**WINNING ONE FOR THE HOME TEAM**

The bettors had their doubts that **Came Home** (Gone West) could get the mile and a quarter of the GI Pacific Classic, but the three-year-old charged past the leaders at the top of the stretch and held off the late surge of **Momentum** (Nureyev) to win the \$1 million test by 3/4 of a length at Del Mar yesterday afternoon. "He just gives it all he's got," said jockey Mike Smith. "In the end, it was a question of whether he was good enough or not. He was." The dark bay,

who was sixth in the GI Kentucky Derby in his only other try at 10 furlongs, gave jockey Chris McCarron a victorious final ride in the June 23 GIII Affirmed H. and, with Smith on board for the first time, captured the GII Swaps S. July 14. But he was overlooked at 10-1 facing older horses here. Allowed to settle in fifth as **Sky Jack** (Jaklin Klugman) and **Bosque Redondo** (Mane Minister) duked it out through six furlongs in 1:09.82, Came Home closed to take the lead as they raced to the eighth pole and held on despite drifting in late. The victory was vindication for his owners and for trainer Paco Gonzalez. "We were the only ones who had faith in the horse," Gonzalez said. "They were saying the only way he could get a mile and a quarter was to get in a helicopter. We showed them today." It was **War Emblem** (Our Emblem), the 6-5 choice, who failed to last. Coming off his facile score in the Aug. 4 GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park, the Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner pressed the pace early and strode up to take a short lead as they raced into the stretch, but faded late to be sixth. Jockey Victor Espinoza blamed the effort on yet another poor break. "The back door wasn't even closed when they opened the front one," Espinoza said. "He wasn't ready to break and we came away a little too slow. I didn't want to rush him to try and make the lead. I just had to be patient. Turning for home I felt he might go, but it wasn't there at the end."

**Trouble Before the Start...**

There was trouble at the gate for **War Emblem** even before the break. According to Del Mar starter Gary Brinson, "He was rearing up and pawing at the gate, so we backed him out. We loaded him again and he started rearing and pawing at the gate again and we backed him out. I was afraid if we didn't back him out, he would hook a foot over the door and hurt himself." Trainer Bob Baffert countered, "I understand the starter was trying to help, but I don't need that kind of help." He added that the colt would get a break now.

**Surgery for Bosque Redondo...**

While Came Home drove to victory, stablemate **Bosque Redondo** tired to be fifth, then broke down as they hit the wire. The five-year-old fractured both sesamoids in his right front ankle and suffered a condylar fracture of the right front cannon bone. He will undergo surgery Monday or Tuesday, according to trainer Paco Gonzalez. Jockey David Flores, who was thrown from the chestnut, took off his remaining mounts yesterday, but escaped serious injury.

Shine Again became the first horse to win back-to-back runnings of the Ballerina with an off-the-pace victory. Fifth in her seasonal bow, the Hurricane Bertie S. at Gulfstream in March, the dark bay ran Xtra Heat to a length when second in the GII Genuine Risk H. at Belmont May 12 and followed with a third-place effort to that same foe in the June 9 GII Vagrancy H. The Bohemia homebred overwhelmed a pair of Belmont allowance fields June 27 and July 16, respectively, but was coming into her title defense off a second-place finish to Mandy's Gold in the GIII Honorable Miss H. Aug. 2. Stretching back out to seven furlongs for this, a distance at which she was a perfect two-for-two, the five-year-old was the third choice behind the returning Raging Fever and the Honorable Miss winner. Longshot Devastating (Bold n' Flashy) set the pace tracked intently to her outside by Mandy's Gold and a three-wide Raging Fever as Shine Again was patiently handled in behind the leaders. The two favorites hooked up at the top of the lane, Mandy's Gold on the inside and Raging Fever to the outside, but Shine Again kicked it into gear on the grandstand side and overhauled the duo in the waning strides for the win. "I was pretty happy with the fractions," commented winning trainer Allen Jerkens. "It's tough to go seven furlongs when they go in about :22 in the first part of it." Elusive City swept from last to first to beat Zafeen (Fr) and maintain his unbeaten record. Although he appears a nervous colt around the starting stalls, his class and ability overshadows that shortcoming. "He does have a small problem with starting stalls and, although he was very calm in the preliminaries and calm down there at the start, he did get very worried when the others arrived," said trainer Gerard Butler. "Hats off to the French stalls handlers, but it's a problem we have to correct and we will leave no stone unturned." Elusive City powered away from Revenue (Ire) to win the G2 Richmond S. by three lengths at Goodwood July 30, showing his ability to quicken off a fast pace and gallop powerfully all the way to the line. He demonstrated that talent again here on ground deadened by the elements and Deauville's watering policy. Kieren Fallon deliberately missed the kick and settled Elusive City in the rear, as he had at Goodwood, but was always in contention as Ela Merici (Fr) (Beaudelaire) cut out an even tempo in front. Finding a split between horses inside the final quarter of a mile, he quickened to take control with 150 yards remaining before asserting for the score. "We had it all to do to go and catch Zafeen," said Willie Carson, British racing manager to The Thoroughbred Corporation. "The ground looks on the dead side and I think Elusive City was struggling to change gear--we'll see a better turn of foot on fast ground." Polish Summer, who has never been out of the first two in his career, denied the strong late challenge of Califet for his most important success to date. He has been brought along steadily by his connections, who seemed to be leaning towards staying contests for the colt last season. The Juddmonte homebred made one start over nearly two miles last year, finishing a fine runner-up to Speedmaster (Ger) in the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier at Longchamp. He returned this term to take a competitive Chantilly conditions event over 10 furlongs June 1 before finishing the two-length runner-up to Ange Gabriel (Fr) in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud June 30. Stepped back up in trip last time in the G2 Prix Maurice De Nieuil at Maisons-Laffitte July 20, he found the smart stayer Pushkin (Ire) too strong, but finished a game second. Here Olivier Peslier settled him wide in fourth early as Breknen le Noir (Fr) (Pelder {Ire}) set a steadily increasing tempo. Seizing the initiative with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, he was able to gain first run on the penalised Califet, who was struggling to find room towards the inner, and had enough to hold that rival in the closing stages. Teddy Beckett, racing manager to owner Prince Khalid Abdullah, commented, "This is a most consistent horse...in 10 races, he was won three times and finished second in the other seven. Second in the GIII Tropical Park Derby when that Jan. 1 race was taken off the Calder turf, The Judge Sez Who was rested with a summer campaign in mind. The winner of a 6 1/2-furlong allowance in his June 11 return to the races, the bay was second in the June 22 Unbridled S. in the slop at Calder, but bounced back to win the Migrating Moon S. in Miami by 3 1/2 lengths July 5. He was a rallying third to Magic Weisner and Wiseman's Ferry in the GII Ohio Derby two back, and the latter got the better of him by a neck in the GIII West Virginia Derby in his most recent outing Aug. 10. Unhurried behind a solid early pace, The Judge Sez Who made steady headway down the backstretch before shifting to the outside for the stretch drive. The defending champion in this event after defeating Go Go (Falstaff) and Warren's Whistle last year, Kalookan Queen kicked off her six-year-old campaign with a 1/2-length victory in the GI Santa Monica H. at Santa Anita in January before finishing second to the fleet Above Perfection in the GII Las Flores H. Feb. 23. A half-length winner versus the boys in the GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. in Arcadia Mar. 30, the dark bay mare returned to be a neck runner-up in the GIII Desert Stormer H. at Hollywood Park June 7, but turned in an uncharacteristically dull performance when third last out in the July 14 GII A Gleam H. The odds-on choice to halt her mini-skid, Kalookan Queen showed good early speed and dueled for the lead three deep, edged to the front approaching the stretch and drew clear under brisk hand encouragement. "She's so classy," said winning rider Alex Solis. "I never hit her. I just showed her the stick. She was running as hard as she could run. Riding her kind is nice. It's special." Winning trainer Bruce Headley indicated that the winner would likely run next in the GI Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. versus males at Santa Anita Oct. 5. Ben Perkins Jr. made history at Monmouth yesterday, becoming the first trainer to saddle three straight winners of this event. Wild Snitch put her conditioner's name in the record books with a commanding victory, the easiest Sorority score yet for Perkins, who sent out Stormy Pick to win by 1 3/4 lengths in 2000 and Forest Heiress to take the race by 3 3/4 lengths last year. "The other two were really pretty fillies, but Wild Snitch looks more like a colt," Perkins said. "She acts like a colt, too--she's strong as a bull." Wild Snitch had just one race under her girth going into the Sorority, breaking her maiden in impressive style at Monmouth Aug. 7. Adding an extra furlong yesterday, the chestnut rated just off the pace as 17-10 second choice Advancing Storm (Storm Cat) led them through a quarter in :21.62 and a half in :45.48. Wild Snitch went after the pacesetter as they raced down the stretch and had just taken a short lead when Advancing Storm broke down. Wild Snitch was left alone on the lead and, with little urging from jockey Eibar Coa, she cruised under the wire an easy winner. "I wish I could tell you how good this filly is, but I can't," Coa said. "I haven't asked her for run in either of her races. The only way to describe her is that she's like a car--you step on the gas and she takes off. I know I had plenty left. There's no telling how good this filly is." It has not yet been decided where Wild Snitch will run next. Advancing Storm was loaded into the ambulance and brought back to her barn on the Monmouth backstretch. Winless since taking an optional claimer at Emerald Downs 14 months ago, Sabertooth was off the board in his first two starts of 2002, but had filled the runner-up spot in his last three appearances. The bay had run up against Moonlight Meeting in his two most recent outings, finishing a half-length behind that rival in the July 4 Independence Day H. and 5 3/4 lengths in arrears in the July 28 Mt. Rainier Breeders' Cup H., both over this track. He was given little shot to turn the tables in this graded affair, but broke sharply, set all the pace and had no trouble holding off his nemesis in the final furlong.
