UN OFFERS REPARATIONS

He made them wait for it, but **With Anticipation** (Relaunch) finally gave his connections a victory in the GI United Nations H., beating **Denon** (Pleasant Colony) by a neck at Monmouth Park yesterday afternoon. Disqualified from the win after drifting out during the stretch drive in 2001, the gray returned as the 5-2 second choice in this year's running of the event. With jockey Pat Day in the saddle, he kept a straighter course to take the photo finish and redeem himself for last year's disappointment. Still, trainer Jonathan Sheppard waited until the result was in the record books before starting the celebration. "I wasn't going to get too excited until they made it official," the Hall of Fame horseman said. Sheppard has no quarrel with the Monmouth stewards, however. "There are no hard feelings over last year," he said. "I think the stewards made a fair call." (cont. p2)

THE HAWK ECLIPSES SHOLOKHOV

Hawk Wing (Woodman) lived up to all the pre-race expectations to beat **Sholokhov (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in yesterday's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. by 2 1/2 lengths, leading home another one-two finish for trainer Aidan O'Brien. Hawk Wing seemed destined for Group 1 success this season, after finishing runner-up in both the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 and G1 Epsom Derby June 8, but O'Brien was wary that the latter, run on soft ground over a stamina-sapping mile and a half, might have taken its toll. Having beaten Sholokhov by three lengths in the G2 Futurity S. at The Curragh in August, he had his stablemate four lengths back in third next time back at that track in the G1 National S. the following month. Returning amidst a feeling of mild hysteria in the Newmarket Classic, lack of pace on his side of the course allowed stable companion **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** first run, yet he still got to within a neck with a powerful late surge. Significant rain at Epsom turned the prospects of outlasting the immensely talented **High Chaparral (Ire)** on their head, however he still put a distance of 12 lengths between himself and the third-placed colt there. This time, the 'Hawk' settled in fourth as Sholokhov carved out an even pace early. As they entered the straight, the leader carried **Equerry** (St. Jovite) wide into the centre of the track, opening up all the space that Hawk Wing needed for a trouble-free passage. Still on the bridle passing the quarter-mile marker, he loomed upsides Sholokhov soon after and drew away from his rival late over the dead ground. Emulating the stable's **Giant's Causeway** two years ago in winning this after finishing second in the Newmarket 2000 Guineas, he was the first Epsom Derby runner-up to follow up since **Dancing Brave** in 1986. That colt went on to take the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot, but where Hawk Wing goes from here is open to debate. "I think he could go either way--he could go back to a mile or a mile and a half or handle a mile and a quarter," said O'Brien. "You really need a horse with that kind of class to get very different trips--he is a different horse." The trainer went on to say that the winner is possible for the G1 King George at Ascot July 27 or the G1 Juddmonte International at York Aug. 20.

THE BEAT GOES ON With Anticipation (Relaunch) bounced right back after losing out on the 2001 version of the U.N., winning the G1 Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga and the G1 Man o'War S. at Belmont Park. But he looked less than sharp at the end of the season, closing it out with a seventh-place finish in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont and a ninth-place effort in the G1 Japan Cup at Tokyo Racecourse. Second in his first two outings of this campaign, including the May 4 G1 Woodford Reserve S., the seven-year-old gelding was coming off a fourth-place performance in the G1 Manhattan H. June 8. "He was kind of trapped behind horses in that race, and he clearly was not putting forth his best effort," Sheppard said. "But he vindicated himself today." The Pennsylvania-bred settled in second as the crowd's choice, **Suances (GB)** (Most Welcome {GB}), took them along through moderate fractions. He went after the leader while three wide on the far turn, but it was still anybody's race. Denon and **Sarafan** (Lear Fan) came at him from the outside, and there were four horses across the course at the top of the lane, but With Anticipation proved gamest, holding off his challengers for the score. "I felt that when I put him to the task, he would respond, and he did," winning jockey Pat Day said. "When they put the pressure on us at the head of the stretch, he was up to it." Added Sheppard, "Pat gave him a beautiful ride. I was concerned that he might get tired, but that's Pat's forte--coaxing the last little bit out of them." With Anticipation lost the winner's share of the purse last year, but he was credited with the course-record final time of 2:13.40. He broke his own mark this time, running the 11 furlongs in 2:12.81. He will be pointed for a title defense in the Sword Dancer at Saratoga Aug. 10. Click [here](#) for the brisnet.com chart

The Prioress was boosted to Grade I last year and was won by Xtra Heat, who has gone on to be the finest distaff sprinter in years. Carson Hollow, now unbeaten in four career starts, demolished New York-breds by 18 3/4 lengths at first asking Mar. 22 and followed that up with a measured score in open company Apr. 21. Back with state-breds for her stakes debut, she was ridden out to a five-length tally in the Bouwerie S. May 19. Those three victories had all come at seven furlongs, and she was treated with Lasix for the first time for the six-furlong Prioress. Bumped slightly at the start, Carson Hollow quickly reached the front and laid down fractions of :22.04 and :44.67 while chased by A New Twist (Storm Cat) and Spring Meadow. She opened up a bit turning for home and maintained a safe margin all the way to the wire. "There is no way in the world I thought she would get the lead," said winning trainer Richard Dutrow, Jr., getting his first Grade I victory. "She just came out running. The inaugural running of the American Oaks was decided by Hollywood Park stewards, who justifiably took down the number of Dublino after she clearly interfered with Megahertz leaving the midstretch marker. "Dublino came out several lanes, made contact with Megahertz, turning her sideways and causing her a chance for her rightful position," explained steward Pete Pedersen. In eight starts overseas, Megahertz was entered for claiming prices no fewer than six times, but closed that chapter with a third in the Listed Criterium de l'Ouest in the French provinces last September. She has proved unstoppable in four U.S. starts this season, all resulting in stakes victories and capped by a visually impressive 3/4-length score in this oval's GII Honey-moon Breeders' Cup H. June 8. Settled towards the rear while racing in the clear through the opening stan-zas, the British-bred filly advanced outside into and on the second turn and was set down five wide for the drive. Dublino commenced a similar rally two paths to the inside of Megahertz, but drifted out leaving the eighth pole, where the infraction occurred. Additionally, Megahertz was also struck by the whip of jockey Kent Desormeaux aboard the demoted filly. "This is an in-credible filly," commented winning rider Alex Solis. The call went out to the bullpen when Godolphin decided to keep G1 Dubai World Cup and GI Stephen Foster H. winner Street Cry (Ire) in the barn in favor of the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga Aug. 3. When the phone rang, it was for E Dubai, winner of the GII Dwyer S. and second to Point Given in the GI Travers S. a year ago. Caught late by Outofthebox in the GI Super Derby Sept. 23, the colt did not make an appearance over the winter in Dubai and instead was trained up to the GII Brooklyn H. June 15. After showing some early zip in the slop that afternoon, the bay gave way readily en route to a fourth-place finish and was the third choice in the field of seven. Allowed to lope along on the front end outside Pleasant Breeze (Pleasant Tap), he raced well within himself and had the field at his mercy after six furlongs in a pedestrian 1:12.84. Asked for his best at the quarter pole, he drew clear from a hard-ridden Lido Palace and held that rival at bay for the win. Favored Macho Uno finished well to be third. "He ran very good. He was ready," said winning rider John Velazquez, who swept the afternoon's graded stakes. "He had the Brooklyn to get him here. I was relaxed on him through most of the race. I was basically a passenger to the quarter pole. I asked him to run and he really responded and ran hard."

Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. cont.

Campaigned exclusively in California-bred company for the first 10 races of his career, Disturbingthepeace was a 1/2-length winner going this distance at Santa Anita Mar. 20 and followed up with a 3/4-length victory in his first try against open company in Arcadia Apr. 13. Most recently, the gelding pressed fast fractions to take a local optional claimer over the Triple Bend trip May 19. Trying stakes company for the first time, Disturbingthepeace set the pace along the inside tracked by D'wildcat from the three path and favored Kona Gold (Java Gold) between those two. The former showed no signs of giving in after a half in :44.91 and three quarters in 1:08.90 and pulled clear for a relatively easy victory. Making his second start of the season, eight-year-old Kona Gold remained in contention to the stretch before fading back to sixth. Winning jockey Victor Espinoza admits to having disobeyed trainer's instructions following the scratch of main speed Full Moon Madness. "Darrell Vienna told me 'just stay off the pace, like two or three off the pace,' he explained. "But there was no speed at all so I jumped in there to see what was going on. I rushed him just a little from the gate and there I was, all by myself in front." Of Kona Gold, jockey Alex Solis said, "He tried but he just didn't have that punch like he usually does." Elder statesman Cetewayo proved that rumors of his demise--caused by his slacking form at the end of 2001--were greatly exaggerated. After finishing 12th in the GII Red Smith H. at Aqueduct in November, he welcomed 2002 with a score in the GI Gulfstream Breeders' Cup H. Feb. 16 at odds of 18-1. After a second in the GII Pan American H. Mar. 23, he was upset as the favorite and finished third in the GIII Elhorn S. at Keeneland Apr. 24. Last out, he took the Greenwood Cup H. at Philly Park June 8. Improving his record to three-for-five this year, the eight-year-old bay raced a ground-saving trip in seventh through the initial mile, steadily improved his position as they rounded the far turn and got his neck in front in the dying strides for the win, setting a new course record in the process. "It was a slow pace," said winning jockey Rene Douglas. "It was hard to make a run at first. I was so far back and I kept watching in front of me. I took my time. He exploded like a good horse in the stretch." Dr. John Chandler, owner and breeder of Cetewayo, indicated the 1 1/2-mile GI Sword Dancer at Saratoga Aug. 10 might be next. "A mile and a quarter is a bit short for him against younger horses. He needs to get his stuff together early and come running late, as you saw today. [The Sword Dancer] would be an obvious place." True Passion ran his skein to six with this impressive, wire-to-wire effort. The dark bay hadn't made much of an impact going two turns in the claiming ranks, but cut back to 6 1/2 furlongs Apr. 7 and responded with a 6 1/2-length score. When that foe broke poorly, True Passion rushed up to the front to set a pressured pace. He shrugged off Yonaguska's challenge turning for home and was ridden out to the wire. "Every time I ride him, he just gets better and better," said winning jockey Tony Black. "I knew there would be company up front, but my colt was just so willing to keep going. With small fields the tempo changes dramatically and it was a bit stop-start; it just took her time to get into a rhythm and a momentum and finally I got there. She's going to be a horse that stays very well--she's an out-and-out galloper."

He was seventh in the G1 Derby Italiano in Rome May 26 on ground which would have been too lively, but had impressed previously when winning the Listed Jean Harzheim-Rennen at Cologne Apr. 7.
