NEXT DESERT NO MIRAGE IN GERMAN DERBY

A week after trainer Aidan O'Brien saddled the top three finishers in the Irish Derby, German trainer Andreas Schutz countered with the one-two-three finishers in yesterday's G1 Deutsches Derby in Hamburg, as **Next Desert (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}) led home **Salve Regina (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) and **Tomori** (Royal Academy). Although stamina doubts persisted around the favourite's chances in this extremely testing ground, he made light of those worries by powering away from his chasing stablemate and G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) winner **Salve Regina** in the straight. **Next Desert** carried an unbeaten record into the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) at Cologne May 20, but could not match the pace of Dupont (GB) as runner-up there on the lively going. He booked his place for yesterday's race with a highly impressive performance in winning the G2 Union-Oppenheim-Rennen June 16, showing an ability to kill a contest with early acceleration before staying strongly. Looking to make it two-in-a-row, **Next Desert** broke well from his middle draw before settling behind **Irulan (Ire)** (Monsun {Ger}) in second as the pair pulled away from the scrimmaging in behind. That caused **Salve Regina** to take a wide course and, as she started her move to close on the leaders, she was forced out by **Mamool (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}). Her challenge was too late, however, as the smooth-traveling **Next Desert** and jockey Andrasch Starke, who was enjoying his third Derby success after coming back from six months' suspension, took command with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining. The response was immediate and the colt put instant daylight between him and the chasing pack before staying on relentlessly all the way to the line. Gestut Wittekindshof's homebred **Next Desert** was on offer at the Baden Baden Yearling Sales two years ago, and, as is the stud's policy, went into the ring without a reserve. However, when the bidding halted at DM160,000, his owner-breeder Hans-Hugo Miebach decided to buy the colt back. Schutz, who was winning the German Derby for the third time since 1998, said: "He handled the ground very well and showed an impressive turn of foot in the straight. The G1 Grosser Preis Von Baden [Sept. 1] is his main objective."

GYGISTAR GOES LONG

Gygistar (Prospector's Music) entered yesterday's GII Dwyer S. at Belmont Park with four wins in five starts, including a 10 1/2-length romp in the Apr. 20 Hallandale Beach H. and a 4 1/2-length score in the June 8 GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup S., but the chestnut gelding had never tried two turns before yesterday. The distance proved to be no problem for pacesetter **Gygistar**. He was briefly challenged by **Yankee Gentleman** (Storm Cat) turning for home, but spurted clear to a six-length advantage before holding off **Nothing Flat** (Peaks and Valleys) late for a half-length victory. "He stumbled a couple of strides out of the gate and got scared and took off," explained winning rider John Velazquez. "That wasn't my plan. He's not used to being on the lead and he got to looking around at the quarter pole. He was loping in the stretch and that other horse was so wide he didn't see him right away. Once he did he pulled away and started running again when we galloped out. I think he'll be better with a target." Trainer Mark Hennig said **Gygistar** could start next in the Aug. 24 GI King's Bishop at Saratoga. Click [here](#) for the brisnet.com chart.

Lone Star Sky came from just off the pace to take his debut at Arlington Park June 13 while sprinting 4 1/2 furlongs. The colt rated just behind the early leaders, swung out five wide for the drive and overtook favored Posse in midstretch before sailing clear to the wire to finish in stakes record time. Posse, coming off a win in the May 27 GIII Kentucky Breeders Cup S., was never far back, gained the lead in the final quarter and couldn't hold off Lone Star Sky down the lane. "Beating a horse the caliber of Posse is a terrific thing," said winning trainer Tom Amoss. "He's one of the best in the Midwest. I feel that our horse has the caliber to go on and he proved it today. We're going to sit down and talk about the future of this horse, but we would like to be in Chicago [for the Breeders' Cup].

Ziping provided a further boost to his fourth-place finish in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 with a last-gasp success in yesterday's Prix Ris d'Orangis. As a juvenile, he was rated France's number two behind Act One (GB) in the International Classifications on 116 pounds following a win in the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte in July and later in the season was good enough to finish second to Johannesburg in both the G1 Prix Morny over this course in August and G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket in October. In his 2002 debut, the Irish-bred had to settle for second behind Massalani (Fr) in the Listed Prix Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 8, but was able to reverse that form in his most recent start in the Newmarket Classic. This time, he lingered in last place early as Swedish Shave (Fr) (Midyan) denied Tycoon's Hill (Ire) (Danehill) the early advantage. Confidently ridden throughout, the sophomore was eased closer to the pace as May Ball led approaching the furlong marker. The former had to work to catch the gallant mare, but he answered every call to nose out his foe in the final stride. "I gave him a good break after the 2000 Guineas and he has returned in very good form," said trainer Robert Collet. "He had a six-pound penalty here, so winning the race was quite a performance. The most important thing, even if he had lost, was to set him up for his next start in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest here [Aug. 11]."

Multiple Group 1 stakes winner Lord Card showed that he still packs a punch at the ripe old age of eight to take his second Gran Premio 9 de Julio. The elder statesman of the turf won this race three years ago, but lacked support this time while trying to make it back to the races following a four-month layoff. Looking to stretch his Group 1 tally to four, the bay settled off early leader Fascio (Arg) (Fitzcarraldo {Arg}) while saving ground along the rail. Heading into the stretch, Lord Card found the gap he needed, moved through fluidly and drew off for the easy win.

Mr. John shipped in from his homebase at Churchill Downs and knocked off his first stakes win with a commanding performance. The bay, who sold for a cool half-million as an FTSAUG yearling, looked promising as a three-year-old when he fired a 109 Beyer and finished second by 3/4 lengths to Keats in the GII Lexington S. at Keeneland in April of 2001. Trainer Elliott Walden took a shot and started him in the Preakness S., where the colt got off to an awkward start and was eased with an injury to finish last. After being sidelined for the remainder of the season, he returned against allowance foes and reeled off two straight, at Keeneland in mid-April and at Churchill on the Derby undercard. Last out, he took on Congaree in the GIII Lone Star Park H. and finished a respectable fourth, beaten 4 1/4 lengths. Dismissed here against a very tight field, the colt was well placed in third behind the dueling pacesetters through the half, moving up to challenge after six furlongs. He was set down for the drive with a head in front and powered clear for the open-length success. "We put blinkers on him," said winning owner Thomas Van Meter, "and it made a huge difference; he's just grown up now. He's got a huge engine and he's built like a sprinter." David Fortner, assistant to Walden, added, "He really stepped up. It was a tough field, but we did think he was up to the task. We've been waiting a while. We're very, very proud of him." Second choice Unshaded, seventh as they turned for home, closed well for second. The 2-1 bettors' choice Euchre (Personal Flag), who won this contest last year, was within striking distance, but flattened out and finished a non-threatening fifth. 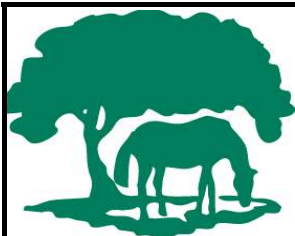

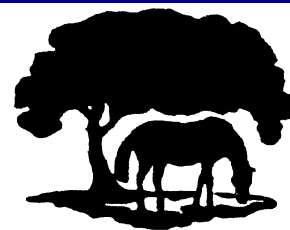
