SAKHEE BEATEN AT DEAUVILLE

Making his first start since finishing third in the Mar. 23 G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad Al Sheba, Godolphin's **Sakhee** (Bahri) was sent off the 1-5 favourite in the G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron at Deauville, but could not get past 6-1 **Wellbeing** (GB) (Sadler's Wells) and suffered the one-length upset. "It was obviously disappointing to get beaten and that must rate as a below-par performance," Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford said. "We needed him to win to go forward with plans, so now we will have to take him home and see if something wrong comes to light."



Wellbeing Beats Sakhee Photo Finish

The one-two finishers had last met in the 2000 G1 Epsom Derby, where 12 1/2 lengths separated the runner-up Sakhee and the fifth-placed Wellbeing. They had traveled very different paths since--while Sakhee was establishing himself as last year's International Classifications highweight, Wellbeing was winless in three starts, finishing second in the G1 Coronation Cup before being transferred from Henry Cecil's yard to that of trainer Pascal Bary. This season, the five-year-old was disappointing when eighth in the G3 Prix d'Hedouville over fast ground at Longchamp Apr. 18, but showed he had retained his ability when taking the Listed Grand Prix De Compiègne July 3 in impressive fashion. Here he was keen in the early stages, but eventually settled in Thierry Thulliez's hands as **Sydenham** (A. P. Indy) cut out the running for Sakhee, who sat third. Thulliez was content to race alongside the favourite early, but made the decisive move to go to the front at the half-mile marker. Sakhee loomed at Wellbeing's quarters and, for a brief period, it looked as if he might go past, but Wellbeing gained control. "I am convinced that he is better over a mile and a quarter than this mile and a half, but I was confident he would run a very good race today," Bary said. As for what's next, he added, "We have many options, but we may go for the G2 Prix Dollar [Oct. 5] before going to Newmarket for the G1 Champion S. [Oct. 19], or we could go straight to the Champion." (*Chart, p2*)

WITH ANTICIPATION DEFENDS HIS TITLE As he did last year, **With Anticipation** (Relaunch) prepped for the Sword Dancer in the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park. The big gray finished first in the 2001 U.N., but was disqualified and placed second for drifting into Senure in the stretch. He went on to take the Sword Dancer and the GI Man o'War S., but ended the season with off-the-board efforts in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf and G1 Japan Cup. Second in a Gulfstream allowance in his 2002 debut, the seven-year-old ran into Beat Hollow (GB) in his next two, finishing second to that rival in the May 4 GI Woodford Reserve S. and fourth behind him in the June 8 GI Manhattan H. Back for another tilt at the U.N. July 6, the Augustin Stable homebred hit the wire a neck in front of **Denon** (Pleasant Colony) and this time was able to keep the winner's share of the purse. The second choice behind the U.N. runner-up this time, he settled in fourth off a swift early pace. Denon, just in front of him, strode to the front in the stretch, but With Anticipation finished with determination for the score. "Pat did a masterful job," trainer Jonathan Sheppard said. "Pat really got into him and, sure enough, he dug down deep and did what he had to do." The winner will likely go after a second straight Man o'War S. at Belmont Park Sept. 7.

Buffythecenterfold dueled for the lead in her June 15 debut at Hollywood Park and prevailed by a length at 10-1, then went gate-to-wire to take the GIII Landaluce S. at 6-1 over that track July 4. Finally favored at third asking, the bay was forced out into Indy Groove at the break, then raced head-and-head with longshot My Honey Bunny (Swiss Yodeler) through the opening quarter. She was hooked by Tricks Her after a half, but fought her off to take a narrow score after a heated stretch drive. "I thought she'd win it today," jockey Matt Garcia said. "I rode with great confidence. I hit her a couple of times in the lane, but I really didn't have to do too much with her. I could see she had the idea--she knew what to do." Trainer Mel Stute compared the filly to his two Breeders' Cup winners. "She stacks up with Brave Raj ['86 Juvenile Fillies] and Very Subtle ['87 Sprint]," he said. "You can see how she was today--she went to the lead and battled all the way. Nothing much bothers her. She just keeps running--she just digs in." The winner goes next in the GII Del Mar Debutante S. Aug. 31. Tricks Her was jostled at the start and her jockey, Pat Valenzuela, claimed foul against the winner, but the stewards ruled it was My Honey Bunny that caused the interference and allowed the result to stand. "The incident away from the gate cost her the race," Valenzuela said. "I know it wasn't the winner's fault, but she came over on me and banged me into the other horse." Second, four lengths behind Johannesburg, in the G3 Anglesey S. in Ireland last year, Wiseman's Ferry was shipped across the Atlantic for what has become a lucrative three-year-old campaign. The chestnut followed a third-place finish in a Gulfstream allowance test in March with wins in a Keeneland allowance Apr. 14 and in the GIII Lone Star Derby May 11. The Kentucky-bred did not fare well in the final leg of the Triple Crown, finishing 50 lengths to the rear of Sarava in the June 8 GI Belmont S., but bounced back in his latest. Off as the 4-5 favorite in the July 20 GII Ohio Derby, he set all the pace before being collared by Magic Weisner in the final yards to finish second by a neck. The 8-5 chalk to make amends here, Wiseman's Ferry once again sprinted to the lead right out of the gate. He set a solid pace and, despite getting leg weary in the final sixteenth, was able to hold off the late surge of The Judge Sez Who. [Click here](#) for the brisnet.com chart.

A 10-length allowance winner at Keeneland Apr. 19, Minister's Baby led from flagfall to finish to record her first stakes win in the Diamond Trail S. at Prairie Meadows May 18. Last of six in the GII Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill Downs June 15, the chestnut earned a nose victory over Caressing in the July 6 Iowa Distaff S. last out and was the lukewarm favorite to make it consecutive stakes scores. Content to race in midpack behind a moderate pace, the Ken McPeek trainee advanced towards the front entering the far turn, assumed command at the head of the stretch and powered clear. June 30. Returned to the dirt for her latest, the Ontario-bred finished third by a neck in the July 13 Wilderness Song S. Cutting back to one turn for this test, Mulrainy showed good speed to duel with favored For Rubies through sharp fractions of :22 1/5 and :44 4/5. The latter looked poised to go on to victory after securing a clear lead in upper stretch, but Mulrainy rallied inside the final furlong and won going away. "That was pretty exciting," said winning jockey Chantal Sutherland. "The plan was to stalk the pace, and then I found myself up there. She was running easy and when [For Rubies] came on the inside to pass, I thought, 'we're not done yet' and she really dug in. "I love it when the plan comes together," said trainer Dennis Manning after watching Valid Video overpower seven rivals here. Manning had been pointing Valid Video to this race since the gelding's first start, when he broke his maiden in the mud at Monmouth June 14. The Florida-bred was given a break after that effort, skipping the July 20 Tyro S. to await the Sapling. Sent off as the crowd's choice, Valid Video was bumped around as no less than three of the eight horses in the field stumbled at the start, but quickly recovered and sprinted to the lead. He dashed through an opening quarter in an eye-catching :21.39 and a half in :44.45, then had enough left in the tank to pull away from Tyro winner Farno for a handy victory. "I rode the best horse in the race," jockey Chuck Lopez said. "He came out of there running and there was really no reason to take him back. They were trying me the whole way, but they weren't really getting to him. He kept running all the way to the wire." As for what's next, the trainer said, "A lot of people think I should go on to the Hopeful [GI, Aug. 31, Saratoga], but I think that's too hard a race, especially coming off this one. We'll see how he comes out of this race, but we'll probably wait and look at the Futurity." The GI Futurity will be run at eight furlongs at Belmont Park Sept. 15. Manning is confident his charge will handle the added quarter mile. "He will rate," he said. "He doesn't have to be in front-he showed that in his first race. I believe he will stretch out." Shifted out in upper stretch, he rallied willingly, took command from El Soprano inside the final furlong and edged clear. The victory represented the fifth Breeders' S. win for Sam-Son Farm, which took the third leg in Canada's Triple Crown in 1987-88, 1991 and 1996, and the third for trainer Mark Frostad (1995-96). Looking ahead for the winner, Frostad said, "Portcullis has been very busy this year. Now it's probably time to give him a little break and start thinking about next year." EMERGENCY SURGERY FOR LEFT BANK **Left Bank** (French Deputy), who last Saturday captured the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga, had to be shipped to the equine clinic at Tufts University in Massachusetts for emergency colic surgery yesterday, the *Daily Racing Form* reports. The five-year-old showed signs of colic yesterday morning and did not respond to treatment. He arrived at Tufts at 1 p.m. Trainer Todd Pletcher told *DRF* he had not heard any news by yesterday evening, but said the veterinarians had promised to call at once "if anything catastrophic happened. So I guess no news is good news." This was not the first colic surgery for Left Bank, who had 12 feet of intestine removed during an operation in 1999. It is likely that the latest surgery will spell the end of his racing career. To date, he has won 14 of his 24 starts, including the GI Vosburgh, the GI Cigar Mile and the GI Tom Fool H., where he set a Belmont Park track record of 1:20.17 for seven furlongs. His earnings stand at \$1,402,806.

NINE FOR ARLINGTON MILLION Nine turf runners have been pre-entered for the GI Arlington Million, to be run Aug. 17. Leading the list is Juddmonte Farm's **Beat Hollow (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who won back-to-back Grade I races before finishing second behind fellow Million hopeful **Sarafan** (Lear Fan) in the GI Eddie Read H. last time. Beat Hollow's team of Juddmonte, trainer Bobby Frankel and jockey Jerry Bailey combined to take the 2000 Million with Chester House. The four-strong European contingent, scheduled to fly into Chicago over this weekend, consists of G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup runner-up **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}), Group winner **Cheshire (GB)** (Warning {GB}), Listed winner **Freefourinternet** (Tabasco Cat) and **Ulundi (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), a sometime hurdler who took a handicap at Royal Ascot June 21. Completing the pre-entries for the 10-furlong contest are GISW **Forbidden Apple** (Pleasant Colony) and possibles **Falcon Flight (Fr)** (Persian Bold {Ire}) and **Mystery Giver** (Dynaformer). The Million is the fifth leg of the World Series Racing Championship. Post positions will be drawn Wednesday.

HAYDOCK CARD LOST Britain's Haydock race course was forced to abandon yesterday's card, featuring the G3 Rose of Lancaster S., after heavy rain caused water-logging. Haydock had raced on heavy ground the previous evening, but 18 millimetres of rain fell on the track overnight, causing standing water.

FOUR NEW CASES OF POTOMAC FEVER IN LEXINGTON Four additional cases of Potomac horse fever have been diagnosed at two equine clinics in Lexington, Kentucky. According to a report in *The Horse Magazine*, three of the horses affected were at Hagyard-Davidson-McGee Veterinary Clinic, where two were recovering and one had to be euthanized. The fourth was being treated at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital. Four more horses at HDM have been tested, with the results not yet known. Kentucky recorded its first-ever fatality from the disease when a Thoroughbred filly had to be put down at Rood and Riddle June 18. Potomac horse fever is normally detected in only one or two horses a year in Kentucky.

ECHO EDDIE OUT OF VANDERBILT Cal-bred **Echo Eddie** (Restless Con) had to be withdrawn from today's GII A.G. Vanderbilt H. at Saratoga Race Course after developing a fever. The five-year-old gelding, second behind Vanderbilt favorite Orientate in the July 13 Smile Sprint H. at Calder last time out, flew in from California Thursday evening. A routine temperature check uncovered the problem. "We treated him yesterday and his temperature is normal now," Scott Chaney, assistant to trainer Darrell Vienna, said, adding, "It's pretty disappointing. He traveled so well." It has not yet been decided where the gray will go next.

Dwelling at the start here, Tout Seul was in last, five lengths adrift of Devious Boy, who Flores had travelling well in pole position from the gate. Not panicked, Fallon asked his mount to pick up passing the halfway and he responded to deliver a strong challenge up the stands' rail as Devious Boy wandered off a true line in front. Seizing the advantage with 300 yards remaining, he powered past the weakening front-runner and, despite drifting right across the course in the closing stages, was comfortably clear at the line.
