GOOD TO GO

On the board in 11 of his 12 tries on the turf, **Good Journey** (Nureyev) stamped himself a GI Breeders' Cup Mile contender with a 1 1/4-length score in yesterday's GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. at Churchill Downs. Winless in three starts in France at three, the six-year-old made his U.S. debut in the fall of 2000. Twice a winner at four, he finished second in a Santa Anita allowance in January of 2001, then was sidelined for nearly nine months before finishing second again in an optional-claimer at that track Sept. 26. The chestnut shipped to Hawthorne for the Nov. 3 GIII Robert F. Carey Memorial H. and finished third before ending the season with a half-length win over Decarchy in the Nov. 24 GII Citation H. at Hollywood. Good Journey had been out just once since, closing for a one-length victory in a one-mile Churchill allowance test June 15. "He was in training a long time, the same old grind, so I took him to my daughter's [Michele Nakatani's] farm in Bradbury [California] and he got exactly two months to the day off," trainer Wally Dollase said. "Then we started training him again...and, with just that little rest, I've seen a tremendous change in this horse. He's much stronger than he has ever been." Sent off the second choice in the nine-horse Firecracker field, the Flaxman Holdings homebred was on the bit while racing off a moderate early pace. He angled inside on the far turn, then swung wide for the drive and ran down Morluc before edging clear. "I had a real good trip," jockey Pat Day, winning his first stakes of the meet, said. "He was kind of taking me to them off the turn--I eased him out and he responded beautifully and went on about his business." Looking ahead, Dollase said, "The plan now calls for one or two more races and hopefully he'll have enough points to get into the Breeders' Cup." For the brisset.com chart, click [here](#). MONEY IN THE BANK

Left Bank (French Deputy) added his name to the Belmont Park record books yesterday afternoon as he dashed the seven furlongs of the GII Tom Fool H. in a record-setting 1:20.17. The time knocked a tick off the mark set by You and I in 1994. "We were really cooking around the far turn and I knew we were going really fast," jockey John Velazquez said. Left Bank had won 12 of his 22 prior starts, but put in a lackluster effort last time out, showing brief speed in the May 27 GI Met Mile before tiring to finish fifth. Sent off the 8-5 favorite yesterday to erase the memory of that sub-par performance, the chestnut stalked the pace from third as **Express Tour** (Tour d'Or) zipped through an opening quarter in :21.96. **Appealing Danger** (Appealing Guy) had a head in front as they clipped off a half in :44.27, but Left Bank took command after six furlongs in a smokin' 1:07.99 and opened up on the field to win it by 6 1/4 lengths. As for what's next, trainer Todd Pletcher said, "We've been kicking around the idea of stretching him out. He has won from six furlongs to a mile and an eighth. - It was 95 degrees at post time, but for most of the race, it felt more like 150 to trainer Randy Schulhofer. He watched helplessly as Arthur Hancock's Owsley found herself in traffic and buried at the rail for most of the 10-furlong journey, but exploded through an opening in deep stretch to defeat Volga by a neck. "Before the eighth pole, I was beside myself," the conditioner admitted. "I had my head buried until she got out. And then [jockey Edgar Prado] finally got her out and she finished strong." Second in the GIII Lake George S. last season, the dark bay, fifth in a Gulfstream turf test Jan. 26, was a head winner over the Aqueduct lawn Apr. 17 before running an excellent fourth, a 1/2 length behind Tweedside (Thunder Gulch) in the GII Sheepshead Bay H. over 11 panels June 1. Settled along the inside, Owsley was shuffled back to last entering the far turn, was crying out for running room turning for home and closed with a rush for the victory. "Today is the best she's done," said Schulhofer, who was credited with his first official stakes win in New York. "I just hope she continues on this path." Who says The Tin Man has no heart? Sent off the second choice in this seven-horse field, the dark bay went right to the front and set a moderate pace. He was 1 1/2 lengths clear at midstretch, but had to give it all he had in the final yards to hold off the late charge of Devine Wind. The Tin Man did drift out under jockey Mike Smith's left-handed whip, and the stewards looked at the tape, but found no reason to reverse the order of finish. "When we were coming down to the wire, my horse was looking around so much, I went to left-handed just to shake him up a little bit," Smith said. "I was hoping we'd get over to [Devine Wind] a little bit, so that my horse would see him and go on. That's what happened, but it did get a little too close for comfort there." The Tin Man won three in a row before trying stakes company for the first time in the Apr. 27 GII San Francisco Breeders' Cup H., where he finished third. He was looking to rebound after a disappointing ninth-place finish in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile May 27. "He came out of the Shoemaker stiff and sore, but he trained good up to this," trainer Richard Mandella said. "I'm not sure what's next, but we're going to keep testing him." Jockey Alex Solis, aboard the runner-up, did not blame the brush with the winner for his mount's loss. "I tapped him one time with the whip and he sulked on me," Solis said. "He quit after that." Boston Common had eaten the dust of none other than Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner War Emblem earlier this year, but the Fourth of July was his turn to shine. Let go as the second-longest shot on the board, the bay grabbed the lead soon after the start and never looked back. That wasn't quite the way things went when Boston Common met War Emblem. The two faced each other in an allowance race at Sportsman's Park Mar. 17, and the hero of two-thirds of the Triple Crown came home 13 3/4 lengths in front of the third-placed Boston Common. Undaunted, Boston Common's connections sent him into the GII Illinois Derby as a 135-1 outsider and the Kentucky-bred ran to his odds, finishing 33 1/2 lengths in back of runaway winner War Emblem. Both of those races were around two turns, however. Boston Common improved sharply after being dropped back into sprint races, and into less lofty company, winning an allowance at Mountaineer May 4 and finishing second in the Legal Light S. at Delaware Park May 25. He set the pace before tiring to finish third in the Oh Say S. at Delaware last time out, but showed no signs of stopping yesterday. After dashing off a quarter in :21.84 and a half in :44.63, Boston Common easily held off Listen Here for the victory. "This colt has got a lost of gas--he's fast," winning jockey Eddie Martin Jr. said. "The race played into my hands pretty much the whole way." Buffythecenterfold registered a 10-1 upset to break her maiden by one length at first asking June 15 and was adding Lasix to her repertoire for her stakes debut. Quickest away from the gate, the Overbrook Farm-bred filly maintained a narrow advantage through the opening half-mile while racing between Himalayan (Mountain Cat) to her inside and Spirit Run (Saint Ballado) to her outside. She turned away the respective challenges from those rivals at the head of the stretch, dug in stubbornly and held off Tricks Her for the victory. "I'm very happy," trainer Mel Stute said. "I've been in a little bit of a slump for a few years and I hope this filly turns it around. I do believe she will go on, and at this stage of the game she is better than Brave Raj [his 1986 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner]." Added jockey Matt Garcia, "The filly broke strong and kept going. She won comfortably in her first race and I knew she was better today. When the other horses came to her, she'd just pin her ears and go." The winner was purchased this spring. "I bought this filly privately after the Barretts March Sale through the efforts of agent Charlie Lambert, who deserves a lot of credit," Stute said. "Her owners bought her back for \$70,000 and I was able to buy her for a slightly higher price." Future plans call for Buffythecenterfold to get a break before running at Del Mar. Favored Magic Smoke (Smokester) chased the pace and tired late to finish eighth. Proud Girly (Proud Irish) broke down on the backstretch and was vanned off. Workmen's Compensation Bill Delayed:

A bill designed to alleviate the cost of workmen's compensation insurance for California horse trainers will not be heard by the state senate until after they return from summer recess Aug. 5. But it should pass without a problem once the legislative session resumes, Thoroughbred Owners of California President John Van de Kamp told the *Daily Racing Form*. "The bill has no opposition and should go to the Senate floor at the first opportunity," Van de Kamp said. "Our goal has been to make it emergency legislation so the governor signs it as soon as it hits his desk." The bill could allocate as much as \$5 million from purses to a workmen's compensation fund, but is not considered the final solution to the insurance cost crisis, which saw premiums rise from 30 to 50 percent at the end of June.

SOUMILLON SUFFERS SPILL

Jockey Christophe Soumillon suffered a nasty-looking fall when unseated from his mount in the first race at La Teste de Buch yesterday. Soumillon was riding **Blue Senk (Fr)** (Epervier Bleu {GB}) for trainer Jean-Jacques Boutin in the Prix Helleniqua, a €20,000 six-furlong juvenile conditions event, but looked in serious danger when the two-year-old colt failed to negotiate the home turn and careered into a rail on the opposite side of the track. The Belgian-born jockey was thrown to the turf with some force and was taken by ambulance to the local medical facility at Arcachon. The extent of the jockey's injuries was not revealed by medical staff.

Nayef's participation may depend on G1 Dubai World Cup disappointment **Sakhee (USA)** (Bahri {USA})'s programme. Last year's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner may have a racetrack workout during next week's July meeting at Newmarket. Godolphin's racing manager Simon Crisford told *Racing Post*: "A racecourse workout is possible for next week but we are going to wait until closer to the weekend before we decide anything. It depends what the ground is like and we need to talk to the clerk of the course to establish a convenient time for everybody."
