COLONY, 'DAWN TAKE TWO

When last they locked horns, **Summer Colony** (Summer Squall) and **Dancethruthedawn** (Mr. Prospector) dueled the length of the stretch in the May 17 GIII Pimlico Breeders Cup Distaff H., the former asserting in the waning strides along the inside for a nose success. The two four-year-olds, widely regarded as the two

best distaffers outside of Azeri, rematch in this afternoon's GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga as the 120-pound co-highweights.

"Both fillies ran great that day," said Summer Colony's trainer Mark Hennig, referencing the Pimlico event.

"We've got a lot of respect for Dancethruthedawn. I'm glad to see they're at equal

weights." Both have shown affinity for the Saratoga main track. Summer Colony won a pair of races last year by a combined 42 1/4 lengths, while the Canadian filly, fourth in the GI Alabama S. in 2001, registered her first local victory in the GI Go For Wand H. in her most recent effort July 28. "So far, so good," trainer Mark Frostad said of Dancethruthedawn. "She did what she was supposed to [last time]. It was a bob of the head that separated them the first time they met. I would imagine a similar finish this time." The field is completed by Grade I winner **Critical Eye** (Dynaformer), Grade II winners **Two Item Limit** (Twining) and **Starrer** (Dynaformer) and MGISP **Transcendental** (Mt. Livermore).

KYLLACHY COMPLETES STORY FOR CANDY

Jamie Spencer brought the 3-1 favourite **Kyllachy (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) over to the rail from his high draw and threaded him through in the closing stages to beat **Malhub** (Kingmambo) by a half-length in yesterday's G1 Victor Chandler Nunthorpe S. at York. For trainer Henry Candy, it was reward for the experience of witnessing Eveningperformance (GB) being caught in the final strides by Kyllachy's sire Pivotal in this event in 1996. Kyllachy always promised to be the one to bring the story full cycle, showing brilliant acceleration when winning the G3 Palace House S. at Newmarket May 4 before following up in the G2 Temple S. at Sandown June 3. Based on the latter performance, where he was an impressive four-length winner, the four-year-old was sent off the favourite in the G2 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot June 18, but could manage only third behind **Dominica (GB)** (Alhaarth {Ire}), beaten a head and a half-length. Despite being handed an unfavourably high draw here, Spencer was keen to avoid being caught on the stands' side, and as the gates opened drew his colt across the width of the track, where he made steady progress in that group taken along by **Lady Dominatrix (Ire)** (Danhill Dancer {Ire}). As Malhub drew upsides the long-time leader in the centre of the track under Richard Hills and was committed inside the final quarter mile, Spencer was looking for room up the far rail. Finding the gaps in time, he drove Kyllachy through and the colt quickened to cut down his rival in the final 25 yards. "How far he ran shows that he is somewhat better than the others, but he needed the cover," said Candy. "Jamie was speechless when he got off--he said he had to take a check at halfway. He was much happier being a fresh horse and being off since Ascot has really suited him. If you think he is a horse that likes cut then you realise how good a horse he is to win here. I think he would like the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye [at Longchamp Oct. 6], and Hong Kong is a possibility too. He is seriously good, he has got the gift of being able to quicken off the fastest of paces." Spencer added, "When we started to get going it was incredible and luckily it all worked out." Russian Rhythm was almost stopped in her tracks at the quarter-mile marker, but showed all the "class, determination and guts" that trainer Sir Michael Stoute spoke of to deny Danaskaya and Romantic Liason in a dramatic renewal of this contest. "This was the one I was looking forward to riding most of all this week," said jockey Kieren Fallon afterwards. His dream ride almost turned to horror, however, as the early pacesetter Wunders Dream (Ire) (Averti {Ire}) cut across the favourite's path as she made her move from the rear towards the rail past halfway. Snatched up by Fallon, her chance appeared lost, as the rider recounted. "I thought the race was over there, and when Frankie [Dettori] closed the gaps in front, I thought I had no chance of recovering." As Dettori launched Romantic Liason to the head of affairs at the furlong marker, Russian Rhythm responded by quickening impressively in the final 100 yards, hit the lead with 25 yards remaining and edged clear. "I was lucky the gaps came after all the trouble earlier on--she has been showing all the signs of a decent filly at home and she proved it today," said Fallon. Having beaten the smart Fancy Lady (GB) in a Newmarket maiden June 28, Russian Rhythm impressed when following up in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot July 27. Stoute, who also saddled 2000 winner Enthused to win both races, said, "I thought it was all over, but not many can do that--she will probably go to the G1 Cheveley Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 4], but we will have to see how she is." Russian Rhythm certainly impressed Coral Eurobet who cut her to 4-1 as favourite for next year's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket in May. EMBLEM SCARES NO ONE AWAY Kentucky Derby and Preakness hero **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) has been installed the 2-1 morning line favorite for Sunday's GI Pacific Classic, the centerpiece of the summer meeting at Del Mar. Despite his status as the most accomplished member of the field, 12 other trainers have seen fit to take their crack and the gate crew will welcome a full field of 14 at 2:42 p.m. Sunday afternoon. Richard Mulhall, racing manager for The Thoroughbred Corporation, is unfazed by the size of the field. "They're all fuguring that there'll be a lot of speed and the speed will die," he said. "Actually, it's better for us. The bigger the field, the better it is. We're going to be in front. All the rest of them will be in traffic. I think we have the best horse." Trainer Bobby Frankel knows his way to the winner's circle following the Pacific Classic, having saddled the winner of the race a remarkable six times, including the last two years with the recently retired **Skimming**. **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again) will do his best to make it an even seven for his conditioner. The winner of the GI Santa Anita H. earlier this season, the Stronach Stables colorbearer comes into the Classic off a third-place finish behind **Sky Jack** (Jaklin Klugman) and **Momentum** (Nureyev) in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup in Inglewood July 14.

TAYLORS TO DISPERSE Karen and Mickey Taylor, owners of the late Seattle Slew, have decided to begin dispersing their Thoroughbred holdings beginning at this year's Keeneland November Sale. Reiley McDonald of Eaton Sales will act as consignor for a majority of the dispersal, which includes mares, yearlings and sucklings, many by Seattle Slew. "If Slew were still here, we wouldn't be getting out of the business, but the way things fell into place, we all felt that it was better now to get out," Mickey Taylor commented. "Slew's gone and with him passing away, [groom] Tom [Wade], [wife] Karen and Albert [Finney] and I talked about [dispersing]. We made the decision together and it was unanimous. We decided that things are just not going to be like they used to be. It was a very difficult and emotional decision. There are some other things that will come out later; there's no reason to worry about it now. We thought it was the best for all of us, including Slew." The Taylors were hard hit by the effects of last year's mare reproductive loss syndrome, losing a total of 14 mares. Asked whether this marks the end of his involvement with Thoroughbreds, Taylor commented, "We've had the best of the best in the Thoroughbred business. We're going to take one step at a time."

FLOWING EUTHANIZED Flowing (El Gran Senor--Flo Russell, by Round Table) was euthanized Aug. 18 due to complications from chronic laminitis. She was 14 years old. Bred by Tommy Stack and trained by Dermot Weld, the grey won the G3 Flying Five S. in 1991 prior to being purchased by Brushwood Stables at the 1991 Tattersalls December Sales. A repeat winner of the Flying Five in 1992, she was also second in that year's G2 Premio Omenoni in Italy and was named that season's highweight older mare in Ireland at 5-7 furlongs. Sent to the U.S. the following year, Flowing went on to produce a total of eight foals, including Irish Listed placed Lady Shannon (Mr. Prospector) and Round Prospector (Mr. Prospector), who sold for \$300,000 at the 1996 Keeneland July Sale and \$400,000 at the Barretts March Sale the following year.

WAY WEST COLT TOPS OBS FINALE A colt by Gone West's sire son Way West (Fr) brought a final bid of \$87,000 from trainer Bob Baffert to top Thursday's final session of the OBS August Yearling Sale in Florida. Consigned by Sue Vacek, agent for John H. Cooper Jr., the chestnut, named Exspressway West, is out of Exrani (Exclusive Ribot) and is a half brother to Fortunate Charmer, winner of the Luvinheriseasy S. at The Meadowlands. The session's top filly was hip 1106, a dark bay by Overbrook Farm stallion Cape Town out of Dottie Lou's Star (Star de Naskra). She was purchased by Mark Casse, agent, for \$42,000 from Beth Bayer acting as agent for Pleasant Crest Farm. Final results from the three open sessions were mixed against last year's four-session sale, with a 14.3-percent decrease in the overall gross and a 5.9-percent falloff in the average. The overall median, however, managed an increase of five percent.


Warners Euthanized:

The stable of trainer Todd Pletcher took yet another hit when **Warners** (Dehere) was euthanized Tuesday night after suffering from laminitis and an unidentified illness. "We were in the process of winning the battle with the illness, but often times the problem with that situation is that they develop laminitis," the conditioner commented. "He was starting to lose contact between his coronet band and one of his hind feet. He was in an advanced stage of laminitis beyond repair." The three-year-old, purchased by Eugene and Laura Melnyk for \$1.05 million as a two-year-old, was being prepared for a start in Saturday's GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga. Pletcher's barn has also suffered through an emergency colic surgery for GI Whitney H. winner Left Bank as well as the death of GII Schuylerville S. winner Freedom's Daughter from Colitis X. Warners had a record of 6-2-3-0 and earnings of \$101,000.

THEFULL CIRCLE (c, 3, Unbridled's Song--Highland Vixen {MSW, \$171,103}, by Highland Ruckus), third in all three previous tries on the turf, finally dispensed of his maiden with a rousing 1 3/4-length win over the Belmont lawn July 18. West Nile Infected Mosquito Found at Churchill:

Officials from the Jefferson County (Kentucky) Health Department have discovered at least one mosquito infected with the West Nile Virus at Churchill Downs. Local officials have made regular inspections at the track since last November, when a two-year-old Thoroughbred died from the disease. That is the only reported death at any Kentucky track. "Churchill Downs has been working with local and state health officials to ensure that we are taking every possible precaution to protect the humans and horses at our track from exposure to the West Nile Virus," said John Long, acting president of Churchill Downs Inc. The track has also taken measures to control the mosquito population by monitoring its drainage system and other areas where water may stagnate. Track superintendent Butch Lehr uses chemicals to kill the insects in their larval stage and has also utilized flypaper-like sheets to otherwise trap mosquitos.

Want To Be In The Movies?:

Extras are being sought for Seabiscuit movie scenes. Frank Marshall, producer of the upcoming movie on 1938 Horse of the Year, has confirmed that parts of the movie will be filmed in Kentucky and Southern Ohio beginning in October and is seeking extras for those scenes. Producers of the movie, along with the Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky Film Commission, are scouting sites. Several racing scenes will be filmed at Keeneland Race Course in Lexington. Recently retired jockey Chris McCarron has signed on as the film's racing consultant, and Hall of Fame jockey will also appear in the film as Charley Kurtsinger, who rode Triple Crown winner War Admiral against Seabiscuit in their famous match race. Fellow Hall of Famer Gary Stevens will step into irons in the role of jockey George Woolf. Tobey Maguire has signed on to play Seabiscuit's regular jockey Red Pollard. Casting sessions for those wishing to appear in the movie as extras will be held on Friday and Saturday at the Millennium Hotel in Cincinnati.

"I wanted to retire while I could still enjoy myself and do some of the things I always wanted to do," he said. "I am looking forward to having some time to just enjoy watching the races from the other side of the mutuel window."
