SHORE EASY

On a balmy summer day at the Jersey Shore, Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) returned to the racetrack with an authoritative wire-to-wire victory in yesterday's GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park.

The dark bay colt had not raced since his Triple Crown bid came undone with a stumble at the start of the June 8 GI Belmont S. Fans at the Oceanport oval bet War Emblem down to 1-5 and he gave them no anxious moments. Fractious in the gate, the colt broke sharply and set moderate fractions of :23.83, :47.23, 1:10.67 and 1:35.41. He took a 4 1/2-length advantage into the stretch and finished under wraps and 3 1/2 lengths to the better of Preakness runner-up **Magic Weisner** (Ameri Valay) in a final time of 1:48.21. "I never really asked him to run," admitted winning jockey Victor Espinoza. *Cont. p. 2*

A WIRE-TO-WIRE DANDY

Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado {Ire}), off since finishing second behind Sarava in the June 8 GI Belmont S., broke on top and led every step of the way for a 13 3/4-length victory in yesterday's GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga.

Ridden to the front soon after the start, the dark bay colt set fractions of :23.60, :46.70, 1:10.74 and 1:35.11 before finishing the nine furlongs in 1:47.82. The race was marred when **Iron Deputy** (Silver Deputy) and jockey Richard Migliore were sandwiched between **Gold Dollar** (Seattle Slew) and **Quest** (Seeking the Gold) at the top of the stretch. Quest came in on Iron Deputy and caused the bay colt to stumble badly and lose his rider. Migliore was taken to Saratoga Hospital for x-rays of his right arm. Quest finished second, but was disqualified and placed eighth. "I was trying my hardest to keep him in a straight line," Quest's rider Javier Castellano explained. "He was trying to lug in from the three-eighths to the quarter pole. I didn't see [Migliore]. I thought I was clear." With the Jim Dandy win, jockey Jerry Bailey continued his hot streak at the Spa. "There's been a severe inside speed bias all day long," Bailey said of his ride on Medaglia d'Oro. "If I could get to the rail with the lead before the first turn, that's where I was going to be. He broke well and we got to the front. I was real happy once we were clear. He's just better than these." Winning trainer Bobby Frankel added, "[Bailey] said he was going to try to make it to the lead, but I didn't know if he'd make it that easy. The way the track's been playing, it looks like a jet stream on the inside. I just hope he didn't run too good today for the [Aug. 24 GI] Travers." Attendance at the upstate New York track yesterday was an all-time Saratoga record 69,523, bettering the mark of 66,942 set last Aug. 5.

Of the race, jockey Victor Espinoza said, "He was excited going into the gate and he reared, but I told the guy on the gate crew to just leave him alone and he'll settle down. When he broke from the gate, it was pretty much over." Commenting on the traditional Haskell hat giveaway, which this year outfitted the crowd of 45,212 with gold baseball caps, Espinoza added, "It was a little funny coming out of the tunnel there. All I saw was this sea of yellow hats. It looked like a giant pumpkin." Trainer Bob Baffert added, "I asked Victor after the race when he knew he had the race won. He said he knew as soon as he came out of the gate, he had so much horse. I hoped the race would be that easy. The easier the race, the longer they last. He had been going so well at Del Mar, getting stronger and stronger, we knew he was ready." Of what is next for the Derby winner, Thoroughbred Corporation racing manager Richard Mulhall said, "We'll take him back to Del Mar now and see how he does. The [Aug. 24 GI] Travers [at Saratoga] is a possibility, but we're leaning towards the [Aug. 25 GI] Pacific Classic [at Del Mar]. It's cooler there and he loves the track." Kaieteur powered past the front-running Equerry (St Jovite) at the top of the straight and galloped relentlessly to the line under jockey Pat Eddery to beat the staying-on Noroit by two lengths. "We had three horses to beat and he's been knocking on the door in some good races and at this point 1 1/4 miles is his best trip," explained trainer Brian Meehan. "This race was very suitable and the fact that he is only three gives even more credibility to the win." Second in the G3 Classic Trial at Sandown Apr. 26, he missed the French Derby with the virus that struck Meehan's yard in late spring. He returned with a fine fourth placing behind Balakheri (Ire) in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot June 21 before finding only the smart Burning Sun 3/4 of a length too strong in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte July 14. Here, he settled in second early as Equerry assumed a clear lead. Always travelling strongly, he was asked to quicken as he made the second turn into the straight and swept past the long-time leader with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining. Meehan continued: "Pat got a good lead all the way round, and on the second turn, he wasn't happy with the pace and some of the others were looming so he kicked on. At Ascot he needed the run, so, although 1 1/2 miles is possibly too far, we will think it out and analyse it as he is in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 6]. I wouldn't be worried about anything."

After finishing third in the Mar. 3 GI San Carlos H. at Santa Anita, Grey Memo traveled to Dubai to take the G2 Godolphin Mile by 3 1/2 lengths. Back in the U.S., the gray Cal-bred ran sixth in the GI Met Mile and was coming off a fifth-place effort in the seven-furlong GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood July 6. Gray Memo trailed the field early, moved up four wide down the backstretch and came into the stretch three wide. Favored Congaree, on the lead from the start, looked en route to an easy win, but Gray Memo reeled him in down the lane and won going away. "I figured I'd be running at the end and when I hit the quarter pole, I was going by them like they were standing still," explained winning rider Eddie Delahoussaye. "You've got to give congratulations to [trainer] Warren [Stute]. He did great with him." Stute added, "He's training better right now than he ever has. So I hope his six-year-old year will be better. I was worried when Congaree was running so easy out in front there. I was wondering where the other speed was." On the beaten favorite, David Flores said, "He just ran out of gas. No excuses. Bernimixa was only fifth in her only try at stakes level at two, in the G3 Prix Miesque at Maisons-Laffitte in November, but she looked a different proposition when winning the Listed Prix De Thiberville at that track last time July 14. The manner of her success there prompted connections to take this considerable jump in class. "Last time, she was only winning a Listed race, but she was very impressive on the day," said the owner Jean-Luc Lagardere's racing manager Roland de Longevialle. "That is why she went straight for this Group 2 and she has proved her point today." Here, she was held up with only two behind in the early stages as Casanga (Ire) (Rainbow Quest) cut out the running. Always tracking Martin Dwyer on Shadow Dancing, she stayed in her slipstream as that filly hit the front shortly after the turn into the straight. Olivier Peslier needed only to apply minimal encouragement for his filly to pass that rival with 75 yards remaining before she asserted for a comfortable success. Bernimixa will take another step up in class now according to de Longevialle: "We have no choice but to go to Group 1 level now and the Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 15] is next." After the withdrawal of Banks Hill (GB), this mile event took on a more competitive feel and it was Turtle Bow who proved strongest in a duel with Dedication. Turtle Bow had been absent since finishing third, before being disqualified and placed fourth, behind Bright Sky (Ire) in the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 9. She had previously beaten that filly in the Listed Prix Finlande at Longchamp Apr. 7, after which she added the G3 Prix Cleopatre at Saint-Cloud May 13 to her tally. This time, she settled in third early as Proudswings moved to the front to set a steadily increasing tempo. Switched wide for her run as the leader was starting to increase the pressure with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining, she quickened past that rival with 1 1/2 furlongs to race before holding off the late rally of Dedication. Winning trainer Francois Rohaut explained: "She is a really nice filly and she deserved this. I think maybe she didn't stay the 10 furlongs of the Diane, so we will think about the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois here [Aug. 18] next. That is not easy, however, and it is only two weeks from now, so we will see how she comes out of this. We are also considering the GI EP Taylor S. at Woodbine at the end of September." Criquelette Head-Maarek said of Dedication, "She will not go for the Jacques le Marois now as she probably found the the mile a bit too far."

Love Regardless proved too strong for his rivals here to reward the faith of connections and claim his first stakes success. Confidence in this colt has never been in shortage, with considerable hype pushing his ante-post odds down to 12-1 for the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 on the basis of smart homework and a Newcastle maiden success last September. He was a respectable 13th in the mile Classic behind Rock of Gibraltar, after which he was ill and forced to miss a series of top mile events. Brought back for a conditions race at Doncaster July 18, he found only L'Oiseau d'Argent a short head too strong there, but he showed the benefit of that effort with game success this time. Taken to the front early by jockey Keith Dalglish, he travelled well to steal a clear advantage turning into the straight and looked to have the race sewn up at the quarter-mile marker. It was left to Touch Down to serve up the only meaningful challenge from rear and as he bore into the leader's advantage and loomed upsides he appeared a serious threat. As the pair battled to the line, it was Love Regardless who asserted, despite drifting across the runner-up slightly, prompting a stewards' inquiry.

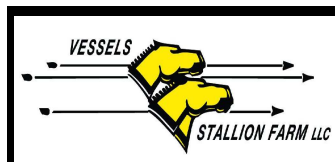

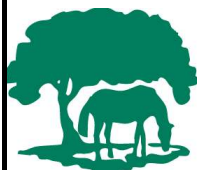

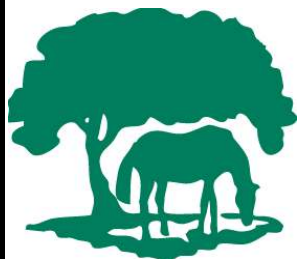

FALLON HITS ANOTHER CENTURY

Kieren Fallon completed a treble at Chester yesterday as he became the first jockey to record 100 winners this year. Having taken the maiden on **Late Claim (USA)** (King of Kings {USA}), he reached the landmark on **Random Quest (GB)** (Rainbow Quest {USA}) in the Curzon Park S., before recording win number 101 of the campaign aboard **Sequential (GB)** (Rainbow Quest {USA}) in the closing handicap. Fallon, who has taken the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot on Golan (Ire) and G1 Nassau S. on Islington (Ire) in the space of a week, is in a rich vein of form at present as he stands 23 clear of his nearest rival Richard Hughes. Fallon, who has taken the jockeys' championship three out of the last four years, was denied a sequence by a serious fall which caused serious damage to his right arm in 2000. "Winning the King George was the highlight and following up with Islington made it a fantastic week--the only sad part is we haven't had the owner here to see it, which puts a little bit of a dampener on it," said Fallon. "I've got a good agent in Dave Pollington who gets me good rides and I'm just glad and thankful for anybody who gives me the rides."

GOODWOOD A HIT

After five days of action at the 'Glorious Goodwood' meeting, Clerk of the Course and General Manager Rod Fabricius was delighted with the outcome of the festival. Despite attendances and tote turnover being slightly down on the 2001 figures, Fabricius was upbeat yesterday: "Considering the very changeable weather forecast last weekend, I think we were fortunate to get through the five days with no bad weather until yesterday which was bad luck, coinciding as it did with the biggest crowd of the week. As far as the racing itself is concerned, we were very lucky to have had the pleasure of seeing Rock of Gibraltar, who I think will go down as one of the best Sussex Stakes winners of all time, and a tremendous renewal of the Vodafone Nassau Stakes, with Islington being the decisive winner. The significant move of the £100,000 William Hill Mile to Friday's card seems to have achieved the objective of making all five days attractive."
