she was always holding **Totally Cosmic**, who stayed on in the closing stages.

WAR EMBLEM BACK ON TRACK Kentucky Derby and Preakness S. winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) breezed an easy three-eighths of a mile yesterday in :35 4/5 at Santa Anita for trainer Bob Baffert. It was the dark bay's first official work since his eighth-place finish to Sarava in the GI Belmont S. June 8. "He went really nice," the conditioner told *The Blood-Horse*. "He was sharp and wanted to do a lot more." Baffert has yet to map out a summer campaign for the colt, owned by Prince Ahmed Salman's The Thoroughbred Corporation, but did mention a possible return sometime during the upcoming meet at Del Mar. "The [GI] Pacific Classic is one possibility," Baffert told *The Blood-Horse*. "We have a lot of options. We just don't know which way we're going with him yet."

Victory Ride Nears Return:

Victory Ride (Seeking the Gold), off since finishing third in the May 18 GII Shuvee H., is expected to return to trainer Rusty Arnold's barn July 1. After winning last year's GI Test S., the four-year-old filly was sidelined nine months with a fractured right foreleg. Arnold noticed she was not right after her Shuvee run and sent her to Rood and Riddle equine clinic. "The x-rays and everything came back clean, but she wasn't hitting the ground the way she was and she's always been an excellent mover," Arnold explained. "Dr. [Larry] Bramlage assured me that her previous injury and surgery had nothing to do with this problem. We gave her three weeks off and she should be back at the barn July 1. We'll take it one step at a time when she comes back and if she's not right, we'll retire her." Victory Ride has hit the board in all six of her career starts to date, with four victories and earnings of \$338,031.

Buddha Works:

GI Wood Memorial winner **Buddha** (Unbridled's Song) worked six furlongs over the Oklahoma training track at Saratoga Monday in 1:16. The colt, scratched from the Kentucky Derby with a bruised foot, is expected to start next in the July 7 GII Dwyer S. "Everything looks great," trainer James Bond said yesterday. "The main goal is the [Aug. 24 GI] Travers and right now we're looking at the Dwyer and either the [Aug. 4 GI] Haskell or [Aug. 4 GII] Jim Dandy. In the first week back of training, he got back to where he needs to be."

Exchange Rate Stud Fee Lowered:

Exchange Rate (Danzig--Sterling Pound, by Seeking the Gold), who stood his first season this year at Padua Stables near Ocala, Florida, will stand the 2003 season for \$7,500. "We are very pleased Exchange Rate has a full book of 70 mares for this year," said Padua's General Manager Nadia Sanan. "However, we feel that lowering his stud fee will allow more breeders the opportunity to utilize this exceptional son of Danzig in their breeding program. The reduction is also retroactive for 2002 breeders." The five-year-old began his stud career for \$10,000. Exchange Rate captured the 2001 GII Tom Fool H.

Coa Rides Five Winners at Monmouth:

Jockey Eibar Coa, who led Jose Ferrer by one victory going into yesterday's action, put some distance between the two when he booted home five of his seven mounts on Wednesday's card at Monmouth Park. Coa was victorious in the second and third races of the afternoon with a pair of odds-on favorites before riding the winners of races six through eight. The 'Eibar' Pick Three returned \$31.60. He has now ridden 30 winners from 116 mounts during the current meet.

Aramram started his career in a Doncaster maiden Mar. 21 before winning the Listed Thirk Classic Trial Apr. 20 and finishing sixth in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4. Sponsors Coral Eurobet make trainer Aidan O'Brien's **Hawk Wing (USA)** (Woodman {USA}) their 4-5 favourite, with Godolphin's **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge {USA}) and **Noverre (USA)** (Rahy {USA}) next best at 9-4 and 5-1, respectively. Sir Michael Stoute's G2 Queen Anne S. winner **No Excuse Needed (GB)** (Machiavellian {USA}) is quoted at 8-1, while the David Elsworth-trained **Indian Creek (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) at 10-1. Simon Clare, spokesman for the firm, said: "Hawk Wing has already finished second in two classics this season and will be well backed to make it third-time lucky. The Eclipse is the first clash of the generations, and Hawk Wing will be tested to the full by the likes of Noverre and No Excuse Needed. The Eclipse roll of honour features some of the truly great racehorses--Dancing Brave, Nashwan, Mtoto to name but a few--and we are extremely proud of our long and rewarding association with this great race." Andrew Cooper, director of racing at United Racecourses, commented: "The Sandown Park going is currently good to firm and watering is continuing to maintain it at that."
