**I, SPARTACUS**

Aidan O'Brien, who saddled four starters, ran his record in the G1 Independent Waterford Wedgwood Phoenix S. to five in a row at The Curragh yesterday. But it was 16-1 outsider **Spartacus (Ire)** (Danehill) who kept the streak alive, beating 7-2 **Marino Marini** (Storm Cat) by a half-length to lead home another one-two for his trainer. In the process, he supplied Team Ballydoyle with its seventh consecutive Irish Group 1 juvenile prize. "It wasn't a real shock, as he's a nice horse that's going to get further," O'Brien said. The conditioner's biggest concern was the health of his runners--Ballydoyle's three-year-old yard is currently under a cloud due to coughing. "The way our horses are, you just don't know if they are going to be okay," O'Brien said. His other Phoenix runners, **Ontario** (Storm Cat), who beat Spartacus in the G3 Anglesey S. July 13, and 11-10 favourite **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat), were fifth and last respectively, with the latter stumbling at the break and reportedly suffering from respiratory distress at the finish. **LEFT BANK STABLE AFTER COLIC SURGERY**

MGISW **Left Bank** (French Deputy), who underwent emergency colic surgery at the Tufts University equine clinic in Massachusetts Saturday, came through the operation well. "The surgery was a success and he is in good shape this morning," trainer Todd Pletcher said, adding, "There can always be complications to these things. We're just hoping everything goes smoothly." It has not yet been decided if the five-year-old, winner of last Saturday's GI Whitney H., will race again, but indications are that he will be retired. "He'll need to stay [at the clinic] for seven to 10 days and then 60 days of rest," Pletcher said. "It would be near the end of the year before he got back into training."

**"HOLIDAY" IN THE ADIRONDACKS**

**Holiday Runner** (Meadowlake), the \$35,000 KEESEP yearling who has yet to be beaten, heads a field of six in the GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga Race Course this afternoon. The two-year-old filly started her career with a maiden win at Keeneland in April, beat the boys in the May 4 Three Chimneys Juvenile S. at Churchill Downs and made it three-for-three with a victory in the June 6 Fashion S. at Belmont. "She snuck up on us," trainer D. Wayne Lukas admitted. "We did expect her to run well in her first race, but none of us thought she would have won the way she did. She has developed and has done everything the right way to this point. She has become a lovely filly." But can she carry her speed the 6 1/2 furlongs of the Adirondack? The bay just held on in the five-furlong Fashion, winning by a head after leading by five in the stretch. **Awsome Humor** (Distorted Humor), in contrast, rallied to win her most recent outing, taking the 5 1/2-furlong GIII Debutante S. by a widening two lengths at Churchill July 6. The dark bay, now a perfect two-for-two, was purchased by WinStar Farm after that effort. New trainer Elliott Walden said, "I feel really good about this filly. I had her work out with an older horse last week and she kept up with her." (Field, p6)

**SPARTACUS SPRINGS THE UPSET Spartacus (Ire)** (Danehill) was winning for the first time since his impressive debut in a seven-furlong maiden at Gowran Park May 15. After that effort, however, he trailed in ninth behind stable companion Statue of Liberty on fast ground in the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 18. He rebounded to be second in the Anglesey. "He ran a nice race here last time against Ontario and everyone saw what he did at Gowran," O'Brien said. "At Royal Ascot he was all at sea and was just very green." Making virtually all under Colm O'Donoghue against the stands' rail here, Spartacus gave more when headed by stable companion Marino Marini past halfway to regain the advantage and defy the grey's persistent challenge in the closing stages. As for the future, the trainer said, "All options are open. The runner-up may go to the G1 Prix Morny [at Deauville Aug. 25] and maybe Spartacus will go there, too." Apprentice Colm O'Donoghue, celebrating his 75th winner and first Group 1 race success, commented, "I was third in both the Irish 2000 and Irish 1000 Guineas for the boss earlier this season and have ridden most of the best horses we have had. It was a real thrill to win such a big race on Spartacus."

Gerald Mosse displayed the same acute awareness of pace as he had in the Listed Grand Handicap de Deauville half an hour earlier to ensure a deserved first Group 1 success for May Ball. "It is real thrill, because this is the first time one of my horses has won a Group 1 race," Lord Hartington, her delighted owner, said. "She got a perfect ride from Gerald Mosse, who made his challenge at just the right time. She loves this ground, which was also a key factor." With those ideal conditions underfoot, she was positioned in second, tracking the Japanese-trained frontrunner Air Thule, who stole a healthy advantage on the field in the early stages. Steadily increasing the tempo from the front, Mirco Demuro had most of his rivals struggling to close inside the final quarter-mile, but May Ball was perfectly placed in his slipstream and when Mosse asked her to quicken, she responded to cut down the leader with 300 yards remaining. Pushed out to assert from there, she was always in control. May Ball's only previous stakes success came over this course in August 2000, when she beat G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches runner-up Peony (GB) in the Listed Prix De Lieurey. She went on to finish third in the G2 Sun Chariot S. in the fall before a low-key four-year-old career, the highlights of which were a pair of thirds in the Listed Spring Trophy at Haydock in May and the G3 Prix Perth at Saint-Cloud in November. She made her seasonal return in the former event at Haydock May 4, but finished last of seven before showing marked improvement to be beaten a nose by Ziping (Ire) (Zafonic), from whom she was receiving five pounds, in the G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis over six furlongs July 7. Looking ahead, Lord Hartington said, "I will discuss with the trainer where she runs next, but she may return to France for the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 13]." Ziping proved the disappointment this time with a lackluster sixth-place showing. "Ziping came back bleeding, which resulted from him banging his head just before the start," explained Robert Collet. A Thoroughbred isn't supposed to get his first Group 1 win at age 10, but there is no script where Yavana's Pace is concerned. The veteran has been a consistent performer at this level over the past three years, having finished runner-up in five Group 1 contests. He was within a nose of collecting one in the G1 Preis von Europa at this track in September 2000, a race in which he was also second last year. Since Yavana's Pace took Doncaster's November H. in 1998, he has steadily scaled the heights of the pattern system and improved with age, as he showed when taking the G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris last September. He had looked better than ever in his last two races, when he was third behind Millenary under a three-pound penalty in the G2 Princess of Wales' S. at Newmarket July 9 and second in the G1 WGZ Bank-Deutschland Preis July 28. Here he was taken to the front early, where he was allowed an uncontested lead. Always in control of the tempo, his kick off the final bend proved decisive. He was passed by the filly Salve Regina with a quarter-mile remaining, but battled back bravely against the rail as the filly leaned across slightly while tiring in the closing stages. The gelding gave one last effort to regain the lead with 50 yards remaining before taking young jockey Keith Dalglish to his first Group 1 success. "He just seems to be better this year and the obvious target is the G1 Irish St Leger [The Curragh, Sept. 14], which he has been runner-up in twice," trainer Mark Johnston said. Azeri, coming off four consecutive Grade I victories, was the overwhelming favorite to pick up a fifth straight win and did so with ease. The four-year-old filly was third away from the gate, but took the lead within a matter of strides and never relinquished it, easily holding off the late bid of the field's longest shot Angel Gift for another dominant score. "She's just a terrific mare," said jockey Mike Smith, who has ridden the chestnut in every one of her starts. "I had a ton of horse under me all the way. She broke well and I was going to ease her back, but that hole opened on the rail and I dropped her head and she was up in there. She felt awful good all the way around. I've been lucky enough to ride some really great fillies in my day--champions like Sky Beauty, Heavenly Prize, Ajina--but this mare is right up there. She's as good as any of them and she may be better than any of them. She is special." Added trainer Laura de Seroux, "The beat goes on and let it march on to the Breeders' Cup." Azeri could make her next start in the GI Ruffian H. at Belmont Park Sept. 14 or the GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. at Santa Anita Oct. 2. Which way is de Seroux leaning? "Both of the options are handicaps and weight can be a very determining factor," she said. Azeri's win created a minus show pool of \$130,262. Orientate, winner of the GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland in April, the GIII Aristides H. at Churchill in June and the Smile Sprint H. at Calder in his latest appearance July 13, was looking to remain undefeated in main-track sprints this season. Odds-on to do just that, the dark bay dashed away from the gate to take up his customary position on the front end. Pressured briefly by New York-bred Say Florida Sandy after a half in :45.80, the Gainesway-bred colt opened it up again in the stretch and won as much the best. "I figured the race was over two jumps from the gate," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "He outbroke the field, had his ears up and was relaxed. The first quarter was easy for him." Added trainer D. Wayne Lukas, "He could go :21 and :43 if he's asked. That was almost a Hollywood script for me--we didn't want a tough race, we just wanted to get a good run." He added that Orientate does not have to have the lead to run his best race. "You're going to see this horse sit three or four lengths off the lead if he has to," the Hall of Famer said. "He's very versatile." Looking ahead, he said, "We're going to meet some tough horses, but we're at the top of our game right now. We're looking to the Forego [GI, Saratoga, Sept. 1] and then we may or may not run once more before the Breeders' Cup." Chancellor showed resolution in the finish to ward off the late challenge of Sights on Gold and confirm the form of the G3 Meld S. over this course July 27. Last time out, Chancellor had beaten that rival by a head, but was swamped by the late flourish of the winner Imperial Dancer (GB), who had raced wide in the centre of the track. Previously he had shown tenacity to finish fourth behind Rebelline (Ire) in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup May 26, having beaten Border Arrow (GB) by 1 1/2 lengths in the G3 Gordon Richards S. at Sandown Apr. 27. Here he raced in second early, shadowing Simeon (GB) (Lammtarra) before being asked to stride on past that colt with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining. Although jockey Pat Smullen got to the hindquarters of the winner on Sights on Gold inside the final furlong, Chancellor pulled out more to assert for the score. He may now head for the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 7 before another crack at the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 19, in which he was a disappointing 11th last year. Rainbows For All made all, turning down the challenge of the market leader Yesterday and her better-fancied stable companion Rapid Ransom to retain her unbeaten record. Having sprinted to a low-key Limerick maiden success on her debut June 8, she was passed over by jockey Declan McDonogh here, but it was Wayne Smith who reaped the rewards of that decision with a well-judged ride from the front. Kicked clear of her rivals with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining, she had first run on Rapid Ransom and kept on in determined fashion as that filly threatened inside the final quarter-mile.

With Michael Kinane bringing Yesterday from the rear with a smooth run, the front-runner looked in danger, but her battling spirit came to the fore and she repelled her rival's challenge to assert inside the final furlong.

Trainer Kevin Prendergast, enjoying a double after the impressive success of Walayef in the opening maiden, said, "If there was no pace, the plan was to go on with her and make a steady gallop. She'll probably come back here for the G1 Moyglare Stud S. [Sept. 1] now."

A member and steward of The Jockey Club and trustee emeritus of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association, he ran the 750-acre Sharp Farm in Middletown, Delaware, where he bred his best runners, including GISW Mississippi Mud and GSW and top sire Dixieland Band. "Aside from having an outstanding record as a breeder and an owner, he was an outstanding leader in the industry," his son-in-law, William S. Farish, the U.S. Ambassador to Great Britain and owner of Lane's End in Kentucky, told the *Wilmington News Journal*.
