ORO SHINES IN MIDSUMMER MUD

He was 2-5 on the morning line and ended up going off at 3-5, but **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) had to reach down deep despite a grabbed quarter to deny the returning **Repent** (Louis Quatorze) by a half-length in the Midsummer Derby, the \$1,000,000 GI Travers S. yesterday afternoon at Saratoga. "He was very game and dug in," said winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "Repent really tested us. He definitely grabbed his quarter. I'm just hoping it's not too serious that we lose time with him. I was surprised Repent [off since April] ran as good as he did." Longshot **Nothing Flat** (Peaks and Valleys) rallied from last to finish third. *Travers cont., p2*

YOUNG GUNS

Three-year-olds **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) and **Came Home** (Gone West) will have their work cut out for them when they face older horses for the first time in the \$1,000,000 GI Pacific Classic this afternoon at Del Mar. The free-running War Emblem has rolled to victories in the GI Kentucky Derby, the GI Preakness and, most recently, the GI Haskell Invitational H. Aug. 4, but will face some serious pressure on the front end this time from the likes of **Sky Jack** (Jaklin Klugman) and **Bosque Redondo** (Mane Minister). Attempts to rate the nearly black colt have not been

very successful in the past and he will have to summon all of his class to prevail today. **Momentum** (Nureyev) will try to make it three straight victories in this race for jockey Garret Gomez, who piloted another son of Nureyev, Skimming, to wins in 2000 and 2001. The four-year-old bay just missed by a nose after a stretch-long duel with Sky Jack in the 10-furlong GI Hollywood Gold Cup July 14, but should get an ideal stalking trip this time. Hoping for a hot pace will be **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again). The Big 'Cap winner was too far back to make an impact in the Hollywood Gold Cup, but will likely be kept in closer touch. The ultra-consistent Came Home, unbeaten in California, still seems suspect at 1 1/4 miles and will need to use some early speed to gain position from post nine. Making his stakes debut is **Pleasantly Perfect** (Pleasant Colony). The lightly raced four-year-old captured a first-level Hollywood allowance June 20 and followed that up with a victory in an optional claimer Aug. 4 over this surface. Trainer Craig Lewis had hoped to saddle Arbiter, but that runner was forced to miss the race with a minor injury. According to Lewis, "I think there could be an upsetter, and that would be Pleasantly Perfect. He's a horse that hasn't had a lot of races, but I think he's got a lot of talent, maybe not enough seasoning, but I think he fits the race and I like his running style." *Pacific Classic field, p6*

MEDAGLIA MAKES HIS MOVE Longshot **Shah Jehan** (Mr. Prospector) quickly jumped out to set the pace in the 133rd renewal of the Travers, but **Medaglia d'Oro** tracked him intently through honest fractions of :23.14 and :46.82 as **Repent** was unhurried back in sixth. The Edmund Gann colorbearer took command with a half-mile to run and had a clear lead turning for home. **Repent** came with his patented late run, but the favorite displayed his determination for the narrow score. "He broke with running on his mind today," said winning rider Jerry Bailey. "He was strong at all times. If anything was bothering him, he had enough courage to not let it show." **Medaglia d'Oro** was purchased by Gann after breaking his maiden impressively at Oaklawn Park; in his first start for Frankel, the dark bay stunned the then-Derby favorite Siphonic in the GII San Felipe S. Shipped east, he missed by just a head in the GI Wood Memorial, but then had the two worst races of his career. He missed the break in the Kentucky Derby before rushing up to be fourth, but never fired in the Preakness, coming home a distant eighth. Frankel kept going with the colt and **Medaglia d'Oro** responded, finishing a game second to **Sarava** in the GI Belmont S. June 8. Given a brief vacation, the burly three-year-old returned as the 3-5 favorite in the GII Jim Dandy S. Aug. 4 at the Spa, but ran more like 1-20, romping home by 13 3/4 lengths while earning a Beyer Speed Figure of 120. His Travers victory makes him the second Grade I winner of the meet for Gann, following **You's** success in the GI Test S.

The Return of Repent

Repent had flirted with Derby favoritism earlier this year, winning the GII Louisiana Derby, but finished second to **War Emblem** in the GII Illinois Derby in April and was diagnosed with ankle chips. Trainer **Kenny McPeck** had enthused about the dark bay's chances all week and was delighted with his charge's effort. "He's a fantastic horse, and he deserves to be ranked with the top three-year-olds in North America," said the conditioner. "Maybe we'll sit until the Breeders' Cup [Oct. 26]. He's run well off the layoff, and you can do these kinds of things with a good horse."

Dublino came flying to nail arch rival **Megahertz** at the wire to earn her first career stakes victory. The dark bay had made two starts in France for **Andre Fabre**, taking her Nov. 20 debut at Saint-Cloud before returning this spring to run **G1SW Sophisticat** to 3/4-length in the **G3 Prix de la Grotte** Apr. 14 at Longchamp. Repatriated, **Dublino** was no secret at 4-1 in the \$500,000 **American Oaks** at Hollywood July 6 and crossed the line in front of favored **Megahertz**, but was taken down for interference and placed second. The pair were alongside in the gate, with **Dublino** drawing the rail, and were content to race well off the early pace set by **Fair Bianca (Bien Bien)**. **Dublino** took the overland route on the turn and came flying into the stretch as **Megahertz** opted to go inside. The little chestnut had the lead in the final strides, but **Dublino** finished determinedly to earn the nose victory. "The last 100 yards she threw a lead change and just about shut down," said winning jockey **Kent Desormeaux**. "I started throwing crosses at her, trying to get her to keep her mind on her business. And she came running like nobody could. She's something." **Dublino** could go next in the **GI Queen Elizabeth** at Keeneland Oct. 12.

Brought to you by the hot team of Evans, Hennig and Velazquez--who took Friday's GI Personal Ensign with Summer Colony--Gygistar ran his winning streak to five with this authoritative display. A winner at first asking last May at Churchill, the homebred was put away for the year following a second in the GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup H. May 28. He made a successful reappearance in a Gulfstream allowance Mar. 23 and had Lasix added for the Hallandale Beach H. Apr. 20, which he captured by 10 1/2 lengths. He then trounced his GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup H. rivals by 4 1/2 lengths June 8 and the decision was made to try the chestnut at a route. He secured the early lead in the GII Dwyer over 1 1/16 miles and held sway late over Nothing Flat (third in yesterday's GI Travers) July 7 at Belmont. Plans to go to the GII Jim Dandy S. were scrapped when Gygistar got sick, but Plan B, the King's Bishop, has worked out just fine. With Boston Common and Day Trader (Phone Trick) ripping through a half in :44.91, Gygistar sat just off them in third and came three wide off the turn to collar Boston Common. That pacesetter clung on stubbornly, but Gygistar gained a narrow lead at the stretch call and pulled away through the final furlong. "He missed a good 10 days to two weeks of training," said Hennig. "We're probably going to focus on the Breeders' Cup Sprint [GI, Oct. 26]. He's versatile, and he could lay off the pace. I wouldn't be afraid to run him a mile in the Jerome [GII, Sept. 14]."

The majority of his two-year-old string has been waylaid with coughing, but trainer Aidan O'Brien took a calculated gamble in saddling Van Nistelrooy and that paid off as the colt maintained his perfect record. In doing so, he showed the same cruising speed he displayed when winning his July 14 debut, then taking a slowly run Listed Tyros S. over this course July 27. Van Nistelrooy may now emulate last year's winner and stablemate Hawk Wing in attempting to follow up in the G1 National S. at this track Sept. 15, with plans dependent on the his health. "The plan all along was for him to have four runs, ending with the National S.," said O'Brien afterwards. "It's a relief to see him win again as our two-year-olds are very much under a cloud with the coughing." Van Nistelrooy settled in sixth early on the rail as King's Mountain (King of Kings {Ire}) cut out the running. The royally bred juvenile was looking for racing room near the three-furlong marker, quickened when in the clear and responded to comfortably hold off the late flourish of Chappel Crescent. Van Nistelrooy, who recorded a time over a second faster than Hawk Wing's last year, was quoted at odds of 16-1 by Coral Eurobet for next year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket in May.

The Fourstardave lost much of its luster when it was taken off the turf, with just five horses going postward. Back in February, Capsized had inished second when the GIII Canadian Turf H. was moved to the main track, and he followed that up with a third to Pyrus in the grassy GIII Fort Marcy Apr. 27. After finishing eighth in an off-the-turf allowance at Belmont June 8, the six-year-old was given a brief break and he returned with a resounding three-length victory over Pyrus in a one-mile allowance over the yielding Saratoga lawn July 24. The third choice in this short field, Capsized broke alertly under Jose Santos and went up to press Pyrus as that runner clicked off fractions of :23.49 and :47.21. He made his move turning for home and splashed home an easy winner as the main-track only Pure Prize came from far back to complete the exacta. "I knew Chavez [aboard Pyrus] was sending and I didn't want him to get too easy a lead," said Santos. "My horse had a perfect trip. Like a good bottle of wine, he is going to get better with age." For trainer Lisa Lewis, it was her first Spa stakes victory since 1991. "It's been a long time coming," she said. "It's nice to get the job done."

Tillerman swooped to conquer in a blanket finish here to reward the daring of his jockey Richard Hughes. Held up in rear in the early stages in customary fashion as Redback moved to the front, Tillerman travelled well before being asked to quicken inside the final 1 1/2 furlongs. Although he lugged inwards as he delivered his challenge, which denied **Where or When (Ire)** (**Danehill Dancer {Ire}**) a clear run, he hit the front with 50 yards remaining before asserting as his rivals drove towards the line almost in unison. Tillerman, who was beaten a short head when runner-up to **No Excuse Needed (GB)** in the G2 **Queen Anne S.** at **Royal Ascot** June 18, was subsequently disappointing when last of six behind **Atavus (GB)** in the G3 **Criterion S.** at **Newmarket** 11 days later. That day, the six-year-old had failed to get the fast early pace and the luck in running he requires to show his best. "He's a really good horse on his day when everything goes right for him," said the trainer's husband, **Mark Perrett**. "He needs his ground, a good gallop and needs producing with a burst--that's the only way to ride him. He deserved to win a big race as he's always threatened to do it and we've always thought he was good enough. He showed at Ascot that he was capable and thank God he's done it today."

A daughter of Unbridled, Surya had never started on the main track, but handled her two rivals easily while earning her second stakes victory. The royally bred bay began her career in France under the tutelage of Jonathan Pease, for whom she ran second to Fantastic Filly (Fr) in a Saint-Cloud conditions test and third to Banks Hill (GB) in a similar contest at Maisons-Laffitte. She made one start at three for Bobby Frankel, overwhelming Del Mar maidens by 12 lengths, and made her eagerly awaited return this year in a Hollywood allowance May 5, winning by three lengths. After duly obliging at 3-5 in the GIII Royal Heroine S. July 6, the big bay got caught in traffic in the GI Ramona H. and could only manage a fourth, beaten 2 1/2 lengths by Affluent and Golden Apples (Ire). Shooting Party went up to set the pace, but Surya had her number, easily taking command on the far turn, and was kept busy down the stretch. "She looked at the grandstand," said winning rider Jerry Bailey. "I had to tap her a couple of times to keep her looking straight." Trainer Bobby Frankel indicated that Surya would make her next appearance at Belmont.

Naheef returned to winning ways under jockey Frankie Dettori, denying Chianti's bold bid to make all. Settled in second travelling easily behind Chianti in the early stages, he tackled the long-time leader at the furlong marker before stretching clear for a convincing score. Having won the G3 Vintage S. at Goodwood last July, he was taken to The Curragh the following month to contest the G1 National S., but proved no match for Hawk Wing there, finishing the 2 1/2-lengths runner-up to the impressive winner. Hopes were high that he would spearhead the Godolphin sophomore army this term and when he took the private trial in Dubai in April he confirmed that impression. He was therefore disappointing when 14th in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 and seventh in the G1 Epsom Derby June 8. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented, "I think a mile and a quarter on fast ground suits him and he was training very well--he will improve for this. He has always had the class so we'll have to find a Group 2 race for him. Frankie [Dettori] was happy with him and we'll have to wait and see now before we decide on whether he goes for the G1 Dubai Champion S. [at Newmarket Oct. 19]." A winner in 10 of her 23 career starts, she captured this race by a half-length last year, and added a victory in the seven-furlong GII First Flight S. at Belmont Oct. 26 to run her record at seven-eighths to two-for-two. **Raging Fever**, first or second in all six starts this year, accounted for victories in the Jan. 18 GIII First Lady H. at Gulfstream, the Mar. 30 GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. and the Apr. 20 Bed o' Roses Breeders' Cup H. at Aqueduct and, most recently, the June 22 GI Ogden Phipps H. going a mile and a sixteenth at Belmont Park. She drops back in distance, but trainer Mark Hennig said, "I think she can sprint with the best of them."

It is no secret that the fillies in France have overshadowed the colts so far this term. With no domestic colts on show this time in defense of this crown, which has been taken overseas seven times in the last eight years, it is left to the fairer sex to ward off the foreign threat. Chief among those is the unbeaten **Loving Kindness**, impressive winner of the G3 Prix de Cabourg over this track Aug. 3. That day, she spredeagled a competitive field and she bids to emulate her dam Coup de Genie, who followed up in this event after having taken that contest. She may have better prospects than **Zinziberine** and **Ela Merici (Fr)**, second and third, respectively, behind Never a Doubt (GB) in the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte July 28. That was a reversal of the form of the G3 Prix du Bois at Chantilly June 28, where Ela Merici had the length call over her rival. **Elusive City** enters this race with bright prospects, having demolished a field of sharp types in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood July 30 last time. That form has been franked by the three-length runner-up Revenue (Ire), who went considerably closer to winning Wednesday's G2 Gimcrack S. at York. One concern for connections is that he encountered a furious early pace that day which he is not guaranteed here. **Al Turf (Ire)** beat smart stable companion Cosmo (Ire) in a Newbury maiden June 13 and is open to vast improvement, while **Zafeen (Fr)** shaped as if he needed more time when winning his maiden at Salisbury July 26.



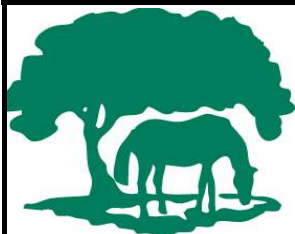

REBELLINE AIMING FOR CHAMPION **Rebelline (Ire)** (Robellino {USA}), winner of the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 26, will line up for the G1 Ireland the Food Island Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 7. Absent since beating Bach (Ire) by two lengths at The Curragh, the Kevin Prendergast-trained four-year-old looks set for a clash with Hawk Wing (USA) or Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the 10-furlong contest. Prendergast told *Irish Racing online*: "Everyone seems to under-rate her, but she won her three races in the spring and beat Nayef in the Tattersalls Gold Cup. In the same conditions she is always hard to beat and, on soft ground, she will go to Leopardstown with a live chance. She will not run if its fast ground--she would want it yielding."

O'BRIEN SOPHOMORES BACK IN WORK Trainer Aidan O'Brien was yesterday planning an assault on the major prizes of the fall as he revealed that his older horses were "over the hump" of the coughing outbreak, adding that, "all the good ones are in full work again." Having been forced to sidestep York's Ebor meeting last week, O'Brien said that **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}), **Hawk Wing (USA)** (Woodman {USA}) and **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}) would all return to the track soon. "We will be looking to run most of them in a fortnight or so at the earliest," the Ballydoyle conditioner said, stating that the feature races at Leopardstown and Haydock Sept. 7 and at Longchamp Sept. 8 would form the comeback races for his stable stars. The "Rock" could bid to make history as the first to win seven consecutive Group 1 races in either the G1 Ireland the Food Island Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown or the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. Hawk Wing could return in the Irish Champion with **Sholokhov (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}), while **Landseer (GB)** (Danehill {USA}) is likely to bid for sprinting honours in the G1 Stanley Leisure Sprint Cup at Haydock. According to O'Brien, "If Hawk Wing runs at Leopardstown in the Irish Champion, Sholokov would run there as well, with Landseer possibly going to Haydock. High Chaparral is in the Irish Champion at Leopardstown as well, but he might wait for the G2 Prix Niel Longchamp the following weekend in [Sept. 15]. All this depends though on them staying healthy in the meantime."

JOCKEYS FACE RANDOM TESTING

Irish jockeys will face random drug tests for the first time in the 2003 flat season, it was announced yesterday. As part of a set of new initiatives to be introduced by the Irish Turf Club, 50 jockeys will be called upon to submit urine samples next year, with up to 100 per year expected in time. The Turf Club's Medical Officer Dr. Walter Halley told *Irish Racing online*: "I warmly welcome this move and lots of jockeys I have spoken to have no objections. They are in a split-second decision making situation and they don't want someone drunk or on drugs riding with them." Among those substances targeted will be alcohol, 'leisure' drugs such as cocaine and ecstasy, and diuretic drugs. Some prescribed medications will be allowed if declared in advance of use. Other notable changes include the increase of the minimum weight to seven pounds and 12 ounces, and a new balloting system. Other measures include the harmonisation of the interference rules between Britain and Ireland and re-development of The Curragh's main stand.

COUGHING WRECKS O'BRIEN PLANS

Despite the success of **Van Nistelrooy (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) in yesterday's G2 Galileo EBF Futurity S. at The Curragh, trainer Aidan O'Brien confirmed that "the majority" of the juvenile team at Ballydoyle are coughing. Having withdrawn both **Spartacus (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}) and **Marino Marini (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}), first and second, respectively, in the G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh Aug. 11, from today's G1 Prix Morny at Deauville. According to O'Brien, "They [Spartacus and Marino Marini] seem to be okay, but we have just decided not to run them." **Statue Of Liberty (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}), not seen since taking the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 18, is also unaffected, but is on a break at the moment, according to O'Brien.

REIGNING QUEEN SUNLINE WINS MUDGWAY
Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}), the four-time New Zealand and three-time Australian Horse of the Year, showed she has lost none of her feistiness with a gutsy win in the G2 \$NZ100,000 Mudgway S. at Hastings in New Zealand Saturday--possibly her final appearance on home turf. Attacked ferociously in the early stages of a race liberally peppered with class horses, Sunline handed up the lead to Tit For Taat (NZ) (Faltaat {USA}), pulled out at the top of the straight, hit the front with 400 meters remaining and fought off a determined charge from the runner-up on the inside. The seven-year-old mare may head across the Tasman to either Melbourne or Sydney for her next outing, or remain in New Zealand for the Challenge S. at Hastings Sept. 14. "If the weather stays good, then she might stay put," said co-trainer Steve McKee. Australian options include the Feehan S. in Melbourne or the Chelmsford S. in Sydney. "She is just so adaptable. She can go left or right-handed, on wet or dry tracks, spring or autumn, it doesn't matter to her. Even though she is now seven, there is no sign she has lost her determination or her will to win either. Right now she's about 90 percent," he said. Sunline is unbeaten in 10 starts in New Zealand and 10 attempts at 1400 meters. "We take everything one race at a time and also weather conditions are important as while she is coming up to her peak, we don't wish to have her overtaxed early," McKee said. "Last year, she had her first run at Moonee Valley and the heavy track took a great deal out of her. She won her next start, but it did take a while to bring her right back to her best again." McKee and his father Trevor have ruled out traveling to Dubai or Hong Kong, with the G1 Cox Plate the ultimate aim this spring.
