BANKS WINS ONE FOR THE HOME TEAM

Banks Hill (GB) (Danehill) swept from the rear to lead with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before stretching away to beat **Domedriver (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) by 1 1/2 lengths as the 19-10 favourite in yesterday's G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville. In doing so, she was capturing her first Group 1 prize in her native country to add to her successes in last year's G1 Coronation S. at Royal

Ascot in June and GI Breeders' Cup Fillies and Mares Turf at Belmont in October. That race is where she is headed again according to Teddy Beckett, racing manager to owner Prince Khalid Abdullah. "Banks Hill has really blossomed in the last two months and today she had the good to firm ground that

SLOWER SESSION AT DEAUVILLE

Sunday's second session of the L'Agence Francaise Yearling Sale at Deauville lacked the energy and seven-figure horse of Saturday's opener and returns were down for a second consecutive day. Although the percentage of horses sold (75 percent) was much better than on the opening day matched the figure from last year, the session gross was down by 35 percent at €7,640,000 and the average price dropped 37 percent to €149,804. For the first two days of the sale, the gross is down 27 percent at €16,412,000 and the average off by 22 percent versus 2001 at €174,596. The market remains very selective and international. Most of Saturday's top buyers were again very active, but the day saw the arrival on the market of agent Demi O'Byrne, acting for Coolmore, who secured the joint top lot on the day at €600,000. Cataloged as hip 135 and consigned by Haras du Mezeray, the bay filly is by Sadler's Wells out of Irish Order (Irish River {Fr}), making the Jan. 30 foal a three-parts sister to G1 English 2000 Guineas winner Entrepreneur (GB). O'Byrne indicated that his purchase would go to Ballydoyle in Ireland to be prepared for his racing career. Commenting on the activity thus far at the sale, Mezeray's Charles Henri de Moussac said, "I think it is a very selective sale. There is a lot of money for a few good horses, but they have to be well received. They have to have the pedigree and the conformation and the vet work." O'Byrne remained active at the top of Sunday's action, going to €540,000 for hip 75, a Danehill colt out of Al Galop (Affirmed), herself a half sister to multiple Grade I winner Both Ends Burning. Peter Doyle was the busiest buyer on the day, accounting for seven lots and a total of €1,015,000, including €600,000 for the session's joint top lot, a colt by Sadler's Wells. Hip 119 is out of Encens (GB) and is therefore a three-quarters brother to G1 Dewhurst S. winner Scenic (Ire) from the female family of Rainbow Quest, Warning (GB) and Derby winner Commander In Chief (GB). Haras des Capucines, who consigned the colt, also sold a full sister last year at Deauville for FF3.7 million. (cont p4)

BANK SHOT Although Banks Hill was third before being promoted to second in this contest run on testing ground last year, she encountered her favoured faster conditions this time. The filly was held up in sixth early behind the respectable pace set by **Best Of The Bests (Ire)** (Machiavellian). As that colt increased the pressure from the front, **Turtle Bow (Fr)** (Turtle Island {Ire}) threatened briefly as the favourite made her move approaching the quarter-mile marker. Passing the long-time leader with 1 ½ furlongs remaining, she was challenged by Domedriver, but was always holding that rival in the drive to the line. Third on her return behind Best of the Bests over the extended nine furlongs of the G1 Prix d'Ispehan at Longchamp May 19, Banks Hill ran out of stamina when third behind Grandera (Ire) in the 10-furlong G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 19. She will return to that trip in the Filly & Mare Turf, for which she was cut to 5-1 as favourite by Coral Eurobet yesterday. For owner Khalid Abdullah, it was a remarkable weekend, with a pair of Grade I wins Saturday at Arlington prior to Banks Hill's success. Simon Crisford, racing manager to Godolphin, was "pleased" with Best of the Bests, who will now be aimed at the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp Sept. 8.

Philip H. Iselin H. cont.

Cat's At Home won the GIII Westchester H. and GIII Excelsior Breeders' Cup when based in New York last year, but has been campaigned exclusively at the Jersey Shore this season. The Edward Evans homebred returned from a six-month absence to finish a neck second in a June 7 money allowance tilt before bouncing back to win the Skip Away S. by 5 1/2 lengths June 30. In his latest effort, the five-year-old made most of the pace before fading to fourth in the GIII Salvator Mile H. July 27. With regular rider Eibar Coa electing to ride Bowman's Band, jockey Jose Velez Jr. got the call from trainer Mark Hennig and put the bay on the front end setting solid fractions of :47.63 for the half and a demanding 1:10.68 for six furlongs. Bowman's Band advanced along the inside and loomed a threat at the head of the stretch, but Cat's At Home dug in gamely and held on for the victory. "Nobody pressured me so I was able to set the pace the way I wanted," the winning rider commented. "He got up to me, Bowman's Band, but my horse kept digging and digging." Include (Broad Brush), favored at 1-2, was wrapped up in front for the first time and was never involved, finishing a well beaten sixth. Jockey Jerry Bailey offered no excuses. "No comment," he said. "You can ask me any question you want and I'll say 'no'." Make it six in a row for Cal-bred Disturbingthepeace, who outgamed Hot Market for his third consecutive Grade II success. The winner of a pair of allowance tests at Santa Anita Mar. 20 and Apr. 13, the gelding made it three straight with a one-length score at Hollywood May 19. Freshened off that effort, the bay wired the field to win the July 6 GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. at 16-1 and ran his Del Mar record to two wins from three starts with a 3/4-length win in the Bing Crosby Breeders' Cup H. July 27. Content to sit just off the flank of second choice Hot Market, Disturbingthepeace turned up the heat on that front runner at the quarter pole, poked a head in front with a furlong to come and held gamely. I Love Silver came with a rail run into the stretch and closed willingly for third. "We're definitely looking at the Breeders' Cup," said winning trainer Darrell Vienna, who added that his charge would have to be supplemented for \$90,000 to the Sprint. Will he run again before that? "[Mr. Milch] has been articulating the idea of not running until [the Breeders' Cup] and I am not opposed to that at all. He [the horse] has been pretty busy." Beaten by double-digit margins in a pair of main-track maidens this spring, Wonder Again improved dramatically when tried on the Belmont turf May 31, finishing second by 1/2 length. The bay donned cap and gown for graduation day in Elmont June 26 and most recently came from just off the pace to register a neck success over similar yielding conditions on opening day at Saratoga July 24. The Phillips homebred broke well and settled in a handy third for jockey Edgar Prado as longshot Miss Marcia cut out a moderate early pace. Wonder Again advanced under her own courage on the far turn, assumed command at will outside the pacesetter rounding into the stretch, drew clear and was wrapped up under the wire. Riskaverse, well placed throughout, rallied into the lane, but could not menace the winner. "You can't step up to a graded stakes off an entry-level allowance with just any horse," commented winning trainer Jimmy Toner. "I had confidence in her. The first time I saw her I really believed she had a lot of quality. I wouldn't put her in the same class as Memories of Silver or [champion] Soaring Softly just yet, but she's coming along nicely," he added, drawing a comparison to the two Grade I-winning turf mares he trained in the late 1990s. The winner and runner-up are likely for the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Park Sept. 8. Cut Quartz pulled off a major upset here under Christophe-Patrice Lemaire by getting the better of Clety in a thrilling finish. Stepped up in trip for his attempt at a first Group win, he relished the test of stamina to suggest he can hold his own in some of the premier staying events to come in the fall. Previously, he had shown respectable form over middle distances without threatening to reach the upper strata. Last year his best efforts were a second-place finish in the Listed le Vase d'Argent at Toulouse in March followed by a win in the Listed Grand Prix de Bordeaux at la Teste de Buch in May and a runner-up finish in the G3 Prix Andre Baboin back at Toulouse in October. Returning this year to finish third behind Jomana (Ire) in the G3 Prix Exbury at Saint-Cloud Mar. 9, he was subsequently fifth in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at Longchamp Mar. 31. After two disappointing efforts, the decision was made to step the five-year-old up in trip and he justified that call in the heavy afternoon downpour that changed the going at Deauville. Held up in sixth early as Double Honour (Fr) (Highest Honor {Fr}) was taken to the front, he was patiently ridden and travelled easily in the rain-softened ground until being asked to lengthen in the straight. Picking up well there, he passed Clety with 300 yards remaining before asserting in the closing stages as that rival battled gamely.

Dress to Thrill continued her upward curve with a fluent first-time Group success over the veteran Duck Row. Last year, she took the Listed Tyros S. at The Curragh in July before finishing 3/4-of-a-length runner-up to Quarter Moon (Ire) in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. back at that track in September. Although she was forced to miss the early season Classics, she showed that she retained her ability when comfortably accounting for the smart Chiming (Ire) in the Listed Brownstown S. over this track July 6. This time, she settled in third early as Johnny Murtagh committed Ahsanabad, taking that colt five lengths clear. Always travelling well off that fast tempo, she quickened to challenge wide in the final quarter of a mile and gradually wore down the long-time leader, heading him with 100 yards remaining before asserting as Duck Row battled past the long-time leader in the shade of the post. "We are very happy with that," said trainer Dermot Weld. "She will come back here for the G3 Matron S. on Irish Champion day [Sept. 7]."

Cash Talks:

Former jockey Cash Asmussen was represented during Sunday's session by hip 122, a filly by Irish River (Fr) which sold for €175,000 to the Chantilly Bloodstock Agency. The Feb. 19 foal is out of MSP Filha Do Ar (Tremolino) and is a three-parts sister to G2 Prix d'Harcourt and multiple American Grade I winner River Bay (Irish River {Fr}). Asmussen reflected on the sale. "We've been spoiled," he commented. "I thought the Irish River was very correct. For horses that are popular, you can get a great price, but after that, it's a bit wanting. It's early in the sale and it's too early to make any big judgments. The first couple of days are popular, but can't give you a true reading of the middle and the bottom, so I think we have to give it a few days."

Undefeated at 2, won or placed in nine stakes including the Haskell Invitational H.-G1, Travers S.-G1, Flamingo S.-G3 and back to back runnings of the Baltimore Breeders' Cup H.-G3 where he equaled the track record for 1 1/8 miles in 1:47 3/5.

"[Saturday] it was a very selective market. I was frightened we were trying to find one tree in a forest. We sold one for 2 million and then nothing. It was like we played the first half and then didn't come out for the second half. In the wake of the world economy it wasn't surprising. Deauville is still a fantastic place to buy horses, but the rich aren't as rich. It's getting harder and harder to buy a horse. People are very selective for fewer, but probably better, horses."

FESTIVAL WRAP Trainer Bobby Frankel, fresh off a pair of victories during Saturday's International Festival of Racing at Arlington, was back in Saratoga yesterday assessing the success of his trip and announcing plans for GI Arlington Million winner **Beat Hollow (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). "I'm not running him again until the Breeders' Cup--the Mile," the conditioner said. "I think he's a little too keen to go a mile and a half. A mile and an eighth is his best distance, but a mile is going to be very good too. He's got a lot more speed than people realize." **Chiselling** (Woodman), a 3/4 brother to 2000 Arlington Million winner Chester House, was fine following his narrow win in the GI Secretariat S., Frankel said. "He ran great. He didn't get frantic in the gate. In New York he got frantic.
