### NASHWAN DIES

One of the finest racehorses of the 1980s, **Nashwan** (Blushing Groom {Fr}--Height of Fashion {Fr}, by Bustino {GB}) was euthanized Friday evening after complications arose following minor surgery on his right hind leg. The 16-year-old stallion had been standing at Shadwell Nunnery Stud in Norfolk, England; his elder

half-brother Unfuwain (Northern Dancer) died there earlier this year. "Everyone at Shadwell is absolutely stunned by the loss of this great horse, and the Thoroughbred world has lost in Nashwan and Unfuwain two wonderful contributors to the breed in a very short time," said Richard Lan-

caster, Shadwell's stud director. "We are all absolutely shattered by the loss." The third foal of his champion dam, Nashwan captured both of his starts at two for Major Dick Hern, including the Red Oaks Autumn S., but truly exploded onto the scene as a three-year-old. The handsome chestnut won in succession the G1 2000 Guineas, the G1 Derby, the G1 Eclipse S. and the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., becoming the first horse in history to win those races in a single season. He lost his unbeaten record when prepping for the Arc in the G2 Prix Niel, finishing third to Golden Pheasant. That proved to be his final career start, leaving him with a record of six wins in seven starts with earnings of £793,360. He was named champion three-year-old in England in 1989.

### BAB-ING FOR APPLES

**Jilbab** (A.P. Indy) nearly lost jockey Mike Luzzi at the start of yesterday's GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont Park, but she got her feet back under her and rallied from the three-eighths pole to earn her first graded-stakes victory. Trained by Eoin Harty at two, the Sheikh Mohammed homebred broke her maiden in her third start at Arlington in September, but closed the year with a sixth in the GII Walmac Int'l Alcibiades S. at Keeneland Oct. 5. The dark bay returned to action at Belmont May 16, finishing second in entry-level allowance company, but broke through in her latest, a 13 1/4-length victory at a flat mile June 16. As the gates opened, Jilbab stumbled badly and dropped far back early on as **Sister Girl Blues** (Hold for Gold) and favored **Chamrousse** (Peaks and Valleys) set good fractions for the distance. Patiently handled, Jilbab rallied three wide on the far turn and closed steadily down the center of the track to catch **Tarnished Lady** (Lord Avie). "I was a little worried about her stumbling. I didn't want to see her get too far behind," said assistant trainer Tom Albertrani. "By the three-eighths pole, she was with them. She certainly showed her stamina today." **Bred in the Purple**

Nashwan's dam, Height of Fashion was bred by The Queen and was sold privately to Sheikh Hamdan after her championship two-year-old season. The royally bred mare quickly proved priceless at stud, producing MGSW Alwasmi (Northern Dancer) in her first year and following up with MGSW Unfuwain and Nashwan. She later produced Listed winners Mukdaam (Danzig) and Sarayir (Mr. Prospector); and the stakes-placed pair of Bashayer (Mr. Prospector) and Wijdan (Mr. Prospector). Her final foal is MG1SW Nayef (Gulch). Retired to Nunnery Stud, Nashwan was a solid performer at stud, with 25 stakes winners to date. Among his progeny is **Swain (Ire)**, who proved a top-class performer from three to six with victories in two King Georges, a Coronation Cup, an Irish Champion S. and a fine third in the Breeders' Cup Classic on his final start. Twice the highweighted older horse in England at 11-14 furlongs, Swain's earnings stand at over \$2.9 million. Nashwan also sired U.S. champion turf mare **Wandesta (GB)**, who earned over \$1.2 million while winning three Grade I events; and **One So Wonderful (GB)**, heroine of the G1 Juddmonte International and the highweight older mare in England over 9.5-11 furlongs; as well as Group 1 winners **Aqaarid** and **Nadia (GB)**. Magic Weisner put together a five-race winning skein over the winter at Laurel Park, including three stakes events restricted to Maryland-breds and capping the streak with a 4 1/4-length victory against open company in the Private Terms S. Mar. 20. The bay was forced to endure a three- and four-wide journey in the Apr. 20 Federico Tesio S. at Pimlico and could do no better than second, but gained national attention when he motored down the stretch at Old Hilltop May 18, putting a scare into War Emblem when second by three parts of a length in the GI Preakness S. Most recently the gelding was an even fourth in the GI Belmont S. June 8, but was the second choice in the wagering behind GIII Lone Star Derby winner Wiseman's Ferry. The latter set the early pace, as expected, but "The Weis" (pronounced 'Wiz') was ridden to keep that rival in the crosshairs through the opening furlongs. He felt a crack of jockey Richard Migliore's whip with five-sixteenths to run, dug in gamely and caught the front-runner in the shadow of the wire for a well-deserved first graded-stakes success. Owner, breeder and trainer Nancy Alberts said that her charge is under consideration for the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Aug. 4 and/or the GI Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 24. **Prix Maurice De Nieuil cont.**

Pushkin, ridden with confidence by jockey Dominique Boeuf, delivered a convincing turn of acceleration to overhaul the favourite Polish Summer in the closing stages for his most important success to date. Last year, he took the Listed Prix Michel Houyvet at Deauville in August before finishing third in the G3 Prix de Lutece at Longchamp in September and G2 Prix Hubert de Chaudenay at that track the following month. Returning to finish third in the Listed Prix Lord Seymour Mar. 31, that form received a considerable boost when the winner Ange Gabriel (Fr) went on to beat Polish Summer in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. Having finished fourth behind Califet (Fr) in the G3 Prix du d'Hedouville Apr. 18, he took the Listed Prix du Carrousel by a short neck from Miraculous last time. This time, he was held up in last place early off the even pace set by Boreas (GB) (In The Wings {GB}) before angling out on the turn into the straight. Quickening to challenge Polish Summer, who had been committed by jockey Olivier Peslier with 2½ furlongs to race, he passed that rival at the furlong marker before asserting under a hand ride.

**Delaware Oaks cont.**

A five-length winner of her two-turn debut in the Churchill slop May 2, Allamerican Bertie was tested for class in the GIII Dogwood S. May 25, and acquitted herself very well, finishing third, beaten three lengths by the ultra-tough Take Charge Lady. A half sister to the late Hurricane Bertie, the bay was hand ridden to an easy 3 3/4-length allowance score beneath the Twin Spires June 21 and was the third choice in this sextet. The Klein family colorbearer was snugly held as she argued the early pace with favored Alternate before poking her head in front after a half mile in a solid :46 2/5. She shook loose entering the far turn and extended her advantage down the stretch to win impressively. "The first thing I wanted to do was get her to relax," commented winning rider Larry Melancon. "The last time I rode her, she did not relax. Today she broke and really settled. I had her in hand and when she turned for home she just exploded." Saratoga is next on the dance card for the winner. "We'll probably run her in the [GI] Alabama S. [Aug. 17]," winning trainer Steve Flint said. "The mile and a quarter really intrigues me." California shipper Adoration (Honor Grades), recent winner of the GII Hollywood Breeders' Cup Oaks, struggled with the track and finished last.

**Hanshin Cup H. cont.**

Bonapaw started the year with back-to-back stakes wins at Fair Grounds, then shipped halfway around the world for the Mar. 23 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen and finished sixth, 9 1/2 lengths behind Caller One. Rested after that effort, the six-year-old came back on the 4th of July and, after pressing a quick pace, tired to be fourth in the Iowa Sprint H. Sent right to the front this time, the bay had four lengths on the field after a half in :45 1/5. He shook off a challenge from Hero's Tribute as they dashed six furlongs in 1:09 flat and opened it up again in the final drive to win decisively. The 5-2 favorite, Binthebest (Binalong), coming off a second in the June 29 GIII Aristides H. at Churchill Downs, trailed early and beat only one home. "I knew if I could keep him happy and relaxed, they weren't going to beat him," winning jockey Gerard Melancon said. As for the future, owner Jimmy Richard said, "We were thinking about going to New York with him, but he ran so well here, we'll probably stay right here for the Arlington Sprint [Aug. 24] and then the Sea O'Erin [Breeders' Cup Mile, turf, Sept. 29], or we might skip the Sprint and go right to the Sea O'Erin." Crowned Dancer finished second in his May 8 bow, a 4 1/2-furlong test which went in a swift :51 1/5 and validated that performance next out, graduating with a five-length success in the restricted Willard L Proctor Memorial S. at five panels May 26. Bet down to 3-10 to make it consecutive stakes wins in the June 16 Haggin S., the \$225,000 OBSMAR juvenile purchase dueled for the early lead before tiring to finish third behind Oberwald (Swiss Yodeler) and was adding blinkers this time around. The Florida-bred showed good early speed and vied for the lead with Oberwald, inched away from that rival on the turn and held on gamely for the win, providing his sire a second juvenile stakes winner on the afternoon. Favored Kafwain (Cherokee Run) hesitated at the start, made a nice move on the turn, but flattened out late to be fourth. "He broke very alertly," said winning rider Alex Solis. "I just had to make my own pace. He finished very strongly."

**NEW YORK TO SUPPORT HIALEAH?** The talks are only in the parliamentary stages, but Hialeah owner John Brunetti and New York Racing Association Chairman Barry Schwartz have had at least two conversations about a Florida race meeting at Hialeah. Hialeah has applied for a Jan. 3 through Apr. 13 meet in 2003, putting them head-to-head with Gulfstream, which has applied for Jan. 3 through Apr. 25 dates. Former Gulfstream President David Romanik, who is handling legal matters for Hialeah, said, "In addition to having their horsemen support Hialeah's meeting, NYRA could also help us gain access to New York OTB [a valuable source of betting dollars] and give us an exclusive to Aqueduct's signal during the winter. We [Hialeah] would look at running a four-day-a-week meeting: Saturday, Sunday, Monday and Tuesday. On Saturday and Sunday, we'd stage five-to-seven turf races a day, and on Monday and Tuesday, we could be the only signal on New York OTB. It could work to everyone's advantage, except Gulfstream." Schwartz described the talks as being "only preliminary conversations, they never went beyond that stage. My plate's full with the VLTs, and we have to take care of that first." But he added that, after last winter's Gulfstream meeting, "a few [New York-based trainers] urged us to participate in a Hialeah meeting. They weren't very happy with Gulfstream last winter, and they urged me to get involved." NYRA President Terry Meyocks said, "We are pretty busy right now, but I wouldn't say we have completely abandoned the idea of having our horsemen support a meeting at Hialeah. We'll try and do what we can to help our trainers."

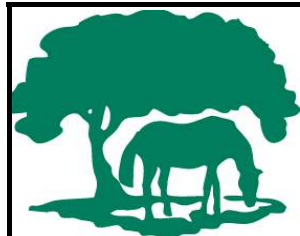
