BELMONT RETURNS WITH A VENGEANCE

Racing returns to Belmont Park Friday and the meet gets off to a roaring start with a Super Saturday card that includes three Grade I events. Veterans **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold) and **With Anticipation** (Relaunch) seek repeat wins in the GI Woodward and GI Man o' War, respectively,

while a talented field of three-year-old fillies will square off in the GI Gazelle H. Trainer Bobby Frankel's Lido Palace won both the GI Whitney and the Woodward last year before ending the season with an eighth-place effort in the G1 Japan Cup. The five-year-old Chilean-bred is

winless in three starts this year, most recently running third in the Whitney, but Frankel is confident Lido Palace can regain his winning form Saturday. "He's the class and it's weight for age," Frankel commented. "He's doing really well." With Anticipation, a seven-year-old gelding, will seek to become only the third horse in 44 years to win back-to-back runnings of the Man o' War. The gray is coming off victories in the GI United Nations H. and GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. "What's amazing about him is that he maintains his enthusiasm at his age," trainer Jonathon Sheppard said of With Anticipation. In the Gazelle, three distaffers will try and reassert their positions among the top of the deep sophomore fillies division. Godolphin's **Imperial Gesture** (Langfuhr) dominated competition at Nad al Sheba before an eighth-place effort in the GI Kentucky Oaks. "She got banged up at the start of the Oaks and ran hard just trying to catch up through the race," explained assistant trainer Tom Albertrani. "She didn't seem herself afterwards. She was dull in her training and lost a lot of weight." Given time off after the Oaks, Imperial Gesture impressed with a six-length allowance victory at Saratoga in her Aug. 23 return to the races. Also in the Gazelle field is GSW **Bella Bellucci** (French Deputy), off since an 11 3/4-length allowance win at Belmont July 19 and **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere), off since winning the May 25 GIII Dogwood.

MAGIC WEISNER IMPROVES Preakness runner-up Magic Weisner (Ameri Valay) appears to be improving from a mysterious neurological disorder which afflicted him over the weekend, according to *The Baltimore Sun*. Magic Weisner remains at New Bolton Center in Kennett Square, Pennsylvania, but his Maryland-based veterinarian Dr. Bob Vallance is encouraged by the gelding's condition. "They're not really sure what's wrong with him," Vallance told the *Sun* yesterday. "But I'm very optimistic because his condition is improving rather than deteriorating." Nancy Alberts, who bred, owns and trains Magic Weisner, admitted, "He's a sick horse. He's listless, but he's eating and drinking. They're not disappointed in how he's doing. This has got to run its course and they hope he'll be 100 percent." Magic Weisner was scratched from Monday's GIII Pennsylvania Derby when he began running a fever.
