BAILEY SWEEPS SARATOGA STAKES

Ending a stellar weekend at Saratoga with a flourish, jockey Jerry Bailey guided **Dancethruthedawn** (Mr. Prospector) to a 3 3/4-length victory in the GI Go for Wand H. yesterday afternoon. It was the fourth consec-

utive graded-stakes win at the Spa for the Hall of Fame rider, who started the streak with Del Mar Show in the GI Bernard Baruch H. Friday, then, as part of a four-win day Saturday, scored the stakes double for trainer Bobby Frankel with Tate's Creek in the GI Diana H. and You in the GI Test S. "He's

got to be one of the best riders of all time," Frankel said yesterday. It wasn't the string of victories that impressed Bailey's 10-year-old son Justin, but the fact that the giveaway at Saratoga yesterday was a Jerry Bailey Bobblehead Doll. "It's kind of neat winning today, because in my son Justin's eyes I didn't make it until I had a Bobblehead Doll," Bailey said. The Texas native, who was aboard Dancethruthedawn when she finished third as the even-money favorite in the GI Fleur de Lis H. last time out June 15, settled the Canadian champion in fifth as **With Ability** (A.P. Indy) took them through a half in :46.63. He eased the 2-1 favorite closer as **Miss Linda** (Arg) (Southern Halo) led through six furlongs in 1:10.92, angled her wide for the final drive, fought past 28-1 **Too Scarlet** (Colonial Affair) and rode her out to a decisive victory. "Her last race was disappointing...but she came back and trained so well we decided to give it a shot here," trainer Mark Frostad said. "I was really happy to see her run that way today." The winner likely will make her next start in the GI Personal Ensign H. at a mile and a quarter Aug. 23; she beat colts going 10 furlongs in the Queen's Plate last year. "I know she'll get the distance," Frostad said. **Transcendental** (Mt. Livermore) got up for second, a nose ahead of Too Scarlet, and will also point for the Personal Ensign. "We had a good trip," jockey John Velazquez said. "She was closing fast, the winner was just too far in front." (Chart, p2)

A FAN OF DEL MAR

Sarafan (Lear Fan) had started just once before over the Del Mar turf, taking the restricted Harry F. Brubaker H. on the course last season, and he ran his record to a perfect two-for-two with a rallying 1 1/4-length win over **Beat Hollow** (GB) (Sadler's Wells) in the GI Eddie Read H. yesterday. The five-year-old, who bested Beat Hollow by a neck in the GI Explosive Bid H. in March, had finished fourth twice before missing by 3/4 of a length when third in the July 6 GI United Nations H. last time out. Beat Hollow, coming off back-to-back Grade I wins in the May 4 Woodford Reserve S. and June 8 Manhattan H., was off at 1-2 and settled in third as **Redattore** (Brz) (Roi Normand) cut out an easy pace. But Sarafan, at the back of the pack early, was able to get the jump on the favorite, driving between horses at the top of the lane and taking the lead as Beat Hollow found himself trapped at the rail. "I was a little concerned that he might pull himself up when he made the lead, but not a bit of it," winning trainer Neil Drysdale said. "He went on about his business." Marienbard arrived late to wrest this prize from Yavana's Pace and secure Godolphin's second renewal after the exploits of Mutafaweq two years ago. Brought from last to first in the short straight, he showed an impressive turn of acceleration to cut down the the ultra-game front-runner in the closing stages for a comfortable success. Described by connections as a better and more willing horse this year, he gave the signal that he had improved when flashing home late to finish fourth behind Nayef in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 23. On his return to Europe he beat Millenary (GB) by a neck in the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 3, form that was subsequently boosted when the runner-up took the G2 Princess of Wales's S. Beaten by the testing ground when 12 lengths fourth behind Boreal (Ger) in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 7, he bounced back here for his first success at the highest level. The winner was held up in last place alongside Samum early, travelling easily off the respectable pace cut out by old-timer Yavana's Pace. The leader was tackled and passed by his stable companion Sir George Turner (GB) (Nashwan) with 300 yards remaining as Marienbard hitt top gear on the outside. Yavana's Pace came back, but his late surge was not enough; Marienbard swooped to hit the front with 150 yards remaining before being pushed out under a hand ride to score. He could now head for the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden Sept. 1.

Never a Doubt denied the strong challenge of Zinziberine in the dying strides to provide Barry Hills with his second renewal in this event, following in hoofsteps of Ozone Friendly in 1989. In her first two starts, Never a Doubt had the misfortune of tackling the smart Presto Vento (GB) and Hurricane Alan (Ire) before beating the talented Speed Cop (GB) and Duty Paid (Ire) in a Sandown maiden June 3. Beaten 3 1/2 lengths by Romantic Liason (GB) in the G3 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot 16 days later, she raced too freely when two lengths back in fourth in the July 9 G2 Cherry Hinton S. over six furlongs at Newmarket. Dropped back in trip here, she was settled in sixth by Michael Hills, who was keen to stay close to the inner while tracking early leader A Bay Wisp (GB) (Whittingham {Ire}). That proved a wise option as the field fanned across the track inside the quarter-mile marker, causing a concertina effect that pushed Zinziberine and Olivier Peslier wide. Never a Doubt found a gap and was pointed through it, instantly quickening to grab the lead with 400 yards remaining. As Zinziberine drove towards the line in the centre of the track, Hills asked for more effort and his mount dug deep to hold her slender advantage.

Bernebeau avenged past defeats by Guys and Dolls (Efisio {GB}) and Victorian Order (GB) (Zamindar) to claim his first stakes success here. Last year he found Guys and Dolls three-quarters of a length too strong when runner-up in the G3 Prix La Rochette in September before a resounding 3 1/2-length beating by Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the G1 Grand Criterium the following month. Returning to finish two lengths second to Victorian Order (GB) in the Listed Prix Pelleas at Longchamp June 20, he needed to step up on those efforts here, but had the assistance of a healthy allowance of three pounds from Guys and Dolls. Held up in fifth early by jockey Olivier Peslier behind pacesetter Well Chief (Ger) (Night Shift), he had to be switched at the quarter-mile pole. Guys and Dolls was taken to the front, with Mineshaft in close attendance, but Peslier switched his whip hand and, with three slaps, Bernebeau quickened past those rivals with 50 yards remaining before asserting under hand riding for a comfortable score. Guys and Dolls, judged to have caused interference to Mineshaft, was disqualified from second and placed fifth.

Left Bank Readies for Whitney:

Left Bank (French Deputy), who zipped seven furlongs in a record-setting 1:20 while winning the GII Tom Fool H. last time out, prepped for Saturday's GI Whitney S. yesterday morning, going five-eighths in :59 3/5 over the Saratoga main track. Trainer Todd Pletcher said the five-year-old, who worked in company, went faster than planned, adding, "Hopefully, it didn't deplete the tank any." Left Bank has not raced around two turns since taking the GIII Discovery H. as a three-year-old.

Repent Back on Work Tab; Possible for Travers:

Three-year-old **Repent** (Louis Quatorze), unraced since finishing second behind War Emblem in the Apr. 6 GII Illinois Derby, was back on the work tab yesterday morning, going three furlongs in :37 2/5 on the Saratoga main track. Trainer Ken McPeck was pleased with the breeze and said the colt could be back in time for the Aug. 24 GI Travers S. "We only wanted to work him three-eighths, but he wanted to go five-eighths," McPeck said. "I clocked him going in 1:03 for five-eighths. He was aggressive and wanted to do it. I think we have to seriously consider nominating him for the Travers. I think we are ahead of schedule." Repent underwent surgery to have a chip removed from his left front ankle at Rood and Riddle Equine Clinic in Lexington Apr. 15 and missed more training when he came up body sore after returning to the track in June.

The second choice in a competitive field, the dark bay was never far back while racing in midpack, split horses at midstretch, was overtaken by Attico inside the final sixteenth, but fought back for a game score, giving jockey Rene Douglas a sweep of the weekend's turf stakes.

He also handled the brilliant sprinter Lochsong (GB), who took two renewals of the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in 1993 and 1994, as well as the G1 Nunthorpe S. in 1993. After 38 years of training, he will hand over the establishment to his son Andrew, who received plaudits from his father for his conditioning of last year's G2 Mill Reef S. winner Firebreak (GB) (Charnwood Forest {Ire}). "Andrew and I have been sharing the horses, and he's just done extremely well and it's high time he took over," Balding explained of his decision. "It's been wonderful to train a few good horses for lots of wonderful owners. I suppose Mill Reef's Arc de Triomphe probably was the high point and, more recently, emotionally Lochsong's second Prix de l'Abbaye. We will still have a few jumpers and I will continue to manage one of the yards."

NAYEF FOR QUICK RETURN Marcus Tregoning yesterday reported **Nayef (USA)** (Gulch {USA}) "at the top of his game" after his battle with Golan (Ire) in Saturday's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. Tregoning favours a quick return to the track and a drop in trip for the colt, who will tackle Hawk Wing (USA) in the 1 1/4-mile G1 Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 20. "He is in great form and lost virtually no weight, which I couldn't believe because of the hot weather," Tregoning said yesterday. "The Juddmonte International is a real possibility for him, because the track would really suit him, especially going left handed. If he stayed in training [next year] that would be wonderful. He could go for the Dubai World Cup, which was the original intention this year. He was a baby last year and is still improving physically, although whether that makes him go faster, I don't know."
