AWESOME ADIRONDACK

Awesome Humor (Distorted Humor) kept her perfect record intact when she proved too strong for her five rivals in Monday's GII Adirondack S. The dark bay took command straight out of the gate and showed everyone that she was no joke as she cruised through blistering early fractions. Eased down by jockey Pat Day to a

more sensible pace through the second quarter mile, the filly looked like she might run out of steam in the stretch, but according to Day, "she had a little more in the tank." The classy Patrick Biancone-trained filly **Stellar** (Grand Slam) took her shot in the final furlong, but Awesome Humor dug in gamely en route to a comfortable win. "Going to the

lead wasn't by design," said Day, following his third win in this event. "My filly kind of dragged me up to the lead, so I just let her be happy. Coming into the stretch, she was way out of the bridle...waiting for the opposition." The juvenile, who won at first asking by a neck at Keeneland before returning almost three months later to score impressively in the GIII Debutante at Churchill Downs July 6, appears poised to make her Grade I debut in either Saratoga's GI Spinaway S. Aug. 30 or the GI Matron S. at Belmont.

BANKS HILL RETURNS IN MAROIS

Banks Hill (GB) (Danehill) was yesterday confirmed on course for Sunday's G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville. Last year's champion three-year-old filly has failed to build on her highly impressive success in the GI Breeders' Cup Fillies and Mares Turf at Belmont Park in October with two defeats this term. The four-year-old finished third in a pair of Group 1 events this year; the Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 19 and the Prince of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot June 19. Those runs prompted connections to drop her back to a mile for the Marois, over which she took last year's G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. According to Teddy Beckett, racing manager to owner Prince Khalid Abdullah, "The obvious target is a repeat win in that race at Arlington [BC Filly & Mare Turf, Oct. 26]. She has taken a while to come to herself, but she is in good form now."

Less than a year after an Overbrook Farm-bred filly came on the market at Keeneland's September Sale, I am busily looking for an obvious explanation for this Capote filly's position in the catalogue. Tucked away as hip no. 3381 on the 10th day of the sale, when the average price was less than \$15,000, the Overbrook filly boasted a female line worthy of the sale's premier sessions.

Here was a youngster whose third dam was Square Angel, a champion Canadian three-year-old who enjoyed tremendous success as a broodmare. Although Square Angel produced only five daughters, they included Kamar (Canadian Oaks), Stellarette (GIII Barbara Fritchie H.), Love Smitten (GI Apple Blossom H.) and Dancing On A Cloud (Beverly D. S.) and three of these stakes winners bred one or more Grade I winners.

The Hermitage Farm dispersal back in 1987 provided a measure of this family's rising status, with Kamar--already the dam of two Graded winners--realising \$2,600,000 and Stellarette--virtually unproven as a broodmare at that stage--making \$800,000.

Since then the family's fortunes have continued to soar, to the extent that this female line must now rank among the successful and fashionable lines in America.

A tough act to follow.....

Kamar needs a catalogue page virtually to herself. Her Slew o'Gold filly Gorgeous became a triple Grade I winner and her Seattle Slew filly Seaside Attraction--who sold for more than \$1,000,000 as a weanling in 1987--won the Kentucky Oaks prior to producing two Grade I winners and a pair of Grade III winners from a tragically small total of five foals. No fewer than six of Kamar's daughters have bred stakes winners, with Jood adding another gem to the family's glittering crown in the shape of Fantastic Light, a Grade I winner in the U.S., Hong Kong, England and Ireland.

Remarkably, Kamar's sister Love Smitten produced a middle-distance performer of similar calibre to Fantastic Light in Swain, who so nearly added the Dubai World Cup and the Breeders' Cup Classic to his three Grade 1 wins on turf.

Unfortunately, Stellarette had only six foals, but three of them have made their mark. Nuryette, her unraced daughter by Nureyev, produced the dual Grade II winner Northern Afleet to Afleet and the Grade I-winning Tap To Music to Pleasant Tap. Then Stellarette produced Cuddles, a Mr. Prospector filly who became a Grade I winner for Overbrook Farm in the Hollywood Starlet S. Cuddles' Storm Cat filly Katz Me If You Can has kept up the good work for Overbrook, notably taking last year's GII Genuine Risk H.

Stellarette's final foal, the Nijinsky II filly Augusta Springs, also did well for W.T. Young, winning three of her five starts as well as taking third place in a stakes race at Keeneland. With her combination of outstanding pedigree and respectable performance, Augusta Springs had to be given every chance as a broodmare. The most obvious route for this daughter of the big, stamina-packed Nijinsky II was the Mr. Prospector male line and Augusta Springs' first three mates were Mr. Prospector and his sons Woodman and Seeking the Gold. Surprisingly, none of these matings lived up to expectations, even though Mr. Prospector and his sons have sired Cuddles, Golden Attraction, Red Carnival, Cape Canaveral, Cape Town and Northern Afleet from the Square Angel family.

Aratama Indy, who was lightly raced prior to his four-year-old campaign with only one win in three starts, notched two wins in 11 efforts last year. The patiently handled chestnut was 0-2 this year before taking his last outing in July, and he parlayed that victory into his first graded-stakes success here. Off well in second, he waited until the stretch drive to launch his bid, taking control in the final stages for the sharp 3/4-length score.

A different approach was tried in 1999, when Augusta Springs was sent to Capote. As a son of Seattle Slew, Capote represented the male line responsible for siring the outstanding fillies Gorgeous and Seaside Attraction from this family. However, the resultant filly was considered surplus to Overbrook's requirements and only \$40,000 was required to buy her last September.

As I don't rank among Capote's greatest admirers, I was tempted to attribute the filly's lack of appeal to her sire, who hadn't had a single graded stakes winner to his credit in either 2000 or 2001. This theory doesn't hold water, though, because other yearlings by Capote achieved such good prices as \$575,000, \$275,000, \$250,000 and \$200,000 in 2001.

In these circumstances, one can only assume that the Capote filly's lack of appeal stemmed from some fault in her conformation. This hypothesis gained some support when she reappeared in March as hip no. 138 at Barretts, where she was bought back for \$70,000. However, if she does have a fault, it wasn't bad enough to prevent the experienced trainer Mel Stute from falling for her at the Barretts sale. He reportedly offered slightly more than \$70,000 for her in a private deal and the filly--Buffythecenterfold--has thoroughly vindicated her trainer's assessment. Three runs have resulted in three wins for this fast filly, with has now added the GII Sorrento S. to her victory in the GIII Landaluce S. Despite the speed which has been the hallmark of her career so far, Buffythecenterfold has a pedigree which suggests she'll stay a mile, so she may yet justify the comparisons Stute has made with his Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner, Brave Raj.

What must she be worth now, as a dual Graded winner with a pedigree similar to those of Seaside Attraction and Gorgeous?

SOLID OPENER FOR DEL MAR AUCTION

Sunday's opening session of the Del Mar Yearling Sale at the Del Mar HorsePark was highlighted by the \$250,000 purchase of a filly by Unbridled's Song. The Cal-bred yearling is out of the mare Running Redhead (Storm Bird) and is a half sister to graded stakes winner Lethal Instrument (Gulch). She was consigned by breeder Tommy Town Thoroughbreds and was purchased by NW Management, agent for Sunland Park owner Stan Fulton. With 51 yearlings sold, the first-night average was \$47,676--down 9.9 percent from a year ago. The median was \$40,000. "We are extremely pleased with the results of the first night," said Doug Burge, general manager of California Thoroughbred Breeders Association Sales. "The average dipped about 10 percent from [last year's] opening session. However, this year's catalogue is better balanced between the two sessions and we're optimistic when we assess the entire sale it will be on par with last year." The sale concluded last night and complete results will appear in tomorrow's *TDN*.

Held over a three-day period, from Aug. 9-11, the pool left the result of the three races, the Breeders' Cup Turf, Mile and Filly and Mare Turf, up in the air as the field was made favorite in all three events. Among the top picks for this year's turf events:

GODOLPHIN WAIT ON SAKHEE DECISION After Sakhee's (USA) (Bahri {USA}) shocking defeat in Saturday's G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron at Deauville, Godolphin are leaving a decision on the five-year-old's future until he has worked over the next two weeks. "He got back to the yard this morning and preliminary inspections show that he's the same as he always is after his races and everything seems fine," racing manager Simon Crisford told the *Racing Post* on Sunday. Sakhee's connections hope he follows the workmanlike return to action he displayed last year when winning the Listed Steventon S. at Newbury in July before his spectacular performances in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York the following month and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in October. "The important thing is to remember that from Newbury to York last season, he made significant progress, and the question is, are we going to see any progress now?" Crisford added. "We'll have to see if this rhythm and momentum is going to kick in during the next couple of weeks; if not, we'll have to talk to Sheikh Hamdan and see what he would like to do." Sakhee was lengthened to 8-1 for the Longchamp autumn showpiece by Coral Eurobet after he was defeated by Wellbeing (GB) in Saturday's contest. "We expected him to win, and it was disappointing that he didn't. It was a below-par effort compared to what he did last season," Crisford continued. "He traveled well enough throughout the race, but when Richard [Hills] asked him to extend, the acceleration was not there. He probably beat Sydenham here as far as he did in his work-out at Sandown, and fitness was not an issue." Future training of last year's International Classifications highweight will depend on the horse's knees according to Crisford, "Sakhee has a history of knee problems and has to be handled extremely carefully."

Burning Sun (USA) (Danzig {USA}) yesterday headed a competitive field of 13 left in Thursday's G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville. Having taken the Listed Hampton Court S. at Royal Ascot June 20, the Henry Cecil-trained three-year-old beat subsequent Group 1 scorer Kaieteur (USA) by 3/4 length in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte July 14. Teddy Beckett, racing manager to owner Prince Khalid Abdullah, commented yesterday, "He's in good form and worked well on Saturday. His form keeps working out very well as the horse he beat at Ascot has won since and Kaieteur won a Group 1. It is drying, and he goes well on a softer surface, but he wouldn't want it too soft. We'll keep him to a mile or a mile and a quarter for the moment." He looks set for a stiff task in giving five pounds to opposition, including the Andre Fabre-trained **Bernebeau (Fr)** (Green Tune {USA}), winner of the G3 Prix Daphnis at Maisons-Laffitte July 28. **Guys and Dolls (GB)** (Efisio {GB}), who was runner-up in that contest before being demoted to fifth place, re-opposes on four pounds better terms in Thursday's 10-furlong contest. Also engaged are the Marcus Tregoning-trained **Highdown (Ire)** (Selkirk {USA}), the impressive Listed Steventon S. winner at Newbury July 20, Godolphin's **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) and the Andre Fabre-trained **Shaanmer (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), runner-up in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris June 23.
