PUTTING HER TO THE TEST

Carson Hollow (Carson City) puts her undefeated record on the line in today's GI Test S. at Saratoga. After beating fellow New York-breds by a handy five lengths in her third start, the May 19 Bouwerie S., the three-year-old filly added Lasix for the GI Prioress S. and overcame a bumpy beginning to post a front-running two-length score. "She was never really asked in her first three races...and when they came to her in the Prioress, she drew off," trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. said.

"She does what she has to do." She will have to do her best to beat **You** (You and I). The Bobby Frankel trainee already has four Grade I wins to her credit, including a 7 1/4-length romp in the June 7 GI Acorn S. going a mile at Belmont Park last time out. In her most recent sprint attempt, the dark bay took the 6 1/2-furlong GII Adirondack S. over this track last August. "I know she likes this track, and the others have never run on it," Frankel said. "She ran huge in the Adirondack last year." As for shortening up in distance, the Hall of Fame trainer said, "There are a lot of fast horses in the race, so I could be making the wrong decision. But she likes to be up there close to the lead, fighting all the time. Hopefully she'll be in a good spot where she can get them [at the wire]."

IT'S UP TO GRANDERA IN KING GEORGE

With **Sakhee** (Bahri) unlikely to start, **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) will look to carry the day for Godolphin in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot this afternoon. While the chestnut lacks the record of his stable companion, he is a horse on the upgrade, judging by his display of power in the June 19 G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot last time. His sustained burst of speed at the end of that 1 1/4-mile contest took him 7 1/4 lengths clear of the fourth-placed **Nayef** (Gulch) in the most competitive middle-distance event run this season. Originally set for an international campaign this summer, his performance brought about a *volte face* and Godolphin have their sights firmly on a fifth King George since 1995. The significant overnight rain that would ensure Sakhee's participation is unlikely to materialize. Although he has put up top-class performances on fast turf before, the five-year-old is undoubtedly better suited by a soft surface. But the hero of last year's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic and G1 Dubai World Cup is a brilliant individual and always gives his all despite the conditions, making him a formidable opponent if connections decide to go ahead. Nayef, fourth at Royal Ascot in his latest, captured the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic Mar. 23, but disappointed when subsequently third in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 26 and in the Prince of Wales's. It may be that a mile and a half will bring improvement, but this truly run test may stretch his stamina to the limit. Golan looked set for major laurels when winning last year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket over an inadequate mile, but found Galileo (Ire) too strong when runner-up in the G1 Epsom Derby and third in the Irish version at The Curragh. He went on to win the G2 Prix Niel in September and was a fine sixth in the G1 Japan Cup in November. He makes his first start since Tokyo, but trainer Sir Michael Stoute excels in producing improved older performers and he will be bidding for his third renewal of this event.

Affluent has gone up against Azeri in each of her last three starts and, racing on the main track, has been second all three times, most recently missing by three lengths in the June 22 GI Vanity H. Looking to avoid that monster, the four-year-old switches to the turf, where she has two wins and a second from three starts. The chestnut filly was second in the GI Del Mar Oaks over this course and distance and captured the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup last season. Del Mar Oaks heroine **Golden Apples** has won every other start since that effort, including the GII Las Palmas H. over older fillies last November and the GII Santa Ana H. two starts back Mar. 23. The bay has not been out since running second in the 10-furlong Apr. 20 GII Santa Barbara H., so is on pace to win again.



After a fifth-place finish in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup and nearly six months on the sidelines, the bay captured the GIII Beaugay H. at Aqueduct in May. A solid third in the May 27 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood, she comes off a victory in the GIII Locust Grove H. at Churchill Downs June 22. **Snow Dance**, a perfect two-for-two on the Saratoga turf, wired the field in the GII Lake Placid H. at the Diana distance last summer. On the board in her next six starts, she needs to get back on track after finishing fifth in both the May 27 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood and in the Locust Grove last time out. Bing Crosby Breeders' Cup H. cont.

Trainer Bruce Headley is hoping that two pounds makes the difference with his champion sprinter **Kona Gold** here. Carrying 126 pounds in the July 6 GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood last time out, Kona Goldtired late to finish sixth, 6 3/4 lengths behind **Disturbingthepeace**. A perfect five-for-five at Del Mar, the eight-year-old totes 124 today. "He's ready to go," Headley said. "He's healed up from his last race, where he picked up some nicks on his legs." The Eclipse winner goes for his third straight in the Bing Crosby. Disturbingthepeace bids for his fifth in a row. The Calbred made his stakes debut in the seven-furlong Triple Bend and led all the way to take it by three lengths at 16-1. The four-year-old broke his maiden at this track and distance last August. **Mellow Fellow** had a six-race winning streak snapped with a third-place finish behind Disturbingthepeace and **D'wildcat** in the Triple Bend. The seven-year tied up his skein with a victory in the May 11 Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup Sprint H. He has been on the board in 15 of 17 starts at six furlongs, winning 10 of them.

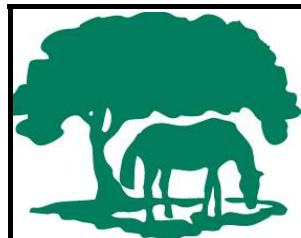

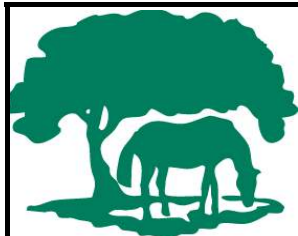


