**SEVEN SET FOR MARATHON**

Just one of the seven fillies entered in today's GI Coaching Club American Oaks has ever been beyond nine furlongs, so the additional 3/8-mile looms as a big question mark for most of these. The lone graded-stakes winner in the field, **Chamrousse** (Peaks and Valleys) displayed her tactical speed in defeating **Shop Till You Drop** (Thunder Gulch) in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. May 17 and followed that up with a second in the GI Mother Goose S. June 29. "Her consistency is one of her best characteristics," said trainer Niall O'Callaghan. "Her types benefit in long races on the dirt. It's

always hard to tell if they'll get this distance beforehand, but I think she will." **Jaramar Rain** (Thunder Gulch) never got involved when a distant fifth in her stakes debut, the GIII Dogwood H. May 25, but got back on track July 3, rolling to 6 1/4-length victory against elder allowance foes at Belmont. The distance isn't a concern for trainer Rusty Arnold. "She's by a Belmont winner out of a mare by a Belmont winner," he noted. The chestnut's broodmare sire is Risen Star. **Linda Eder** (Lear Fan) ships in from California on the strength of a 3 1/2-length success going 1 1/2 miles on the turf at Hollywood June 20.

The chestnut wired the field in winning the GIII Lone Star Derby May 11, but packed it in early when ninth in the GI Belmont S. June 8. He cuts back to a much more suitable distance this time and will be tough to run down. "He just couldn't handle the track and when the jockey [Jorge Chavez] saw that, he didn't punish him in a 1 1/2-mile race," said trainer Niall O'Callaghan. **Magic Weisner** missed becoming Maryland's hero by just 3/4-length when second to War Emblem in the GI Preakness S. May 18. He followed that up with a fourth in the Belmont.

Despite the disappointing turn out, both in terms of quality and quantity, this appears a tight and competitive renewal. **Pushkin** had **Miraculous** a short neck back in second when giving that rival three pounds in the Listed Prix du Carrousel at Longchamp June 6, his third visit to that track so far this term. Previously he had finished fourth behind Califet (Fr) in the G3 Prix du d'Hedouville Apr. 18 and third behind subsequent G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud winner Ange Gabriel (Fr) in the Listed Prix Lord Seymour Mar. 31. **Polish Summer**, a late-maturing type, was only beaten two lengths when runner-up to Ange Gabriel in Saint-Cloud's showpiece June 30, holding Aquarelliste (Fr) by a short head with Califet (Fr) four lengths back in fourth. He has always promised to be a smart staying prospect, evidenced in his fine second to Speedmaster (Ger) in the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier at Longchamp last May. **Clety** put in a fine effort when a neck second to And Beyond (Ire) in the Listed Prix la Moskowa at Chantilly June 28 and warrants respect, as does **Boreas**. He is suited by this trip, as he proved last time when second to Daliapour (Ire) in the G3 Curragh Cup June 29 and when runner-up to Zindabad (Fr) in the G2 Yorkshire Cup at York May 16.

**SLEW REMEMBERED** A memorial service was held for Seattle Slew Friday evening at Hill 'n' Dale Farm. A sculpture of the 1977 Triple Crown hero was unveiled at the service. "It was 27 years ago on this very night at Fasig-Tipton; I will never forget the first time I met you," said owner Karen Taylor. "You were a gift from God and we were your caretakers." The Taylors purchased Slew at the Fasig-Tipton July Sale; he went on to win the Triple Crown while unbeaten and earned divisional titles at two, three and four before becoming one of the nation's most acclaimed stallions. "You made an indelible mark on the Thoroughbred world," Taylor added. "You were simply exceptional. You wore your own crown."

**MORE SURGERY FOR SUNDAY SILENCE** Leading Japanese sire **Sunday Silence** (Halo) underwent surgery July 18 to remove pus in his right foreleg, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The 16-year-old had been taken out of stud duty in May after suffering from a bacterial infection in his right foreleg. He had covered 130 mares prior to concluding his season. Officials at Shadai Stallion Station remain concerned about the star stallion's condition.

**STRONACH INTERESTED IN GREATNESS** The *Thoroughbred Times* has reported that Frank Stronach has purchased a minority interest in the undefeated three-year-old **Greatness** (Mr. Prospector). Terms of the agreement have not been disclosed, but Stronach has purchased the breeding rights to the colt, who is currently racing for his owner/breeders, Edward and Marilyn Seltzer. Out of the stakes-winning Danzig mare Harbour Club, Greatness is a 3/4-brother to MSW Holzmeister (Woodman) and descends from top broodmare High Voltage. He won by 3 1/4 lengths at first asking May 19 before romping by 10 1/2 lengths July 15 at Belmont. "He's been handling the sprints fine," said Ed Seltzer, "but it appears what he really wants is a distance of ground." That will have to wait until after Saratoga, as Seltzer has tabbed the GII Amsterdam S. Aug. 3 and the GI King's Bishop Aug. 24 for the chestnut colt.

Preparing for his title defense in the GI Whitney H. Aug. 3, **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold) worked five-eighths in 1:00 2/5 Friday morning...**Miss Mary Apples** (Clever Trick) tuned up for Wednesday's GI Schuylerville S. with a bullet half-mile breeze in :47 2/5...Also scheduled to run in the opening day feature at Saratoga, **Crimson and Roses** (El Prado {Ire}) stopped the clock in :48 3/5 for her four-furlong breeze at the Spa.

**Iron Deputy Points for Jim Dandy:**

**Iron Deputy** (Silver Deputy), a winner in three of his four starts including the Count Fleet S. at Aqueduct Jan. 5, will likely make his next appearance in the GI Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga Aug. 4. The bay had been sidelined since his Count Fleet score. "He had a little fracture in his shin, down low," trainer Jimmy Jerkens said. "We gave him some time off and it healed quickly. He has been training very good. He'll be weighted for the Haskell [GI, Monmouth Park, Aug. 4], but we're not really considering that race. We're pointing for the Jim Dandy." The colt, who worked a half-mile in :49 2/5 over the Belmont training track Wednesday, heads to Saratoga today. Jerkens added that **Puzzlement** (Pine Bluff), who was scratched from the GI Belmont S. with an abscess in his right front foot, will also be pointed for the Jim Dandy. The colt, trained by Jerkens' Hall of Fame father Allen, has not been out since finishing second in the May 25 GI Peter Pan S.

**Potomac Horse Fever Claims Filly:**

A Thoroughbred filly on a Central Kentucky farm recently died from Potomac Horse Fever (PHF), a disease rarely diagnosed in the Bluegrass. The cause of death was undetermined until results from a post-mortem performed at the University of Kentucky Livestock Disease Diagnostic Center were released June 27. The disease has its origins in the Potomac River area in Maryland, where an outbreak occurred in the 1980s. Researchers were able to link the bacteria which causes the disease to the parasites of freshwater snails and scientists at the University of California at Davis later determined that the bacteria infected the eggs of mayflies. The disease is transmitted when horses accidentally ingest the mature flies while grazing. In this instance, a two-year-old filly went off her feed and was suffering from a severe case of diarrhea. "We first noticed a little bit of a dip in her brightness prior to the sudden onset of severe diarrhea and depression," her owner explained. "On the morning of June 11, we placed an emergency call to our vet who advised us to send her to the clinic." The filly was transported to Rood and Riddle Equine Clinic in Lexington and was placed in isolation, standard operating procedure when diarrhea is present, but still, the root of the problem remained unclear. "We had no idea what the problem was," the owner continued. "If we had known what it was, they may have been able to treat her." The filly's condition deteriorated rapidly after several days in the clinic. "She was very swollen. Her face and her legs looked like a draft horse. Unfortunately, she began to founder in all four legs and the decision was made to put her down." The owner's eight other horses are reportedly well and show no sign of the disease. According to *thehorse.com*, owners are advised to be on the lookout for possible symptoms including lethargy, fever, loss of appetite and possibly diarrhea, according to Dr. Neil M. Williams.

**AQUARELLISTE ON TRACK FOR KING GEORGE**

Alec Wildenstein has reported **Aquarelliste (Fr)** (Danehill {USA}) on course for her clash with Sakhee in next Saturday's King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot. Last year's G1 Prix de Diane Hermes and G1 Prix Vermeille winner was beaten six lengths when second to Sakhee in the Arc. Wildenstein told the *Racing Post*, "They are making so much noise about Sakhee and Grandera that they must be trying to intimidate us--but we won't be intimidated." The Elie Lellouche-trained four-year-old suffered only her second career defeat last time when third in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud June 30, but she was in season. Wildenstein expects a bold show on Saturday. "She could not be in better form," he said. "Saint-Cloud was also her first time on a left-handed course and it seemed to bother her. She kept hugging the rail." He added, "If it is confirmed that she doesn't go well left-handed, it cuts out races in the United States and the Japan Cup. But we have nothing to lose by running her now."

Simon Crisford, racing manager to the Dubai-based operation, reported Sakhee to be "going particularly well at the moment" and "peaking at the right time," confessing that he believed, "it would very hard for Frankie not to ride him." Last year's International Classifications highweight on the basis of his wins in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York in August--in which he beat Grandera by seven lengths--and the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, and his runner-up performance in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic at Belmont Park in October, was subsequently third on his return in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23. He recently completed a racecourse gallop at Sandown. "He needed that quite badly because he'd been off the track since the Dubai World Cup," Crisford explained, adding that Sakhee's participation, however, "does hinge on the ground. If we consider the ground to be too firm, then we wouldn't risk Sakhee because he has had a history of knee problems...and we wouldn't want to risk him on really firm ground." Ascot's Clerk of the Course Nick Cheyne continued watering yesterday in a bid to provide ground no worse than good-to-firm.

## WRITERS UP

### TWO-YEAR-OLD REVIEW - Part 2 by Tom Frary

Through a combination of bad weather and trainer David Loder's softly-softly approach, the ball remains in the court of the "early-type" two-year-olds. Although it is always difficult to distinguish the sharp juveniles from the rest, it is foolhardy and dangerous to assume that, come next May or June, those plying their trade now will have nothing left to give.

Richard Hannon is perhaps the best in the game at garnering speedy types. He has already captured the G3 Norfolk S. with **Baron's Pit (GB)** (Night Shift {USA}), while **Mister Links (Ire)** (Flying Spur {Aus}), **Tacitus (Ire)** (Titus Livius {Fr}) and the unlucky-in-running **Tizzy May (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}) were first, second and fifth in the G3 July S. However, those who choose to patronise and pigeon-hole East Everleigh Stables as a solely "early bird" set-up should take into account that the 2002 crop are, of Hannon's own admission, the best bunch he has ever had.

Perhaps the one that can bid to extend his trainer's record of three 2000 Guineas winners is **Tycoon Hall (Ire)** (Halling {USA}), who made a striking impression when winning the maiden at Newmarket's July meeting, taken last year by no less than Dubai Destination (USA).

Newmarket's July meeting also provided a smart performance from the Barry Hills-trained **Greek Revival (USA)** (Royal Academy {USA}) in a competitive conditions event. That colt was, however, put in his place by **Deportivo (GB)** (Night Shift {USA}) in yesterday's Listed Rose Bowl S. at Newbury. Hills had a fine week there, also collecting the Listed Superlative S. with **Surbiton (USA)** (El Prado {Ire}) and the fillies' maiden, won by Gossamer (GB) last year, with **Fancy Lady (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}). That filly had found the Sir Michael Stoute-trained **Russian Rhythm (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}) a neck too strong in a maiden at the track two weeks earlier and the winner should be a warm order as she begins her rise to the top in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot next Saturday.

Whilst the promising Russian Rhythm has it to prove, **Romantic Liason (GB)** (Primo Dominie {GB}) emerged from the virus-stricken gloom of Brian Meehan's yard to storm clear of her rivals in the G3 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot. Compared with past luminary Forest Flower (USA) by Pat Eddery in the aftermath of that impressive display, she was snapped up by Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum, who will be looking for further success in York's G2 Lowther S. with her.

She will join an army of juveniles carrying on the winning tradition of the maroon and white silks; trainers Mick Channon and Mark Johnston boast a winner from practically every runner for "the boss" so far.

Johnston's enviable strike rate with juveniles, 27 percent, has been helped by such as the smart Listed Chesham S. winner **Helm Bank (GB)** (Wild Again {USA}) and York maiden scorer **Bourbonnais (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) and compares favourably with Neville Callaghan (31 percent) and David Elsworth (29 percent). The latter has two smart prospects on his hands in the Listed Royal Ascot winner **Duty Paid (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}) and unbeaten **Norse Dancer (Ire)** (Halling {USA}), of which there is plenty more to come.

Choice performances from the fillies have enlivened an otherwise dormant French juvenile scene. The Niarchos Family's **Six Perfections (Fr)** (Celtic Swing {GB}) impressed at Deauville, beating the smart **Nellie Nolan (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) by six lengths in the Listed Prix Roland de Chambure. She looks her sire's brightest prospect since Celtic Silence (GB). Others to note include the unbeaten **Ela Merici (Fr)** (Beaudelaire {USA}), whose comfortable success in a strong-looking G3 Prix du Bois at Chantilly prompted Alec Wildenstein to buy a major share, and the eye-catching Criquette Head-Maarek "dark horse" **Acago (USA)** (Royal Academy {USA}), whose burst of speed in a Fontainebleau debutantes event had to be seen to be believed.
