“BONUS” PAYS ON DOMINION DAY

Bonus Pack (Colonial Affair), trying stakes company and a mile and a quarter for the first time, swept past longshot **Attest** (Affirmed) in the stretch and pulled away to win the GIII Dominion Day H. at Woodbine yesterday afternoon by an emphatic 5 3/4 lengths. Sent off as the co-second choice at 7-2, the dark bay was coming off a victory over optional-claiming company at Churchill Downs June 7. Looking for his third win from his last four starts, he tracked the leaders while sitting in fourth for a mile, then fought his way between horses as they came out of the turn, took command at the eighth pole and drew clear. “I had so much horse, I went for the room,” said jockey Jesus Castanon. “Once I got to the quarter pole, I got him through and he was home free. He was ready to go.” **A Fleets Dancer** (Afleet), the 5-2 choice, was never in the hunt, finishing sixth. For the brisnet.com chart, click [here](#).

I suspect that many people outside the Euro-zone will have little idea about the value of the euro--the new

unit of currency throughout much of Europe. In fact, the euro (€) is now worth pretty much the same as a U.S. dollar, so you will realise that the French-based Kaldounevees, who this year commanded a fee of only €8,000, is an unlikely candidate to sire two Group 1 winners in a matter of

months. That, though, is exactly what this son of Kaldoun has done.

Back in March, Kaldounevees' first-crop daughter Terre A Terre collected \$1,200,000 for her victory over Noverre in the Dubai Duty Free, adding this Group 1 prize to her win in last year's G1 Prix de l'Opera. She had also been beaten only narrowly when third in the G1 Hong Kong Cup, so she is a highly accomplished international performer.

Now Kaldounevees has come up with another Group 1 winner in the year-younger Ange Gabriel, who sprang a surprise in Sunday's Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, defeating a field which included last year's winners of the Derby and Oaks in France. Like Terre A Terre, Ange Gabriel was bred by Madame Henri Devin and is trained by Eric Libaud.

It's well worth pointing out that Kaldounevees' fee was down at bargain-basement levels when he sired these excellent performers. He has spent most of his career at a fee of only 15,000 francs--often worth less than \$3,000--and he is based at Haras du Mesnil near Le Mans, some way south of France's main breeding area. In other words, this isn't a stallion born with a silver spoon in his mouth and his total output in his first four seasons amounts to 100 foals.

Could it be, then, that France has finally found the rightful heir to Kaldoun, one of the mainstays of the French industry who died at the age of 25 in 2000?

Kaldoun was another stallion who had to establish his merits the hard way. Although he was good enough to earn a Timeform rating of 122, Kaldoun retired after four seasons on the track with nothing better than a Listed win to his name. This well-bred son of Caro had finished second in three Group races, beaten between a nose and three-parts of a length each time, but second tends not to count for much in this industry. So, instead of retiring to one of France's main stallion farms, Kaldoun plied his trade out in the sticks in the early 1980s. Fortunately, winners of the calibre of La Koumia (GI Gamely H.) and Kadrou (G3 Pix La Rochette) helped Kaldoun work his way up the ladder and he arrived at the prestigious Haras d'Etreham in 1987.

Kaldoun thoroughly justified his shot at the big time and he enjoyed further Group 1 successes with Occupandiste, Spadoun, See You Soon and Mercalle. As four of his five Group 1 winners were fillies, there were hardly any ready-made candidates available to step into his shoes. However, there were plenty of sons which had won at Group 2 or Group 3 level, including Kaldounevees.

A May 15 birthday no doubt contributed to a slowish start to Kaldounevees' racing career, which didn't take off fully until he reached four years of age in 1995.

That was the year he won two Group 3 events--the Prix Edmond Blanc and Prix du Chemin de Fer du Nord--over a mile, before stepping up in distance to finish second in Group 1 events in Germany and the U.S. His American defeat came in the Man o'War S. over 1 3/8 miles, when he was beaten just over a length by Millkom.

Good though these efforts were, they left Kaldounevees some way below the very best of his generation--he received 117 on the 1995 International Classifications, 15 pounds less than the top-weighted Cigar. Breeders can sometimes be persuaded to make allowances about a horse's racing record if his bloodlines are outstanding, but Kaldounevees didn't come into this category. His dam Safaroad is a non-winning daughter of the disappointing stallion Satingo; his second dam, the Prince John mare Traverse Afar, failed to win and bred nothing better than a Listed winner; and his third dam, Giftbearer, was a minor winner who bred two minor winners.

None of this suggested that Kaldounevees had the makings of a Group 1 sire, but that is clearly what he is and he probably owes his prowess to his excellent male line--the Grey Sovereign line which I mentioned a few weeks ago.

Not only has he sired two Group 1 winners, but he has done so with mares from comparatively ordinary backgrounds. Terre A Terre's dam, Toujours Juste, won only one of her 20 starts and is by Always Fair, a stallion now standing at \$3,500 in New York. Ange Gabriel's background is similarly workmanlike. His dam, Mount Gable, was only a minor winner in France and she is by Head For Heights, a very good mile-and-a-half horse with a modest record as a stallion. However, Ange Gabriel isn't the first high-class performer from this family because his second dam, the unraced Cupids Hill, was a half-sister to the wonderfully tough miler Ardoon.

STREET CRY HEADS BREEDERS' CUP CLASSIC FUTURE BET *Street Cry* (Ire) (Machiavellian), the winner of the G1 Dubai World Cup and GI Stephen Foster H. in his last two starts, has been made the 6-1 morning-line favorite for the inaugural Breeders' Cup Future Bet on the Classic. Four-time Grade I winner **Azeri** (Jade Hunter) is the 5-1 early choice in the Distaff and 2000 Eclipse champion **Kona Gold** (Java Gold) is at 6-1 for the Sprint. The Classic, Distaff and Sprint are the three Breeders' Cup races available in the opening Future Bet pool. There are 23 horses offered for each race, plus a field entry consisting of all horses not included on the morning-line list. The pari-mutuel bet will be open July 4-7 from 1-7 p.m. EDT daily and has a \$2 minimum. There are no refunds for horses that do not make it to the Breeders' Cup. PREMONITIONS OF GREATNESS

In less than a month's time, a powerfully built son of Mr. Prospector named Greatness has managed to make a sizeable ripple in a pond that is known both for its depth and the quality of skippin' stones it attracts. Belmont Park, residence to some of the best Thoroughbreds in the world, is home to a promising colt who has a keen eye on stardom's horizon. A perfect two-for-two at the Long Island track, he came within a tick of setting a new course record for 6 1/2 furlongs June 15.

Of course, before we christen the Allen Jerkens trainee the second coming of Man o'War, let's see how he does against stakes company first. Or at least versus non-winners of two.

Owned and bred by Marilyn and Edward Seltzer, who are based in Florida, Greatness' pedigree alone would have saddled the horse with high expectations, but his eye-catching name has added a certain level of excitement to what might be. Perhaps premonitorily sensing the talent of the in-utero foal, Marilyn had already named him a week before he was born.

Thoughts of the self-jinx worried Edward, but he shrugs off the superstitions and laughs, "The name made me nervous. But if [Marilyn] was alright with it, I was, too."

Edward, who was married to Marilyn 11 years ago, entertained thoughts of selling the colt--understandable, considering his commercial pedigree and the hefty tag he might command--but it quickly became evident to the couple that the strapping young chestnut was growing into something special, a horse they wanted to see carry their colors.

"Marilyn's got a real talent for judging a horse, his conformation," says Edward. "From the very beginning, she never wanted to get rid of him. He was spectacular looking, a real giant."

Adds Marilyn, "As a yearling, he was as correct a horse as you'd want to see."

In a move they now regret, they chose not to have Greatness X-rayed after deciding against selling him. It would be discovered later on in the colt's development, as a two-year-old, that he was suffering from osteochondritis dissecans--OCD lesions--an affliction that can affect growing bones and joints. Surgery was performed to remove the offending lesions, delaying the colt's debut.

"After the surgery, we gave him some time off. We weren't rushing him," says Marilyn.

The colt's recovery progressed nicely and, as he continued to bloom physically, it became apparent that it wouldn't be long before he'd be making his first start.

Out the stakes-winning Danzig mare Harbour Club, Greatness first appeared in a maiden special weight contest May 19. He took plenty of support, going to post as the 6-5 choice, and proved he was worthy as he scored easily by 3 1/4 lengths. The eye-opener, however, came a few weeks later when, going 6 1/2 furlongs, he shot through sharp fractions of :22 1/5, :44 2/5 and 1:08 1/5 before burying the field by 10 1/2 lengths in a final time of 1:14 3/5, just 1/5 of a second off the track record.

The wet surface may have been speed-favoring, especially after it had been sealed, but the performance was enough to generate a healthy amount of optimism in the generally reserved Jerkens and the Seltzers. For Edward, whose involvement in the industry began when he purchased 1/16th of a runner for \$150 in 1957, it's optimism tempered by the experience of someone who's in his sixth decade of racing Thoroughbreds.

Interestingly, for a horse that's so far shown a propensity for ripping off speedy fractions as a sprinter, Greatness' pedigree seems to indicate a stretch in distance may be in order for the colt to realize his full potential. His second dam, Over Your Shoulder (Graustark), was a graded-stakes placed filly who won the mile and three-eighths Bayou H. as a four-year-old. His dam, Harbour Club, who was also owned by the Seltzers, was denied by a head in the mile-and-a-sixteenth GI Shuvee H. in 1992, second to a filly named Missy's Mirage. That same filly beat her by a nose in her next start, the mile-and-an-eighth GI Hempstead H.

"He's been handling the sprints fine," says Edward, "but it appears what he really want is a distance of ground."

Incidentally, the trainer of Missy's Mirage, the filly that twice denied Harbour Club a Grade I stakes win? Allen Jerkens, of course, a fact not lost on the Seltzers when it came time to chose a conditioner for Greatness.

"I talked to Allen," a bemused Edward relates, "and told him that he owed me. His filly, Missy's Mirage, could've been taken down in the Shuvee because of interference. He remembered the race and said that he was embarrassed to go the winner's circle afterwards."

Of working with the Hall of Fame trainer, Edward says, "If you love this sport and are lucky enough to have a really nice horse, it's a great honor to work with someone like him."

The Seltzers are going to let Jerkens decide where to run the colt next, either in another allowance test or possibly against stakes company.

"The two races we're really thinking about are the the Amsterdam [GI, Saratoga, Aug. 3] and the King's Bishop [GI, Aug. 24, Saratoga]," says Edward. "That's if we decide to keep him sprinting. And whether or not we'll run him in an allowance race before that is up to Allen. It's all in his hands."

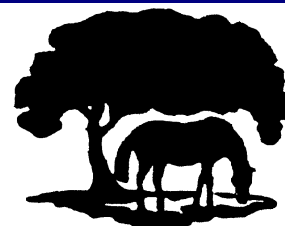

Hawk Wing (USA) (Woodman {USA}) heads the 14 remaining entries for Saturday's G1 Coral Eurobet Eclipse S. at Sandown after yesterday's five-day stage. With Godolphin withdrawing both **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge {USA}) and **Sakhee (USA)** (Bahri {USA}), opposition to the 2000 Guineas and Epsom Derby runner-up diminished to present the prospect of a field in single numbers for the 10-furlong contest. Joe Mercer, racing manager to owner Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid al Maktoum, said yesterday: "It is the intention to run on Saturday as long as the ground doesn't come up soft. He's come out of the Queen Anne very well and we're very happy with him. Last year Sir Michael Stoute and myself always thought that 10 furlongs would be well within his capacity." Godolphin may be represented by **Noverre (USA)** (Rahy {USA}) and **Equerry (USA)** (St Jovite {USA}), while they also left in **Kutub (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}) at yesterday's stage. Equerry, winner of the G3 Prix La Coupe at Longchamp June 20, was confirmed on target by Godolphin's racing manager Simon Crisford yesterday: "At this time Equerry is our most likely contender. He has done well since his win in France but we are looking at the ground conditions and the weather forecast as he doesn't want the going too firm. He has been lightly raced and is heading the right way. He has won his Group 3s and now we feel is the right time to step up against opposition of this quality.
