THE SKY'S THE LIMIT

Trainer John Ward has a four-race plan for **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit) and the handsome colt has duly obliged thus far, upsetting 1-5 **Zavata** (Phone Trick) to take the GI Hopeful S. yesterday at Saratoga. The bay colt posted a 7 3/4-length success in his Aug. 3 bow and was sent off as the 7-2 second choice. Breaking alertly from the outside, the John Oxley colorbearer stalked the leaders while three wide as Zavata rushed up along the rail. Sky Mesa kept the favorite penned in before challenging **Pretty Wild** (Wild Again) in the stretch, put a head in front in the final furlong and drew off. "That's a very good effort for a second start, but he's a big, strong, handsome horse with a good mind," said Ward. **Cont. p2**

FABULOUS FOREGO

This year's GI Forego H., the last Grade I event of the Saratoga meet, will featured the return of 2001 Eclipse champion **Squirtle Squirt** (Marquetry). The four-year-old hasn't raced since running second in the GII Palos Verdes H. back in January and has been laid up following knee surgery. "He's not a 100 percent," acknowledged trainer Bobby Frankel. "It's always a concern when you're coming off a long layoff and facing good horses, but he's doing good." Always a pace factor, Squirtle Squirt will have to contend with the speedy **Orientate** (Mt. Livermore), whose three-race skein includes victories in the GII A.G. Vanderbilt, the GIII Aristides and the Smile Sprint H. "We've got respect for everyone in there, but I think we've established ourselves as the premier sprinter in the country," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. If a serious speed duel develops, Frankel's other entrant **Aldebaran** (Mr. Prospector) could be the main beneficiary. The late-running four-year-old has been the runner-up in each of his last three starts, including the GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup H. in April and the GI Met Mile May 27, and comes off a second in a local seven-furlong allowance test Aug. 3. "He's much better now than he was for that race," said Frankel. "There was no pace in there, but he still put in a good run." **Explicit** (Distant View) was given a brief vacation following his victory in the GII True North Breeders' Cup June 8, his seventh start and third win of the year. "The Forego has been our target all along," said trainer Ian Jory. "I've always said he had the quality to run in the Breeders' Cup. We're going to prove that this fall."

HOPE SPRINGS ETERNAL After his maiden score, **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit) came down with a lung infection, but John Ward was confident that his charge was capable of taking on **Zavata** (Phone Trick). "At this time of year, two-year-old racing is not about experience, it's about strength," he explained. "This horse is a strong, smart horse." It seems likely that Sky Mesa will next tackle two turns in the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland Oct. 5 before heading to Arlington for the Oct. 26 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, which will be run this year at nine furlongs. Runner-up **Pretty Wild** (Wild Again) ran very well at 17-1, battling with Roaring Fever (Storm Cat) through the early fractions before giving way grudgingly to the winner. "We're tickled to death," said trainer Stanley Hough. "He ran great. I'll nominate to the Futurity [GI, 1m, Sept. 15], either that or the Champagne [GI, 8.5f, Oct. 5]." As for the favorite, Zavata was forced to check soon after the start and nearly ran up on the heels of the pacesetters. He switched to the outside in the stretch, but flattened out on his way to third. "He didn't get away [from the gate] real good, but we've been training him behind horses," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "The way he's been working, I thought he'd run those horses down, but that's not how it worked out."

XTRA HEAT TO SELL AT FASIG NOVEMBER
Xtra Heat (Dixieland Heat), the champion three-year-old filly of 2001, will be offered for sale at the Fasig-Tipton Selected November Mixed Sale to be held in Lexington Nov. 3. The four-year-old, second to Squirtle Squirt in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint a year ago, is scheduled to make her next start in the GIII Endine S. at Delaware Park next Saturday. That event will serve as her final prep for this year's Breeders' Cup at Arlington Park Oct. 26. "We're selling her as insurance," trainer John Salzman, who co-owns the filly with Harry Deitchman and Kenneth Taylor, told *Thoroughbred Times*. "We're not rich guys; we're all poor boys. So we can't afford to take the risk of breeding her, because she may not turn out to be much of a broodmare, and then we're in trouble." A winner of 22 of her 28 career starts, including a remarkable 21 stakes, the bay has banked over \$1.7 million.

COWBOY STUFF took his fourth stakes of 2002 with a victory in the Iowa Breeders Derby on Saturday.

Miss Houdini pulled a fast one on 4-5 Santa Catarina, getting first run on the favorite, then holding off her late surge to earn a Grade I victory in her second start. The dark bay had come from off the pace to take her career opener at Hollywood July 13, but missed some time with an infection in her hind leg. Breaking a step slowly, the 11-1 shot tugged her way up into contention on the outside as Santa Catarina drafted in behind the leaders through a half in :44.98. Miss Houdini came away with the lead turning for home and opened up by two lengths, with Santa Catarina forced to wait at the head of the stretch. The favorite found running room and came charging up the rail, but Miss Houdini found the wire in time. For trainer Warren Stute, it was his first Debutante victory since winning with the inaugural running with Tonga back in 1951. It was a good pick-up mount for jockey Gary Stevens, who got the call aboard Miss Houdini after Eddie Delahoussaye, the filly's pilot in her debut, was injured in a spill Friday night. Buffythecenterfold (Capote) tired to finish seventh after disputing the early pace.

Yet another star in the red-and-yellow colors of Sam-Son Farm, Full of Wonder became the third Grade I winner for his champion dam when he came from just off the pace to earn his first stakes success. The dark bay returned from a 10-month layoff to break his maiden in his turf bow Jan. 26 and promptly added an allowance victory Mar. 3, but was thrown to the wolves in his next start, running 14th in the GII Explosive Bid H. He fared better next out, beaten 3 3/4 lengths when third in the GIII Elkhorn at Keeneland, and went on to post consecutive allowance triumphs over this course. Although he failed to run down Stage Classic (Sky Classic) in his latest, an Aug. 11 allowance, Full of Wonder was sent off as the second choice along with his full brother, Strike Smartly. As Stage Classic went up to set the early pace, Full of Wonder was content to settle near the back of the pack, but began to move into striking position approaching the far turn. He came charging three wide, collared the favorite Perfect Soul and outbattled that rival for the victory. "He's beautifully bred and he's been running well this year," said winning trainer Mark Frostad.

Foss Way took part in the competitive six-furlong conditions event won by Greek Revival at Newmarket's July meeting on his debut and ran creditably to finish fourth there before winning a Goodwood maiden July 30. This time, he was held up towards the rear as Royal Robe (Ire) (King of Kings {Ire}) pulled his way to the front. That colt's keenness ensured a generous tempo, and when the leaders started to fold inside the final quarter-mile, it was left to the closers to stake their claim. Short of room on the inner, Foss Way was switched wide, challenged Sweet Return at the furlong marker and steadily wore down his rival to lead in the final strides. "He had a lot of trouble getting out and he was knocked back to last," said trainer John Gosden. "He didn't like the ground at the July course and then won his maiden nicely and Kieren [Fallon] said pick him up to seven furlongs. He'll definitely get a mile, but I don't know much beyond that. His father got a mile very well and he will be a miler next year. He is the kind of horse who ought to be thought of for the Guineas--whether it would be more the French variety rather than the English time will tell. He's the sort of horse who should have another race this year to complete his education because at the end of the day he's still a little bit green. There's nothing worse than taking a horse into these Classics next year if they don't fully know the game." Click [here](#) for the racingpost.com chart.

Those tactics are the key to this colt, who was held up in rear of the group in the centre of the track led by Cape Town (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) throughout the early stages. Devious Indian was asked to quicken at the quarter-mile marker, where the main group started to cross over towards the rail. As Dedication struck the front, Devious Indian was sent in pursuit and when the gaps appeared he had enough acceleration to seize the opportunity, wearing down that rival in the final strides.

Danaskaya beat Great Pyramid (Ire) by a half-length in a Naas maiden July 24 before running Russian Rhythm to 1 1/4 lengths when runner-up in the G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 22. She sets the standard this time, but tackles an extra furlong and although her dam won over 10 furlongs, she is a half sister to the talented sprinter Kistena (Fr), winner of the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye. Nevertheless, jockey Kevin Manning has chosen her over stablemate **Luminata**, who was seventh behind Spartacus (Ire) in the G1 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 11 last time. She was beaten just four lengths on that occasion, but similar stamina doubts surround her chance here, as her dam's half sister Eva Luna (Ire) was at her best over six furlongs when winning the G1 Phoenix S. in 1994. **Pearl Dance** was third in the Listed Henry Carnarvon S. at Royal Ascot June 22 before filling the same position behind Spinola (Fr) in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket July 9. She looks guaranteed to relish this extra distance, as does **Anna Frid**, winner of a Fairyhouse maiden Aug. 25, and **Alexander Anapolis**, who was third in an above average maiden over this course Aug. 11. Trainer Aidan O'Brien was forced to scratch Reach for the Moon when that filly came down with a cough.

She looked to have Yavana's Pace (Ire) beaten everywhere bar the final 50 yards last time in the G1 Credit Suisse Private Banking Pokal at Cologne Aug. 11 before going down by a half length. Interestingly, jockey Andrasch Starke has chosen her over stable companion **Samum**, who returns to the scene of his finest hour, when beating Catella (Ger) by 2 1/2 lengths in the 2000 renewal. Last time, he put up an improved performance when third behind Marienbard in the WGZ Bank-Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf last time, but he needs to better that effort to contend with the major players here.

Gulfstream In Deep Water:

The South Florida Water Management District is pointing the finger at Gulfstream Park's training track in Boynton Beach for the loss of more than 17 feet of water from lakes that make up Venetian Isles. Palm Meadows, owned by Gulfstream's parent company Magna Entertainment Corporation, is just south of the community of Venetian Isles in Boynton Beach and is in the process of digging a 35-foot lake in the center of its three training tracks. Water District officials said the 35-foot lake being dug by contractors was siphoning off water from its neighbors' lake. The contractors working on the training center were pumping the water out of their lake into a nearby Lake Worth Drainage District canal. Since the water district ordered Magna to stop work on the lake on August 19, the water in the lakes at Venetian Isles has stopped receding. The agency said Gulfstream is in line for fines because the excavation broke water district rules.
