

### TEAM BALLYDOYLE RIDING HIGH

It's becoming routine. Trainer Aidan O'Brien and Team Ballydoyle sent out yet another Classic one-two-three yesterday, with **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) leading home the charge in the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh.

Sent off at 1-3, High Chaparral was the shortest-price winner of the race since El Gran Senor scored at 2-7 in 1984. The colt was never in danger once he hit the front under Michael Kinane inside the final furlong, lengthening away from stable companions **Sholokhov (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), an unconsidered 200-1 shot, and **Ballingarry (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and Richard Hannon's **Nysaeen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) to provide the champion sire with the first four finishers.

"They are very genuine, very sound and have plenty of class," O'Brien, praising the progeny of Sadler's Wells, said. "They seem to have everything and they get better and better with every month of the year."

### Following in Galileo's Hoofsteps...

Having won the G1 Racing Post Trophy in October, High Chaparral has traveled the same route as Galileo this term, taking the Listed Ballysax S. Apr. 14 and G3 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial May 12 at Leopardstown before winning the Epsom Classic June 8. That day he proved two lengths too strong for stable companion Hawk Wing on rain-softened ground and the elements favoured him again here as persistent rain preceded the race. Held up in fourth early while traveling strongly as Sholokhov cut out a true gallop, he moved closer on the turn into the straight before being brought wide for his challenge inside the final quarter of a mile. As the long-time leader turned back the bid of Ballingarry, Michael Kinane asked the favourite to lengthen on the outside and he responded to cut down his stable companion with 175 yards remaining. Pushed out from there, he powered away for a convincing success. "He's a lovely lightweight horse and has serious ability and he's done it very easily," Kinane said. "He was cruising through the race--he's never cruised as good. He jumped beautifully and I was in where I wanted to be in an uncomplicated position...I just let him coast there. I had a little look around and as soon as I did he took advantage of me, so I asked him to go on." Owner Michael Tabor added, "It was a great performance--what we had hoped for--and he just exuded class. What a training performance." Planning a different campaign for the second half of the season than he mapped out for Galileo, O'Brien will give High Chaparral a break before preparing him for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 6 and possibly the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf at Arlington Oct. 26. "We felt, with Galileo, that we kept him going too long last year," O'Brien said.

### The Triple Double...

High Chaparral became the third three-year-old in succession to complete the English-Irish Derby double, following Sinndar (Ire) and Galileo (Ire), and the 15th overall to add The Curragh version to the Epsom Classic. He also provided O'Brien with his third Irish Derby after Desert King (Ire) in 1997 and Galileo last year, and his fifth European Classic of 2002.

Ange Gabriel caused a major upset under an enterprising ride from Thierry Jarnet, beating fellow outsider Polish Summer and the 7-10 favourite Aquarelliste.

Tracking the rabbit Virginian (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}) in second through the majority of the race, the winner took over with quarter of a mile remaining before

lengthening into a decisive advantage from there. Polish Summer and Aquarelliste quickened inside the final furlong, but they had been left with too much to do as

Ange Gabriel pulled out more to seal the victory. The hero of the Listed Prix Lord Seymour at Longchamp Mar. 31, Ange Gabriel has been on the board in his three starts since, most recently running second to

Anabaa Blue (Anabaa) in the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly June 9. "This is a really nice horse who has only now reached full maturity," winning trainer Eric Libaud said.

"It looks like he will be a horse for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [Oct. 6], but whether he runs in between depends on how he comes out of this--when they race on this fast ground you never know." Aquarelliste was

very reluctant at the start, causing a considerable delay before traveling strongly in fourth in the early stages. She was switched to the outer with 2 1/2 furlongs

remaining, but could never make an impression on the leader, failing to prize second from the determined Polish Summer. "Maybe she was beaten because I

didn't give the right instructions to Dominique Boeuf," trainer Elie Lellouche said. "I never thought the pace-maker was good enough to go that far, particularly on his first run of the year, and if I had anticipated that I

would have told him to follow him more closely."

Francois Rohaut, trainer of the smart Turtle Bow (Fr), unveiled another talented three-year-old filly as Pearly Shells outbattled the tough Ana Marie in the closing stages to take this competitive contest. Last time, she showed she was capable of pitting her wits at the stakes level with a smooth score in the Listed La Coupe des Pouliches de Marseille May 29, and she did not disappoint connections here under a determined ride from Christophe Soumillon. Held up in fourth place early as Marie du Val (Fr) (Valanour {Ire}) cut out the running, she made steady progress to challenge at the top of the straight as the pack tightened. Quickening to hit the front with 400 yards remaining, she was asked her for maximum effort to hold Ana Marie under a strong Davy Bonilla drive and responded in game fashion to maintain her advantage all the way to the line. "She is very nice and hasn't stopped improving since the spring," commented Rohaut. "Being by Efisio, I was concerned about her stamina, but she proved here that she can handle the trip. We have to think about the G1 Prix Vermeille [Longchamp, Sept. 15] now, and I will take her to Deauville in early August to spend a month there. Depending on how she comes out of this and whether she is well enough, I will think about running her in the G3 Prix de la Nonette there Aug. 25."

Simoun made all in the very testing conditions here and turned down the game challenge of Well Made to collect his second Group success. Last time out, he had that rival back in fourth in the G2 Grosser Mercedes-Benz-Preis at Baden-Baden June 2. That effort reversed the form of the G3 Grosser Preis der Bremer Wirtschaft at Cologne Apr. 7, in which he was runner-up, and of the G2 Gerling-Preis at that track May 5, where he could not land a blow, finishing fourth. Taken to the front early by Andreas Suborics this time, he travelled easily before being asked to lengthen in the straight. Pushed out to hold Well Made, who had been brought with a strong challenge by Andreas Helfenbein, he always had the call in the closing stages and stayed on well for the victory.

Aidan O'Brien unleashed another potential Classic performer as Hold That Tiger turned down the challenge of the game Pakhoes to maintain his unbeaten record. Ballydoyle became synonymous with this race in the days of Vincent O'Brien and, thanks to the exploits of Aidan O'Brien, the Tipperary outfit has again laid claim to it, with Hold That Tiger becoming the fifth winner for his trainer in the last six years. Twelve months ago, Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) emulated King of Kings (Ire) by becoming the second representative to win this en route to 2000 Guineas success. Hold That Tiger became the latest to excite the ante-post market for that Classic as he added to his debut Leopardstown maiden score June 12. Settled in second early by Michael Kinane as stable companion Newfoundland (Storm Cat) cut out the running, he was moved up to take command with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before holding the spirited Pakhoes in the closing stages under considerate handling. "It was a very big jump for him," O'Brien said. "He ran very green in his maiden and I thought Pakhoes would be very hard to beat, but he has a lot of speed and answered the call. I liked that about him." Hold That Tiger earned a 16-1 quote from Paddy Power for the next year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. Pakhoes heads to the G2 Gimcrack S. at York Aug. 21.

For example, 37.5% of the cost of a yearling purchased at a July 2002 sale can be written off in 2002, more than three times the amount allowed under the old rules. A Listed stakes winner in France last November, Inesperado had started twice in his native country this term, finishing fifth in a Listed event at Cagnes-sur-Mer Feb. 24 and second in the Listed Prix Montenica at Maisons-Laffitte Mar. 12. The bay was making his U.S. debut in his first start since his French finale. Sent off the second choice off solid Hollywood trials, he trailed the field through the opening half, saved ground around the turn and was crying for running room as they raced down the stretch. Jockey Kent Desormeaux steadied the colt as he waited for an opening inside the odds-on entry of Regiment and Johar, finally gunning him through a seam on the rail to get up in the final strides. "This is a very brave horse," Desormeaux said. "I sent him for an anticipated hole and he aimed for it before there was room. He's a brave little guy, but also very talented. That was a very, very nice horse in front of him that he caught." It was a bittersweet victory as Inesperado's owner, Audrey Skirball-Kenis, died June 19 at the age of 87. **KING'S BEST RECOVERING FROM SURGERY**

**King's Best** (Kingmambo), who underwent surgery to the off-fore he fractured in the 2000 G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh, was yesterday reported to be making a good recovery. However, Darley Stud confirmed that the stallion will not shuttle to Australia, where he was due to begin his second season at stud in September. "We're very pleased with his progress," said Joe Osborne, director of Darley. "We are expecting him to make a full recovery, given time to recuperate. But, our vets are advising us against shuttling him this season. That said, we're confident he'll be able to go back to Darley Australia in 2003." Oliver Tait, manager of Darley Australia, said, "King's Best has been immensely popular in Australia. Many breeders here have heard how impressive his first foals have been in the Northern Hemisphere and were looking forward to using him, so we're sorry to disappoint them."

**BOYCOTT AVERTED AT HOLLYWOOD** In a protest against rising workmen's compensation costs, trainers at Hollywood Park boycotted the entry box Saturday, leaving the track with only eight horses for the Wednesday, July 3 card. But Racing Secretary Martin Panza left the entries for the program open Sunday and the horsemen ended the boycott. Wednesday's eight-race card drew 68 entries. The boycott followed a 90-minute meeting between horsemen and racing officials Saturday, with the trainers demanding to know what was going to be done about the skyrocketing insurance premiums. The only company providing workmen's compensation coverage for trainers in the California, the California State Fund, are increasing premiums between 30 and 50 percent for approximately 450 trainers whose policies expired yesterday. "It will drive a lot of trainers and owners out of the business," trainer Nick Hines, who attended Saturday's meeting, told *Thoroughbred Times*. "The trainers pass their costs on to the owners, but at this rate, the only trainers who'll still be running horses in California will be the guys who works for the princes and sheikhs and fabulously wealthy owners like that. The owners who don't get out of the business will look to run their horses in states where coverage is less expensive, like Washington and Colorado." California horsemen are hoping that the state legislation will earmark a portion of the purse money, up to \$5 million, to a fund to be used for workmen's compensation coverage.

Seventh in his first start of the campaign, the GII San Antonio H. at Santa Anita Feb. 3, the gelding came back to finish a good second in the restricted Kings Point H. Apr. 28 at Aqueduct and was most recently third against money allowance company May 15 over this strip. Off as the 5-2 third choice, the gray gained an outside stalking position while showing speed early, took the lead at the quarter pole when roused for his best effort and strode away to an impressive four-length victory with something left in reserve.

**O'BRIEN THREATENS MOVE** Aidan O'Brien yesterday spoke of his concerns for his training operation at Ballydoyle in the midst of a row over plans to build an incinerator in the vicinity. The Ballydoyle handler was responding to the proposed development in Rosegreen, which has received planning permission from South Tipperary Council, suggesting that he could move base for the sake of the health of his horses and his family. "If it goes ahead, we would not rear our family here and there's no doubt it will affect the horses too much," O'Brien told the *Sunday Independent* yesterday. "It's madness. If the pollution that could be caused by this incinerator causes even a fraction of a percentage difference in the horses' performances, it is too much. You win and lose races by short heads, by the tiniest of margins. There is no way in the wide, earthly world that anyone can say this couldn't affect the horses' performances. It will wipe us out here." O'Brien's campaign is fully supported by Manchester United Football Club manager Sir Alex Ferguson, part-owner of Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire), who stated in a letter to Coolmore Stud manager Christy Grassick, "I am abhorred that this proposal could be allowed to proceed. If it is constructed, I will be very slow to continue my connection with the area." According to the report, National By-Products Ltd, the company behind the incinerator, claim the new plant will burn only meat and animal bonemeal and would be completely safe from a health perspective.
