### IT'S IN THE MAIL

**Mail the Desert (Ire)** (Desert Prince {Ire}) battled to an all-the-way success in yesterday's G1 Moyglare Stud S. at the Curragh. Having finished 1 1/4 lengths second to Geminiani (Ire) in the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood last Sunday, owner John Livock and trainer Mick Channon decided to pitch her back into battle here in a weak-looking renewal of this Group 1 contest. "Mail the Desert is very game and kept pulling out plenty for me," commented winning rider Steve Drowne. "I wasn't able to get a lead as the boss had suggested, because there was no one keen to make it, and I let my filly stride on." Breaking best from the gate under Drowne, Mail the Desert set a steady tempo throughout the early stages as Richard Hughes tracked her closely in second on **Pearl Dance** (Nureyev). As Mail the Desert applied the pressure from the front, the leading duo looked to have stolen a march on the chasing pack, led by Luminata (Ire) (Indian Ridge) and Seamus Heffernan. As Drowne's filly gave more to assert over Pearl Dance inside the closing stages, it was Luminata who stayed on to grab second in the final strides without threatening the winner. Mail the Desert was fourth in the Listed Henry Carnarvon S. at Royal Ascot June 22 before filling the same spot behind Six Perfections (Fr) in the Listed Prix Roland De Chambure at Deauville July 11. Burdened with a three-pound penalty in both the Listed Star S. at Sandown July 25 and Listed Sweet Solera S. at Newmarket Aug. 10, she ran respectably when third in the former before disappointing on soft ground when seventh behind the smart Soviet Song (GB) in the latter. **Click for the:** [racingpost.com chart](http://racingpost.com/chart) [brisnet.com catalog-style pedigree](http://brisnet.com/catalog-style/pedigree).

### ORIENTATE SKIPS TO FOREGO WIN

"I think we dispelled the theory that if he's hooked, he won't run on," trainer D. Wayne Lukas said after his **Orientate** (Mt. Livermore) outbattled champion Squirtle Squirt (Marquetry) and kicked clear to win yesterday's G1 Forego H. at Saratoga by 2 1/4 lengths. Despite winning three straight springs, including the Aug. 11 GII A G Vanderbilt H., Orientate's detractors pointed out that the speedy colt had never been tested early. That changed yesterday when he and Squirtle Squirt, making his first start since January, dueled through zippy fractions of :21.45 and :44.36. As his rival began to tire, Orientate pulled clear and won in hand. "I think he's clearly established himself as the best sprinter in the country," Lukas added. "I think he went to the head of the class today." The trainer listed the Sept. 21 G1 Vosburgh or the GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup at Keeneland Oct. 5 as possible targets for Orientate, while leaving open the possibility of training up to the Breeders' Cup Sprint. Of fourth-place finisher Squirtle Squirt, trainer Bobby Frankel said, "I think Squirtle Squirt will improve a lot off that race." **SAKHEE RULED OUT OF CHAMPION**

**Sakhee** (Bahri) will be replaced by stable companion **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) as Godolphin's representative in Saturday's G1 Ireland the Food Island Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. Last year's International Classifications highweight was not among Godolphin's provisional plan for the 10-furlong contest, which may feature one of Aidan O'Brien's trio of **Hawk Wing** (Woodman), **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill). Grandera, who took the G1 Prince Of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot June 19 before finishing a disappointing fifth in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 27, is likely to be the sole Godolphin runner in the race taken last year's by the stable's Fantastic Light.

Marienbard proved a class apart from his rivals to take his second Group 1 prize in Germany and book his place in the line-up for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 6. Having tracked the moderate pace in a close-up fourth throughout, Frankie Dettori unleashed his mount's potent turn of acceleration in the straight and the result was settled in a few strides. "We really fancied him very strongly because he is really peaking at the moment," Simon Crisford, racing manager to Godolphin explained. "Sheikh Mohammed was just talking about the Arc, and I think now he deserves to go for it, as he's at the top of his game--he's really coming into his own." Marienbard, winner of the G2 Yorkshire Cup at York last May, ended his 2001 campaign down under with a seventh in the G1 Melbourne Cup in November. He showed his best this year on a fast surface with a 1 1/2-length victory in the G1 WGZ Bank-Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf July 28 last time out. Here he was settled in fourth by Dettori off a pedestrian pace. "The only thing that worried us was the pace, and unfortunately it was a crawl and a sprint," Dettori explained. The Italian jockey set Marienbard alight at the quarter-mile marker. "Once he hit top gear and stretched away it was all over--he gave me a good feel," Dettori added. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor said, "Sheikh Mohammed told me to run him in the Arc, and this is the next race for him. He looks a different horse this year; stronger and happier. Delta Form raced in South Africa before making his stateside debut at Del Mar last summer. The gelding raced only twice in 2001 and returned from a nine-month layoff to run fourth in a July 7 Hollywood allowance followed by a third in an Aug. 15 Del Mar optional claimer last time out. A 20-1 longshot to earn his second U.S. win, the Aussie-bred rated behind the pace-setters, began moving up along the rail on the final bend and closed stoutly to overtake The Tin Man in deep stretch. "He was giving me his best," jockey Goncalino Almeida said of the winner. "I'm happy for [winning trainer] Jenine [Sahadi]. She trusts me and I'm glad she got rewarded for it." Sahadi added, "This horse is not crazy about switching leads and I was worried about the tight turns, but [co-owner] Gary [Barber] was adamant about running here and he had a lot of faith in this horse. Goncalino breezed this horse the best he's ever breezed and he switched leads on cue and that was a little strange because he hasn't done that before. So Gonzo did a great job and I'm happy for everybody involved." **Click for the:**

Danehurst produced her customary late rattle to cut down Lady Dominatrix in the shade of the post for her most important success to date. Although she took three Listed events last term, her disappointing effort when unplaced in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in October left questions about her ability unanswered. She confirmed that she was top class when second to Malhub on her return in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot June 22. Subsequently third in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 11, she disappointed again when 14th in the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York last time Aug. 22. Wearing blinkers for the first time in this contest, she was held up in last place early by George Duffield as Lady Dominatrix blazed the trail. Looking for room inside the final 11/2 furlongs as the long-time leader galloped on powerfully in front, she found space on the inner and picked up well to deny that spirited filly in the final stride.

Triple Crown veteran **Harlan's Holiday** makes his first start for trainer Todd Pletcher in this affair. The colt, winner of the GI Florida Derby and GI Blue Grass earlier in the year, ran seventh as the Kentucky Derby favorite and has been off since finishing fourth in the May 18 GI Preakness. **Wiseman's Ferry**, winner of the GIII Lone Star Derby in May, was intent on running wire-to-wire in the July 20 GII Ohio Derby, but was passed late by **Magic Weisner**. He employed those same tactics to earn a narrow score in the GIII West Virginia Derby last time out Aug. 10. Magic Weisner, second in the Preakness and Haskell Invitational, will miss the race with a fever. Godolphin's **Essence of Dubai** earned a trip to the Kentucky Derby with victories in the G3 UAE Guineas and G2 UAE Derby. The well-bred colt was ninth in Louisville and sixth in the Belmont. He was promoted to third after a fourth-place finish in the Aug. 4 GII Jim Dandy last time out.
