IT'S WAR VERSUS THE 'WIZ' IN THE HASKELL

For the fifth time in the last six years, trainer Bob Baffert will saddle a horse in the GI Haskell. For the first time, he arrives at the Jersey Shore with the Kentucky Derby winner, **War Emblem** (Our Emblem), who headlines this afternoon's nine-furlong feature. Second in 1997 with Anet, the silver-haired (and newly married) trainer returned two years later to saddle Forestry to a third-place finish. Runner-up two years ago with favored Captain Steve, Baffert finally got his first Haskell win with Point Given in 2001. Despite the handsome dark bay's failed bid to win the Triple Crown, the conditioner is bullish on his chances today. "I feel better about him than I did about Point Given last year," he admits. "War Emblem's style is more conducive to the Haskell. I wouldn't have shipped him there for the fans unless he was doing great." Of Baffert's three Kentucky Derby winners, War Emblem is the first to make the Haskell. **Magic Weisner** (Ameri Valay) is no stranger to War Emblem. The Nancy Alberts owned, bred and trained gelding was second by three-parts of a length in the Preakness before finishing an even fourth in the GI Belmont S. June 8. Better when allowed to come from off the pace, the 'Wiz' showed versatility in the GII Ohio Derby July 20, tracking loose-on-the-lead Wiseman's Ferry before reeling in that rival for a narrow score. Mike Luzzi replaces Richie Migliore in the saddle this afternoon. When last seen in the Haskell, jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. guided Forty Niner to victory in the 1988 renewal. The all-time leading rider has the call aboard Alydar S. winner **Like a Hero** (Pleasant Colony), who comes in to the Haskell off a runner-up finish to Came Home in the GII Swaps S. at Hollywood Park July 14. LEFT BANK SPRINGS WHITNEY SURPRISE

In what was billed as the strongest field assembled in the handicap division this season, Michael Tabor's **Left Bank** (French Deputy), a multiple Grade I winner at distances up to one mile, successfully negotiated the nine-furlong trip yesterday at Saratoga, upsetting Godolphin's **Street Cry (Ire)** (Machiavellian) in the GI Whitney H. The final time of 1:47 equaled the stakes and track record set in 1974 by Tri Jet and was the second consecutive track-record setting performance for Left Bank, who won the seven-furlong GII Tom Fool H. on Independence Day in 1:20. The winner of the GI Vosburgh S. and GI Cigar Mile H. last season, the chestnut returned to action with a popular victory in Belmont's GIII Bold Ruler H. May 11. Given just 16 days to recover from that effort, the Todd Pletcher trainee was the 2-1 favorite in the GI Metropolitan Mile H. May 27, but faltered through the stretch to finish a well-beaten fifth. His handy victory in the Tom Fool had his trainer thinking about stretching him out this time around. (cont p2)

"Some races are bigger than others and we've been excited about trying this one for a while," Pletcher commented. "When it works out, there is a little extra gratification." Despite his obvious penchant for sprint distances, Left Bank had previously won going two turns when a wire-to-wire winner of the GIII Discovery H. during his three-year-old season. Still, with the likes of the Dubai World Cup winner, defending champion **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold) and **Macho Uno** (Holy Bull) in the mix, this was hardly a fait accompli. Settled just off the fast pace set by longshot **Saint Verre** (Saint Ballado), Left Bank surged to the front with three furlongs to run and kicked clear. "He is so good right now," commented winning rider John Velazquez. "I was so happy he relaxed down the backstretch. I asked him to pick it up at the three-eighths pole. He picked up the bit and rolled." The winner is a good possibility for the GI Woodward S., with an eye on the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and GI Breeders' Cup Classic.

Islington turned on the after-burner passing the quarter-mile pole to power away from Sulk by four lengths and take this contest as the 10-3 second choice. Burying her disappointing effort when eighth in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 7 on testing ground, she comprehensively reversed form with Quarter Moon, who could manage only third here. Islington was also the second Group 1 winner within a week, following Golan (Ire), for her owner Lord Weinstock, who passed away last Tuesday. Although she failed to show her best behind Kazzia (Ger) at Epsom, she had given due warning that she was potentially top-class when winning the G3 Musidora S. at York May 14. Despite the heavy rainfall that preceded this race, she travelled with ease under Kieren Fallon in fourth on the rail off the early pace set by Starbourne (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). She handled the downhill run to the turn into the straight with grace before being taken wide for her challenge in the straight. Asked to quicken with 2½ furlongs remaining, she responded with a dramatic turn of acceleration which took her clear in a matter of strides. For trainer Sir Michael Stoute, enjoying his third in this contest, the event added further poignancy to the last fortnight. "Lord Weinstock fell in love with this filly, who he called the perfect filly," Stoute said. "The ground was very very testing and very soft in the Oaks and she didn't handle it from a long way out, so it was very inconclusive. She came back very sore in her muscles in front and behind and it took quite a few weeks to get her sound again. She had a nice break and she's been training well for this race and we were very hopeful. That was her today--in the Musidora she wasn't professional enough, but she's learned her job now and she's a very good filly. We need to do a little bit of thinking about where she goes now." As for the future, Stoute said, "You would have to think about the G1 Yorkshire Oaks (at York Aug. 21) for Islington now, but I will have to ask Kieren [Fallon] for his opinion."

Off the board just once in her seven European starts for trainer Carlos Lerner, Little Treasures was the head winner of a restricted conditions event at Chantilly Apr. 16 before closing that portion of her career with her best previous effort to date, a two-length victory in the Listed Prix de Bagatelle at Chantilly May 21. Unraced since that effort and adding Lasix for her stateside debut, the French-bred filly was the lukewarm favorite in the field at 5-2. The bay tugged her way along in second through the opening furlongs as Super High (High Brite) dictated the pace. Asked for her best turning for home, she was sent three wide into the stretch, claimed a short lead past the midstretch marker and just held on to defeat a fast-closing Pina Colada. "I put her in the race and the pace was kind to us," said winning jockey Kent Desormeaux. "Then when she changed leads, she barreled for the wire." The winning time shaved a full second off the previous stakes record set by Flawlessly in 1991.

Listen Here won his first three career starts, including a debut maiden victory at Saratoga last September and a half-length score in the GIII Nashua S. in October. The chestnut tried two turns in his juvenile finale, but tired after pressing the pace to be sixth in the Nov. 24 GII Remsen S. Winless in his first five outings of this campaign, he had been on the board in four of those tries, including a third in the May 4 GIII Withers S. and seconds in his last two starts, the May 18 Hirsch Jacobs S. at Pimlico and the July 4 GIII Hersey Shore Breeders' Cup S. at Monmouth Park. Looking to turn the tables on Jersey Shore winner Boston Common this time, the Bill Mott trainee was at the back of the pack as that rival dueled 6-5 Mayakovsky (Matty G) through a quarter in :21 4/5 and a half in :44 3/5, then came flying as those fractions took their toll, catching Boston Common in the final sixteenth and drawing clear. "This horse has been knocking on the door with seconds and thirds," Mott said. "He's run some credibleraces, but hasn't really gotten the job done. Today, he got the pace he needed and Pat [Day] was willing to let him settle." The winner will be pointed for the GI King's Bishop S. Aug. 24. Mayakovsky tired badly, weaving through the final sixteenth before finishing fourth.

Loving Kindness is by the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Prix de la Salamandre winner Coup de Genie, who went on to run fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and third in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. The winner of this event in 1993, she is also responsible for the stable's G2 Prix d'Astarte hopeful Glia (A. P. Indy). Winning trainer Pascal Bary said, "She is a really lovely filly who does everything right and is also a very nice mover. She also knows how to quicken which she proved today. All being well, she will return here in the G1 Prix Morny [Aug. 25]."

Godolphin carried off this prize with Kutub (Ire) last year and bid to follow up with **Equerry**. Unbeaten until finishing third behind Hawk Wing in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 6 last time, he sets the standard here. Twice a stakes winner at two, he beat Sagacity (Fr) by a half length in the G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange at Longchamp last September before being put away for an ambitious four-year-old campaign. That began with a smooth 3/4-of-a-length beating of Sensible (Fr), who was in receipt of five pounds, in the G3 La Coupe at Deauville June 20. Taken to Sandown for his biggest test yet, he performed with credit to finish five lengths adrift of Hawk Wing in his most recent outing. He had **Imperial Dancer** 3 1/2 lengths back in fourth that day; that colt has subsequently boosted the form by winning the G3 Scottish Classic at Ayr July 15 and the G3 Meld S. at The Curragh July 27. He has been kept busy by Mick Channon since finishing third in the G3 Gordon Richards S. at Sandown Apr. 27, but, judging on his latest performance, has improved for his strenuous campaign. **Simoun** heads the home defence and, on the form of his successes in the G2 Grosser Mercedes-Benz-Preis at Baden Baden June 2 and the G2 Idee Hansa-Preis at Hamburg June 30, has a realistic chance of warding off the foreign threat. Trainer Peter Schiergen took this in 1999 with Tiger Hill (Ire) and it is interesting that he bypassed the G1 Deutschland Preis at Dusseldorf Sunday in favour of this prize.

The combination of trainer Bobby Frankel and jockey Jerry Bailey has been nearly unstoppable during the opening 10 days of the Saratoga meeting and the trend looks likely to continue this afternoon with **Medaglia d'Oro**. The dark bay, winner of the GII San Rafael S., was second in the GI Wood Memorial before trying all three legs of the Triple Crown. A troubled fourth in the Kentucky Derby, he disappointed when eighth in the Preakness, and most recently carried the lead past the eighth pole in the June 8 Belmont S., only to be caught and edged by Sarava.
