**SPINAWAY KICKS OFF FINAL SPA WEEKEND**

A field of 12 two-year-old fillies will go postward in the 111th running of the GI Spinaway S. at Saratoga Friday, which opens the Spa's closing weekend. The likely favorite will be **Awesome Humor** (Distorted Humor), heroine of the GII Adirondack S. and the GIII Debutante S., but keep your eyes on **Forever Partners** (Not for Love). After taking her debut by a nose May 19, the Jersey-bred filly trounced her rivals by 11 lengths at Monmouth in the Colleen S. Aug. 3. Forever Partners made all the running that day and stopped the clock in 1:03 for the 5.5 furlongs. "She did it so easy, it was exciting to watch," said trainer Anthony Dutrow after the race.

Nobel Prize emulated Diego Lowther's stable stalwart El Gran Lode (Arg) in completing a successful international raid. The old warrior is a late developer and has only tackled stakes company this year. Having finished sixth in the Taby Varsprint June 4, he was third, beaten 2 1/2 lengths, by Toysome (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) in the G3 Grosser Preis von Berlin at Hoppegarten July 26 before winning the Listed Zawawi Cup on dirt at Jagersro Aug. 11. This time he raced prominently in fourth throughout the early stages as Just Heavens Gate (GB) (Slip Anchor {GB}) led at a steady pace. Making smooth progress on the outside as they turned into the straight, he passed Red Liason with 250 yards remaining before powering away to a convincing success, despite drifting left across the track late.

**SO FAR, SO GOOD FOR BOSQUE REDONDO**

John Toffan and Trudy McCaffery's **Bosque Redondo** (Mane Minister) is doing well after undergoing surgery Tuesday to repair broken sesamoids and a condylar fracture of his right front cannon bone. The five-year-old broke down while crossing the wire in the GI Pacific Classic, won by stablemate Came Home, Sunday at Del Mar. "The surgery went as well as it could," said Dr. Wayne McIlraith, who flew in from Colorado to perform the procedure. "I looked at him this morning [Wednesday] and he was doing very well. He had no temperature, he ate well and he was putting weight on the leg. We have the leg in a cast and it will remain on for two to three weeks." A bone plate and 16 screws were inserted during the two-hour surgery. Bosque Redondo will remain at the Equine Medical Center in Los Alamitos, California for about a week, then will be transferred to Toffan and McCaffery's farm in Bradbury, California. "The prognosis is very good," said Toffan. "He'll never run again, but it looks like he's going to get through this fine. Hopefully, I'll find a good place for him to stand at stud."

**EXCITING STORY RETIRED** Sovereign Award winner **Exciting Story** (Diablo--Appealing Story, by Valid Appeal), the winner of the 2001 GI Met Mile, has been retired, according to the *Daily Racing Form*. The Florida-bred, champion two-year-old in Canada after capturing two stakes at Woodbine and running third in the GI Hopeful S., was injured in the GI Grey Breeders' Cup S. at the end of the 1999 season. "He had his tendon sheath severed when he got stepped on in the Grey," trainer Mark Casse told *DRF*. "He almost died. When he was getting good at three--another horse jumped on his back leg. He had to be operated on twice, but overcame it all to win the Met Mile at four. He was truly a very good horse." As for the five-year-old's future, Casse said, "We've got some people interested in him as a stallion prospect. There's a chance he could go overseas, but nothing is firm yet." Exciting Story won just one of his 10 starts after the Met Mile, taking a Woodbine allowance test May 17. In his final appearance, an allowance test Aug. 17, he finished fifth as the even-money favorite. The chestnut retires with seven wins, six seconds and a third from 25 starts for earnings of \$911,270.

**'WAR' WAITING FOR ARLINGTON War Emblem** (Our Emblem) is unlikely to race again this year before the Oct. 26 GI Breeders' Cup Classic, the Thoroughbred Corporation's racing manager Richard Mulhall reports. "At the present time, we'll probably freshen him up and go directly to the Breeders' Cup Classic," Mulhall said. "He has run hard through the year and hasn't missed too many dances. He probably needs some freshening. I think that's what we'll do unless Bob [Baffert] changes his mind." War Emblem is coming off a sixth-place finish in the Pacific Classic, his first start against older horses. On an unrelated matter, Mulhall reports that no decisions have been made about the long-term status of the Thoroughbred Corp, which has been somewhat up in the air since the death of Prince Ahmed bin Salman. "Prince Faisal has not taken over," Mulhall said. "He is the executor of the will and is running things at this point. There have been no decisions as of yet. It isn't like he stepped in and took over. We really don't know what is going to happen yet. It's basically in the hands of the family and Prince Faisal."

The two-day Fasig Tipton Texas Summer Yearling Sale concluded Tuesday with gross receipts up substantially from one year ago. With a total of 261 head sold this year, over the 184 sold in 2001, gross receipts soared to \$2,702,500, rising from \$1,064,600 in 2001. The sale average almost doubled from last term, up from \$5,786 to \$10,354 this time, while the median held steady at \$5,000. A filly by freshman sire Tale of the Cat, out of the Val de l'Orne (Fr) mare Winthrop Arms, topped the sale with an \$85,000 final bid from Stonerside Stables' John Adger.

Trainer Kristin Mulhall, the daughter of The Thoroughbred Corporation's racing manager Richard Mulhall, saddled her first winner Monday, sending out **Atarama** (Sadler's Wells) to take an allowance test on the Del Mar turf. An accomplished rider on the show jumping circuit and an exercise rider at Santa Anita, Ms. Mulhall took out her trainer's license in May. She has 16 horses in her care at Del Mar, of which six are owned by The Thoroughbred Corporation. "Horses have always been the major interest in Kristin's life," said her father. "She was always working with our lay-ups and problem horses at Bradbury, and Prince Ahmed regularly asked for her opinion. Apart from her father, I know nobody would have been more proud than Prince Ahmed to see her lead in her first winner as a trainer."

**SHUTTLE STALLIONS REMAIN STRANDED**

The Southern Hemisphere breeding season is set to begin Monday, but 40 Thoroughbred shuttle stallions remain stranded at Eastern Creek Quarantine Centre on the outskirts of Western Sydney. The stallions were due to be released Tuesday, but were detained when a Canadian standardbred stallion exhibited symptoms consistent with West Nile Virus. Tests to date have proved negative, according to Australian Quarantine Inspection Service spokesman Carson Creagh. "We are pretty confident the results will be negative; the preliminary results are fairly strongly negative," Creagh told *TDN*. "The horse has been well. He had an elevated temperature and muscle twitch in his legs, but he recovered quickly and he is fine now." He added, "As far as we know, all the horses will be released later in the week. But it's our job to be professionally paranoid. The horse industry has expressed support. They know how much is at stake. We were concerned about West Nile virus, but not because there is any risk as horses are end-hosts of West Nile Virus. The other thing we were concerned about was the possibility of an exotic strain of equine herpes virus." Stallions including Widden's Mujahid (USA), Dr Fong (USA), Agnes World (USA) and Anabaa (USA), as well as Coolmore sires Galileo (Ire), Fasliyev (USA), Mull of Kintyre (USA), Orpen (USA), Peintre Celebre (USA) and Spinning World (USA) are in quarantine. Coolmore Australia manager Duncan Grimley said, "I hope they are released this week, but it is more likely to be Monday or Tuesday at the earliest," adding, "We don't think it is a problem at all if AQIS need extra time. They need to identify what this horse has got."
