DEAUVILLE AUGUST GETS UNDERWAY

Deauville stages the opening salvo of the 2002 yearling sales season in Europe when it begins auctioning after racing at 5:30 p.m. today. There are 593 yearlings on offer over the five days, with 27 percent of them out of black-type mares and 31 percent out of mares that have produced black-type performers. Agence Francaise will be hoping that the guarded approach stateside is left behind this week. In recent years, the sale has been a commanding success, with the gross up by 133 percent and the average by 114 percent since 1996. Last year's average, which was a record, was the seventh consecutive increase since 1995. With the added incentives of premiums on racecourses to French-bred horses--this year's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club winner Sulamani (Ire) has earned €433,000 in premiums in addition to €663,000 in total prize money--this sale will prove a reliable barometer of the current climate.

The Major Players...

Major consignors include Haras d'Etreham, with a draft of 68 yearlings; Haras des Capucines with 54; Haras de La Rebourriere et de Montaigu, who will consign 37; and Haras du Mezeray with 33. Leading sires represented include Anabaa (GB), Highest Honor (Fr) and Linamix (Fr) with 13 lots; Sadler's Wells with 10; Danehill, Grand Lodge, Machiavellian, Mark of Esteem (Ire) and Zafonic with six; and Indian Ridge (Ire) and Woodman with five apiece. Debutant stallions include Fasliyev (Nureyev), who has a representation of 15 lots; Croco Rouge (Ire) (Rainbow Quest) and Orpen (Lure) with nine; and Stravinsky (Nureyev) with seven. Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) has two catalogued, while Charismatic (Summer Squall) has a sole entry.

BEAT HOLLOW OUT FOR REVENGE

This year's renewal of the GI Arlington Million features another global cast--four of the nine runners are from overseas--but the focus this time is squarely on the American contingent. Considered by many to be the top turf horse in the U.S., **Beat Hollow (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) has suffered two defeats at the hands of **Sarafan**

(Lear Fan) and will be hoping that the third time will indeed be the charm. The blaze-faced bay returned from an 18-month layoff to take his stateside debut in January before running second to Sarafan in the GI Explosive Bid H. He bounced back to post impressive victories in the GI Woodford Reserve and GI Manhattan H., but couldn't get clear in

time in the GI Eddie Read H. July 28 at Del Mar and was the runner-up to Sarafan. Alex Solis, aboard for all of the five-year-old's previous starts this season, has been replaced by Jerry Bailey. Juddmonte, Bobby Frankel and Bailey teamed up to take the 2000 GI Arlington Million with Chester House and the triumvirate will be tough in this spot. "He has more tactical speed," said Frankel when asked to compare the two. "In fact, I think Beat Hollow is probably going to be in front in this race. As for the jockey switch for the Million, that was the owner's decision." Sarafan, reunited with Corey Nakatani in the Eddie Read, picks up nine pounds off that victory and will have to have his run timed perfectly. Beat Hollow may have company on the front end from **Forbidden Apple** (Pleasant Colony), who wired the field in last year's GI Manhattan H. and comes off a heartbreaking third, beaten a neck in the GI Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga July 26. Trainer Andreas Wohler captured the Million last year with Silvano and is back with **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}), a MG1SW in Italy. The big chestnut finished a fine second to Grandera (Ire) in the G1 Singapore Airlines Int'l Cup in May, but could only manage an eighth to that rival in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. after a troubled trip June 19 at Royal Ascot. **Field for the Million, p2**

Bidding to become the first ex-hurdler to win the Million, **Ulundi (GB)** (Rainbow Quest) has been pointing for Chicago since winning a rich handicap at Royal Ascot June 21. The seven-year-old bay is at his best over firm conditions, but has never faced this class on the flat. Illinois-bred **Mystery Giver** will attempt to be a hometown hero. The four-year-old sports a 7-4-2-0 record over the Arlington course and was 13th, beaten 5 3/4 lengths in Sarafan's Explosive Bid. "We were dead stopped in that race," said trainer Chris Block. "I'm not saying he would have won that day, but he would have been a lot closer. So given that race, and being on our home track and the million-dollar purse, that's why we're running."

The 122nd running of the Alabama has come up with a star-studded field, with the heroines of the GI Kentucky Oaks, the GI Acorn, the GI Mother Goose and the GI CCA Oaks facing off with a trio of runners looking to hit the big time. In the latter group is **Bella Bellucci**, who has victories in the GII Astoria Breeders' Cup H. and the GIII Comely under her belt, but no Grade I title just yet. Forced to miss the Kentucky Oaks with a bad blood count, the grey never got untracked in **You's** stakes-record setting performance in the Acorn June 7 and wound up third. "That's a throw-out race," said trainer Neil Drysdale. "She didn't handle the track and that's probably what led to her pulling a muscle." The \$925,000 FTFEB juvenile purchase came back July 19 to annihilate older allowance foes by 11 3/4 lengths. "I was very happy with her last race and she's maintained her form nicely," Drysdale added. **Farda Amiga** came rolling on the outside to upset the GI Kentucky Oaks May 3 at 20-1, leaving Take Charge Lady, Habibt and You in her wake. The bay got sick after that effort and hasn't seen afternoon action since, but has been training well in recent weeks and is well-suited in terms of pedigree (by Broad Brush out of a Pleasant Colony mare) for today's 10-furlong distance. "There was a problem with her white blood count," explained trainer Paulo Lobo. "We decided to give her a rest for a month and train her up to the Alabama." You posted a gut-wrenching victory in the GI Test S. going seven panels July 27 and is unbeaten in two starts at the Spa. Her best shot to see out today's distance will be to make an easy lead, but she will likely have company in the form of **Allamerican Bertie**, who posted a wire-to-wire, 6 1/4-length score in the GIII Delaware Oaks July 20. **Nonsuch Bay**, winner of the GI Mother Goose S. June 29, and **Jilbab**, who overcame a serious stumble to take the GI CCA Oaks July 20, also pose threats.

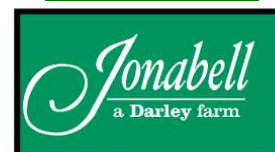

Astra shipped in to Chicago for last year's Beverly D. with a glowing reputation, but floundered over the yielding going, running a distant ninth to **England's Legend** as the 3-5 favorite. She missed the rest of the year with a foot abscess, but has come back with a vengeance in 2002. After starting the year off with a third to **Golden Apples** in the GII Santa Ana H., the six-year-old bay has rattled off impressive wins in the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 20, the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. May 27 and the GI Beverly Hills H. June 29. "Astra loves a target," said trainer Laura de Seroux. "It doesn't really matter how close she is early because she has high tracking speed and then caps it off with an amazing turn of foot at the end." Golden Apples has also displayed nifty acceleration. She got caught in traffic when second to Astra in the Santa Barbara, then missed some time with a throat abscess. The four-year-old came flying late in her comeback effort, the GI John C. Mabee/Ramona H. July 27, missing by a neck to Affluent. England's Legend turned in a front-running tour-de-force one year ago, but disappointed as the favorite in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf, finishing 11th. The five-year-old returned to action with another wire-to-wire victory over this course, the GIII Modesty H. July 27, and will try to repeat that effort. Globetrotting **Golden Silca** makes her first foray to North America. The six-year-old hasn't visited the winner's circle since taking the GIII Desmond S. at The Curragh two years ago, but has finished fourth in the last two runnings of the G1 Dubai Duty Free and ran second in the G2 Falmouth S. two back July 10.

Orchard Park has won six of his last seven starts, including victories in the GIII Palm Beach S. and the GIII Jefferson Cup over subsequent GSWs Mr. Mellon and Quest Star. The homebred chestnut successfully negotiated 10 furlongs last out in the Virginia Derby July 13 and is a deserving favorite. "He's turned into a good horse for us," said Ralph Nicks, assistant to trainer Bill Mott. "The difference between him and some of the others we've brought in the past is that he's a little easier to manage in his races. He's pretty much push-button." The late-running **Mananan McLir** finally got a clean trip in the GII American Derby July 21 over this course and came running to deny Jazz Beat by 3/4-length. **Chiselling**, yet another blue-blooded runner from Juddmonte, got up in time to win the GIII Lexington S. over 1 1/4 miles at Belmont July 14.

With a gaggle of recognizable names but no clear star, this one could be up for grabs as they steam towards the Spa's finish line. Patrick Kelly's **Evening Attire** was a sharp second to Macho Uno in the GII Mass. Cap H. at Suffolk in early June, but looked listless when E Dubai lulled the field to sleep in the GII Suburban H. at Belmont July 6, finishing fourth. **El Gran Papa** is coming off a big win against a stakes-quality allowance test over this track July 29--including two starters in this one--and will start from the seven hole for Bobby Frankel. The five-year-old has placed in three graded events and would like to prove he can pull out a win at this level. **Dollar Bill** is another who has something to prove. After returning earlier this spring from a seven-month layoff due to injury, the bay colt has raced with varied success. He looked solid when second to Street Cry (Ire) in the GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill June 15, but came up empty with a fourth in his latest, the GI Hollywood Gold Cup S. July 14.

Beaten as the 2-5 choice to finish second over that course in the Susan's Girl Breeders' Cup S. June 29, she finished second once again in the GIII Delaware Oaks S. July 20. Mubtaker and **High Pitched** go head-to-head in a fascinating contest. The two met last November in the G3 St Simon S. on good-to-soft ground at Newmarket, where it was High Pitched who came out on top, powering away to leave Mubtaker 6 1/4 lengths back in third. However, Mubtaker meets his rival on seven pounds better terms here and has his favoured fast ground, which is sure to compromise the chance of High Pitched. Helped by overnight rain, that colt scored an impressive seven-length success over **Warrsan** in the Listed Grundon S. at Newbury May 18, but he struggled on fast ground when fourth behind Zindabad (Fr) in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 22. Mubtaker was runner-up behind Millenary (GB) in the G2 Princess of Wales' S. at Newmarket July 9, but that was his seasonal debut and he is expected to improve significantly for that run. **Daliapour** appears best of the rest judged on his two-length defeat of Boreas (GB) in the G3 Curragh Cup June 29, in which **Murghem** was fourth.

Horsemen Get Behind Slaughter Prevention Act:

Three major East Coast horsemen's organizations, headed by the New York Racing Association, have come out in support of proposed legislation HR 3781, The American Horse Slaughter Prevention Act. Writing to Hon. Congresswoman Constance A. Morella, the author of the bill, on behalf of the NYRA Board of Trustees, Patrick L. Kehoe said, "The sale and transport of horses for slaughter and human consumption is both inhumane and unconscionable." At its Aug. 8 meeting in Saratoga Springs, the New York State Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund Corporation adopted a resolution to support the bill. Frank Zanzuccki, the executive director of the New Jersey Racing Commission, also wrote Morella to lend the support of the Commission to the legislation. The bill, which was referred to the House subcommittee on livestock and horticulture Feb. 25, has been cosponsored by 56 congressmen and congresswomen.
