### PALACE PREVAILS IN THE WOODWARD

It was a struggle, but **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold), sent off the 1-2 favorite in the GI Woodward S. at Belmont Park yesterday afternoon, drove past 8-1 **Gander (Cormorant)** for a 3/4-length score. The win was not impressive, but it was enough to get owner John Amerman thinking Breeders' Cup Classic. Amerman said after the race that he may supplement his South American import to the \$4 million event at Arlington Park Oct. 26...but he's not happy about shelling out

\$800,000 for the opportunity to run. "I don't agree with the way they [Breeders' Cup Ltd.] do it, but you've got to play by the rules," he said. "If he can continue to earn enough money, I think we will supplement because I think we have the best horse. As long as he has a good race in the Jockey Club Gold Cup [Belmont Park, Sept. 28], we'll still think that way, so we ought to show people he's the best." The five-year-old beat a much tougher field in taking this event last year, beating Albert The Great by a length, with Tiznow third. His connections decided to skip the 2001 Breeders' Cup, instead shipping to Tokyo for the Nov. 24 G1 Japan Cup Dirt, but the chestnut could do no better than eighth. Fourth in the Feb. 3 GII San Antonio H. in his 2002 debut, Lido Palace was sidelined for five months after that race, returning to be second in the July 6 GII Suburban H. He failed in his title defense in the GI Whitney H., finishing third, but rebounded to get the job done this time. *More on the Woodward, p2*

### ANOTHER MAN O'WAR

**With Anticipation (Relaunch)** looked like he was running out of time in the stretch, but ran down the loose-on-the-lead **Balto Star (Glitterman)** to successfully defend his title in the GI Man o' War at Belmont Park yesterday afternoon. The gallant grey warrior had put up resolute performances in his last two starts, winning the GI United Nations H. July 6 and the GI Sword Dancer H. Aug. 10, and was sent off at odds-on for a repeat victory. Balto Star broke running and set a dawdling pace under a heady

Richard Migliore, clicking off fractions of :51 and 1:16 as With Anticipation raced a couple of lengths back in second. Turning for home with a mile in 1:40, Balto Star kicked clear, but the seven-year-old grey reeled him in through the stretch, getting up to win by a length. "With Anticipation did what he had to do," said winning trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "I wasn't upset about the fractions because he has such a good turn of foot. Lido Palace sat a tracking third as Express Tour dueled Gander through a half in :45.93 and six furlongs in 1:09.61. The two came into the stretch as a team, with the odds-on choice tucked in behind them. The Chilean-bred angled outside for the final drive as Gander put a head in front and fought to the lead in the final strides to gain a narrow victory. "He was bottled up most of the way," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "Obviously, he likes it outside a little better. The inside post bothered me with this horse. I wanted him to get outside at the top of the stretch. He's a bit of a lazy horse, but when I saw Jorge [Chavez] get him to the outside, I was confident. He likes to wear his rivals down." Added Chavez, "I'm not really surprised he won the way he did. He was closer to the pace than I thought he'd be. I had to get into him a little, but I still thought he won pretty easily." Jockey Richie Migliore, finishing second in his second Grade I event of the afternoon, was pleased with Gander's performance. The crowd might have thought that the result was in doubt, but Jonathan Sheppard, who has had seven-year-old With Anticipation in his barn for his entire career, knew better. "Ever since I've been training him as a yearling, he has always had a mind of his own," he said. "You have to be careful not to ask him to do too much before he is ready to do it. He seems to find another gear...it's in there, it's just a matter of getting it out." Added winning jockey Pat Day, who has been aboard for five Grade I wins, "My horse doesn't have quick acceleration; it takes him awhile to get going. Once he's in gear, he reaches out and he strides across the racetrack. I thought I had enough horse to get [Balto Star] in the shadow of the wire." Jockey Richie Migliore thought he had it stolen. "I was surprised they let me go so slow," he said. "At the three-eighths pole, I decided to string the race out a bit. I know my horse has a better turn of foot than With Anticipation and, once we got off the turn, I decided to open up a bit and catch them by surprise. Hats off to the winner...my horse ran a huge race, too." Billed as a thriller, this Group 1 event surpassed all expectations as Grandera got his nose in front of favoured Hawk Wing on the line. Hawk Wing drove past Best of the Bests in the final 25 yards, but it was Grandera who had the last say. "He's a one in a million horse--a very peculiar character," jockey Frankie Dettori said. "He's one of the most enormously talented horses I've ridden. In between races he's always in fifth gear, but when he decides to run, he is lethal." Deliberately reined back exiting the gate as Sholokhov (Sadler's Wells) was sent into a clear lead, Grandera was gradually manoeuvred up to fourth in the shadow of Hawk Wing. Best of the Bests took over from the inside at the furlong marker, and Grandera looked beaten as Hawk Wing bore down on the new leader, but, switched to deliver his run, he picked up dramatically in the final 50 yards to deny the favourite. "Grandera was looking at the crowd, looking at Hawk Wing, then on the line he said, 'I've got to put my head down now,'" Dettori said. Disappointing when fifth in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. July 27, the winner adds this to victories in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup May 11 and the G1 Prince of Wales' S. June 19. Simon Crisford, racing manager to Godolphin, said, "On his day, he's a really great horse. He's not finished with yet and could go for the G1 Cox Plate as that race will suit him well, but we'll have to talk to Sheikh Mohammed." Left to her own devices on the front end, Imperial Gesture had more than enough left to repel Take Charge Lady's bid in the stretch to earn her first stakes victory. At two, the dark bay followed her 10 3/4-length maiden score at Saratoga with a second in the GI Oak Leaf S. before following her stablemate, the ill-fated Tempera, home in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Imperial Gesture kicked off her three-year-old season with a nine-length win at Nad al Sheba Feb. 24, then turned the tables on Tempera by defeating her in the UAE Oaks Apr. 13. She looked live at 7-2 in the GI Kentucky Oaks, but suffered a horrible trip and was given a vacation following her eighth-place finish. Returning Aug. 17 against a stakes-quality field of older distaff sprinters, Imperial Gesture dismissed her rivals with an authoritative six-length success. Breaking alertly this time, the Godolphin runner went straight to the front and posted solid fractions. Take Charge Lady came after her turning for home, but Imperial Gesture let out a notch and drew clear. "After the Oaks, we basically took our time with her," said Tom Albertrani, assistant to Saeed bin Suroor. "She's always been highly regarded. Jose [Santos] was double-handed all the way around there." Invincible Spirit left it late, but his finish proved too strong as he drove past the trailblazing Malhub for his first Group 1 success. After proving he had retained his ability when beating Mugharreb a neck in the G3 Duke of York S. May 16, he finished sixth behind that rival in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot June 22, then was rested with a view to bringing him to this race at the top of his game. Enjoying the fast ground the needs to produce his best here, he raced in a prominent fifth early. Malhub was committed inside the final quarter of a mile and the race looked over as that rival drew a length clear, but Invincible Spirit quickened in pursuit and grabbed the advantage with 50 yards remaining. Winning trainer John Dunlop said, "This six [furlongs] really suits him best. The G2 Diadem S. [at Ascot Sept. 28] would be next I suppose, but today was important." Invincible Spirit is also the winner of the Listed Hackwood S. last July and the G3 Boland S. last September. Inesperado ran his American record to a perfect three-for-three with this victory. The bay, a Listed winner in France, ended his European campaign with a second-place finish in the Listed Prix Montenica at Maisons-Laffitte Mar. 12. He made his U.S. bow a winning one in the June 30 GIII Cinema Breeders' Cup H. and added a victory in the GIII La Jolla H. over this course Aug. 17. The favorite to make it three in a row, he tracked frontrunning Rock Opera from sixth down the backstretch, came three wide around the far turn, drove to the lead at the top of the lane and held off the late charge of Johar for the score. "This horse was unbelievable today," jockey Corey Nakatani said. "This course has some give to it today, so for him to run like that, to be that impressive, was something." The final time was the second fastest in 58 runnings of the race. Second choice Mr. Mellon (Red Ransom), winner of the GII Arlington Classic two back and fifth on the dirt in the GI Haskell Invitational H. last time out Aug. 4, saved ground, but had no late kick and ran seventh. One and Twenty remained unbeaten on the grass with this smooth success. After finishing fourth in her first two starts, the dark bay made a surface change in her latest Aug. 4 at Saratoga and responded with determined victory going 1 1/16 miles over a yielding course. She settled in midpack several lengths off a swift early pace and began to make headway approaching the far turn. Blocked briefly, she angled out for room, seized the lead inside the eighth pole and drove clear for her first stakes tally. "I knew very little [about the horse]," said winning jockey Todd Kabel. "They told me a bit about her...they told me she was a very strong filly and she'll run all day. She certainly showed some determination today. Sam-Son's horse [Swift of Flight] opened up down the lane and she just fought gritty and came on strong. Early in the race, we were in behind some horses, so I had to make a quick judgment to let her run in between a couple of horses before it closed up on us. It turned out to be the right move for us." The brilliant **Rock of Gibraltar** will attempt to become the first horse in history to win seven straight Group 1 victories this afternoon. The dual Guineas winner, who currently shares the record set by Mill Reef in 1971-72, embarks on another episode of his increasingly epic saga at the track where it all began. Encountering soft ground for the first time last fall over this course, he turned the G1 Grand Criterium into a procession before bringing the curtain down on his prolific juvenile campaign with a battling win in the G1 Dewhurst S. 13 days later. That momentum carried him through a wet winter and spring to glory in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4. After making the Irish version look farcically easy at The Curragh May 26, Aidan O'Brien's improving colt was sent to Royal Ascot, where he established himself as the preeminent miler of his generation in the G1 St. James's Palace S. June 18. Finally, he dismissed his elders, led by Noverre, in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood July 31 in his most recent start. Today, the presence of Banks Hill raises the standard he has to reach to continue his sequence. Brilliant in winning the G1 Breeders' Cup F/M Turf around two turns at Belmont in October, she stamped herself as one of the finest of her sex since Miesque. The winner of the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois, she bids to emulate that filly in winning this contest. While six fillies have won this race since 1983, only the Andre Fabre-trained Ski Paradise was older than three when landing the spoils, lending some credence to the chances of the sophomore filly **Gossamer**. She needs it soft to show her best, as she proved when powering away with the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh May 27.

Second in her turf debut at Belmont Park May 31, **Wonder Again** has been unbeatable since. The full sister to Japanese champion Grass Wonder broke her maiden at Belmont June 26, beat subsequent GIII Boiling Springs Breeders' Cup H. winner Showlady a neck in an allowance test at Saratoga July 24 and cruised to a 2 1/4-length score in the GII Lake Placid H. at the Spa Aug. 18. "I was confident going into the Lake Placid and I was thrilled to see her win so easy," trainer Jimmy Toner said, adding, "She's still developing and learning. I'm just as confident coming into this race." **Nunatall** rides her own winning streak into the Garden City. The British-bred bay started her career in France with a win from three starts, then shipped to California, where she hit the board in two of four stakes tries, including a third in the May 4 GIII Senorita S. at Hollywood. The three-year-old headed east after that effort and is a perfect two-for-two on this coast, taking a Belmont allowance June 20 and the GIII Lake George S. at Saratoga July 29. **Mariensky**, a Listed winner in France at two, went winless in three French starts this term, ending her European stint with a sixth-place finish in the G1 Prix de Diane. She made her U.S. bow in the Lake George and, after getting caught in traffic, closed to be third, beaten only a half-length by Nunatall. She should improve off that outing.
