Street Cry (Ire) (Machiavellian) looks to run his 2002 record to four-for-four in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga today. The Godolphin colt is not only unbeaten this year, he is also unchallenged, taking Round 3 of the Maktoum Challenge by 8 1/2 lengths Feb. 28, the G1 Dubai World Cup by 4 1/4 lengths Mar. 23 and the G1 Stephen Foster H. by 6 1/2 lengths June 15. Jockey Jerry Bailey, who has been aboard the dark bay for his last two starts, is also the regular rider of 2001 Whitney winner **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold), but opted to stick with Street Cry. "It was a very tough decision," Bailey said. "I rode Lido Palace all last year--I went to Japan and California to ride him. But I won the world's richest race on Street Cry, then he ran a huge race in the Stephen Foster. If he runs that race again, I don't know if anyone can beat him. It's kind of hard to take off a horse like that." Lido Palace followed his Whitney score with a win in the GI Woodward S., then was off the board in the Nov. 21 G1 Japan Cup Dirt and the Feb. 3 GII San Antonio H. He came back after a five-month break to finish a close second to E Dubai in the July 6 GII Suburban H. Gold Mover (Gold Fever) was the 3-2 favorite in the GIII Honorable Miss S. at Saratoga yesterday, but it was 5-1 **Mandy's Gold** (Gilded Time) who got the job done, posting a frontrunning 1 3/4-length score over **Shine Again** (Wild Again). It was the fourth consecutive stakes win for the four-year-old filly, who started her career with four straight wins before getting disqualified from first in last year's GIII Comely S. Sidelined for nine months after that effort, the chestnut was held winless in her first four outings this season, but got back on track to take the May 25 My Juliet S. at Philly Park, the June 8 GIII Chicago Breeders' Cup H. at Arlington and the July 6 Sweet & Sassy S. at Delaware Park. "It just seems that every race, she gets a little better," trainer Michael Gorham said. The filly goes next in the GI Ballerina S. Aug. 25. As for Gold Mover, she raced alongside the inside while rated off the pace early and showed little in the drive, finishing fourth. Islington bids to bounce back from her eighth placing in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 7 and emulate stable companion Golan (Ire) in collecting a Group 1 win for her late owner Lord Weinstock. As a sister to the smart Group 1 performer Greek Dance (Ire), whose optimum trip was 10 furlongs, she was unsuited by the emphasis on stamina brought about by heavy rain at Epsom. Nevertheless, she gave as much as she could in taking on the eventual winner Kazzia (Ger) until finding the slog too much in the straight. Previously she had shown fine tactical speed in winning the G3 Musidora S. at York May 14 over an extended 10 furlongs on good-to-firm ground. She looks to provide Sir Michael Stoute with his third renewal of this race since 1990, following the exploits of Kartajana (GB) and Hawajiss (GB). **Quarter Moon**, a late substitute for her virus-stricken stable companion Sophisticat, comes off a second-place finish in the G1 Irish Oaks July 14. Having finished runner-up in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas May 26 and in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 7--where she finished 18 lengths in front of Islington--she filled the same spot behind Margarula (Ire) in the Irish Classic last time out. She has the class and the speed for this, but has to prove her tenacity as this is her fifth Group 1 test in the space of three months. **Tarfshi** took the G2 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh June 29, a race won by Ruby Tiger (GB) in 1991 and Alborada (GB) in 1998 en route to taking this. She had Margarula back in fourth that day, but on a line through the third-placed Fraulein (GB) has something to find with Islington. She has an unenviable task in doing so, as the last older filly to beat the sophomores was Ruby Tiger, who was collecting her second Nassau in 1992.

Mayakovsky, who set a track record over this oval last season, going 5 1/2 furlongs in 1:03 1/5 in his debut, makes his first start in four months. The colt followed that victory with a second-place finish behind Came Home in the GI Hopeful S., then disappeared for 8 1/2 months. He came back to win the Mar. 17 GIII Gotham S. handily despite drifting out in the stretch, but was sidelined once again after running fourth in the Apr. 6 GI Santa Anita Derby. The dark bay has been training sharply for his return, going a half in a bullet :46 flat in his final prep Wednesday. Undefeated **Greatness** makes his third start and his stakes debut. The chestnut colt broke his maiden in his first start at Belmont and came back to post an eye-catching 10 1/2-length tally in an allowance test June 15. **Listen Here**, who also broke his maiden at this track last year, is winless this season, but has been on the board in four of five outings. The late-running Bill Mott trainee came back after a short break and rallied for second in the July 4 GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup S. and could benefit from a hotly contested pace here.

BAFFERT DONATES HALF OF APPEARANCE

FEE TO TRF In a statement issued yesterday, trainer Bob Baffert said that he and The Thoroughbred Corporation's racing manager Richard Mulhall did not base their decision to run **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) in the GI Haskell Invitational H. on the appearance fee paid Baffert by the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "I am concerned that the nature of the appearance fee has been mischaracterized and that some might perceive that the fee influenced our decision to enter," the statement read. "Upon additional discussion with The Thoroughbred Corporation, we have decided that half of the fee will be donated to the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation in memory of Prince Ahmed bin Salman. Fees for public appearances and other promotional work are common in other sports. In consultation with my clients, I will continue to accept these fees in the future where warranted."

TAKE CHARGE LADY BACK AT WORK GI

Ashland S. winner **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere), who was given a break after winning the May 25 GIII Dogwood S. at Churchill Downs, was back on the work tab yesterday, going a half-mile in :47 4/5 at Saratoga. "It was fun to watch--it was a very impressive work," trainer Ken McPeck said. "This filly is unbelievably exceptional. She has gears upon gears." Explaining the decision to send her to the farm for freshening, McPeck said, "She was starting to get a little dehydrated. We gave her four weeks at Longfield Farm and I think the timing couldn't have been better." CAME HOME OPTION TO SELL AT TRF GALA

The rights to a season to **Came Home** will be auctioned off at the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation Gala at the Saratoga Golf & Polo club this Monday, Aug. 5. The top bidder at the TRF Gala will earn the right to buy a season to the multiple Grade I stakes winner for a set fee of \$30,000. Owned by William S. Farish, John B. Goodman, Trudy McCaffery and John Toffan, the Gone West colt has eight wins in 10 career starts with earnings of \$1,235,940. "We obviously wanted to do something for the Retirement Foundation," said co-owner Bill Farish, "and we thought that Came Home would be the perfect season. He's awfully well bred, and is a very talented miler that has shown he can carry his speed to a mile and an eighth." Came Home is out of the Clever Trick mare Nice Assay, a Graded stakes winner of \$409,630, and is a half to A.P. Assay (A.P. Ind), a Graded stakes winner of \$381,691. He will stand at Lane's End Farm upon his retirement.

Awesome Humor Bought By WinStar:

Undefeated two-year-old filly **Awesome Humor** (Distorted Humor) has been purchased for an undisclosed sum by WinStar Farm. A \$45,000 FTKJUL yearling, the dark bay filly, from the first crop by her sire, broke her maiden at Keeneland in April and came back to take the July 6 GIII Debutante S. by two lengths last time out for owner Tom Durant and trainer Ronny Werner. She is now being trained by Elliott Walden. She worked a half-mile in :49 3/5 for her new connections at Saratoga Monday.

NYRA Posted Multi-Million Dollar Loss in 2001:

According to a report in the Schenectady *Daily Gazette*, the New York Racing Association posted an operating loss of \$11.3 million last year despite an increase in revenue spurred by growing simulcast handle. It was the first time since 1995 that NYRA reported an operating loss, and the largest operating loss the non-profit organization has posted since it was established in 1955. While NYRA's revenue for 2001 rose from \$155.3 million in 2000 to \$160.6 million in 2001, expenses also grew, from \$153.7 million two years ago to \$171.9 million last year. NYRA officials blamed the increase in operating expenses on higher costs for pensions and other retirement benefits, depreciation and the expense of hosting the 2001 Breeders' Cup. The company also spent \$3.2 million on legal fees on a failed bid to acquire the New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation. NYRA Treasurer/Controller John Giombarrese indicated that the balance sheet is looking decidedly healthier for 2002, with revenues up \$3.4 million and operating expenses down \$800,000 for the first six months of the year.

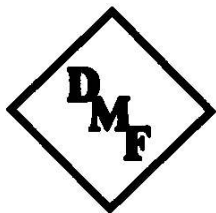

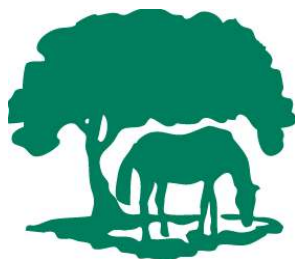

A Solution to California's Insurance Problem?

An insurance company may be stepping in to offer a solution to the workmen's compensation insurance problem that California horsemen have been facing, the *Thoroughbred Times* reports. Costs have skyrocketed since Legion Insurance, which covered most trainers in the state, closed its California operations earlier this year. The only coverage remaining was provided by the government-backed State Fund Insurance at much higher rates. Ed Halpern, executive director of the California Thoroughbred Trainers, declined to name the new carrier, but told *Thoroughbred Times*, "A system has been offered and we're working hard on crossing the Ts and dotting the Is." He added, "It appears rates will be similar to Legion's." The CTT is working with State Fund Insurance to make it possible for trainers to switch their coverage as soon as it becomes available, which may be as early as Sept. 1. Halpern added that the insurance situation has had an effect on racing in California. "There's been a reduction in the labor force and in the number of horses," he said. "Some trainers have left the state and the rest are just hanging on."

Quoted as the 7-2 joint-favourite with Kazzia (Ger) by Coral Eurobet, the Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum-owned colt also has the target of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 6 as a target at present. Trainer Mark Johnston said yesterday, "He did lose a lot of weight which has been one of the frustrating characteristics of Bandari--sometimes even just for a gallop--but at least now we know to give him time between his races. I haven't spoken to Sheikh Hamdan or Angus Gold (racing manager) about plans yet, but obviously the St Leger looks very attractive and it doesn't look the most competitive at the moment, so it would be very hard to ignore it, but that would be very much up to Sheikh Hamdan. The main thing is to get the horse well."
