HOPE AGAINST HOPE

Six two-year-old colts are set to line up for the first Grade I test in their division, the GI Hopeful S. this afternoon at Saratoga. At the head of the class is the speedy **Zavata** (Phone Trick), a \$575,000 FTFEB purchase who has won his last three starts by a combined 19 lengths, including a 7 1/4-length triumph at 2-5 in the GII Saratoga Special Aug. 14. "He has a lot of class and he can do everything," said trainer Patrick Biancone. One of the most impressive debut winners at the Saratoga meeting was **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit), who drew off by 7 3/4 lengths Aug. 3. Trainer John Ward is eager to give the \$750,000 KEESEP yearling purchase a class test. "He's giving up experience to Zavata," Ward acknowledged, "but on the bigger picture, the Hopeful puts us right where we need to be if we're going to get to the Breeders' Cup." Also stepping up from his debut victory is the royally bred **Roaring Fever** (Storm Cat), a full brother to MGISW Raging Fever. The dark bay, who battled on the front end en route to a 2 1/4-length victory Aug. 9, adds Lasix today. "I know he's got a lot of potential," hedged trainer Mark Hennig. "He may have to get beat a time or two to figure everything out." Whatever the result, this year's Hopeful hero has a tough act to follow: the 2001 winner, Came Home set a new stakes record 1:21 4/5 while defeating Mayakovsky and has gone on this year to capture the GI Pacific Classic and the GI Santa Anita Derby.

Easy Way and Andreas Suborics got the better of Checkit and Steve Drowne in a driving finish to this contest, but had the prize taken from them for interference in the closing stages. Checkit was forced to race in sixth early off the furious tempo as Fiepes Shuffle was sent into a clear lead. Sent wide into the centre of the track as the leader turned for home along the rail, Checkit quickened in pursuit of the front-runner, who was staying on in determined fashion. Easy Way threw down his challenge to join the battle inside the final quarter-mile. Checkit was bumped in the shadow of the post, and it was judged sufficient to have affected the outcome by the Baden Baden stewards. For Checkit, who finished third behind Elusive City in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood July 30, this was a well-deserved first stakes success. Having finished third behind Le Vie dei Colori (GB) in the G3 Premio Primi Passi at Milan June 16, he was beaten a short head by Balkenhol (Ire) in the Listed Premio Giuseppe de Montel there July 3. 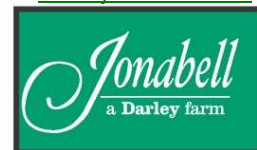

NOVERRE TO WOODBINE? Noverre (Rahy) could make his next start in the GI Atto Mile at Woodbine a week from Sunday, *Racing Post* reports. The four-year-old, whose last North American effort resulted in a seventh-place finish as the favorite in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Belmont Park last October, also holds an entry for the G1 Ireland the Food Island Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown the previous afternoon. "We made the provisional entry for the Atto Mile some time ago and this fits into his program quite well," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford told *Racing Post*. "There is a strong possibility he will go there, but he has a host of entries in other Group 1 events. He wouldn't have to go until Tuesday, so we have got the weekend to think about it." Noverre was last seen when third, beaten two lengths, in the G1 Juddmonte International S. over 10 furlongs Aug. 20.

JET CRASHES NEAR KEENELAND An air ambulance crashed at Blue Grass Airport yesterday afternoon, resulting in at least one fatality, according to the *Lexington Herald*. A Lear jet operated by Care Flight International was attempting to land, but reportedly crashed at the end of the runway, plunged down a hill and plowed through a fence onto the highway, where it struck a westbound coal truck. The airport at which the jet was attempting to land is located across the street from Keeneland Racecourse. One passenger, a woman, was reportedly killed in the crash, while three others remain in serious condition at the University of Kentucky Hospital. According to Tom Tyra, an airport spokesman, a fifth person was on board, but no information is available concerning that person's condition.

AUSSIE SHUTTLERS LEAVE QUARANTINE The dual-hemisphere stallions, held in Sydney's main quarantine facility due to concerns over a Canadian standardbred horse which tested positive for the West Nile Virus, were released from quarantine early Friday morning and are on their way to their respective studs throughout Australia. WHAT'S DOING DOWN UNDER

SUNDAY SILENCE REMEMBERED

The loss of Sunday Silence will be felt keenly in Australia, but his legacy will be felt here for some time to come, with his select first Southern Hemisphere crop now early three-year-olds.

Three from seven named Australian-foaled Sunday Silence horses have raced, including the Gai Waterhouse-trained Sunday Joy. Already a stakes winner, she was scheduled to race in the Listed Sheraco S. at 1100 meters today.

Sunday Joy, a A\$1 million Magic Millions purchase, won the Listed Tommy Smith S. during a juvenile campaign comprising four starts for Waterhouse.

"She has come back to the yard in superb order, she is a well above average filly and definitely showing shades of Group 1 ability," Waterhouse told *TDN*. "She is poetry in motion. Everything she does is amazing, she has a wonderfully fluid action and a lovely temperament. I probably haven't had a filly as talented as Sunday Joy."

Prominent agent Rob McAnulty gave A\$700,000 on behalf of Hong Kong clients for the Sunday Silence filly Sunday Whisper at Magic Millions in 2001. This year, he paid A\$1 million for a Sunday Silence colt at the Inglis Easter sale.

"The Tinaca colt has been broken in at Scone and there are glowing reports; he will go to Clarry Conners, and we won't expect too much from him as a two-year-old, McAnulty said. "But they are fabulous horses and when you think you aren't going to get too much from them early, they surprise you. Both Sunday Whisper and Gai's filly won over six furlongs as early two-year-olds, so prepare to be surprised is my motto with Sunday Silence.

"I didn't think I would have enough money to buy Sunday Whisper and, by world standards, they are cheap. It is not a lot of money for what they are. They are rare jewels."

He continued, "Sunday Whisper has really strengthened and when she gets to a mile, or mile and a half, she will come into her own. If she comes up as good as we think she is, I would like to see her running in the U.S. as a four and five year old. It's a pipe dream right now, but that's my plan."

Graeme Begg trains the other Sunday Silence to have started, the filly Lavishly, who was retained by Arrowfield chief John Messara after bidding stalled short of her A\$550,000 reserve at Easter 2001.

"She was a very nice foal, but she was quite a narrow, athletic yearling," Messara said. "She didn't have the body strength the market likes to see, but we know her family, that of Linamix, is noted for being angular, and we took the view we were happy to retain her."

At her only start to date, Lavishly was beaten a short neck at Randwick over 1200 meters.

"She surprised me greatly at her first start, she'd had a limited education and she wasn't cranked up and she went within half a length of winning," said Begg.

Those in the wings include a colt from the immediate family of Faithful Son purchased by Darley for A\$1.2 million at Easter this year for a colt.

"He is by one of the best stallions in the world from a family that Sheikh Mohammed knows plenty about, but apart from that, he was simply a magnificent individual," said Darley Australian manager Oliver Tait.

The colt is under the tutelage of Lindsay Park trainer Tony McEvoy.

John Hawkes prepares a colt from Bletchingly mare Wrap Around, named Sunday Knight, and the colt will trial in coming weeks.

Sunday Silence yearlings that will be offered in Australasia in 2003 include a colt from the Mr. Prospector mare Phantom Creek, herself a winner over 1200 metres at Nad Al Sheba. She is from a Northern Dancer three-quarter sister to Joyeux Danseur and Fabuleux Dancer. Phantom Creek is a half-sister to Cartier Horse of the Year and champion U.S. two-year-old Arazi and to Group 1 winner Noverre.

"Mark my words, he is special," Messara said.

The colt is likely to be offered at the 2003 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale.

Sunday Silence was leading sire on sale average at the 2002 Australasian majors, with seven sold at an average A\$711,429 and median of A\$517,500, ahead of Danehill (average A\$359,187 for 68 sold) and Zabeel (average A\$182,269 for 92 sold).
