**SUNDAY SILENCE DOMINATES JRHA OPENER**

Japan's leading sire Sunday Silence enjoyed a banner day at yesterday's opening session of the Japan Racing Horse Association Select Sale at Northern Horse Park in Hokkaido. A weanling son of the Kentucky Derby winner fetched a sale-topping final bid of ¥205,000,000 (\$1,708,333) from Genichiro Tahara. Consigned by

Teruya Yoshida's Shadai Farm, the brown colt is the third foal out of G3 Lancashire Oaks winner Fanjica (Ire) (Law Society). Fanjica's second foal, also by Sunday Silence, was bought for ¥150,000,000 at this sale last year. Tahara was primed to spend big at the Select Sale after his company Flag Manufacture sold millions of national flags to fans at the recently concluded World Cup. The sale-topping colt will be sent to trainer Kazuhiro Seishi at Miho Training Center near Tokyo. "I am very excited to have such a nice racing prospect and I feel very honored to have Mr. Tahara send me such a valuable colt," said Seishi, who also trains Japanese Oaks winner Smile Tomorrow. John Ferguson was the underbidder on the colt. Ferguson was also the underbidder on the day's second-highest lot. Hip number 15, another son of Sunday Silence, brought a final bid of ¥135,000,000 (\$1,125,000) from Riichi Kondo. Consigned by Northern Farm, the colt is out of Catalyst (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), a full sister to champion Second Empire (Ire). Two weanlings were offered yesterday from the first crop of Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus. Lot 118, a bay colt out of G1SW Queen Maud (Ire) (Akarad {Fr}), was purchased for ¥85,000,000 (\$708,333) by Hiroyoshi Usuda from the consignment of Shadai Farm. Trainer Hideyuki Mori, who signed the ticket for the weanling on behalf of Usuda, commented, "There are two foals by Fusaichi Pegasus and I like this one better. And my client loves the dam." Also by FuPeg, lot 64, a dark bay colt out of Six Crowns (Seattle Slew), was purchased for ¥81,000,000 (\$675,000). John McCormack made the winning bid on behalf of an American partnership.

**High on Fusaichi Pegasus....**

"Fusaichi Pegasus is the most exciting stallion prospect in 20 years," McCormack said after the purchase. "I would love to get a nice son of Fusaichi Pegasus and this is the one. He looks like his father." McCormack added the colt would likely be sent to a trainer in the U.S. The sale's final session begins Tuesday at 11 a.m.

**STREET CRY BREEZES**

Dubai World Cup victor **Street Cry (Ire)** (Machiavelian) reeled off five panels in a modest 1:03 2/5 at Belmont Park Sunday in preparation for his next start in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga Aug. 3. The four-year-old, a 6 1/2-length winner in the recent Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs June 15, has five wins and five runner-up finishes from 11 starts with just over \$5 million in earnings.

**ACT ONE TO STAND IN ENGLAND**

At the request of his late owner Gerald Leigh, **Act One (GB)** (In The Wings {GB}--Summer Sonnet {GB}, by Baillamont), will be syndicated and commence stud duty in England. Following his syndication by London Thoroughbred Services the winner of Saint Cloud's G1 Criterium International at two and the G1 Prix Lupin at Longchamp May 12 will stand at Shadwell's Nunnery Stud, who recently purchased into the colt, at a fee of £10,000, Oct. 1st terms. Leigh, whose Eydon Hall Farm retains an interest in the sophomore, clearly outlined in the syndication agreement that the colt will cover a maximum of 100 mares per season and will not shuttle to the Southern Hemisphere for double duty. The roan kicked off his career with five wins from five starts, but had that streak snapped in his most recent start, the G1 Prix de Jockey Club at Chantilly June 2, when he was beaten only 1 1/2 lengths by Sulamani. With earnings of \$507,391, Act One was forced to retire because of a hairline fracture to a hind canon bone prior to a much anticipated meeting with High Chaparral in the G1 Irish Derby June 30.

**Simeon** enjoys a huge pull at the weights with his elders here and is a class act on the basis of his third placing behind Sulamani (Ire) and Act One (GB) last time in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 2. Previously he had taken the G3 Classic Trial at Sandown Apr. 26 with a power-packed performance from the front and can enjoy a lead off stable companion **Yavana's Pace** this time. Mark Johnston was the last trainer to saddle a three-year-old winner in this event with 1998 victor Fruits of Love, and in Simeon he has a genuine top-class performer in that mold. At the other end of the scale, Godolphin's **Kutub** has to defy a Group 1 penalty and that proved beyond him in the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 3 when he was fifth behind stablemate Marienbard (Ire) and **Millenary**. Although there appears no obvious reason why he should reverse that form, having disappointed when last of six in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 7, he is worth another chance on ground which will suit him. **Island House** showed an impressive turn of acceleration to win the Listed Leicester Mercury S. June 16, but has to better his best to reverse the form of last year's Listed Godolphin S. over this course in October, when he trailed in fourth behind **Mubtaker**.

## PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

The story goes that Atty Persse--the champion trainer who turned The Tetrarch into one of the legends of the English turf--was asked at a dinner party what he considered the most important quality in a racehorse.

"Speed," was the immediate reply. When Persse was pressed to name the next most important quality, "More speed" was the response. When his persistent questioner tried to extract a different answer by asking "but after that?" an unrelenting Persse replied, "Still more speed."

Persse's belief still holds true many years later, even though racing has changed a great deal in the interim. The enduring value of speed has been well illustrated in Europe in recent years by the stallion success enjoyed by such as Danehill, Indian Ridge, Green Desert, Cadeaux Genereux, Royal Academy, Anabaa and Pivotal, all of whom were major winners over a distance of five or six furlongs after the age of two.

Pivotal, a resident at Cheveley Park Stud, is shaping up as one of the most distinguished members of this select band, even though his fee in his first five years--from 1997 to 2001--was never higher than £6,000. You can get some idea of the impact he has made with his first two crops of racing from the fact that his fee was doubled from £5,000 in 2001 to £10,000 this year, and there's every chance that another substantial rise is on the cards for 2003.

### ***Pivotal makes the most of limited Opportunities***

Among Pivotal's current representatives are Kyllachy, who put up one of the year's best sprinting performances in the G2 Temple S.; Golden Apples, winner of the GII Santa Ana H.; and Megahertz, the remarkable import who kept her unbeaten record intact, thanks to the stewards, in the \$500,000 American Oaks.

From a total of 94 live foals in his 1998 and 1999 crops, Pivotal has already sired seven Group winners, plus another two stakes winners, and some of his other representatives, such as Red Carpet, Needwood Blade, Ratio and Ho Choi, have shown form worthy of a stakes victory. Considering that many of the members of these first two crops were produced by unremarkable mares, these are remarkable figures.

It is going to be interesting to see whether Pivotal can maintain this high profile with his third crop, sired at a reduced fee of £5,000. The signs are encouraging, judging by Saturday's Leopardstown success by his daughter Plume Rouge, whose victory came at the main expense of Some Kind of Tiger, a half brother by Storm Cat to the Oaks and Irish Derby winner Balanchine.

Pivotal was bred at Cheveley Park Stud, as was Megahertz. Although it was normally Cheveley Park's policy at that time to offer their colts at auction, either as foals or yearlings, the son of Polar Falcon did not make it to the sales ring. Pivotal managed only six starts during the two seasons he spent with Sir Mark Prescott, but he was good enough to win four of them, including the G2 King's Stand S. and the G1 Nunthorpe S.

His wins prompted me to ask, in a *Sporting Life* column, "How is it that this season's top British five-furlong performer has two parents who never even tackled a distance as short as five furlongs?"

I went on to explain that not only had Pivotal's parents never tackled Britain's minimum trip, but they had also run respectably over distances beyond a mile.

Indeed, it wasn't until after Polar Falcon had raced 12 times, and won four races over a mile (including the G2 Lockinge S.), that he finally showed himself to be equally at home over six furlongs. This he did by producing a startling late run to collar Sheikh Albadou in the G1 Ladbroke Sprint Cup. (*Insights cont. p5*)

Pivotal's dam, Fearless Revival, was third of 10 in the Ballymacoll Stud S., a Listed race over 1 ¼ miles. At two, she had quickly stepped up to seven furlongs after a facile win over six, and the daughter of Cozzene proved very much at home over the longer distance.

I could have added that the four stallions in the third generation of Pivotal's pedigree--Northern Dancer, Jefferson, Caro and Bustino--all won over at least 1 ¼ miles. Pivotal had clearly done extremely well to show such considerable speed. The source of this speed could be his third dam, Zerbinetta, a dual five-furlong winner at two who was herself a daughter of the fast juvenile Yucatan. However, we mustn't forget that Pivotal's grandsire, Nureyev, sired some very fast offspring, including Fasliyev, Stravinsky, Wolfhound, Dancing Dissident, Great Commotion, Diffident and Vilikaia.

Kyllachy, who will eventually stand alongside his sire at Cheveley Park, has shown that Pivotal is capable of passing on his speed. The signs are, though, that Pivotal is going to be quite a versatile stallion, thanks to the middle-distance elements in his pedigree. Golden Apples, who is inbred 4x3 to Caro, has gained all three of her Graded wins over 1 1/8 miles, including the G1 Del Mar Oaks, while Silvester Lady, a filly inbred 3x3 to Nureyev, won the G1 German Oaks over 1 3/8 miles. Now Pivotal has a third Oaks winner in Megahertz, whose American Oaks success came over 1 ¼ miles.

These winners are likely to be just the tip of the iceberg. The widespread success of Pivotal's first juveniles in 2000 brought him a book of around 100 mares in 2001 and he filled rapidly for this year's season. Cheveley Park showed its faith in Pivotal by committing 22 of the stud's 108 mares to him this year, including daughters of Sadler's Wells, Unbridled, Caerleon, Darshaan, A.P. Indy, Shirley Heights, Fabulous Dancer, Slip Anchor and Nashwan. Clearly the hope is that Pivotal's speed will prove very beneficial to these stoutly-bred mares.

Cheveley Park's 22 include Megahertz's dam, the dual-winner Heavenly Ray, and two half sisters to Golden Apples. Heavenly Ray returned to the races after conceiving Megahertz and showed improved form to win over seven furlongs at Goodwood, where she accounted for the future Group 1 winner White Heart. This daughter of Rahy had cost only \$52,000 as a yearling, even though she was a grand-daughter of the high-class Plankton.

A Graded winner at the ages of two, four and five, Plankton also reached the first three in each of the New York Fillies' Triple Crown events. As Plankton stayed pretty well, it was no surprise when Buckley Boy, her son by Alydar, developed into a Graded winner at up to 1 5/8 miles. Megahertz's second dam, Highest Truth, is a winning sister to Buckley Boy.

It is worth noting that Megahertz's dam has some Raise A Native blood because Pivotal's sire Polar Falcon did well with Raise A Native's descendants, siring the Group 1 winner Exclusive from an Exclusive Native mare and his other Group 1 winner, Shibuni's Falcon, from a grand-daughter of Mr. Prospector.
