READY FOR WAR

War Emblem (Our Emblem) had his final tune-up for Sunday's G1 Haskell Invitational H. yesterday morning, dashing through five furlongs in :59 1/5 on the Del Mar main track. The hero of the Kentucky Derby and Preakness galloped out six furlongs in a rapid 1:11 1/5 and, with exercise rider Dana Barnes trying to pull him up, went seven furlongs in 1:24 2/5. The move was the second fastest of 54 at the distance. "He went very well," Jim Barnes, assistant to trainer Bob Baffert, said. "He is a good work horse. The race is in six days, so we wanted to make sure he was ready...and he is ready." The colt is scheduled to arrive on a Fed Ex flight from California to Newark tomorrow afternoon. "Right now, it looks like we'll be at Monmouth between 2:30 and 3 p.m.," Barnes said. Nancy Alberts, the owner/breeder/trainer of Haskell hopeful **Magic Weisner** (Amerivalay), is not sure who will be aboard the three-year-old Sunday. Richie Migliore has ridden the gelding in his last three starts, but has commitments to trainers at Saratoga on Haskell Day. "He's trying to get out of his other commitments," Alberts said. "But if he can't, Mike Luzzi will ride Magic Weisner."

GLORIOUS GOODWOOD GETS UNDERWAY

Five days of action begins today with the first day of the 2002 'Glorious' Goodwood meeting. Today's card features the G2 Gerrard Investment Management Richmond S. for two-year-old colts and geldings, while St Leger hopefuls line up in the G3 Peugeot Gordon S., headed by **Bandari** (Ire) (Alhaarth {Ire}). He will have to overcome a three-pound penalty for his 13-length success in the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial May 11 as he bids to bounce back from his eighth placing behind High Chaparral (Ire) in the G1 Epsom Derby June 8. He is passed over by jockey Richard Hills in favour of the Marcus Tregoning-trained **Izdiham** (Ire) (Nashwan), while Richard Hannon's **Nysaeen** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) will only run if there is overnight rain. *(Cont. p2)*

Baron's Pit (GB) (Night Shift) will try to defy a three-pound penalty picked up for his success in the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 20 and provide his trainer with his second success in this, following Son Pardo (GB) 10 years ago. He showed fine tactical speed to account for **The Bonus King (GB)** (Royal Applause {GB}) by a head in the Norfolk, but the penalty may swing things in his rival's favour here. Previously, The Bonus King had shown he handles an undulating course when taking the Listed Woodcote S. at Epsom June 8 and, like last year's winner Mister Cosmi (GB), is a typically tough and genuine performer from the Mark Johnston school. Marcus Tregoning's two-year-olds boast an almost 50 percent strike rate at this meeting, and **Fatik** (Gone West) represents the Lambourn handler here. He made eye-catching late progress to finish third behind Greek Revival in a competitive Newmarket conditions event July 10, where the rain-softened ground compromised his fluent action. He could be anything, and it is interesting that Tregoning pitches him at this level instead of taking the maiden route on offer later in the afternoon. **Revenue (Ire)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) had subsequent G3 Anglesey S. winner Ontario back in fourth in the Windsor Castle S. at Royal Ascot June 21, but tackles an extra furlong here, while Hannon's apparent second-string Hurricane Alan (Ire) (Mukaddamah) has to show he can hold his form after a busy campaign. **Elusive City** (Elusive Quality) won an above-average Lingfield maiden on the Polytrack July 17 and, on a strict line of that form, holds the similarly unexposed **Semigold** (Seeking the Gold).

Supporting the main races is the Listed Oak Tree S., which celebrates Goodwood's long-standing ties with the Oak Tree Racing Association of California's Santa Anita Park Racecourse. As well as the Wednesday highlight, the £265,000 G1 Sussex S., the £50,000 G3 Champagne Victor Vintage S. offers the chance for juveniles to advertise their Classic pretensions. Trainer David Loder, responsible for last year's winner Naheef (Ire), may be double-handed this year with **Silver Seeker (Ire)** (Seeking the Gold) and the unbeaten **Dublin (Ire)** (Carson City). Stayers take centre stage Thursday with the £90,000 G2 JPMorgan Private Bank Goodwood Cup run over two miles. **Persian Punch (Ire)** (Persian Heights {GB}) bids for his second renewal at the age of nine, while the juveniles race over the five furlongs of the £45,000 G3 Betfair.com Molecomb S. That five-furlong course, one of the fastest in the country, also features the £50,000 G3 King George 200th Anniversary S., in which **Dominica (GB)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) bids to follow up her success in the G2 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot June 18. Friday's card, which features the £100,000 William Hill Mile, also hosts the £50,000 G3 Theo Fennell Lennox S. over seven furlongs, which looks a likely target for G3 Diomed S. winner **Nayyir (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), and the Listed Lady O Memorial Glorious S. Saturday's closing action centres around the £135,000 G1 Vodafone Nassau S over 10 furlongs, upgraded from Group 2 status in 1999 and won by **Lailani (GB)** (Unfuwain) last year.

PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

At last year's Houghton Sales, only two fillies made more money than the 440,000 guineas that the Cheveley Park Stud team had to pay to secure a rangy daughter of Kingmambo and Balistroika. While the filly's price was substantial, it wasn't enormous for a fashionably bred granddaughter of the remarkable broodmare Balidaress. Members of this family have been in great demand ever since Balidaress' Group 1-winning daughter Desirable made no less than 1,000,000 guineas in the same sales ring as long ago as 1984.

Desirable had recorded the first important win of her distinguished career when she won the Princess Margaret S. at Ascot on her second start and history repeated itself three days ago when the Kingmambo filly, now named Russian Rhythm, was a very smooth winner of the same race on her second start. How smooth can be judged by the fact that the Brushwood-bred filly is now on offer at odds as short as 10-1 for the 1000 Guineas in nine months' time.

The Kingmambo filly possesses a physique which suggests she will train on into a high-class performer, but I suspect that her owners would have regarded her as an excellent buy even if she had won nothing more important than a maiden race. After all, her sire is one of the hottest properties in Kentucky at a fee of \$200,000, and her dam Balistroika is a half sister to two winners of the G1 Cheveley Park S. in Desirable and Park Appeal and to a winner of the G1 Irish Oaks in Alydaress.

True test of time....

For good measure, Balistroika is a half sister to another Group winner, Nashamaa, and her half sisters Desirable, Park Appeal and Salidar are respectively the dams of the Group 1 performers Shadayid, Cape Cross and Bin Ajwaad.

The second generation of Russian Rhythm's pedigree is pure gold. Her four grandparents are Mr. Prospector, one of the few stallions responsible for over 100 graded-stakes winners; Miesque, a winner of 10 Group 1 races and dam of two Classic winners; Nijinsky II, the only English Triple Crown winner in over 60 years and sire of 155 stakes winners; and Balidaress, a true blue hen. In these circumstances it would be unfair to attribute Russian Rhythm's talent to any particular ancestor.

The strength of her pedigree also raises questions about whether Russian Rhythm's class owes anything to the 4x3 inbreeding to Northern Dancer in her pedigree. I am tempted to think it does, if only because she is comfortably the best of her dam's first six named foals and she is the only one inbred to Northern Dancer.

It is also relevant to ask how much of Kingmambo's success is attributable to inbreeding to Northern Dancer. With Northern Dancer back in the fourth generation of Kingmambo's foals, the Lane's End star was bound to be sent a lot of mares with Northern Dancer blood. It is no surprise, then, that the likes of Sadler's Wells, Lyphard, Danzig, Dixieland Band and Nijinsky II have all appeared among the sires of the first two dams of Kingmambo's leading representatives.

The Grade II-winning brothers Parade Ground and Parade Leader both have a Nijinsky mare as their second dam and are therefore inbred 4x4 to Northern Dancer, through his truly exceptional sons Nureyev and Nijinsky. While Nijinsky isn't considered a typical son of Northern Dancer, the idea of combining Nijinsky and Nureyev in a pedigree makes good sense. Whereas Nureyev was small, Nijinsky possessed size and scope; whereas Nureyev managed only three starts, Nijinsky was tough enough to race five times at two and eight times at three; and whereas speed has often been the main asset of Nureyev's progeny, Nijinsky has left a legacy of superior staying power. *(Cont. p4)*

Magnaten, seeking his second straight win in the Sekiya Kinen, stalked the pacesetter in the field of 14. He moved to the lead turning for home and pulled clear to the wire to finish in identical time to last year's victory in the Group 3 race. After the win, the gelding was shipped to Hokkaido for a summer vacation.

Khalid Abdullah experimented with this combination a while ago. One of the Prince's Nijinsky mares was Nijinsky Star, who had the distinction of having two Triple Crown-winning parents (her dam Chris Evert landed the NYRA Fillies Triple Crown). However, Nijinsky Star was a very big, plain mare who never made it to the races. She produced two daughters to Nureyev, which were inbred 2x3 to Northern Dancer.

The better of them was Viviana, a very attractive individual who won two Listed races over 1 1/4 miles prior to taking second place in the G3 Prix de Psyche. This closely inbred mare is now shaping up as an even better producer. Her first foal, the Distant View filly Valuable Idea, was considered very promising until she met an untimely death. Her second foal, the Rahy filly Tates Creek, improved her record to six wins from nine starts with her victory in Saturday's GII Diana H. And her third foal, the Distant View filly Sightseek, made an eye-catching winning debut at Saratoga a day later.

Next in line is an impressive looking two-year-old son of Pulpit, so it looks as though this experiment with close inbreeding is paying off handsomely.

Bailey to Ride Medaglia d'Oro in Jim Dandy:

Trainer Bobby Frankel indicated that jockey Jerry Bailey will ride GI Wood Memorial S. winner **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) in Sunday's GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga. The sophomore, who is also possible for this weekend's GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park, was previously ridden by Kent Desormeaux.

Wheelaway to Stud:

Wheelaway (Unbridled--Cuidado, by Damascus), winner of the 2000 GIII Tampa Bay Derby, has been retired from racing and will stand his first season at Joe and Anne McMahan's McMahons of Saratoga Thoroughbreds in Saratoga Springs. Owned in partnership by Caesar P. Kimmel and Philip J. Solondz during his racing career, the \$250,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase is being syndicated. The five-year-old, who ran fifth behind Fusaichi Pegasus in the 2000 GI Kentucky Derby and fourth in his final career start in the GI Belmont S., retires with two wins, a second and a third from seven lifetime starts, with earnings of \$249,760.

Second behind fellow entry **Noverre** (Rahy) in last year's renewal, No Excuse Needed requires a fast surface to show his very best. "If the ground came up soft at Goodwood, you could just write him off, as he's no good on it at all--he's absolutely in tip-top form, but he's got the Rock to beat," said Joe Mercer, racing manager for the four-year-old's owner Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid al Maktoum. Of the course conditions, Clerk of the Course Rod Fabricius said on Monday, "We finished watering yesterday, and I think it would be very unwise for us to water given the forecast of a change in the weather. But at the moment, we have genuine good-to-firm ground with no jar in it. If we do get a thunderstorm as we go through the week, from the horse's point of view, I think that would be very welcome."
