**PRINCE AHMED DEAD AT 43**

Prince Ahmed bin Salman, owner of this year's Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner War Emblem and last year's Horse of the Year Point Given, died of an apparent heart attack early yesterday morning. He was 43. According to Terence Collier, a consultant to The Thoroughbred Corporation, the Prince was at his home in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia when he began experiencing chest pains. He was rushed to the hospital, but doctors were not able to revive him. The Prince is survived by a wife and five children. It was just a year ago, on July 24, 2001, that the Prince's brother, Prince Fahd, died of a heart attack at age 46. "It is with great sorrow that we learned today of the passing of Prince Ahmed bin Salman," said Tim Smith, Commissioner of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association. "All of us connected with the NTRA and Breeders' Cup extend our heartfelt sympathies to his family and colleagues at the Thoroughbred Corp. His tragic loss is a significant blow to the Thoroughbred racing industry." A member of Saudi Arabia's ruling family, the Prince was chairman of the Saudi Research and Marketing Group and ran an extensive publishing business, operating television stations, newspapers and a holding company in his country. He first came to the U.S. in the 1970s, and later studied at the University of California at Irvine.

***The Rise to Prominence...***

It was while he was at college that he met then-trainer Richard Mulhall and became involved in racing in America. He purchased his first race horse, the stakes winner Hays, in 1981. The Prince campaigned his horses under the colors of first Universal Stable and later The Thoroughbred Corp., and his trainers have included the best in the business. Mulhall handled The Thoroughbred Corp. horses until he retired from training to become the Prince's racing manager. In recent years, the bulk of the stable has been trained by Bob Baffert and D. Wayne Lukas.

***The Glow of Success...***

A familiar presence at the major horse sales in America, the Prince also bred a number of his own runners. Both Spain, who won the 2000 Breeders' Cup Distaff and earned \$3,540,542; and Point Given, who won the GI Preakness, GI Belmont S., GI Haskell H. and GI Travers before retiring with earnings of \$3,968,500, were homebreds. But it was War Emblem, purchased for approximately \$900,000 this April, who brought the Prince the most coveted trophy in American racing, winning the Kentucky Derby just weeks after joining The Thoroughbred Corporation's stable. "I've been dreaming of this race for 25 years or more," the Prince said in the winner's circle after watching War Emblem take the Derby. "It is such a thrill." As for the future of The Thoroughbred Corp. runners, and the 40-plus broodmares owned by the stable, Collier said, "The operation will continue to run normally until we are

instructed otherwise by the Prince's family. The welfare of the horses always came first to the Prince, and I think he would be extremely disappointed if plans for the horses were changed. His life was racing."

## PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

Surely, no horse capable of siring sons of the quality of Aptitude, A P Valentine, Golden Missile, Jump Start, Stephen Got Even, Old Trieste, Pulpit and Symboli Indy could ever be described as a "filly" sire. Yet A.P. Indy, the stallion responsible for this impressive collection, has undoubtedly earned a reputation for being an even better sire of fillies than he is of colts.

His yearlings at the 2000 sales produced an average price of \$793,200 for the colts, compared to an enormous \$936,000 for the fillies, and the bias continued last year, when the average price of \$483,471 for the colts lagged some way behind the fillies' \$653,846. Although an A.P. Indy colt made \$1,250,000 at Keeneland last week, there must be a good chance that A.P. Indy's yearling fillies will again outstrip their male counterparts at the coming sales, just as they have on the track so far this year.

Jilbab's victory in the Coaching Club American Oaks made her the latest daughter of the Lane's End resident to do well at stakes level this year, following such as With Ability, Charmed Gift, Glia and the juveniles Appleby Gardens and Handpainted. This collection underlined A.P. Indy's versatility as a stallion, winning from five furlongs to 1 1/2 miles.

### *Following in the hoof-prints of another classy filly...*

As Jilbab is owned by Godolphin Racing, her emergence as a GI winner has provided her owners with some well-deserved compensation for the death of Tempera, the A.P. Indy filly who took last year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Both Godolphin fillies were bred by Sheikh Mohammed's Darley Stud Management, employing the tried-and-tested method of matching A.P. Indy with mares from the Mr. Prospector line: Tempera's dam, Colour Chart, is by Mr. Prospector, whereas Jilbab's dam, Headline, is by Mr. Prospector's son Machiavellian. The links between these two fillies don't end there, either, because Colour Chart and Machiavellian were both produced by daughters of Halo.

Jilbab and Tempera were conceived in 1998, soon after the merits of the A.P. Indy/Mr. Prospector nick had first been highlighted by the Graded victories of Pulpit, Tomisue's Delight and Accelerator. With Ability and Glia are also out of daughters of Mr. Prospector, while Appleby Garden's broodmare sire, Silver Deputy, is himself out of a Mr. Prospector mare.

A.P. Indy's early Grade I successes with Tomisue's Delight and Runup The Colors also pointed to his suitability as a mate for daughters of Machiavellian. The second dam of this champion French two-year-old is by Hoist The Flag, a stallion who also appears as the sire of the dam of Runup The Colors and of the second dam of Tomisue's Delight.

Headline, the dam of Jilbab, never raced, but it is hardly surprising that she has been given every chance as a broodmare, starting her broodmare career with visits to Seattle Slew and his son A.P. Indy.

She comes from a very famous female line, her fourth dam being Nellie Flag, the top-ranked American juvenile filly of 1934, and her third dam being Nellie L, winner of the Kentucky Oaks and Acorn S. back in 1943. Headline's first and second dams are no less distinguished. Her second dam, Comely Nell, found fame when Bold Forbes, her cheaply-bought son by Irish Castle, returned from Puerto Rico to establish himself as the best three-year-old colt of 1976, when he won the Kentucky Derby and Belmont S. *(cont. p3)*

One of **Comely Nell's** subsequent visits to **Irish Castle** produced the filly **Priceless Fame**, a minor sprint winner whose first foal, **Dunbeath**, was one of the best English juveniles of 1982. Understandably, the bidding soared to \$3,200,000 when **Priceless Fame** came on the market in 1983. Even so, she quickly looked a bargain because her 1984 juvenile was none other than the unbeaten **Saratoga Six**.

Since then it has been the turn of **Priceless Fame's** broodmare daughters to boost the family's reputation even higher. **Milliardaire** visited **Seattle Slew** to produce **Lakeway**, a multiple Grade I winner whose victories included the **Mother Goose S.**, and **Priceless Pearl** produced the fast **Nureyev** filly **Isla del Rey**. Now **Headline** has produced **Jilbab**. With **Machiavellian** as her sire, **Headline** is a product of the same **Raise A Native** line as **Saratoga Six** and his sisters **Milliardaire** and **Priceless Pearl**.

**Lakeway** wasn't the only incentive to send **Headline** to **Seattle Slew** in her first year as a broodmare. **Comely Nell's** **Riva Ridge** filly **See You At The Top** also visited this great **Triple Crown** winner to produce **Life At The Top**, winner of the **Mother Goose S.** and runner-up in the **CCA Oaks** in 1986.

Another branch of the **Comely Nell** family, this one stemming from her **Secretariat** filly **Nellie Forbes**, provided **Imperial Beauty**, a cheaply-produced filly who won the **G1 Prix de l'Abbaye** after being bought for 950,000 guineas at **Tattersalls' December Sales** in 2000. What must **Jilbab** be worth now that her name has been added to the **CCA Oaks' very distinguished** roll of honor?
