INDIAN RIDGE FILLY SETS DEAUVILLE MARK

It didn't take long to break new barriers at Deauville. Hip 12, a filly by Indian Ridge (Ire) from the Haras d'Etream consignment, brought a record €2 million during yesterday's opening session of Agence Francaise's Deauville August Yearling Sale. When the bay, out of Group 1 winner Maximova (Fr) (Green Dancer), walked through the ring, it became evident that bidding would not soon stop. The half-sister to Group 1 winners Septieme Ciel (Seattle Slew) and Macoumba (Mr. Prospector) and graded-stakes winner Maxigroom (Blushing Groom {Fr}) was finally knocked down to Gainsborough Stud of Sheikh Maktoum Al Maktoum, in the process eclipsing the previous Deauville mark of FF9 million set by a daughter of Diesis (GB) out of Allegretta (GB) in 2000. "It's always difficult to evaluate a filly like that," said Marc de Chambure of Haras d'Etream. "She's a very well-bred filly, and if two people like a horse, a record can happen. My appraisal was one million plus; it can go either way, but good horses are going for good money. The rest are just left. People are looking for pedigree and conformation." **Deauville cont. p9**

VIVA AMIGA

It was just a nose back to third-place finisher **Forbidden Apple** (Pleasant Colony), who tried to take them gate to wire and hung on gamely in a blanket finish that saw the first six horses separated by less than a half-length. "The race didn't set up the way I thought it would," said trainer Bobby Frankel, who took the 2000 Million with Juddmonte Farm's Chester House. "I was a little scared of Forbidden Apple on the lead. We thought we'd be in front, but when Forbidden Apple got the lead from the inside so easily, [jockey Jerry Bailey] took him back [and]...he really didn't move on him until the sixteenth pole. A TOUGH BEAT Never worse than third in his 10 career starts, **Beat Hollow (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) disappeared for 19 months after taking the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp. He made his U.S. debut in an optional claimer at Santa Anita Jan. 31, posting a one-length victory, then was beaten a neck by **Sarafan** (Lear Fan) in the Mar. 24 GII Explosive Bid H. He rebounded from that narrow loss to win the May 4 GI Woodford Reserve S. at Churchill and the June 8 GI Manhattan H. at Belmont Park, but fell victim to Sarafan and heavy traffic in his latest, finishing second by 1 1/4 lengths in the July 28 GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar. Odds-on to reverse placings this time, the blaze-faced bay settled in third as **Forbidden Apple** (Pleasant Colony) galloped along through easy fractions, clicking off a half in :50.18 and six furlongs in 1:14.89. The pace picked up with a mile in 1:38.77 and there was a cavalry charge down the stretch, with Beat Hollow getting his white nose down on the wire. "He's a very handy horse--you can put him anywhere in the race that you want," jockey Jerry Bailey said, adding, "He'll be a better horse going a mile than he is at a mile and a quarter. That's about the extent he wants to go, but he tries hard and that's why he was able to gut out the win today." Trainer Bobby Frankel said his charge will be shortening up in the future. "I think he's going to go back to a mile for the Breeders' Cup," he said. "I think he's going to be super going a mile."

Arlington Alibis...

There were excuses for the Million also-rans. "The pace was so slow that I wasn't in a good spot the entire race," said jockey Corey Nakatani aboard late-running runner-up Sarafan. "The pace scenario obviously made the race." **Falcon Flight (Fr)** (Persian Bold {Ire}), fifth, and **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}), sixth, were both trapped behind horses in the stretch. "I had no room," said Rene Douglas on Falcon Flight. "I was hoping to go through everyone--I came out a little bit and took a shot, but there was no room." Jockey Andreas Suborics, aboard Paolini, faced a similar dilemma. "I was making a good run coming into the straight," he said. "The field was so packed, I had no place to run. Sarafan came over on me and...I couldn't move. I couldn't jump over them. Farda Amiga started her career on the turf, but she could be a champion now that she has been switched to the main track. A modest \$45,000 KEESEP yearling, the bay made just two starts last season, breaking her maiden on the grass at Del Mar last September and running fifth in the GIII Miesque S. at Hollywood in November. She kicked off her 2002 campaign with a seventh-place finish in the Jan. 9 Blue Norther S. at Santa Anita, then notched a head victory vs. optional claimers on that course Feb. 9. It was then that trainer Paulo Lobo decided to give the filly a shot on the dirt and she responded with a solid fourth-place finish at 35-1 in the GI Santa Anita Oaks Mar. 9, just two lengths behind You. Her next start was in the May 3 GI Kentucky Oaks at Churchill Downs, where she charged from the middle of the pack for a 1 1/4-length tally over Take Charge Lady. The filly became ill after that race, disappearing for more than three months. "Her problem was that she had a high white count," Lobo said. "She needed a month in her stall. I could only give her five works [before the Alabama]." Farda Amiga was fit enough, however. She broke awkwardly and was near the back of the pack early, but came with a four-wide bid as they raced into the stretch and finished with determination to beat front-running Allamerican Bertie in the final strides. You, the 8-5 favorite, pressed the pace and weakened late to be third. Group placed during an abbreviated European campaign, Golden Apples opened her American stint with an upset win at 20-1 in the GI Del Mar Oaks a year ago. Never off the board since shipping stateside, the bay also accounted for the GII Las Palmas H. at Santa Anita in November and, after a four-month break, the Mar. 23 GII Santa Ana H. over that course. The Irish-bred had been second in her last two, finishing two lengths behind Astra in the Apr. 20 GII Santa Barbara H. and a neck behind Affluent in the July 27 GI Ramona H. Sent off the second choice behind Astra here, she was off a step slowly, then settled along the inside while rating off the pace. Golden Apples angled three wide as they rolled out of the turn, closed on pacesetting England's Legend at the top of the lane, took the lead at the sixteenth pole and had enough left to turn the tables on Astra at the wire. "She's been very unlucky in quite a few races since she got here," trainer Ben Cecil said. "I was confident that we got a nice race into her in the Ramona and she was a little unlucky not to win that. She's come along since that race and I think there's more improvement in her. I've always thought we had the best grass filly in the country and now she's proved it." The winner could go next in the Oct. 5 GI Yellow Ribbon S. at Santa Anita before heading to the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf at Arlington Oct. 26. Chiselling's late surge gave Juddmonte their second Grade I victory of the afternoon at Arlington and, perhaps more significantly, elevated his star dam Toussaud into elite status as a the producer of three individual Grade I winners. After breaking his maiden in his fourth start at Hollywood, the bay colt missed by a head to the talented Rock Opera in a June 15 allowance and headed east to make his stakes debut in the GIII Lexington S. July 14. Despite being reluctant to load that day, Chiselling finished determinedly under Jerry Bailey to get a nose victory in that Belmont test. With that rider opting for 7-5 favorite Orchard Park (Hennessy), the Juddmonte homebred was reunited with Kent Desormeaux, his rider in California. He settled into stride near the back of the pack after getting caught in traffic on the first turn, but came rolling six wide as the field hit the stretch. Irish invader Jazz Beat held a three-length lead at the eighth pole, but Chiselling came flying down the center of the course to claim victory in the shadow of the wire. Chiselling's three-quarters brother Civilisation (Gone West) is the only one of Toussaud's offspring to not win a graded stakes. The complexion of the Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. was changed when the speedy Gander (Cormorant) stumbled badly at the start and tossed jockey Mike Smith, but Evening Attire came rolling by the field--and the loose horse--late for the score. "I wasn't concerned about Gander in the stretch as much as I was going into the first turn," remarked trainer Pat Kelly. "He was right alongside of us and the reins were dangling." Evening Attire took back as Abreeze opened up a clear lead, then advanced with a three-wide move on the far turn. The riderless Gander softened up Abreeze and Evening Attire took advantage of the situation, cruising up to take charge inside the final sixteenth to earn his fourth graded stakes. After defeating Street Cry (Ire) in the GIII Discovery H. on Halloween at 65-1, Evening Attire added victories in the GIII Queens County H. and the GIII Aqueduct H. The grey colt disappointed when fourth in the GIII Excelsior H. Apr. 6, but bounced back to romp by 10 lengths in an Aqueduct allowance May 2 before running second to Macho Uno in the GII MassCap June 1. His closing kick was compromised by the poky pace set by winner E Dubai in his initial try at 10 furlongs in the GII Suburban H. July 6, but he handled the trip this time. "The mile and a quarter was a big factor today--and there is a race a couple of months from now at a mile and a quarter in Chicago [GI Breeders' Cup Classic, Oct. 26]," Kelly said. Yesterday was not jockey Chuck Lopez' day. His run of bad luck started when he clipped heels while launching his bid aboard 5-2 Szep in the seventh race at Monmouth and fell. Lopez had to be taken to Monmouth Medical Center for X-rays after apparently injuring his tailbone, thereby missing the mount on Magic Storm here. And, sent off the longest shot on the board, Magic Storm drove between horses in the final yards to win the Oaks by a half-length over favorite Alternate. Jockey Eddie King Jr. earned the mount on the filly at the 11th hour. "What a pick-up mount," said King, who was undaunted by his odds in the Oaks. "I've ridden for [trainer D. Wayne Lukas] before and I know that you're never out of it until you hit the wire." Third in the GII Adirondack S. and GI Spinaway S. at two, Magic Storm came back after a 9 1/2-month absence to win an allowance race on the turf at Churchill Downs in June. She finished fifth in an allowance on the Churchill main track July 7, and was coming off a distant third-place effort in an allowance over a sloppy Saratoga strip Aug. 2. King settled the dark bay in third and she drifted back to fourth as they raced into the stretch, but found another gear in the final furlong, bursting between horses late and outfinishing Alternate for the win. "It was an impressive race," said Peter Hutton, Lukas' assistant at Monmouth. "Eddie said she still hasn't quite figured it all out yet--she's still green. But when the gap opened between horses, he hit her left-handed and she took off." Magic Storm gave Lukas his fourth Monmouth Oaks victory. On the board in all 12 of his previous starts including three Listed race wins last year, Mubtaker was looking to improve on his second-place effort in the G2 Prince Of Wales's S. at Newmarket July 9. He did so in impressive fashion to record his first group win. The winner raced keenly in rear early as old stager Persian Punch set a good pace. Jockey Richard Hills eased Mubtaker onto the heels of the leaders at the three-furlong pole; the partnership challenged on the bridle at the quarter-mile marker and settled the issue when accelerating to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. "He's obviously got a lot of ability and he is a very versatile horse," winning trainer Marcus Tregoning told *PA Sport*. "He is in the G1 Irish St Leger [Sept. 14], but I think he is capable of winning a big race over a mile and a half and, from a commercial point of view as a stallion prospect, that may be the option we look for." Umistim, second for most of the journey, tried to keep tabs with Reel Buddy, but allowed his stablemate two-lengths grace with 150 yards remaining and the winner needed no second bidding, running on resolutely in the latter stages to hold off the rallying Umistim. Winning trainer Richard Hannon told *PA Sport*, "It's a shame one had to get beat, but Reel Buddy should have won a couple of group races before now, only for things to go wrong. Richard might have got there a bit soon, but when I saw the pocket he was in I thought he would need a tin-opener to get out. I feel a bit sorry for Umistim. Twelve months ago, this race was marred by testing ground and a moderate pace set by the eventual winner Proudswings (Ger). **Banks Hill** struggled to make an impact that day, finishing 1 1/4 lengths back in third before being promoted to second upon the disqualification of the German mare. She fared little better when third next time in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp in September, but was upped in trip for the GI Breeders' Cup Fillies and Mares Turf at Belmont in October and turned the 10-furlong contest into a procession. That performance led connections to try the extended nine furlongs of the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 19 on her return this term. She was beaten 1 1/2 lengths into third by the enterprisingly ridden **Best Of The Bests** there, then found the 10 furlongs of the G1 Prince of Wales's S. beyond her when third behind Grandera (Ire) at Royal Ascot June 19. Brought back to her ideal European distance here, she has strong claims of becoming the fourth filly to win this since 1993. If lack of tempo serves to undermine her again, it could be left to the three-year-olds, headed by **Medecis**, to take advantage. Having finished a neck runner-up to **Bowman** in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau at Longchamp Apr. 14, he was a fast-finishing length behind Landseer (GB) in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains back at that track May 12, reversing form with the third-placed Bowman. He was the fluent winner of the G3 Prix de la Jonchere at Chantilly June 17 last time and bids to become the seventh sophomore to win this since 1993. **Tashawak** took the competitive Listed Sandringham S. at Royal Ascot June 22 before annihilating the opposition with her tactical speed when winning the G2 Falmouth S. at Newmarket July 10. That was the race captured by Proudswings last year; Tashawak will bid to extend the fine record of three-year-old fillies in this.

Millionaire **Include**, a winner in 10 of his 18 career starts, draws jockey Jerry Bailey down from the Spa for this race. Bailey rode the bay to victories in the GII New Orleans H., GI Pimlico Special and the GII MassCap last year, and was also in the saddle when the Robert Meyerhoff homebred finished third in the GII Suburban H. and GII Meadowlands Cup. Sans Bailey, **Include** was seventh after an inside trip in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, but rebounded to be second by a neck in his 2001 finale, the Nov. 23 GII Clark H. He romped home by nine lengths in his 2002 debut, the Apr. 20 Jennings H., but has been out just once since, running third in this year's edition of the MassCap June 1 with Bailey back at the reins. "He came out of that race with mucus in his lungs," trainer Bud Delp said. "It's not unusual for horses to have that this time of year. We gave him some time and got that cleared up with antibiotics." Delp plans another tilt at the Breeders' Cup this year, with the GI Woodward S. at Belmont Sept. 7 next on the agenda. **Bowman's Band**, first or second in eight of his 10 starts, was fifth when trapped inside on a sloppy track in the June 15 GII Brooklyn H., but came back to win the July 20 R.M.M. Carpenter Jr. Memorial S. at Delaware Park in handy fashion. "I was very pleased with the way he ran," trainer Michael Matz said. "We changed some of his equipment for that race --we added a tongue tie and changed his noseband and he ran a really big race. I'm not sure if the changes helped, or if it was the lesser competition. Only he can tell us that. But he ran fast enough [at Delaware] to earn a chance in the Iselin."

MIXED FIGURES AT DEAUVILLE DAY 1 Following disappointing sales at Keeneland in July and at Saratoga last week, there was reason to fear an equivalent trend at Deauville, and the gross on opening day was down 19 percent. But the average remained stable, dropping only 2 percent from 2001. The percentage of horses sold dropped from 79.69 percent last year to 65.15 percent for this first day. The market for well-bred fillies was strongest, with fillies registering the top eight prices of the sale. The top colt, Hip 34, a half-brother to this year Group 3 winner Bernebeau (Fr) by Green Desert consigned by Pegasus Farms, was purchased for €300,000 by Peter Doyle Bloodstock. The Deauville market, as usual, was international. In addition to Sheikh Maktoum Al Maktoum, buyers included his brother Hamdan, who bought two; Teruya Yoshida's Shadai Farm, which bought one; and American Bertram Firestone, who secured a nicely bred Fasliyev filly. Peter Doyle Bloodstock was very active, along with Charles Gordon Watson, the BBA and BBA Ireland. French buyers proved more active than usual on the first day, with Chantilly Bloodstock Agency securing four lots, the Wertheimer brothers taking two and Horse France, French Bloodstock Agency and French trainers also spending. The sale resumes today after the last race, at approximately 5:30 p.m.

What They're Saying At The Sales...

Philippe Augier, president and general manager of the Agence Francaise:

"The market is very, very selective and, with the number of horses sold dropping down, the gross had to drop. The encouraging sign is that the average has remained quite at the same level as last year. We have to wait until the next days to see what the trend will really be. It is too early to draw conclusions."
