**END SWEEP DEAD**

**End Sweep** (Forty Niner--Broom Dance, by Dance Spell), America's champion freshman sire of 1998, was euthanized Thursday at Shadai Farm in Japan. The 11-year-old stallion suffered an injury to his withers last month and it was announced Tuesday that End Sweep would not shuttle to Arrowfield Stud in Australia for the southern hemisphere breeding season. His condition

continued to deteriorate and the decision was made to euthanize the stallion. "I believe he will prove to be a big loss not only to Arrowfield but to the Australian breeding industry," said John Messara, chairman of Arrowfield, told [racenet.com.au](http://racenet.com.au).

Arrowfield purchased End Sweep in 1999. "He was

a champion sire that was set to make a big impact here with his first runners. We are really disappointed with what has happened as Australian breeders supported him very well in his time here," Messara added. From five crops to race, he has sired 22 stakes winners and the earners of over \$23 million.

**STARINE RETIRED**

**Starine (Fr)** (Mendocino--Grisonnante {Fr}, by Kaldoun {Fr}) has been retired by owner and trainer Bobby Frankel. The trainer did not spell out any specific physical ailment in the five-year-old, telling *Daily Racing Form* that she "has come back bad twice now." Winner in her native country of the Listed Prix Saraca, the grey mare exploded onto the U.S. scene last year with an impressive win in the GII Diana H. at Saratoga. A distant 10th in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf, she ended the season with a victory in the GI Matriarch S. at Hollywood Park and was twice second in two starts this year, first to Golden Apples in the GII Santa Ana H. Mar. 23 and most recently by a head to Astra in the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood May 27. "She's been good to me and I should be good to her," the conditioner told *DRF*. She retires with a career mark of 31-9-12-1 and earnings of \$963,740.

**XTRA HEAT LOOKS XTRA TOUGH AGAIN**

The ever-dominant sweetheart of the Thoroughbred world, sprinter **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat), returns after a month's rest to strut her stuff carrying a hefty 127 pounds as the highweight in today's GII Princess Rooney H. at Calder. Last year's champion three-year-old filly returned from a demanding trip to Dubai, where she was third to Caller One and Echo Eddie in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen S. Mar. 23, to show no ill effects and wire the field in the GII Genuine Risk H. at Belmont May 12. She was most recently all out to hold off the late challenge of **Gold Mover** (Gold Fever) by a neck in the GII Vagrancy H. June 8 and that rival should prove toughest this afternoon. Ridden for the first time by jockey Jerry Bailey, the Edward Evans-homebred, disqualified from a victory in the GI Humana Distaff at Churchill May 4, has the benefit of the inside and is in receipt of 12 pounds from the favorite. She'll likely be closer to Xtra Heat's flank here in an attempt to reverse her fortunes at the line. Longshot **Vague Memory** (Ward off Trouble) got the better of Gold Mover in the GIII Chaposas Springs H. at Calder last December, earning the win in a photo. The locally based five-year-old had gone winless in 2002, prior to leading the field from gate to wire in the Ms. Gibson County S. over track and trip June 16.

**SOFT GROUND FOR OAKS HOPEFULS** Thursday's heavy rain has changed the going to soft ahead of Sunday's G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh. Aidan O'Brien declared both **Kournakova (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Starbourne (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) for the 1 1/2-mile contest yesterday alongside Cashmans' 4-5 favourite **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). The latter will bid to become the first runner-up in the G1 Epsom Oaks to gain compensation here since Regal Exception took in 1972. She will need to confirm the form of the Epsom Classic June 7 with the fifth-placed **Red Rioja (Ire)** (King's Theatre {Ire}) and sixth-placed **Mellow Park (Ire)** (In the Wings {GB}), who beat **Lady's Secret (Ire)** (Alzao) by 1 1/2 lengths in last Saturday's G3 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock. Red Rioja was subsequently third behind **Irresistible Jewel (Ire)** (Danehill) in the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot June 21 and that Dermot Weld-trained filly is currently quoted as the 11-2 second favourite.

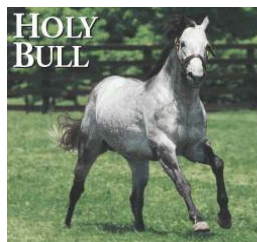

Bobby Frankel's **Staging Post** debuted for the trainer on American soil to win versus \$80,000 optional claimers at 1 1/8 miles at Santa Anita in early March. Stretching out two starts later to 1 3/4 miles in the GI San Juan Capistrano H. Apr. 21, he turned for home with a short lead, but relinquished in the final panel to finish second by 3 1/2 lengths. On vacation since, Frankel shipped him to New York this week after a series of works at Hollywood. **Startac** took the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington last August, but the hasn't visited the winner's circle since. Sixth to Denon in the GI Charlie Whittingham H. at Hollywood June 15, the principles of the Allen Paulson Living Trust decided that there were more opportunities for the four-year-old on the East Coast and the colt was transferred from Laura de Seroux to the barn of Bill Mott. **Moon Solitaire** looks to make it two straight, after winning the GII King Edward Breeders' Cup H. at Woodbine June 16.

After this event attracted no more than three contenders last year, the decision was made to restrict the race to three-year-olds and drop the trip to a mile. While that policy appears to have worked only marginally, **Century City**, who is having his final start for Aidan O'Brien before he is transferred to the States, should have too many guns for his two stable companions and three outside opponents. Having won the Listed Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial S. Apr. 14, he took the G3 Tetrarch S. over this course May 6 before being outclassed when second to Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas here May 25. He was only beaten four lengths by No Excuse Needed (GB) when fifth in the G2 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 18 last time, showing he is still on the upgrade. Gerard Butler's **Common World** stepped up from handicap company to finish third behind Burning Sun in the Listed Hampton Court S. at Royal Ascot June 20 and he appears the biggest threat. Overseas raiders have won eight of the last 10 renewals and he will relish this rain-softened ground.

Having finished ninth behind stable companion Statue of Liberty in the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 18, Spartacus is on a retrieval mission, having created a smart impression on his debut when winning a Gowran Park maiden May 15. Ontario fared better at the Royal meeting over the five furlongs of the Windsor Castle S. June 21, finishing fourth behind Revenue (Ire) from an unfavourable draw. Having beaten the tough and game Pakhoes (Ire) by a head in a soft ground Curragh maiden May 6 previously, he sets the standard here and may appreciate the trip more than his stable companion, whose Gowran success came over seven furlongs.

**Tout Charmant** (Slewvescent), retired from racing earlier this year to be bred to Storm Cat, has been returned to the California barn of trainer Ron McAnally to prepare for the resumption of her racing career. The six-year-old, winner of the GI Del Mar Oaks at three and the GI Matriarch S. in 2000, lost her Storm Cat foal and the decision was made to give her another shot at the races. "We checked her at 18 days and she was fine, but was empty after we checked her after the 26th day," Bobby Spalding, manager of Robert and Janice McNair's Stonerside Farm told The Blood-Horse. "She's completely sound." Also the runner-up in the 2000 Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf, the bay has eight wins from 27 trips to the post and career earnings of \$1,721,877.

Runner-up in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. last season and third by a neck in the GIII Pebbles H., both over this turf, Shooting Party was a distant seventh in the GIII Athenia H. in October and closed the season with a fifth in the Frances A. Genter S. at Calder Dec. 15. In two starts this year, the homebred was fifth sprinting over the local main June 5 and was most recently a very rank eighth going 8 1/2 panels on the turf July 5. Cutting back to a sprint for this, the grey filly raced with the pace three wide, put a head in front turning for home and held gamely for the win ahead of a tough-luck Dat You Miz Blue and favored Softly Tread, who dead-heated for second.

**Breeders' Cup Sets New Eligibility Rules:**

In an effort to prevent seriously overmatched horses from being entered in the Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships, the Board of Directors of Breeders' Cup Limited yesterday established new minimum eligibility requirements during their annual board meeting in Lexington. The rules apply to six of the eight championship races, but do not apply to the Breeders' Cup Juvenile or the Juvenile Fillies. The rules read as follows:

•*For a three-year-old or older horse that has broken his maiden: Any horse that has started for \$15,000 or less and has not won for \$20,000 or more in the previous two years or has not finished second, third, fourth or fifth for \$20,000 or more since running for \$15,000 or less, is not eligible to be pre-entered, entered or run in a Breeders' Cup race.*

•*For any maiden three-year-old or older that has started in a maiden-claiming race of \$32,000 or less: Maidens that have started in a maiden race of \$18,000 or less will not be eligible. Maidens that have started in a maiden race of \$32,000 or less at ANY TIME and have not finished second, third, fourth or fifth in a maiden race greater than \$18,000 within their last four starts will not be eligible. Horses must start in at least four maiden claiming races for this rule to apply.*

The rules take immediate effect with this year's running of the Breeders' Cup at Arlington Park.
