SOMETHING SPECIAL

Michael Tabor's **Zavata** (Phone Trick) stalked the pace from the outside and took over entering the stretch en route to an easy 7 1/4-length victory in yesterday's GII Saratoga Special S. at the Spa. Second as a maiden in the Three Chimneys Juvenile on Kentucky Derby day, the handsome bay added a convincing 6 1/4-length win in the GIII Tremont S. downstate June

29 and was odds-on to make it consecutive stakes wins. Close to the early pace while wide, jockey Jerry Bailey hit the accelerator with two furlongs to run and Zavata kicked in, sprinting away to post yet another daylight success. "He was caught a bit wide," commented winning trainer Patrick Biancone. "He is so much better than the other ones. He

is just a galloping machine." Biancone indicated that the winner is likely to remain at sprint distances and contest the GI Hopeful S. over seven furlongs Aug. 31.

SUNDAY SILENCE'S CONDITION WORSENS

Kentucky Derby winner and champion Japanese sire **Sunday Silence** (Halo) has taken a turn for the worse. The 16-year-old stallion, who underwent three operations after developing bacterial peritendinitis in his right foreleg, seemed to be improving after the latest of the surgeries July 18. But he began showing signs of laminitis in left foreleg last week and it now appears he is foundering in his hind legs as well. Eisuke Tokutake, a spokesman for Shadai Stallion Station, where Sunday Silence has stood his entire career, told AP, "He seemed to be making a miraculous recovery. We were a little worried about laminitis, but there was no sign of it and we thought luck was on our side." He added, "He's in quite a bit of pain now. If it gets much worse, [euthanization] will be our only option." Added Arthur Hancock, who bred and raced Sunday Silence in partnership with Ernest Galliard, "I understand it's a tough go, but he's a fighter of the highest degree. I know it's not good, but he has always had an indomitable spirit."

WHO'S WORTH A MILLION?

A field of nine was drawn yesterday for Saturday's GI Arlington Million, the centerpiece of the International Festival of Racing, which also includes the GI Beverly D. and GI Secretariat S. Juddmonte Farms, which sent out Chester House to win this event in 2000, sends out the 6-5 morning-line favorite **Beat Hollow (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). The five-year-old, a Group 1 winner in France at three, has arrived on the scene this year with Grade I successes in the Woodford Reserve Turf Classic and Manhattan H., but his two defeats this season have come at the hands of **Sarafan** (Lear Fan), second choice at 3-1. The bay gelding got the better of the Bobby Frankel-trainee first in the GII Explosive Bid H. Mar. 24 and most recently in the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar July 28. **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}) will attempt to give his connections a second straight Million, following on the success of Silvano (Ger) a year ago. The 10-1 chance, second in the GI Canadian International in 2001, comes into the race off a disappointing eighth to Grandera in the G1 Prince of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot June 19. Burning Sun has a progressive profile, having stepped up from maiden company to take the Listed Hampton Court S. at Royal Ascot June 20 before beating subsequent Group 1 scorer Kaieteur by 3/4 of a length in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte July 14. Nevertheless, he faces a stiff task conceding five pounds to some above-average opponents in a strong-looking renewal here. He was beaten a neck by **Nysaeen** in a Windsor maiden over this trip Apr. 29, while **Highdown** was defeated only 3 1/2 lengths by Burning Sun when handing him five pounds at the Royal meeting. Nysaeen has subsequently finished third behind High Chaparral (Ire) in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 30 before returning to easily dispose of his rivals in Sunday's Listed Prix Ridgway over course and distance. Highdown went on to beat Foreign Affairs (GB) by four lengths in the Listed Steventon S. at Newbury July 20, showing fine acceleration there.

FREEDOM'S DAUGHTER DIES Freedom's Daughter (Saint Ballado), winner of the GII Schuylerville S. July 24, died early Monday morning, *The Blood-Horse* reports. The two-year-old developed a fever Saturday evening. She appeared to respond to medication, but her temperature was up again by noon Sunday and she was sent to an equine clinic near Saratoga. Dr. Bill Barnes, the supervising veterinarian, started treatment and the results were initially favorable, but the filly's condition began to deteriorate at midnight and she died at around 2 a.m. Monday. The early diagnosis was Colitis X. "It took her by storm," trainer Todd Pletcher told *The Blood-Horse*. "I thought we were being extremely cautious when we took her to the clinic. But that's why they call it Colitis X--they don't know what causes it or how to stop it." It has been a tough few days for Pletcher, who had to send MGISW Left Bank to Tufts University equine clinic for emergency colic surgery Saturday. Freedom's Daughter, purchased by Padua Stables for \$525,000 as a Saratoga yearling, had won both of her career starts, breaking her maiden by 7 1/4 lengths at Monmouth Park June 22 before her 1 1/4-length score in the Schuylerville. She earned \$109,200.

WAR EMBLEM WORKS WELL FOR CLASSIC

Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) breezed a half mile yesterday morning in :48 4/5 at Del Mar and remains on track for his next start in the GI Pacific Classic Aug. 25. "It was just what the doctor ordered," said a quietly confident trainer Bob Baffert. "If we're going to run, we're leaning towards running here [at Del Mar]. What's important now is we keep him sound and healthy. He looked good this morning." Baffert caught War Emblem galloping out five-eighths in 1:00 4/5. In his first start since finishing eighth in the June 8 Belmont S., the dark bay colt traveled to Monmouth Park to record an easy, 3 1/2-length victory in the Aug. 4 GI Haskell H.

Consistent Like A Hero Gets Taste of Spa:

Only once out of the top three in his seven career trips to the post, **Like A Hero** (Pleasant Colony) looks to continue the trend when he goes postward in Saratoga's GI Travers S. Aug. 24. The dark bay was out for work over the Saratoga main track yesterday morning, going a leisurely half mile in :54. "He just needed to stretch his legs," commented trainer Beau Greely. "My exercise rider was delighted with the way he went. He doesn't need much at this point. He came out of the Haskell great and has really taken to training in Saratoga great." Like A Hero has run into a pair of monsters in his last two, finishing second to Came Home in the July 14 GI Swaps S. at Hollywood Park and most recently third to War Emblem in the GI Haskell H. Aug. 4.

Owned and bred by Joseph Shields, **Puzzlement**, second earlier this year in the GI Peter Pan S., was the winner of a local allowance test July 24.

NYRA Trustees Approve 2003 Schedule:

The Board of Trustees of the New York Racing Association has approved a 36-day Saratoga meeting for 2003 to run from Wednesday, July 23 through Labor Day, Monday, Sept. 1. The schedule mirrors the racing dates since 1997, when the season was extended to six weeks.

Gryder a New Papa:

Jockey Aaron Gryder became a father for the second time early Tuesday morning when his wife Karen gave birth to an eight pound, three ounce baby girl, which the couple has named Grace Noelle. Both mother and daughter are doing well and are expected to leave Long Island Jewish Hospital on Thursday. Gryder expects to be back at Saratoga this afternoon in time for the day's racing.

Surgery for Clearly A Queen:

Clearly A Queen (Lucky North), winner of the Gill Matchmaker S. and the Gill Eatontown H. at Monmouth Park this summer, underwent surgery to repair a fractured sesamoid at an equine clinic in New Jersey Monday. The five-year-old mare was injured during the Aug. 4 Eatontown. "Dr. Beth Hogan did the surgery, and the mare came out of it very well," trainer Terri Pompay said. "They removed a piece of the sesamoid. She'll have stall rest for four weeks and then walk for three weeks, and then she should be ready to go back into training. If everything goes well, she could be back racing this winter in Florida." A winner in nine of her 28 career starts, Clearly A Queen has earned \$479,532.

Edward Hand Dies:

Edward J. Hand, a veteran of 50 years in the Thoroughbred business, passed away yesterday morning following a long illness. An original founder of the Ryder Truck Company, Hand campaigned several stakes winners including **Varick** (Mr. Prospector), winner of a division of the Oceanside S. in 1986; and **Controlled** (In Excess {Ire}), a four-time stakes winner in California-bred company and third in the GII Santa Ynez S. in 1999. Hand's operation was represented yesterday at Del Mar by two-year-old first-time starter **Excessive Barb** (In Excess {Ire}), who broke his maiden in the second race.

Inamorato Sidelined With Virus:

Inamorato (Tale of the Cat), an impressive maiden winner at Hollywood Park July 6, has been sidelined by a virus and has been removed from consideration for the GIII Best Pal S. Aug. 21. "He won't make the Best Pal and if he can't make the Best Pal, I don't see how he can make the [GII Del Mar] Futurity," said Eoin Harty, who conditions the dark bay for Godolphin. Noting that several of his two-year-olds have been bothered by the same ailment, he said, "Basically we are out of commission here."
