### CASHIER'S DREAM UNDERGOES SURGERY

Grade I winner **Cashier's Dream** (Service Stripe) is in serious condition after undergoing emergency surgery for a severe colic attack. The Michigan-bred breezed five-eighths with stablemate Easyfromthegitgo in 1:00 4/5 at Churchill Tuesday morning, but began showing signs of discomfort after returning to the barn and was



sent to the Hagyard-Davidson-McGee equine clinic, where eight to 10 feet of her small intestine were removed. "She's in very serious condition and is by no means out of the woods," said trainer Steve

Asmussen. "But she appeared to be a lot stronger [Wednesday] and hopefully she's on

her way back." Purchased privately by Team Valor after winning her first two starts last year, the chestnut filly broke Churchill's track record for 5 1/2 furlongs in winning the GIII Debutante S. in 1:02 2/5 July 7. She then lost by a neck to You in the GII Adirondack S., but bounced back to take the GI Spinaway S. by six lengths Aug. 31. In her lone start this season, Cashier's Dream was a game winner of the GIII La Troienne at Churchill May 2. "If she can live through it, she'll be fine," Asmussen added. "I just want her to live. She's done nothing but give me joy."

**Caller One** (Phone Trick) may be supplemented for the G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket July 11. Withdrawn from last Saturday's G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot with a throat infection, he is expected to make a quick recovery. "There was some mucus down his throat," said Jim Chapman Sr., part-owner and father of trainer Jim Chapman Jr. "It was a very simple problem, and despite his illness, he is fit and in very good condition. He trains well on the turf, but we'll wait and see before deciding what race would be next for him."

**WELD'S WEATHER WATCH** Dermot Weld was yesterday hoping for continued drying of the ground at The Curragh ahead of Sunday's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby. Weld saddles **In Time's Eye (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}), who was a length second to **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) while receiving seven pounds in the G3 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial at Leopardstown May 12 and is considered Weld's best chance in this one. The trainer will also send **Jazz Beat (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) to post. "High Chaparral is 1-4 for Sunday and should win," Weld told *Irish Racing online*. "Being realistic, I think he will be very hard to beat. But, if the ground turned fast, that might suit my horse better than a Sadler's Wells. In Time's Eye loves quick ground, and he does have another gear. High Chaparral has probably improved another seven pounds which means we have to improve 14 pounds to catch up. In Time's Eye has improved, but I don't know if he has improved that much. Jazz Beat is in super form, too, and will run a good race." Pat Smullen will ride In Time's Eye, with Pat Shanahan on Jazz Beat. The ground at The Curragh yesterday was officially "good to yielding." Weld also confirmed last Tuesday's G3 Coventry S. runner-up **Pakhoes (Ire)** (College Chapel {GB}) would make a quick return in Sunday's G3 Railway S. on the Irish Derby undercard. Weld said, "Pakhoes is a very decent horse, and hopefully he will go and win one now. He is adaptable, so the ground should not be a problem."

**SCORPION TO VINERY** Vinery Kentucky has announced that **Scorpion** (Seattle Slew--Petiteness, by Chief's Crown) will enter stud in 2003 at the Lexington, Kentucky farm. A stud fee has not yet been announced. A \$490,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase, Scorpion won at first asking as a two-year-old and went on to place in four graded stakes that year, including a second in the GII Saratoga Special S. and a third in the GI Futurity. At three the bay colt captured the GI Jim Dandy S., defeating A P Valentine and Congaree. He has not started since being eased in February's GII Strub S. Scorpion concludes his career with a record of 19-4-1-3 and earnings of \$555,749.

**Morluc for a Mile?**

One of the nation's leading turf sprinters, **Morluc** (Housebuster) will attempt to stretch his speed out to a mile in the GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. July 4 at Churchill. The six-year-old captured the GIII Aegon Turf Sprint last year and ran his record to six wins in eight starts over the Churchill lawn in winning a tough money allowance June 15. Trainer Randy Morse had been invited to bring Morluc to Newmarket for the G1 Darley July Cup, but opted for this spot instead. "I'm going to give him a break after this is over until early fall," Morse said. "They're wanting us to bring him over to Newmarket, but that's a lot of hauling. I'd rather keep him here because he loves this turf and he has won going long here." Though he has been campaigned exclusively over sprint distances since 2000, Morluc won a pair of two-turn allowances at Churchill as a three-year-old. He has been the runner-up in the last two renewals of the \$1-million Hong Kong Sprint and that newly Group 1 event is his main goal this year.

**Cooksey Second In Return to Competition:**

Jockey Patty Cooksey, one of only two female jockeys to ride 2,000 winners in her career, returned to the saddle on Wednesday after battling breast cancer for over nine months. The 44-year-old guided Gold Empress to a runner-up finish in the fourth race for \$30,000 maiden claimers, but it might as well have been the Kentucky Derby, according to Cooksey. "This is the best," she said. "After 9 1/2 months off, I feel good, my legs feel good and I got a nice blow, kind of a nice workout. I think it was a good start." The native of Youngstown, Ohio, was diagnosed with breast cancer last September and subsequently underwent a mastectomy and reconstructive surgery. She began preparations for a return to the saddle by working horses over the winter at Churchill and this spring at Keeneland.

**Seabiscuit Trophy Donated to Museum:**

The winning trophy from Seabiscuit's victory in the 1938 Agua Caliente H., stolen in the early 1950s, has been recovered and donated by the Howard Estate to the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame in Saratoga Springs, New York. The theft occurred in 1952-1953 when Seabiscuit owner Charles Howard's widow Marcela sent several trophies to be cleaned. When the items were unpacked, it was discovered that the Agua Caliente trophy, as well as three Buick auto racing trophies, had gone missing. In 2001, Laura Hillenbrand, author of *Seabiscuit: An American Legend*, found the Agua Caliente trophy for sale on eBay and notified the seller that it had been stolen. The item was promptly removed, but seller and trophy disappeared. In August 2001, a visitor to the museum approached curator Lori Fisher to see if it would be interested in purchasing the trophy. Noticing that it was the stolen article, Fisher notified authorities, who encouraged Fisher to pursue negotiations. Prior to completing the "sale", the seller shipped the trophy to the museum, at which time it was confiscated by the FBI, which conducted a thorough investigation. The U.S. Attorney's Office recently concluded that the trophy rightfully belonged to the Howard family heirs, who in turn decided to donate it to the museum. No one has ever been prosecuted for the theft of the Agua Caliente trophy and the three Buick trophies have never been recovered.

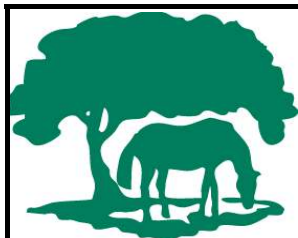

**COCHRANE SUES OVER 2000 PLANE CRASH**

A lawsuit was filed yesterday on behalf of former jockey Ray Cochrane against Sheikh Mohammed's Godolphin Racing and the estate of the late pilot Patrick Mackey. The suit states that Cochrane is entitled to more than £50,000 in lost wages and personal suffering due to injuries he incurred while pulling jockey Frankie Dettori to safety when the plane in which they were flying crashed. Cochrane also attempted to save the life of Mackey, who was employed by Godolphin and flying the Seneca III aircraft that went down shortly after take-off from Newmarket June 1, 2000, but was unable to reach the ill-fated pilot through the burning fuselage. Cochrane was hospitalized for seven months following the accident and claims he was forced to retire from injuries sustained in the crash. The lawsuit alleges that Godolphin allowed an insufficiently trained pilot to fly in unfavorable weather conditions. Cochrane's lawyer, Richard Brooks, indicated the lawsuit was filed to protect the ex-rider against the two-year statute of limitations to claim in air crashes. A statement by Godolphin expressed sympathy for Cochrane, but denied any wrongdoing in the incident.
