Take Charge Lady (Dehere), sidelined since taking the GIII Dogwood S. at Churchill Downs May 25, makes her return in the GI Gazelle H. at Belmont Park this afternoon.

Will the filly show any signs of rustiness after 105 days on the shelf? "She's ready to go," trainer Ken McPeek said. "She's filled out quite a bit and she's stronger." But, he added, "This isn't going to be her best race. It will be a good race, but I don't

want the Gazelle to be her peak. I'd rather save that for a couple down the road." Four-for-five on the year, Take Charge Lady cruised through victories in the Feb. 16 GIII Silverbulletday S., Mar. 9 GII Fair Ground Oaks and Apr. 6 GI Ashland S. before suffering her lone defeat, running second as the 8-5 chalk in the May 3 GI Kentucky Oaks. She bounced back with her win in the Dogwood, then was given an extended vacation. "I thought I saw her going in the wrong direction," McPeek said. "She was a little dehydrated towards the end of May and she was losing some weight." Looking past the Gazelle, McPeek said the bay will be pointed for the GI Overbrook Spinster at Keeneland Oct. 6 and the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Arlington Oct. 26. Also returning after a break is **Bella Bellucci** (French Deputy), who was last seen taking an allowance test at this track and trip July 19. The gray has won three of her five starts on the Belmont main track, including the GII Astarita Breeders' Cup S. last October.

A CHAMPION IN THE CHAMPION?

Aidan O'Brien believed he had a realistic chance of capturing the British Triple Crown with **Hawk Wing** (Woodman), a colt he described as having the look of Nijinsky. Triple Crown dreams died when Hawk Wing came up a neck short behind Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the G1 2000 Guineas, but the three-year-old will plead his case for a championship in the G1 Ireland the Food Island Champions S. at Leopardstown today. Hawk Wing was hampered by significant rain before the G1 Epsom Derby, running second to stablemate High Chaparral (Ire) in that Classic, and connections clearly felt they were risking his reputation by running him on similarly testing ground in the G1 Eclipse S. July 6. But he pulled through, beating **Sholokhov (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) by a comfortable 2 1/2 lengths. With considerably faster conditions forecast here, Hawk Wing will be heavily favoured to emulate Giant's Causeway, who, like Sadler's Wells, Elmaamul, Pilsudski (Ire) and Swain (Ire) before him, completed the Eclipse-Irish Champion double in the same season. He faces an opponent of considerable talent in Godolphin's **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), who will expose any weakness. Last year, Fantastic Light gave Godolphin its third win in the race in the last four runnings. Like Fantastic Light, Grandera was impressive in winning the G1 Prince of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot, but, unlike that stalwart, he failed to land a blow in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. July 27, finishing a disappointing fifth behind Golan (Ire). Nevertheless, he suffered a bad trip there and will be more at home back over 10 furlongs.

Lido Palace lays over the field in a particularly weak renewal of the Woodward. The five-year-old is winless since taking last year's edition, but came back after a five-month layoff to be second in the July 6 GII Suburban H. and, most recently, was a solid third behind the now-retired pair of Left Bank and Street Cry in the Aug. 3 GI Whitney H. Jockey Jorge Chavez, aboard the chestnut for the first time in the Whitney, gets the mount once again. Chavez' style of riding should suit the Chilean-bred. "He's a one-paced horse, you've got to ride him," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "You can't sit and take a hold of him." **Cat's At Home**, who wired the field at 10-1 in Monmouth's nine-furlong GI Iselin H. Aug. 18, gets Edgar Prado in the irons for the first time. With Anticipation, who is three-for-four at 11 furlongs, including a win in this event last season, bids for his third straight Grade I after taking the July 6 United Nations H. at Monmouth Park and the Aug. 10 Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga. His main competition is likely to come from Juddmonte homebred **Skipping**. The five-year-old, a Listed winner in France, captured the restricted Jim Murray Memorial H. at Hollywood May 19, but has not been out since running third in the GI Charles Whittingham H. June 15.

With the forecasted rain failing to materialize to any great degree, **Malhub** has similar conditions to those he encountered when winning the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot June 22. He will be favoured to repeat off that pillar-to-post display of raw speed. The colt was unsuited by the slower ground when seventh to Continent in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket, then found the combination of five furlongs and Kyllachy (GB) beyond him in the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York Aug. 22. Nevertheless, he was only beaten a half-length when second there and, back at his best trip, has an outstanding chance of emulating last year's winner Nuclear Debate, who was also runner-up at York. Both Danehill in 1989 and Royal Applause (GB) in 1997 won this after taking the Royal Ascot sprint under its usual title as the Cork and Orrery S. Continent, who subsequently beat **Bahamian Pirate** by a half-length in the July Cup, was fourth at York last time. He needs overnight rain to become the first July Cup winner since Ajdal in 1987 to complete the double.

He is three-for-four lifetime. **Johar**, third in the Cinema and second to Rock Opera in the Oceanside, goes for his first stakes score.

SAKHEE TO NUNNERY STUD IN 2003 Sakhee

(Bahri), last year's International Classifications highweight, will retire to owner Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's Nunnery Stud in Norfolk at the end of the current season, it was announced yesterday. The five-year-old's autumn campaign may centre around a title defense in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 6. Last year's Arc and G1 Juddmonte International S. winner and GI Breeders' Cup Classic runner-up will stand alongside Green Desert and Act One (GB). "We are obviously delighted to be having Sakhee at Shadwell," stud director Richard Lancaster said. "He will join our other new stallion Act One, and they, together with Green Desert, will make up a formidable stallion team for 2003. It is especially good for Shadwell to be getting a stallion like Sakhee following the losses of Nashwan and Unfuwain." The two star Shadwell stallions, Nashwan and Unfuwain, died this summer. Lancaster paid tribute Sakhee yesterday, saying, "Sakhee's racing career has been absolutely outstanding, and nobody will forget the manner in which he absolutely decimated two high-class fields last year in the Juddmonte International and in the Arc. He has all the credentials for making an outstanding stallion."

PADUA TO SKIP SEPTEMBER SALE *The Blood-Horse* reports that Padua Stables, one of the top buyers at American Thoroughbred auctions, will not be present at the upcoming Keeneland September Yearling Sale in Lexington. Last year, Padua was the eighth-leading buyer at the sale, purchasing seven yearlings for an aggregate of \$3,925,000. "We have a business plan in place and we achieved our quota [for yearlings] at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky and Saratoga sales," Satish Sanan told *The Blood-Horse*. Sanan added that Padua will be buying mares at the breeding stock sales later in the year and will likely be active at the two-year-old sales at Calder and Barretts next year. Padua, the leading buyer at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July and the Saratoga Selected sales, has purchased 24 yearlings for a total of \$4,686,000 this year.

Well Fancied wasn't actually fancied by the bettors with the presence of even-money Say Florida Sandy (Personal Flag) in the field, but the four-year-old recovered from a bleeding episode in his last race to post a clear success. He had finished third in his most recent outing, an open allowance at Belmont July 7. Racing in second as Private Enterprise (Belong to Me) cut out a sharp early pace, Well Fancied collared the leader in the stretch and drew off smartly. "In his last race, he bled pretty good," explained winning trainer Richard Dutrow Jr. "Things were so tough at Saratoga, and I didn't want to run him back in a 'two other than' within 30 days." Say Florida Sandy was a non-threatening sixth.

Major Facelift for Gulfstream Grandstand:

A demolition crew began tearing down the north end of the Gulfstream Park grandstand Thursday. The contractors are currently knocking out non-supporting walls on the rear section of the first and second floors and removing the final remains of plumbing and electrical wiring before beginning the heavy work of dismembering the seats and I-beams holding up the structure. Gulfstream President Scott Savin said, "The work should be done in about 2 1/2 weeks." Asked about the simulcast center that is planned to replace the section of grandstand being torn down, Savin said, "We're not going to do that now. We're going to plant sod up to the top of the stretch [about 27,000 square feet] and turn it into a picnic area, the way they have at Monmouth."
