**SARATOGA SELECTED SALE STARTS TODAY**

Two years ago, **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) brought \$300,000 at Fasig-Tipton's Saratoga Selected Yearling Sale. The colt went on to win the G1 National S. at two and this year has been second in both the G1 Epsom Derby and the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas. Is there another Classic contender in this year's catalogue? A total of 229 yearlings have been catalogued for the three-day auction, which begins today at the Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion in Saratoga Springs, New York. Bidding begins at 7:30 p.m. nightly. The list of stallions represented includes A.P. Indy, Deputy Minister, French Deputy, Gone West, Grand Slam, Kingmambo, Saint Ballado, Storm Cat and Unbridled. There are also yearlings from the first crops of sires such as Artax, Charismatic, Exploit, Forestry, Mazel Trick, Menifee, Real Quiet, Silver Charm and Victory Gallop.

**Will History Repeat?**

Two mares that had seven-figure yearlings at Saratoga in 2001 will have lots sell again this year. Miss Caerleona (Fr) (Caerleon), whose colt by Storm Cat (now named Stone Cat and unraced) sold for \$2.4 million last year, will be represented by Hip #220, a filly by Coronado's Quest. The dark bay is consigned by Stonerside Stable, with Lane's End as agent. Hip #192, from the Blackburn Farm, agent, consignment, is a colt by Touch Gold out of Win Crafty Lady (Crafty Prospector; her 2001 offering, a colt by Unbridled's Song (Mister C's Song, unraced), was purchased for \$1.85 million. The 14-year-old broodmare has already produced MGSW Graeme Hall and SW Harmony Lodge.

**Others to Watch...**

Other yearlings of interest include Hip #41, a colt by Capote out of Felicita (Rubiano). The gray, consigned by Three Chimneys Sales, agent, is a half-brother to this year's GI Ashland S. winner Take Charge Lady. Hip #89, offered by Darby Dan Farm, agent, is a half-brother to Eclipse Award-winning Sprinter Squirtle Squirt by Langfuhr. A half-sister to MGSW Lido Palace (Chi) by Unbridled's Song sells as Hip #162. The dark bay is from the Taylor Made Sales Agency consignment. (*Outs, p2*)

**Quest Star** (Broad Brush) was overlooked at 11-1, but shot between horses in the stretch to take the GIII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. at Saratoga yesterday afternoon. "He split horses gamely, ran on

down to the wire and got the job done," winning jockey Pat Day said. Nominated to the 2002 Triple Crown, Quest Star finished a distant fourth behind Wiseman's Ferry, Sarava and Quest in a Keeneland allowance race in April and was switched to the turf. In his three previous grass outings, the dark bay was third in the May 11 GIII Hawthorne Derby, the June 8 GIII Jefferson Cup at Churchill Downs and, last time out, in the GIII Kent Breeders' Cup S. at Colonial Downs. "It's nice to finally get a win," trainer Elliott Walden said. "He's always been kind of a bridesmaid." With the victory, Day moved to within \$239,330 of jockey Chris McCarron's all-time earnings record of \$264,351,679.

The dark bay started this season with a win in an optional claimer over this track May 12, took the GIII Alberta Derby at Stampede Park June 15 and made it four in a row in the Ky Alta H. at Northlands Park July 13. Odds-on to add yet another victory to his skein, he grabbed the lead after an opening quarter in :23 4/5 and never looked back, winning as much the best.

## PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

Bearing in mind that the last sizeable crop by Northern Dancer was born back in 1987, the stallion sons of this extraordinary patriarch are a dwindling species. It's a sobering thought that, by the time next year's breeding season comes around, Danzig will be 26, Dixieland Band will be 23 and Sadler's Wells 22. The message is make full use of them while you still can and the same applies to Night Shift, another who is an aging 23.

Night Shift's fee of Ir£15,000 ranked him only 11th in this year's pecking order among Coolmore's Irish-based stallions, and the majority of his current representatives were sired at a slightly lower fee. Even so, this unsung hero is having a tremendous year. On July 28, his two-year-old daughter Never A Doubt won the G2 Prix Robert Papin; his ex-French daughter Nunatall gamely took the GIII Lake George S. July 29; and five days later another ex-French daughter, Little Treasure, set a new stakes record in landing the GII San Clemente H. This trio have improved Night Shift's total of group and graded winners for the year in the Northern Hemisphere to seven, the others being Tashawak (who looked a filly with a very bright future when she won the G2 Falmouth S. in July), Baron's Pit (G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot), Moon Solitaire (GII King Edward Breeders' Cup H.) and Zarewitsch (G3 Deutscher Herold-Preis).

Never A Doubt and Baron's Pit lead a remarkable batch of 2002 juveniles by Night Shift. No fewer than 15 of his juveniles had won before the end of July, including the fast English stakes winner Deportivo and Coconut Penang, a good fourth in the G3 Coventry S.

Altogether, Night Shift has shown most of the attributes of Northern Dancer's best stallion sons. While he is capable of siring plenty of two-year-old winners and the occasional group-winning sprinter, such as Lochangel (G1 Nunthorpe S.), Eveningperformance, Vision of Night, Struggler and Dyhim Diamond, Night Shift can also supply very good performers beyond a mile. His daughter Daryaba won both the French Oaks and the G1 Prix Vermeille, while another daughter, In The Groove, was an exceptional performer at up to 1 1/2 miles, defeating colts in three Group 1s after her victory in the Irish 1000 Guineas. Listening-- yet another daughter--won the Hollywood Oaks.

Listening was a member of Night Shift's 1993 crop, sired during the short time he spent at Lane's End Farm at a fee of \$30,000. That crop consisted of only 28 live foals, from a book of 42 mares. Exactly why Night Shift wasn't in greater demand is hard to tell. The lateness of his arrival can't have helped--his move from England was announced in December, 1991--and neither can his racing record. He retired with earnings of only \$9,282, with a record of 7-1-0-2, and his only win had come in a six-furlong maiden at Monmouth.

He had a magnificent pedigree, though, being a brother to the champion filly Fanfreluche and to the good Canadian colt Barachois. His half sister Somfas had already done very well as a broodmare, as had Fanfreluche.

Night Shift had also quickly established that his exceptional bloodlines were far more relevant to breeders than his modest achievements on the track. Despite having started his career in England as a virtual unknown at a modest fee (as low as £2,500 in his fourth season in 1988), he had finished second to Sadler's Wells among the leading sires in Britain and Ireland in 1990. He had also sired an encouragingly high proportion of winners to runners.

Night Shift hadn't completed his first season in Kentucky before the financial problems suffered by Don Johnson of Crescent Farm forced his sale. Coolmore--an organisation fully aware of his talents--quickly stepped in to buy him for a sum reported as slightly more than \$3,000,000. Night Shift, who has also shuttled to Australia on four occasions, has repaid Coolmore's confidence in him several times over.

Although Night Shift is now elderly, the best may yet be to come from him because he commanded the highest fee of his Irish career--20,000 guineas--in 2000 and 2001. His yearlings and weanlings should therefore be well worth a look at this year's sales, and American buyers could do a lot worse than considering his youngsters. Remember, Night Shift's North American stakes winners include the Grade I winners Creaking Board and Listening, plus Nunatall, Little Treasure, Moon Solitaire and GII Sunset H. winner Plicck.

**CAME HOME TO PACIFIC CLASSIC MGISW**  
**Came Home** (Gone West), who skipped a trip to Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park and had been pointing to the seven-furlong GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga Aug. 24, will instead take on older horses at a mile and a quarter in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 25. "[Trainer Paco Gonzalez] decided he wanted to give the horse another shot at a mile and a quarter, and the Pacific Classic is in his own backyard," co-owner Bill Farish said. "He's training awfully well, and he thought this was a good opportunity." Came Home is scheduled to stand at Lane's End Farm upon his retirement. No stud fee has been set. A live foal option to breed to Came Home at a price of \$30,000, live foal, was scheduled to be auctioned off at last night's Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation fundraiser. "While no stud fee has been set, we thought by putting the live foal fee at \$30,000 for the purpose of this auction, we would be able to generate a healthy donation to a very worthy cause," Farish said. Results of the TRF auction will be in tomorrow's TDN.

**WOODBINE FIRE KILLS 32** The early morning fire that destroyed two barns at Woodbine Sunday left 32 horses dead, it was confirmed yesterday. Possible causes are still being investigated by the Ontario Fire Marshall's Office. Track officials indicated damage could have been much worse, but the heroic actions of local firefighters, policemen and backstretch personnel prevented graver loss of equine life. No people were lost in the blaze. The barns, which held 126 horses conditioned by several different trainers, suffered a similar fire 12 years ago that killed six horses and injured 12 people. Among those horses killed was the gelding **Highland Legacy** (Highland Ruckus). Out of the Lord Avie mare Nonfiction, the four-year-old won the 2000 GIII Swynford S. and was named Canadian Champion Two-Year-Old Colt that year.

An 11-1 longshot winner in the GI Hempstead H. at Belmont in June of 2001, Critical Eye had hit the board only once in nine subsequent starts, winning an off-the-turf allowance test May 19. Last out, she ran sixth to Summer Colony in the GIII Delaware H. July 21. Returning here to face a tough bunch of allowance foes, including graded stakes winner Shiny Band, the bay mare patiently tracked the field in last through the half before moving up into contention leaving the backstretch. **Stronach Announces Plans for Pimlico:**

Magna Entertainment Chairman Frank Stronach has announced that recently acquired Pimlico Racecourse will be torn down and a new facility will be reconstructed on its existing site. "I think the whole track needs to be torn down," Stronach told the *Baltimore Sun*. "Pimlico must remain; there's too much tradition involved. But it would be totally rebuilt from scratch. We would flatten it completely." Early plans call for the track to be demolished soon after the 2003 Preakness, second jewel in the Visa Triple Crown, which would force the event to be held at Laurel Park in 2004. The Baltimore oval is slated to be ready for the 2005 season. Stronach, who agreed to buy 51 percent of Pimlico and Laurel for \$117.5 million, is still awaiting the approval of the sale by the Maryland Racing Commission. "It sounds like something that, if done properly, would preserve Pimlico and be great for the city and for Maryland racing," Commission Chairman Lou Ulman told the *Blood-Horse*. "But clearly, we would want to make sure if he tears down Pimlico, he doesn't for whatever reason decide not to rebuild it." In response to those concerns, Stronach commented, "We'll put up a bond or anything. We'll go way out of our way to assure people--the racing commission, horsemen--that we're committed to Pimlico. The racing world will look at us by what we do at Pimlico. It's our top priority."
