DERBY DOUBLE FOR HARLAN'S HOLIDAY

Harlan's Holiday (Harlan) failed to bag the 'mother of all Derbies' when he ran seventh behind War Emblem in the GI Kentucky Derby May 4, but he would not be denied a second Derby when he drew off late to win yesterday's GIII Pennsylvania Derby at Philadelphia Park. Following the defection of Magic Weisner and Iron Deputy, Philadelphia's centerpiece was whittled down to only five contestants, and the crowd accurately made the sole Grade I winner in the field the joint even-money choice. Pacesetter **Wiseman's Ferry** (Hennessy) veered wide at the start and Harlan's Holiday took advantage to save ground on the first turn while settling in second. Holding that position through the opening six furlongs, the bay bid for the lead past the quarter pole, passed tiring Wiseman's Ferry and drew off late for the easy win.

CONGAREE VICTORIOUS AT DEL MAR

Congaree (Arazi) proved he had at least one more win left under his belt with a gutsy victory yesterday in the Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. Last year, the colt won the GI Wood Memorial before finishing third in the GI Kentucky Derby and the GI Preakness S. Fresh from a two-month layoff, he won the GI Swaps S. at Hollywood in July before ending 2001 with a distant third in the GI Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga last August. Congaree returned in 2002 with an impressive score in the Lone Star Park H. May 27, but slipped in a stinker when sixth in the GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs June 15. Favored here following a third-place finish last time in the GII San Diego H. Aug. 4 off another two-month respite, Congaree took command early, fought off the challenge of **Prodigious** (Son of Briartic) through the opening six furlongs, inched ahead leaving the second turn and held on courageously in the stretch. "[Trainer] Bob [Baffert] told me to keep him off the fence," said winning jockey Mike Smith. "He thought he'd relax better out there. He was right. [Congaree] was going fast and easy. Second to With Ability in the GIII Sixty Sails H. at Sportsman's Park in April, Lakenheath was off the board in her next two starts, but rebounded to post an 11-length victory in an optional-claiming event at Arlington July 17. The chestnut filly shipped to Ellis Park for her most recent outing and finished second in the Aug. 10 GIII Gardenia H. The third choice in this five-horse field, she tracked her Sixty Sails nemesis through six furlongs in 1:11.10, went after the pacesetter in the stretch and wore her down after a prolonged stretch duel to take the photo. "My filly was getting a little tired, but she wouldn't give up," winning jockey Chris Emigh said. Added trainer Gene Cilio, "With Ability beat us handily in the Sixty Sails, but our filly is getting to know more of what she has to do. She went right after her today and beat a very game filly." Jockey Robby Albarado, aboard runner-up With Ability, said, "It was a big race for my horse. I had everything go my way, but Chris had a nice filly and he rode a great race." Band Is Passing, the winner of the GII Appleton H. in 2000, finished in the money in six of eight 2001 starts, including a pair of victories in the Blazing Bart H. over this same course and distance last June and the Dec. 8 GIII Tropical Turf H., again over this track, in his seasonal finale. With only a pair starts this term, the six-year-old appeared poised to improve off a solid 2002 debut, a second-place finish in the 1 3/8-mile GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. Feb. 16, however, the bay could only manage a fifth-place finish behind Unite's Big Red (Unite) in Gulfstream's Equalize S. over this distance Mar. 16. A generously supported second choice this time despite returning from a 5 1/2-month layoff, Band Is Passing settled in fourth through the opening four furlongs behind early leader Marquette (Spectacular Bid). The homebred challenged the front rank from the outside down the backstretch, but cut over to the hedge as he took over at the quarter pole. With the race firmly in his pocket, the joint highweight edged clear late for the win. According to trainer Stanley Ersoff, Band Is Passing is being aimed at the Tropical Turf H. Dec. 7 as his ultimate target.

Ibn Al Haitham (GB) showed promise when he placed behind Essence of Dubai in the GII Norfolk S. at Santa Anita as a juvenile, but he didn't make an impact in his two-year-old finale, a ninth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Belmont. Third in his sophomore debut in the G2 UAE Derby at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23, the dark bay finished fifth in his next start in the GII Peter Pan S. before settling for sixth when dropping back to maiden company at Belmont July 7, his final start for trainer Saeed bin Suroor. Inspired by the change over to the turf last time for a 1 3/8-mile maiden at Saratoga, the colt destroyed a field of nine to win by 9 1/2 lengths. Sent off the second choice to score his first graded-stakes score, the English-bred raced close to early leader Regal Sanction (Regal Classic) and continued to track that horse through a modest three quarters. With an eye firmly set on the lead, the colt took over heading into the stretch and dug in gamely late for a narrow victory over a slow-closing Finality. "The horse was push-button, he did everything right," said winning jockey Richard Migliore. "He was just in a kind of high gallop down the backstretch and when we straightened up off the turn for home, he dropped his head and finished well."

Lone Star Sky started his career with a maiden win at Arlington Park June 13 and came back July 7 to take the GIII Bashford Manor S. by 3 1/2 lengths at Churchill Downs. The bay shipped to Saratoga from his homebase at Churchill for his latest effort and finished second, beaten 7 1/4 lengths by Zavata, after being steadied on the far turn in the GII Saratoga Special. The odds-on choice facing a softer field here, Lone Star Sky was bumped around on the first turn, but recovered to press longshot Payforaday through six furlongs in 1:11 3/5. winner for freshman sire (by Green Desert).

I know it sounds contradictory, but it is possible for a stallion's first yearlings to sell almost too well. With yearling prices well out of proportion with the stallion's fee, the stallion can become the focus of unrealistic expectations. If he fails to meet those expectations, the backlash is usually against the young stallion, rather than the buyers who lost their grip on reality in the rush to buy a youngster by the latest hot young sire.

I rather feared that the Irish National Stud's Desert Prince could become an innocent victim of this phenomenon when the word went around the sales arenas that this son of Green Desert was the next big thing.

Don't get me wrong, there was every reason to expect this handsome horse to make the grade as a stallion. Although he achieved less as a two-year-old than had once had seemed likely, he made full amends the following year when he took three of Europe's most competitive mile events--the Irish 2000 Guineas, the Prix du Moulin and the Queen Elizabeth II S. In addition to a very solid record on the track, Desert Prince had the attraction of being by a stallion who had already shown distinct promise as a sire of sires. He also has a classic-winning mare as his second dam, his female line being one of Europe's richest sources of high-class winners (but generally not of successful stallions).

Bargain Price Yields Solid Returns...

Altogether, he represented a very attractive proposition at his fee of Ir20,000 guineas, especially in a year when there were very few new stallions in the higher price bracket in Europe. It was no surprise to see him receive a book of over 110 mares in 1999, to produce a first crop of 100.

The foal sales of 2000 provided the first concrete proof of how much was expected of Desert Prince. At Ir£190,000, his son out of Ploy was the highest-priced weanling at Goffs' November Sale and, at 230,000 guineas, his daughter out of Green Rosy was the top-priced weanling at Tattersalls' December Sales. Altogether, he had eight weanlings sold for six-figure sums, helping him achieve an average roughly five times his fee.

After this welcome, Desert Prince was a certainty to hit the headlines at the next year's yearling sales and he didn't disappoint, even though his median price was as low as 30,020 guineas. He achieved the remarkable feat for an unproven stallion of siring the year's top-priced yearling--a feat he achieved when his spectacular son out of the G1 winner Park Express sold to Gainsborough Stud Management for 2,300,000 guineas. Other big battalions prepared to pay substantial prices for Desert Prince's youngsters included Demi O'Byrne, John Ferguson, the Thoroughbred Corporation and John Gosden, acting for Sheikh Mohammed.

With this strength of support behind him, Desert Prince clearly had to make an immediate impact if he was to avoid being labelled disappointing. Happily for the Irish National Stud, the seven-year-old stallion is now back in the headlines thanks to a hard-fought Group race double over 7 furlongs at the weekend. First, John Gosden's colt Foss Way snatched victory in the G3 Solario S., and then Mick Channon's tough filly Mail The Desert courageously turned back several challengers to take the G1 Moyglare Stud S.

The fascinating aspect of Foss Way's pedigree is that he is inbred 3x3 to the great Danzig. Inbreeding closely to a horse who was restricted by physical problems to only three starts might seem a dangerous ploy, but it has clearly worked in this instance. Foss Way's success will no doubt encourage more experimentation in Europe and Australia, where breeders are sure to send Danehill mares to Fusaichi Pegasus, again creating 3x3 to Danzig.

Mail The Desert--like Foss Way a graduate of Goffs' Orby Sale--has a lot of pedigree for a filly bought for Ir£54,000. Her fourth dam, Kyak, won the Park Hill Stakes--the so-called Fillies' St Leger--and so did two other daughters of the outstanding broodmare Felucca. All three daughters--Kyak, Cutter and Ark Royal--bred important winners and Kyak found lasting fame through her Ribot filly Ripeck, who ranks as Mail The Desert's third dam.

Ripeck was almost incapable of producing anything other than very talented performers, numbering the Oaks winner Bireme and the St Leger second Buoy among her six stakes winners. Mail The Desert's second dam, Boathouse, wasn't one of those stakes winners, but she was still very good, as her Timeform rating of 116 indicates.

Although Boathouse has produced only three winners from nine foals, four of her non-winning daughters have produced Group performers somewhere or other. One, Charlotte Dundas, has a G1 winner in Brazil by Gilded Time, while another, Head of the River, is dam of a champion juvenile filly in New Zealand. Another daughter, Laugharne, produced Power Lake, a tough and fast juvenile, to Formidable, the stallion responsible for Mail The Desert's dam, the unraced Mail Boat.

Several of the black-type performers descending from Kyak have Mill Reef somewhere in their pedigree and this may have provided the incentive to send Mail Boat to Desert Prince, a horse inbred 4x4 to Never Bend through Courtly Dee and Mill Reef.

The Recipe for Victory...

"We were well aware that Wiseman's Ferry was the only speed in the race," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "I left it up to [jockey] Edgar [Prado] as to how to ride the race." The winner of the GI Florida Derby at Gulfstream Park Mar. 16, Harlan's Holiday made it two in a row with another impressive score in the GI Blue Grass S. Apr. 13 before his Kentucky Derby loss as the chilly 6-1 favorite. Last time out, the usually consistent bay failed to fire his best shot and came home fourth in the GI Preakness S. at Pimlico May 18, his final race for trainer Kenny McPeck. "We expected him to be a lot sharper off the layoff," said Pletcher. "Kenny [McPeck] did a marvelous job with this horse and he deserves a lot of credit. We had hoped today we'd see the horse we'd seen all spring."

He could have probably run again, but not at the top level. You have to be 100 percent to race in Group 1 races, so we decided to retire him. He's certainly the best horse I've trained to date. He had many qualities--the best were his character and an outstanding turn of foot. He's been brought by a French breeder and will either stand in France or Ireland. Keltos is in the process of being syndicated; an announcement will be made early next week." The four-year-old was sixth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp last year before winning the Listed Prix de Pontarme at Chantilly. Subsequently sixth in the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot, he was rested before returning to win the G3 Prix Perth at Saint-Cloud in November. Eighth behind Street Cry (Ire) in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23, he returned to Europe to take the G2 Prix du Muguet at Saint-Cloud May 1 before his Newbury success. The colt retires with six wins and a second from 10 career starts for earnings of \$285,770.

WILDENSTEIN BUYS INTO MARGARULA Alec Wildenstein has purchased a half-share in **Margarula (Ire)** (Doyoun {Ire}), the *Racing Post* revealed yesterday. Having beaten Quarter Moon (Ire) by two lengths in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 14, the Jim Bolger-trained filly may now be supplemented at a cost of €100,000 for Saturday's G1 Ireland The Food Island Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown.

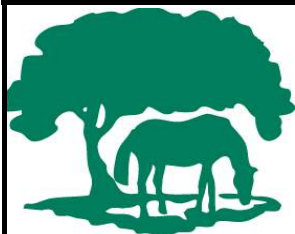
