WAR EMBLEM HASKELL HIGHWEIGHT

Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) was named the 124-pound highweight for the Aug. 4 GI Haskell Invitational and Thoroughbred Corporation racing manager Richard Mulhall quickly announced the colt was now "50-50" to run in the \$1-million race. Came Home follows on the weight list at 122, Medaglia d'Oro at 121 and Booklet at 120. "I think 124 pounds is too much weight," Mulhall said. "Why put that much weight on a horse that just got beat a zillion miles? I don't know what they're thinking. We're coming off a bad race and Came Home has won his last two races...maybe they don't want us to come." Mulhall said other possible starts for War Emblem include the Aug. 24 GI Travers or the Aug. 25 GI Pacific Classic. War Emblem, who has not raced since finishing eighth after stumbling at the start of the Belmont S. June 8, shipped to Del Mar last Thursday. "He's training great--he loves it at Del Mar," Mulhall said. "That's a factor in our decision, but the main factor is the weight." Trainer Paco Gonzalez said yesterday that **Came Home** (Gone West) is pointing for the Haskell. "We are planning to come for the Haskell," Gonzalez said yesterday. "We're going to try and ship to Monmouth two or three days before the race. He's doing good."

SCHOOL IS IN SESSION

The lightly raced **Grammarian** (Definite Article {GB}) taught his more experienced rivals a lesson yesterday with a determined victory in the GII Sunset H. at Hollywood Park. The bay gelding had only raced twice since breaking his maiden in his debut over the Kentucky Downs turf last September, finishing second in a May 30 Churchill allowance and fourth in a 1 1/16-miles allowance in Kentucky July 7. Unimpressed, the Hollywood Park bettors sent Grammarian off a 29-1. He shadowed pacesetter **Slew the Red** (Red Ransom) before taking command in upper stretch and gamely holding off **Continental Red** (Flying Continental) despite drifting out in deep stretch. Of his horse's antics down the lane, winning rider Brice Blanc explained, "I don't think I bothered anybody. I should have corrected him a little more, but he's such a long-striding horse, I was afraid if I really tried to correct him too much, it would break my momentum." Winning trainer Kellyn Gorder, a former assistant to Jack Van Berg, earned his first graded stakes victory in yesterday's Sunset. Grammerian may now be heading down under for the Melbourne Cup. "Lindsey Williams, his owner, had a dream," explained Gorder. "He always wanted to bring a horse back to Australia to run. Strike Smartly ended his 2001 campaign with a runner-up finish in the GII Sky Classic H. at this trip and distance last October and returned this year with a narrow defeat over the Keeneland turf in April. Most recently seventh in the June 16 GII King Edward Breeders' Cup, the well-bred bay and his more accomplished stablemate Quiet Resolve were sent off the 3-5 favorites in the field of nine. As his stablemate attended the pace, Strike Smartly ran a ground-saving race early. He angled out at midstretch and just collared Quiet Resolve in the shadow of the wire. "Strike Smartly really tries and it's nice to see him get up for the stakes win," said owner Tammy Samuel-Balaz. "Quiet Resolve is the sentimental favorite, but this guy--he's been waiting for it." Winning rider Laurie Gulas added, "When the hole opened up so wide, he was very brave and he just kicked. Riding a horse like that is so incredible."

Mananan McLir missed by just a head in the one-mile Round Table H. at Bay Meadows two back before running fourth in the nine-furlong GIII Cinema Breeders' Cup at Hollywood Park last time out June 30. Last early, the colt made progress turning for home, moved out four wide for the drive and got up in the dying strides for the first stakes win of his career. "He relaxed perfectly," commented winning rider Rene Douglas. "I covered him up the whole way. It was a slow pace. I was following the two horse [Jazz Beat]. You can't take anything away from Jazz Beat. He was running at the end. I knew where he was the whole way. I was right behind him. I wanted to wait a little longer but I knew I had to go around him because I knew he'd have a lot of horse left." Winning trainer Wally Dollase said Mananan McLir would likely start next in the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Aug. 17. "He's out of a St. Jovite mare and that's pure stamina. I think he'll get the 1 1/4 miles [of the Secretariat]," Dollase said.

Summer Colony, who made a name for herself by defeating division leader Azeri in the La Canada S. at Santa Anita in February, was coming off a second-place effort in the June 29 GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H. The dark bay mare found herself in traffic from the start. Boxed in in the early going, she was bumped around the second turn before finally extricating herself with a four-wide move. Once clear she unleashed a powerful stretch run and just got passed Your Out in the final strides. "I tried to follow Pat Day's horse [Pompeii (Broad Brush)] and we got stuck in traffic all the way to the eighth pole," explained winning jockey John Velazquez. "I was trapped between Starrer (Dynaformer) and Two Item Limit and I had to force my way out of it coming to the three-eighths and quarter pole. Miesque's Approval, second in all three of his previous graded stakes attempts, won the Pilgrim S. at Aqueduct last November before narrowly losing the Nov. 24 GIII Generous S. The bay colt returned seven months later and was beaten half-length in the June 15 GIII Hill Prince S. over a soft Belmont turf. Heavily favored to get his first graded stakes score, Miesque's Approval sat just off the early leaders, charged to the front with a three-wide move leaving the backstretch and sailed home an easy winner. "Today he got real aggressive when we turned onto the backside," commented winning rider Jerry Bailey. "He started drifting out a little bit. But as it turned out, he was much the best." Street Poker caused an upset in yesterday's G3 Lotto Hessen-Pokal by getting the better of Pappus, Near Honor and long-time leader Kasai (GB) (Brief Truce) in a tight finish. He had failed to build on a success in the G3 Walther J Jacobs-Rennen at Bremen last June and had shown little in this year's efforts to suggest he could take a competitive renewal of this race. On his return he finished fifth behind Well Made (Ger) in the G3 Grosser Preis der Bremer Wirtschaft at Cologne Apr. 7 before being beaten five lengths by Near Honor in the Listed BMW Sachsenpreis in Dresden June 16. This time, he broke smartly and disputed the early lead with Kasai before being settled in second. Driven out to challenge the game front-runner in the final furlong, his persistence paid dividends in the final 50 yards as he overcame that rival and held off the fast-finishing Pappus and the staying-on Near Honor.

It's been a wild year for Canadian racing--what with 82-1 longshot TJ's Lucky Moon (Tejabo) going straight from a maiden score to winning of the country's most prestigious race, the Queen's Plate at Woodbine June 23. This time, it was the lightly raced Le Cinquieme Essai who made his stakes debut with dramatic flare, taking the second leg of Canada's triple crown. The chestnut broke his maiden only two starts back in his seasonal debut, romping by 7 3/4 lengths June 9. He shipped to Woodbine to try the lawn in his latest, winning easily going a mile July 7 against entry-level allowance foes. Tossed into the deep end here against a field that saw many of the same faces that appeared in the Queen's Plate, including the 8-1 shot TJ's Lucky Moon, Le Cinquieme Essai was away in good order and tracked the pacesetters from a wide position going into the first turn. After being rated on the backstretch to provide a breather, the colt came four wide on the far turn, gained the lead at the top of the lane and gamely held the challenge of the hard-charging Bravely for the score. Sherpa Guide made the successful switch from state-bred company to the open classes, winning a non-winners of one by 2 1/4 lengths May 4 before making it two in a row with a sharp score June 8 as an inexplicable 34-1 longshot. You'd get no such odds in his return to statebred company, as the bettors' choice trailed the field through the half while racing well off the rail. Jockey Jose Santos inquired for run on the far turn and received a favorable response, his mount ranging up to take the lead and powering clear for his first stakes success. "He's been a different horse since [trainer] Tom [Bush] brought him back this spring," said Santos. "I knew I had the race won nearing the eighth pole. He's got a strong late kick." Added Bush, "This horse has gotten pretty solid. We've got him to relax and now he's finishing so darn good. He's growing up and maturing. I don't know what kind of races are out there for him. There's a chance we may take a flyer at something."

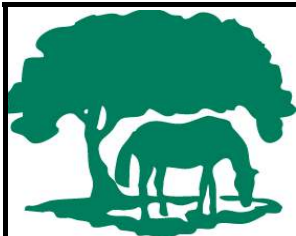

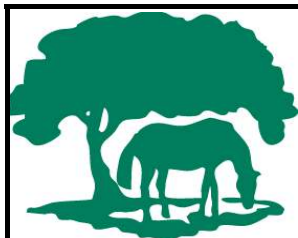

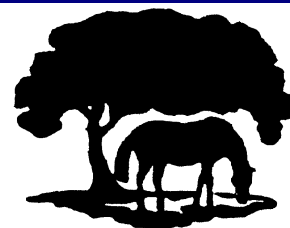

Connections of **Boreal (Ger)** (Java Gold {USA}) yesterday confirmed that jockey Kieren Fallon has been booked to continue his partnership with the four-year-old in Saturday's £750,000 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot, despite the presence of the Sir Michael Stoute-trained **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}). While Fallon rode the Peter Schiergen-trained colt to success in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 7, it was expected that he would renew his connection with Lord Weinstock's colt in the mile-and-a-half championship. Last year's G1 2000 Guineas winner recently undertook a racecourse gallop at Newmarket, but has not been confirmed a definite runner by his trainer. Boreal was the winner of last year's G1 Deutsches Derby on heavy ground and he reveled in those conditions again in the Coronation Cup last time. Nevertheless, he was third behind **Nayef (USA)** (Gulch {USA}) on a faster surface in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23 and Gisela Schiergen was unconcerned as she told *PA Sport* yesterday, "It was soft at the Coronation and it was firmer in Dubai, so it doesn't matter what the ground is like--maybe he is a little bit better on softer ground."

Horse for the Course....

Meanwhile, trainer Marcus Tregoning is hoping that the dry spell continues as he prepares Nayef for the mile-and-a-half contest. He told *PA Sport* yesterday: "We are keeping an eye on the weather, but I think the forecast from midweek is pretty good, so hopefully he will run. I'd rather have fastish ground--good or fastish, but not on the easy side as it blunts his speed." Officials at Ascot are to continue watering today. Clerk of the course Nick Cheyne told *PA Sport* yesterday: "We missed all the rain yesterday and we are good to firm at the moment. There's an odd shower forecast today and it's a bit overcast here and we are going back in starting watering tomorrow morning. We watered last week, but stopped over the weekend because of some showers around, and if we miss all those, then we go in watering first thing."
