STORM CAT FILLY TOPS \$1 MIL AT SARATOGA

It took until nearly the close of the second session, but Fasig-Tipton's Saratoga Selected Yearling Sale got it's first seven-figure purchase last night when Hip

#143, a daughter of Storm Cat, brought \$1.3 million. Consigned by Eaton Sales, agent, the chestnut was purchased by John Sikura. The filly, from the family of Geri and Raging Fever, is the eighth foal from Sacahuista (Raja Baba), who was the champion three-year-old

distaffier of 1987 after taking the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. The 18-year-old mare has already produced MGSW Ekraar (Red Ransom). "She's from a fabulous female family and her dam is already proven as a producer," Sikura said. "I was surprised the bidding ended so quickly. I expected her to sell for double what she did." Asked why he opened the bidding at \$1 million, he replied, "I wanted to try to push people aside as quickly as I could. I wanted to force them into a quick decision on whether to buy her or not. I didn't really care who I was bidding against. All I worried about was what I was trying to accomplish." The filly will be trained in Canada by Josie Carroll.

Another Big Sale for Forestry...

A yearling from the first crop by Forestry (Storm Cat) caught the buyers attention yesterday. Hip #125, a dark bay colt consigned by Bluewater Sales LLC, Agent III, was purchased by John Oxley for \$800,000. Oxley outlasted Wayne Lukas and Buzz Chace. "I thought he had a very nice pedigree with a combination of speed and stamina," Oxley said. "This colt is very athletic, strong and well-made. He vetted out very well and we thought he looked the part. I also like Forestry. His pedigree is outstanding and I think he'll be a good stallion. I thought it was a fair price for him."

Storm Cat Colt Stirs The Crowd...

The final lot through the ring last night, Hip #152, a son of Storm Cat out of Shared Interest (Pleasant Colony), looked to be taking over the role of sales topper when bidding hit \$3.8 million, but it turned out that the reserve for the chestnut, consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, was \$3.9 million. Owner Robert Evans will hold on to the colt. Evans bred and sold the colt's full brother, GISW and promising sire Forestry; and half-sister, GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine Cash Run (Seeking the Gold). "There was definitely a lot of interest in the colt, but we knew that there was an outside chance that he wouldn't sell," Duncan Taylor said. "He is a later foal [Apr. 28]...maybe if he'd had those extra couple of months, people might have had a better feeling for how he'd be in the future. Personally I am a little disappointed, but in the end, the owner gets to make the final call and that's what he did."

Padua Takes Top Colt...

Satish Sanan's Padua Stables outbid former trainer D. Wayne Lukas to buy the top colt last night, going to \$900,000 for Hip #141, a son of Honour and Glory out of stakes-placed Ruby Wedding (Rubiano). The bay's second dam is GISW Share The Fantasy (Exclusive Native). "I thought he was the best colt in the sale," Sanan said. "We paid a lot more money for him than we thought we would, but that's what happens when two people hook up. Logic goes out the window and you just try to buy the horse. That's what happens with all the good ones." Lukas, on the cell phone with John Moynihan, took his time between each bid, but Sanan was very quick--a discrete tap of the foot and the ball was back in Lukas' court. Asked if that was part of the plan, Sanan replied, "It was. We know who they are and we just wanted them to know that we were very serious."

The Fasig-Tipton Assessment...

Through the first two sessions, the figures for the Saratoga Selected Sale dropped, with the average off 26.8 percent and the median down 11.3 percent. Fasig-Tipton Chairman D.G. Van Clief said, "Obviously we have seen declines in the average and the median and there could be a couple of reasons. I hate to make knee-jerk judgments, but there seems to be a general chill in the economic arena and it appears to be taking its toll. There is also a lack of the extremely high-priced horses and a lack of energy at the top of the market." Added President Walt Robertson, "This is not easy. Some of our nice horses did sell well, but others did not. Certainly one of the players at the top level [Prince Ahmed Salman] is no longer with us. The players who had confidence in this market a year ago at the million-dollar level are now not comfortable at the half-million dollar mark. The right people are here, it's just been a little thin at the top, it appears to me."

What They're Saying At The Sales...

Tom Van Meter, Eaton Sales:

"We had a tough opening night and we sort of knew that we would based on our pre-sale vet work. If people don't want to pay \$150 to have these horses vetted, then they are certainly not going to want to pay \$150,000 for the horses themselves. It's not entirely doom and gloom, but there just doesn't seem to be a lot of vigor or excitement out there. The market just seemed kind of flat. It should get better as the sale goes on."

Buzz Chace, bloodstock agent:

"I thought the opening session was good for the horse flesh that went through the ring. The stock was good, just not high end. [Wednesday] is going to be better. There are better horses and the prices should be better accordingly. When a good horse goes through, the people are going to be there to bid on it. Overall, I think there is a sense of well being, although I am not overly optimistic. At the same time, I don't think there is a lot of negativity either."

Linder Back With Pedigree Power

"I have a compulsive need to be around animals," says breeder Bertram Linder from his seat at the Taylor Made barns at Fasig-Tipton. The 86-year-old, who consigned horses in his name until three years ago, now leaves the "dirty work" to Taylor Made, but with hip 180, the resident of Daulton, Pennsylvania, makes a remarkable 47th consecutive trip to these sales.

The chestnut colt sports an impressive page. He is from the first crop of 1999 Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Charismatic (Summer Squall) out of Turbo Launch (Relaunch) making him a half brother to SW and MGSP U R Unforgettable and to Turko's Turn, the dam of 2001 Horse of the Year Point Given. Linder is scarcely able to contain his excitement.

"This is one of the best individuals I've brought here in a while," he enthused. "He has a combination of so many things. You cannot fault him conformationally. He has a super disposition, he's intelligent and I just can't brag enough about him. You know, sometimes you have a good physical and no pedigree and sometimes it's the other way around. Everything has come together with this colt. Whoever buys him is going to have a serious racehorse."

The veteran of World War II is no stranger to success at the sale either. Among horses that Linder has bred and sold at Saratoga include Obeah, a two-time winner of the Delaware H. and dam of the late Go For Wand; and Optimistic Gal, winner of no fewer than six Grade I races in her career. Still, despite his good luck, Linder is mindful of the ups and downs of this business. When asked on a scale one to 10 how excited he is about selling this colt, he says, "nine."

"After all of my years in the game, I have experienced real highs and real lows," he reflected. "The market right now, it leaves me a little bit jittery. But this is exciting for me. Believe me, when he goes through the ring, it will be very difficult to control my pulse."

Linder is soon to be faced with a dilemma. Turbo Launch gave birth this year to a Thunder Gulch colt, making the offspring a close relative to Point Given. To keep or not to keep...that is the question.

"Usually the only time I hold on to one is when we don't want to lose the bloodline, so I don't know. I'm tempted to hold on to it, but we'll see."

The Linder breeding program is also represented this afternoon across Union Avenue at the track. New York-bred Sultress of Swing (Dixie Brass), owned by David Cassidy and Debbie Avellino, is the morning line favorite with Jerry Bailey in the seventh race.

Blackburn Hoping Lightning Strikes Twice

Just a year ago at this sale, Michael Barnett and his Blackburn Farm sold a colt by Unbridled's Song out of Win Crafty Lady (Crafty Prospector) for \$1.85 million. Barnett is back this year with another colt out of the same mare and hopes for similar success.

The good-looking bay colt from the second crop of Touch Gold (Deputy Minister), is a half brother to SW and GISP Harmony Lodge (Hennessy); and a three-parts sibling to Graeme Hall (Dehere), winner of the GII Arkansas Derby in 2000 and runner-up to stablemate Left Bank in the GI Cigar Mile H. last season.

"He is a classic-looking horse," Barnett said. "He reminds me a lot of Graeme Hall, actually. He is very similar to him in terms of his body type and the way that he moves. Win Crafty Lady was an excellent racemare and has been a very good producer."

The choice of Touch Gold as a sire was an easy one, according to Barnett, and even though he has not had the quickest start with his first crop, Barnett thinks his get will improve with time.

"Touch Gold was best at three, so you wouldn't necessarily expect his two-year-olds to sprint right out of the box," he explained.

Citing the success of French Deputy and Dehere, he added, "He'll get better and I think we've seen that sons of Deputy Minister have proved to be good sires."

Blackburn's other offering is hip number 168, a gray colt by Wild Rush--Strawberry Clover (Darn That Alarm) that "fills the eye," according to Barnett.

Darby Dan Loaded For Bear

Darby Dan Farm sends two very well-bred yearlings into tonight's closing session. Hip 193 is a dark bay colt from the second crop of Claiborne stallion Arch out of Darby Dan's outstanding producer Wings of Grace (Key to the Mint). The Apr. 24 foal is closely related to GI Yellow Ribbon S. winner Plenty of Grace (Roberto) and is a three-quarter brother to Soaring Softly (Kris S.), winner of the inaugural Breeders' Cup F/M Turf and champion turf mare of 1999. The second of their two offerings in hip 216, a colt by Tale of the Cat. The chestnut is a half to Blazing Fury (Dynaformer), scheduled to make his next start in this Saturday's GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at the Spa.

BIG M STAKES WORTH \$1.5 MILLION The Meadowlands Racetrack has released an eight-race \$1.5-million stakes schedule for its 63-day fall meeting. Five of the eight events are graded. The season is highlighted by the \$400,000 GII Meadowlands Cup on Oct. 4. "The Meadowlands Cup is positioned three weeks before the Breeders' Cup this year," said Robert Kulina, vice president of Thoroughbred racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "That should ensure a strong Meadowlands Cup, which we hope will complement a strong meet." The other graded-stakes races scheduled for the Meadowlands meet are the Sept. 6 GIII Boiling Springs Breeders' Cup H., the Sept. 20 GIII Violet H., Sept. 27 GII Pegasus H. and Oct. 11 GIII Cliff Hanger H. Post time at the upcoming meet, which runs from Sept. 2 through Nov. 23, will be 1:10 p.m. Tuesday and 7:30 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday. The afternoon post time will also be in effect Sept. 5 and for the special Monday cards Sept. 2, Oct. 14 and Nov. 4, 11 and 18. "The special post times will give us a new opportunity to take advantage of more lucrative simulcast markets," Kulina explained. "It should ensure that the Meadowlands signal reaches the greatest amount of outlets from coast to coast."
