The inaugural running of the \$500,000 American Oaks this afternoon at Hollywood Park has drawn a contentious field from across the U.S. as well as shippers from France and Ireland. "There is no other race like it for three-year-old fillies in North America," said Hollywood Park racing secretary Martin Panza. "It gives them a chance to stay in their own age group and run a classic distance before meeting older fillies and mares in the Breeders' Cup." **Megahertz (GB)** (Pivotal {GB})

**HAWK SEEKING REDEMPTION**

The beaten favourite in two English Classics this year, **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) will head the market once again in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. today at Sandown. Trainer Aidan O'Brien's tentative theory in April that Hawk Wing could provide him with his first Triple Crown winner might have been realized in any other year, without two such outstanding stablemates--Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) and High Chaparral (Ire)--with a slice more luck on their side. He will be a short price here, on ground that will be plenty soft enough for him, but he should find life a lot easier than his conditioner's only other Eclipse winner, Giant's Causeway. Godolphin will look to the unbeaten **Equerry** (St. Jovite) to encroach on the big stage here. Brought along stealthily up to now, he has readily out-classed smart rivals at Longchamp in both the G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange in September and G3 La Coupe June 20. Strictly on the reading of his half-length defeat of Sagacity (Fr) in the former event, he has to be considered up to this class, especially on this easier surface, but he faces a baptism of fire against the favourite. **Indian Creek (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) could be the fly in the ointment on the basis of his performance when runner-up to Grandera (Ire) in the G1 Prince of Wales' S. at the Royal meeting June 19. He suffered an interrupted preparation for that race and is the type of improving older horse with which trainer David Elsworth excels.

The bridgejumpers were out yesterday afternoon at Belmont Park as the hot 1-2 chalk Shibboleth (Danzig) came up empty in the final furlong. The winner, Volponi was making his first start on the turf in nearly a year, but had broken his maiden in the GIII Pilgrim S. on the grass at Belmont as a two-year-old. At three the bay colt had finished fourth in the GIII Lexington S. before heading back to the main track, where he posted a win in the GI Pegasus H. Oct. 19. Fourth in the GI Cigar Mile to close out 2001, he returned with a sharp allowance score at Belmont May 8, but bounced in his next start, running fourth at 2-5 in a money allowance. The blinkers were taken off for this outing. Saint Verre jumped out to set the pace, with Shibboleth racing in second as Volponi took third on the outside. After three-quarters in 1:08 1/5, Volponi made his move and collared Saint Verre in midstretch before drawing clear. "I guess I'm going to keep him on the turf for now," said winning trainer Phil Johnson. "We'll look at the Bernard Baruch [GII, 9f, 7-26]. I'll also look at the Sword Dancer [GI, 12f, 8-10]. I've had a lot of success in that race and I love a mile and a half [for Volponi]." As for Shibboleth, jockey Jerry Bailey said, "I never had any horse at any time."

The only horse to defeat pro-tem divisional leader Beat Hollow this season is **Sarafan**, who bested the Bobby Frankel trainee by a neck in the GII Explosive Bid H. at the Fair Grounds Mar 24. The gelding could do no better than fourth behind the controlling speed of **Suances** in the GII San Francisco Breeders' Cup H. at Bay Meadows Apr. 27 and comes into this effort off a troubled fourth-place finish to **Denon** in the GI Charles Whittingham H. at Hollywood June 15. Suances, a Group 1 winner in France at three, was 10th in the Explosive Bid and most recently wired the field in the June 15 Dallas Turf Cup at Lone Star Park. He should face pace pressure from **With Anticipation**, who finished first in this event a year ago before being demoted to second. The grey, fourth to Beat Hollow in the GI Manhattan H. at Belmont June 8, retains the services of jockey Pat Day. Denon captured the GI Hollywood Derby in his U.S. bow last November, but was off the board in his subsequent two starts--both at 12 furlongs--before bouncing back to form in the Whittingham.

Carefully handled since his victory in the 2000 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, he will attempt 10 furlongs for the first time since finishing fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic over this surface Oct. 27. Making his first start since a fourth in the Feb. 3 GII San Antonio H., **Lido Palace** will attempt to recapture his form of last summer, when he took the GI Whitney H. and the GI Woodward H. in succession. Those victories were at nine furlongs, and the Chilean-bred chestnut has finished second in each of his at tempts at 1 1/4 miles in the U.S., including a runner-up finish to Albert the Great in last year's Suburban.

**WAR EMBLEM TO HASKELL** Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) will make his next start in the \$1 million GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park Aug. 4, it was announced yesterday. "Right now, that's the plan," said Richard Mulhall, the racing manager for the colt's owner, Prince Ahmed Salman. "I talked to the Prince and [trainer Bob Baffert] today, and we decided that the Haskell would be next." War Emblem missed out on his attempt at the Triple Crown, stumbling at the start of the June 8 Belmont S. and finishing eighth. But, fully recovered from that disappointment, he worked Tuesday, going a half-mile in :48 at Santa Anita. "He's doing great," Mulhall said, adding that War Emblem's connections will attend Baffert's wedding to Jill Moss in California on the evening of Aug. 3 before heading to New Jersey. "We'll send the horse ahead, and then probably just charter a plane to take us to the Haskell," he said. Baffert sent Point Given to win last year's Haskell during that colt's Horse of the Year campaign.

**SEEKING DAYLIGHT INJURED** Seeking Daylight (Seeking the Gold)'s racing career may be over after the four-year-old colt sustained a fractured left front cannon bone Thursday morning, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The colt had been training for today's GII Suburban H., but trainer Mark Hennig noted that he appeared off and ordered X-rays, which revealed a hairline fracture. "It's going to need screws to accelerate the healing process," Hennig told the *Form*. A winner of both of his starts at two, Seeking Daylight spent all of his three-year-old year on the sidelines with another cannon bone fracture, but returned this year to take the GII Brooklyn H. authoritatively by 8 1/4 lengths. That win took his career record to 7-4-1-0 with earnings of \$244,710. The Edward Evans homebred could eventually return to the races, according to Hennig. "There's no reason he couldn't come back to run if that's something Mr. Evans chooses to do," Hennig continued. Out of the GSW Play All Day (Steady Growth), Seeking Daylight is a half-brother to Hedonist (Alydeed), winner of the GI Santa Anita Oaks, and he is a 3/4-brother to Zaha (Kingmambo), hero of Canada's Coronation Futurity.

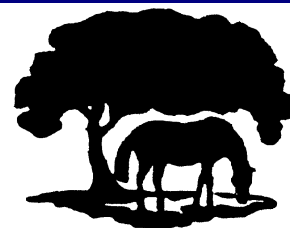
