"Frank [trainer Alexander] said to let the others go and ride her like you were coming from behind in a sprint race."

### THE HIGH, THE MIGHTY

Ballydoyle trainer Aidan O'Brien, who has so far sent out the winners of four European Classics in 2002, looks to G1 Epsom Derby winner **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) to make it five in this afternoon's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh. Unbeaten since his debut in a Punchestown maiden last September, the dual Group 1 winner is likely to be sent off the shortest-priced favourite since El Gran Senor scored at odds of 2-7 in 1984. Having beaten stable companion Hawk Wing by two lengths at Epsom June 8, High Chaparral bids to become the 12th colt to complete the English-Irish Derby double in over the last 30 years, including Sinnar (Ire) and Galileo (Ire) in 2000 and 2001, respectively. He heads a team of four representing his trainer, including **Ballingarry (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who may be the best of the others based on his unlucky runner-up finish to Rakti (GB) in the G1 Derby Italiano in Rome May 26.

### Hoping for an Upset...

Trainer Dermot Weld, who won this with Zagreb in 1996, will bid to prevent another Ballydoyle one-two here with **In Time's Eye (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) and **Jazz Beat (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}). In Time's Eye, still a maiden, was a one-length runner-up to High Chapparral in G3 Derrinstown Derby Trial at Leopardstown May 12, but was in receipt of seven pounds that afternoon and will struggle to finish as close this time. Sir Michael Stoute has decided to add a sporting challenge to this Classic by confirming the impressive Haydock maiden winner **Princely Venture (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}) and last week's G2 King Edward VII S. scorer **Balakheri (Ire)** (Theatrical {Ire}). The latter bids to emulate Stoute's Shareef Dancer, who in 1983 became the last to follow his Royal Ascot score with an Irish Derby victory. He bids to provide Stoute with his fourth Irish Derby following the exploits of Shareef Dancer, Shergar (GB) (1981) and Shahrastani (1986). Pat Eddery, who takes the ride on the improving colt, is another looking to add to an impressive tally after winning this with Grundy (Ire) in 1975, El Gran Senor in 1984, Law Society in 1985 and Commander In Chief (GB) in 1993. *Field, p5*

Astra cemented her claim as the nation's leading turf distaffer in winning her second straight GI Beverly Hills H. Sidelined after a disappointing ninth at 3-5 in the GI Beverly D. S. last August, the bay mare started 2002 off with a third in the GII Santa Ana H. Mar. 23 before rallying to take the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 20. She came flying to win the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. May 27 and was sent off as the prohibitive chalk to run her skein to three. Away alertly, Astra settled into second as Snowflake (Caerleon) opened up a lonely lead, but began to reel that filly in on the far turn. She came wide into the stretch with a length advantage and had to dig in to deny the challenge of German invader Peu a Peu along the rail, setting a new stakes record. "Last time [in the Gamely], I might have sat too long," remarked winning rider Kent Desormeaux. "This time, I may have moved too soon, I don't know. But she keeps getting me there first. That's the bottom line, and it's all Astra. She idled when she made the lead. But when the other horse collared her 100 yards out, she maintained her advantage. For all of those who think she's only got an eighth of a mile run, she sprinted a half a mile today." Winning trainer Laura de Seroux said that she would consider the GI Ramona H. at Del Mar July 27 for Astra's next outing, but indicated that a return trip to the GI Beverly D. at Arlington Aug. 17 was the more likely option for the six-year-old.

Trainer Shug McGaughey, who underwent triple bypass surgery June 13, wasn't on hand to saddle Atelier, but he had to be feeling better after his mare outfinished favorite Summer Colony here. "Shug is home watching and I'm sure he's pleased," said McGaughey's assistant trainer, Buzzy Tenney. He'd have to be. Atelier hadn't won a race in nearly 15 months and was coming off a disappointing fifth in the May 18 GII Shuvee H. at Belmont. Summer Colony, a winner in seven of her last eight starts, was the crowd's choice and America's leading distaff money earner Spain was the second favorite. Ignoring the tote board, Atelier moved through an opening along the rail to take the lead from Spain as they raced down the backstretch. She cruised through moderate fractions with the two favorites just off her tail and held off the final bid of the runner-up for the score. Jockey John Velazquez, who helicoptered down from Belmont Park for the mount on Summer Colony, said, "She wasn't on the bridle the way I thought she would be at the beginning of the race, but she ran hard the whole way around and still race a good race." Spain, who was bred to Storm Cat six weeks ago, never offered a challenge. Her jockey Jorge Chavez, shared the ride from New York with Velazquez. "She broke good and I had a perfect trip," he said. "I just didn't have the horse today when I called on her." Atelier becomes the fifth Molly Pitcher winner for McGaughey, who also sent out champions Personal Ensign and Inside Information to take the race. She will be pointed for the Grade I race named for Personal Ensign at Saratoga Aug. 23.

Having opened her season with victory in the Listed Dahlia S. at Newmarket May 3, Tarfshi was a shade disappointing when last of four runners in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown June 4. She made amends for that effort here and scored her most important career win to date for a pillar-to-post success, with jockey Philip Robinson once again proving the master of tactical pace. Tarfshi was sent straight to the front upon flagfall and continued to set a steady pace in advance of Kournakova (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) until reaching the home turn. Robinson's plan of kicking his mount further ahead once into the stretch run proved a decisive one, effectively sealing success in the final stages of the race. Tarfshi was still two lengths to the good entering the final furlong as Wrong Key made her bid, but the latter's effort was in vain as the eventual winner held enough in reserve to withstand that challenge for a game win. "Tarfshi is very genuine and she doesn't like being passed," Robinson told *Racing Post*. "I knew it would take something special to catch her when I kicked for home after the others had allowed me an easy lead early in the race."

A Triple Crown nominee, Mr. Mellon may have found his future on the turf with this impressive effort. The \$950,000 Keeneland September yearling went straight from his Gulfstream maiden victory to winning Turfway's Rushaway S. Mar. 23, but faltered to sixth in the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 13 and was given some time off. The dark bay colt made his turf debut in the GIII Jefferson Cup June 8; after getting caught five wide on the far turn, he was outfinished by Orchard Park and had to settle for second. A grandson of Broodmare of the Year Glowing Tribute, herself a very good turf runner, Mr. Mellon settled into a ground-saving position in midfield as San Francisco shipper Cappuchino (Capote) set the pace, with Doc Holiday in second. Still skimming the rail turning for home, Mr. Mellon was in tight quarters in midstretch, but was deftly angled out by Rene Douglas, split horses and accelerated nicely to nip Doc Holiday at the wire. Winning trainer Elliott Walden is planning a dual-surface future for his charge. "I'd like to keep both avenues open," said Walden. "He definitely has a turf pedigree. We'll point next for the Jim Dandy [GII, 9f, dirt, Aug. 4]. We're not coming back for the American Derby [July 21], but I expect to be back for the [GI] Secretariat S. [Aug. 17, turf]."

Orientate showcased his speed over a sloppy strip at Keeneland in winning the GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup H. Apr. 14, but switched to the turf for his next two outings. Ninth by 3 3/4 lengths in the GIII Aegon Turf Sprint May 3, he missed third by a nose in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile May 27. Back on the main track this time, the dark bay colt came out running, joined by No Armistice as the pair opened up nine lengths on the field through a half in :44.42. Orientate shook free as they straightened away into the stretch and began to open up, crossing the line as much the best. The time was a new stakes record and just .07 seconds off the track record. "He's a fast horse and he loves to sprint," said Mike Maker, assistant to winning trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "When I saw that he had his ears pinned when they were in the backstretch, I knew he was going to be tough to beat. He's every bit as talented as any sprinter. We're pointing him to Calder's Summit of Speed [\$400,000 Smile Sprint H., July 13]." The winner of the last two renewals of the Aristides, Bet On Sunshine (Bet Big) appears to have lost the edge from his powerful late kick at age 10, finishing fourth at 3-1. "I thought he ran pretty good," said his rider Calvin Borel. "Those horses just didn't come back. But he's getting old and, like I told Paul [trainer McGee], it might take more than a race or two to get this horse back to his game."

Zavata started his career in the Three Chimneys Juvenile S. on Derby Day at Churchill Downs and found just one better, the talented filly Holiday Runner. The bay came back against fellow maidens, cruising to a 5 1/2-length victory at Belmont May 27, and was odds-on with a return to stakes company. He tracked front-running Hussar while on the bit down the backstretch, floated four-wide around the final bend and collared the pacesetter as they hit the stretch before powering away to a handy score. "He's doing everything right--all I have to do is keep him healthy and sound," trainer Patrick Biancone said. "This horse can do anything--he's a star for sure." As for what's next, Biancone said, "We'll want to give him a little break now. We'll aim for the Saratoga Special [GII, Saratoga, Aug. 14] and the Hopeful [GI, Saratoga, Aug. 31]." Jockey Jerry Bailey, winning the Tremont for the fourth time, added, "I asked him to run hard from the quarter pole to the eighth pole and then I kind of idled on him. He's got a lot of talent...I don't know how far he wants to run." The final time for the 5 1/2 furlongs, 1:02 3/5, was one tick off the track and stakes record set by More Than Ready in 1999. Zavata's victory created a minus show pool of \$45,022.21.

**TAKE THAT Oh Take (Brz)** (Latin American), the runner-up in the G1 Estrellas Juvenile last year, made his debut under Nelson Bunker Hunt's colors a winning one, taking the G1 Gran Premio Estrellas Classic at Palermo yesterday by a decisive 2 1/2 lengths. The three-year-old was the only foreign-bred to hit the board on a day understandably dominated by Argentine-bred runners. He was coming off a five-length victory in the G2 Otono June 8. But Haras La Providencia, who sold Oh Take just before Las Estrellas, had reason to celebrate when their undefeated two-year-old **Freddy (Arg)** (Roy) captured the G1 Gran Premio Estrellas Juvenile by an emphatic four lengths. A six-length maiden winner in his May 17 debut, the colt was nevertheless let go at 11-1 and came home as the biggest longshot on the Estrellas card. Jockey Antonio Rivero, victorious aboard Freddy in the Juvenile, came back to take the G1 Gran Premio Estrellas Sprint with **Mister Phone (Arg)** (Speakerphone). The four-year-old had captured the G1 Gran Premio Estrellas Junior Sprint at two. This year's Estrellas Junior Sprint went to **Chollo (Arg)** (Roy), who was making his stakes debut after posting his maiden victory Apr. 27. The more accomplished **Miss Terrible (Arg)** (Numerous) picked up her fourth straight Group 1 win in the G1 Gran Premio Estrellas Juvenile Fillies, beating stablemate **Virginia Fitz (Arg)** (Fitzcarraldo {Arg}) by a length. In the race for the older fillies, the G1 Gran Premio Estrellas Distaff, four-year-old **Tanganyika (Arg)** (Interprete {Arg}) bounced back from a fourth-place finish in a Group 3 event May 18, where she finished 31 lengths behind winner **D'Ohana (Arg)** (Candy Stripes), to turn the tables on that three-year-old with a four-length victory.

She bids to become the first filly to win this event since User Friendly (GB), who was also runner-up in the previous year's Arc, ended the drought for her sex in 1993. Her case is strengthened by the fact that since 1991 seven winners of this had fought out the finish in the previous year's Arc. Last year's G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) winner, Anabaa Blue bids to emulate Montjeu (Ire) in adding to his success in that Chantilly Classic. He bounced back from his Ganay run by taking the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly June 9 by 1 1/2 lengths from **Ange Gabriel**, but needs to better his best to have an impact here. **Califet**, fourth on that occasion under a five-pound penalty, should reverse that form and can follow the favourite home.

He had previously impressed when winning the G3 Grosser Preis der Bremer Wirtschaft Apr. 7 and G2 Gerling-Preis May 5 at Cologne in contrasting conditions. On the former occasion he gave Simoun five pounds and a two-length beating before extending that superiority in the Gerling-Preis. Albaran has finished runner-up in the last two renewals of this contest and must come into the reckoning again this time.

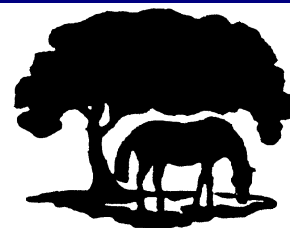

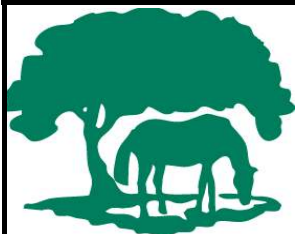
