CAUTIOUS OPTIMISM AT KEENELAND

The first of the summer's major yearling sales, the Keeneland July Selected Yearling Sale gets under way this evening at 7:30 p.m. in Lexington, with 175 horses set to go under auctioneer Ryan Mahan's hammer. As was the case a year ago, a sputtering economy, fueled by corporate misdeeds, looms a threat to buyer confidence, but Keeneland Director of Sales Geoff Russell is trying to view the glass as half full. "We naturally have to be concerned about the situation with the stock market, but we tend to look on the positive side of things," he commented.

Despite Tough Times, Sale Continues To Prosper...

The general economic decline has been well documented, yet in many ways, the July Sale has weathered the storm quite well. In 2000, Keeneland reported sales on a total of 130 horses for \$80,732,000 and an average of \$621,015, marking the sixth consecutive year of increases in both statistics. Due in large part to a catalog which featured just 164 yearlings, the streak was partially snapped last July when the gross reached "just" \$63,212,000. However, only 89 lots were reported as sold during two sessions, resulting in an average of \$710,247, a 14.4-percent increase over the three-session sale in 2000. A more important barometer, according to Russell, is the performance of the middle market. Last year's median of \$430,000 represented a 7.5-percent hike versus 2000. "We really don't like to focus on the average," he explained. "We're more concerned with the median, which we would certainly like to see grow. Sometimes it's hard to recruit buyers when they see that the average for a sale is so much higher than the median." *Cont. p2-3*

TACTICAL CAT

Storm Cat - Terre Haute, by Caro (Ire)

Grade I winner at 2

First yearlings sell this summer



Sire Firepower...

The typically strong menu of world-class stallions includes perennial leading sire Storm Cat, whose five yearlings a year ago sold for an aggregate of \$8.85 million, headlined by his \$3-million filly out of Inca Lagacy, a full sister to GISW Catinca. The Overbrook Farm stallion is represented by six yearlings, including hip number 105, set to sell early during tomorrow's final session. The chestnut filly, consigned by David and Ginger Mullins (Doninga), agent, is out of Amelia Bearhart (Bold Hour), making her a half sister to 1997 champion grass horse Chief Bearhart, GISW Explosive Red and Ruby Ransom, the dam of MGSW Strut the Stage. Deputy Minister leads all sires with 15 cataloged, while other prominent stallions include A.P. Indy (6), Danzig (5), Gone West (10), Kingmambo (11), Saint Ballado (3), Seeking the Gold (6), Thunder Gulch (2), Unbridled (7) and Unbridled's Song (4). A pair of Kentucky Derby winners and two promising sons of Storm Cat head up a list of eight freshman sires with their first crop of yearlings. Taylor Made's Forestry (Storm Cat, seven cataloged) and Exploit (Storm Cat, six) are joined by Three Chimneys' Silver Charm (Silver Buck, one), winner of the 1997 Run for the Roses; and Lane's End's 1999 Derby hero Charismatic (Summer Squall, two). Old Trieste (A.P. Indy, six), champion sprinter Artax (Marquetry, one), Horse Chestnut (SAf) (Fort Wood, one), and 1998 Belmont S. winner Victory Gallop (Cryptoclearance, one) complete a formidable group of newcomers. "We have a strong catalogue that appeals to both foreign and domestic buyers," Russell commented. The quality of the horses when our veterinarians checked them out earlier this year and everyone seems happy that the horses have progressed nicely."

New Kids On The Block...

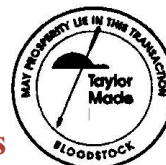
Several new consignors appear on the July scene for the first time this year. Comprised of Central Kentucky horsemen Kerry Cauthen, Walmac's John T.L. Jones Jr., bloodstock agent Dan Kenny and Glencrest Farm's David Greathouse, Four Star Sales, founded this past March, consigns five head to the sale. "The response that we have gotten has been extremely positive," Cauthen, who is the managing partner of the agency, commented. "We've all been around for a while and we enjoy our working partnership." Four Star Sales will expand in the near future. Cauthen estimates that his group will consign about 170 horses to the September Sale and somewhere between 225 and 250 to the Keeneland November Sale. Another new name in the Keeneland July catalogue is Paramount Sales, a partnership involving Taylor Made Sales Agency, Gaines-Gentry Thoroughbreds, Castleton Lyons farm and Pat Costello of Drumkenny Farm. Explaining how Paramount came to be, Mark Taylor of Taylor Made said, "With our name recognition, new people were coming to us, looking to get into the business, and we were seeking a new outlet to keep people under the Taylor Made umbrella while still spending the lion's share of our time focusing on our existing customers. We created a really interesting mix of people, something that had not been done before in the horse industry." Paramount debuted at the Keeneland October Sale and was an immediate success, ending the auction as the leading consignor by gross sales and selling the saletopper, a \$400,000 Pleasant Colony colt. "When people see the quality that Paramount will be represented with at Keeneland July and Fasig-Tipton July, I think they will be impressed," Taylor said. "They have seven at Keeneland and 15 at Fasig-Tipton, and they have stunning individuals in both catalogues." Also making their Keeneland July debut is Chris Hodges and his wife Mindy Powell-Hodges, who consign under the banner of Hodgewell Farm. The Florida-based operation was active at last year's November Sale, acquiring five weanlings for a combined \$614,000. Each of the five lots is wheeled back this week, the most expensive of which is a Saint Ballado--Smokey Mirage filly (hip 184), which was purchased for \$235,000. Also included in the consignment is a Gulch filly purchased in January. "We're pleased that we have some new clients participating in the July Sale for the first time," Geoffrey Russell commented. The July Sale is an important barometer for the whole industry and people want to be part of it. The success of the July Sale has made it obvious that it's a sale they need to participate in."

The Return of Some Old Friends...


Keeneland also welcomes the return to the mid-summer sale of William S. Farish's Lane's End Farm. The Versailles, Kentucky- based nursery had focused its attention on the September Sale over the last two years, where they were the top consignor, with nearly \$85 million in combined sales. "We are very much still going to be a part of this year's September Sale, but we felt that some of the horses in our yearling crop fit very well into this sale so we decided to enter them," said Bill Farish of Lane's End, who estimates that they will consign about 100 head in the first two books of the September Sale. Other major Central Kentucky studs with consignments include the Hancock family's Claiborne Farm, Calumet Farm, Arthur B. Hancock III's Stone Farm and Sheikh Hamdan's Shadwell Farm, which makes its July debut after consigning horses to the 2002 January Sale.

Taylor Made 2002...

This year, Taylor Made will offer 30 lots. One to watch, said Mark Taylor, is Hip 186. "There are not a lot of Storm Cats on the market this year and that makes our Storm Cat colt out of Tacha (Mr. Prospector) obviously one in the spotlight," he said. "Past him, we have a slew of horses who are really good physicals and have pedigrees that make people think about winning the best races in the world. We also have a lot of young sires represented, including two of our own first-crop stallions, Exploit and Forestry. I think when people come in and see them, they are going to be blown away." Taylor Made will also sell Hip 180, an Unbridled's Song colt that was purchased by Aaron and Marie Jones for \$1.1 million at the Keeneland January Sale. "He is a carbon copy of his sire," Taylor said. "He was purchased in January, and not necessarily as a pinhook. But Mr. Jones had a change in plans and now nearly every yearling he owns will be sold. He sold three horses at Keeneland July last year that grossed almost \$7.5 million, and that allows him to diversify and do other things, maybe buy a made race horse. Also, Unbridled's Song had a great spring, with one of the best three-year-olds in the country [Buddha], and he had a Breeders' Cup winner last year in Unbridled Elaine, so there have been some things over the past several months that have had a positive effect on this horse's value."

A Positive Spin on the Market...

The stock market dropped precipitously last week, reaching lows not seen since 1997. But some believe that could actually be a positive sign for the Thoroughbred market. Mark Taylor of Taylor Made Sales Agency is one of them. "I think the risk levels of the two, the stock market and the Thoroughbred market, have flipped," he said, echoing the thoughts of Geoff Russell. "People have no confidence in what's going on in the stock market, but they have a lot of confidence in the people they have been dealing with in the Thoroughbred market. The horse business had been perceived as more high risk, but with the stock market in the state it's in, that's not the case any more." He added, "In our game, you want to believe, as Wayne Lukas has always said, that yearling sales are inflation-proof on the top end. It's more about people being in love with the horse business and wanting to play at the top level, and they want to play at that level regardless of the ebbs and flows of the economy. We are cautiously optimistic that we will have a very good sale. We have a great collection of horses...hopefully we will have as good a sale as last year, which was incredible." Taylor Made was the leading consignor by gross last year, selling 17 yearlings for a total of \$15,130,000. They had four sell for seven figures, including the sales-topping \$4-million Saint Ballado colt.

The six-year-old Sky Jack became the latest California-bred Grade I winner when he outbattled Momentum in a thrilling stretch duel. A seven-length winner of the GIII Native Diver H. in December of 2000, the front-running grey was forced to undergo knee surgery and didn't return until Feb. 9, when he ran second by a nose in a Santa Anita allowance. He never fired when 14th in Milwaukee Brew's GI Santa Anita H., but bounced back to form with a free-running victory in the GII Mervyn LeRoy H. May 12 at Hollywood. Macaneo (Arg) (Payant {Arg}) came through along the rail to test Sky Jack early, but they were able to get through a half in :46.94. As Macaneo began to tire on the far turn, Sky Jack was joined by Momentum and the battle began in earnest. The pair raced in tandem, with Sky Jack on the inside pinning his ears back to deny Momentum's challenge and giving jockey Laffit Pincay, Jr. a record ninth Gold Cup victory. "Oh man, that was exciting, a good race," exclaimed Pincay. "I had a little more competition up front than I expected, but my horse was still doing it easily. [After he was headed] he kept digging in and he kept coming back. He likes the fight." Jockey Garrett Gomez, aboard Momentum, quipped, "I wish that old man [Pincay] would retire. He's tough, but I guess that's why he is a Hall of Famer." Pincay had previously been tied with Bill Shoemaker for most Gold Cup victories.

Gold Cup Winner from the Golden State Foaled in Temecula, **Sky Jack** is the 12th California-bred to win the Hollywood Gold Cup. It's been a long, strange trip for the six-year-old, according to trainer Doug O'Neill. "He's actually had two knee surgeries on the same [right] knee, a chip taken out each time," he said. "And then during the recovery time of the second [surgery] he actually had a bout of colic twice. It is really to the credit of the Lamberts who are so patient with their horses."

MARGARULA OVER THE MOON Margarula (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) had provided no clues so far this year that she was capable of besting such as **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), finishing fifth in the Listed Victor McCalmont Memorial S. at Gowran Park June 6 and fourth in the G2 Hunston Financial Pretty Polly S. over this course June 29 in her two tries at stakes level. Previously she had won a competitive handicap at Leopardstown May 12 in her only other race at this distance. Nevertheless, the ease with which she traveled in last place throughout the early stages and the confidence with which Kevin Manning rode her from there belied her starting odds. Aided by the sterling work carried out up front by Quarter Moon's stable companions **Kournakova (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Starbourne (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), she made smooth progress on the inner at the top of the straight as most of her rivals struggled to get on terms. As Michael Kinane switched the favourite for her run, which took her to the head of affairs approaching the quarter-mile marker, Margarula found herself running into a pocket as Starbourne and Kournakova tired. Extricated from that squeeze by Manning, she quickened to collar the favourite at the furlong pole and, despite that filly's rallying efforts, was always in control from there, asserting to win a shade comfortably. Last successful in this event with Give Thanks (GB) in 1983, her trainer Jim Bolger pulled off a surprise here equivalent to that of Jet Ski Lady, whom he trained to win the 1991 Epsom Oaks at odds of 50-1. "We were hopeful that she would run into a place," Bolger said. "She ran well here when fourth in the Pretty Polly S. and we knew the extra two furlongs here today would be a big help." Margarula will now head to the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York Aug. 21.

Came Home had a wonderful partnership with Hall of Famer Chris McCarron, the pair combining for seven wins from nine career outings. That chapter was closed June 23 at Hollywood, when McCarron hung up his tack after piloting Came Home to victory in the GIII Affirmed H. Jockey Mike Smith was tabbed to fill McCarron's irons for the Swaps, and the new team has started successfully with a front-running victory yesterday at Hollywood. "Everything they told me about him was right on," Smith said. "Chris has been so good about everything. He called me this morning and he gave me his scenario about how he thought the race would set up. It certainly gave me a lot more confidence, and it worked out just like he told me." A record-setting winner of the GI Hopeful S. at two, the brilliant colt reeled off three straight victories to begin 2002, taking the GII San Vicente, the GII San Rafael and the GI Santa Anita Derby in succession. The 10 furlongs of the GI Kentucky Derby proved a bit too far, but Came Home still finished a solid sixth in the May 4 Classic. With the Affirmed victory under his belt, the heavy chalk broke alertly and dueled with Battler Bob (Shuaailaan) through three-quarters in 1:10.73. Came Home began to inch away on the far turn and was ridden out to score by a comfortable margin. A return trip to Saratoga is possible for the dark bay, either for the GI King's Bishop S. Irguns Angel maintained her perfect record in 2002 by reeling in pacesetting Secret Liaison to earn her first graded victory. An eight-length maiden winner at two, the bay filly followed that up with a second to Collect Call (Meadowlake) in the GIII Santa Ysabel S. last January, but was sidelined with ankle chips following a fourth in the restricted Torrey Pines S. Aug. 31 at Del Mar. She resurfaced May 2 to take an optional claimer over this surface, then shipped up to Bay Meadows to win the Sunnvale H. exactly one month later. Secret Liaison broke running and held a clear advantage through fractions of :21.74 and :44.04 as hot favorite Kalookan Queen raced in third. She passed the eighth pole 2 1/2 lengths in front, but Irguns Angel had commenced a strong run on the turn and was drawing nearer with every stride, finally getting up to win by a head. "Looks like a day for the senior citizens," commented winning rider Eddie Delahoussaye, following Laffit Pincay Jr. with a graded-stakes victory of his own. "I knew that Kent Desormeaux [aboard Secret Liaison] would try to scoot away, but I waited until my filly straightened up before I really called on her." As for the favorite, six-year-old Kalookan Queen never gave jockey Alex Solis the speed she usually possesses. "I felt that she should have run a lot better," he said. "She was kind of flat today."

He reversed Newbury form at the Royal meeting to beat Izdiham (Ire), who has subsequently taken the Listed Gala S. at Sandown July 5; and Common World, runner-up in Saturday's G2 Goffs International S. at The Curragh. Here he traveled easily in second early under Richard Quinn as Kaieteur went to the front in an attempt to stretch his rivals. Those tactics looked sound in the straight as most of the field were at work to make inroads, but Quinn was stoking his mount for a challenge and he responded with a strong effort. That took him past the long-time leader with 300 yards remaining and he was pushed out to assert from there, always holding the rallying runner-up in the drive to the line. "He has been getting better with each race--he's very genuine and he just takes a while to warm up as he probably gets a mile and a half really," said Quinn. "The trainer [Henry Cecil] specifically came to this race to keep him to three-year-old company, but the horse he beat at Ascot [Izdiham] took on his elders at Sandown and beat them, so his form is very very good." Aramram (Danzig), whose only previous start in France came when unseating Steve Drowne during the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly June 2, repeated that trick at the top of the straight this time. The G1 St. James's Palace S. third swerved badly from the gates and pulled hard in behind before dumping Drowne.

Chiselling becomes the fourth graded-stakes winner from five foals to race for his dam, the talented Toussaud. "[Trainer] Bobby Frankel told me not to mess it up," said winning rider Jerry Bailey. "He didn't want to go in the gate, but it didn't upset him. I knew from the way he was warming up he wouldn't have much early speed. He had no problem going through any of those holes and he really dug in the last eighth."
