SEPTEMBER STARTS AMID MARKET CONCERNS

Today at 10 a.m., the Keeneland Sales Company will begin the world's largest, and one of the Thoroughbred industry's most important events--the Keeneland September Yearling Sale--with great non-expectations. After a summer of discontent in some of the top Thoroughbred sales, and after a summer of watching some of the world's largest buyers take a more cautious approach, the world of Thoroughbred auctions is more than a little unsettled and more than a little unpredictable. "The real question, I think, is whether or not the big boys are going to come and play," said Tom Van Meter, who along with partner Reiley McDonald operates the Eaton Sales Agency. "This year, it seems, that Demi [O'Byrne, who buys for the Coolmore partnership of Michael Tabor and John Magnier], Sheikh Mohammed and, obviously, The Thoroughbred Corp., just haven't been as visible and active. They may have bought 10 for \$10 million, while in the past they have bought 30 for \$30 million. That's a big difference and it has a cascade effect on the entire market. The real contraction in the marketplace has been at the top, and if Sheikh Mohammed doesn't show up this September, it's going to be even worse. That's one of my biggest worries."

Fashions of the Times

On paper, the catalogue holds its own. There are 20 offspring of the grand stallion Storm Cat who are currently catalogued for the sale. Just this week, Overbrook Farm and W.T. Young announced that Storm Cat's stud fee will remain at the lofty figure of \$500,000 for a live foal. In addition, there will be 31 yearlings by A.P. Indy, 35 by Deputy Minister, 45 by Dixieland Band, 20 by Gone West, 38 by Kingmambo, 48 by Saint Ballado, 23 by Seeking the Gold, 32 by Theatrical (Ire), 22 by Unbridled, 53 by Unbridled's Song and 26 by Wild Again. "With the depth and breath of its catalogue, the Keeneland September Sale is the ideal marketplace," said Geoffrey Russell, who serves as the director of Keeneland's sales. "Our September sale is so popular because it consistently proves to have a horse for every profile of buyer. This year's catalogue is as strong as ever."

"ROCK" OF AGES

Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) (Danehill) etched his name in the history books yesterday, earning his seventh consecutive Group 1 victory in the G1 Netjets Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. Swooping from the rear under Michael Kinane to pass **Banks Hill (GB)** (Danehill) in the closing stages under a hand ride, the 2-5 favourite marched past the standard set by the great Mill Reef from 1971-1972. Sir Alex Ferguson, part-owner of the irrepressible "Rock," knows about star status as he manages the Manchester United Football Club, but he is honoured to be in the presence of such a phenomenon.

Off since Independence Day, Good Journey ran down a stubborn longshot for his first Grade I victory. The regally bred runner has quietly compiled an enviable record and will now likely head to the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, along with another nice miler, Rock of Gibraltar. The chestnut announced himself last November by defeating Decarchy and Irish Prize in the GII Citation H. before going on vacation. He returned June 15 to take a Churchill allowance, then annexed the GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. July 4 at the Louisville oval. As 55-1 Chopinina sizzled through an opening half in :44 4/5, Good Journey raced in sixth, but he began to advance as the filly clicked off 1:08 4/5 for the three-quarters split. The six-year-old steadily reeled in the pacesetter under a hand ride from jockey Pat Day. "I didn't have to work very hard today," Day conceded. "To win on a horse like this for people like this, is extra special." The 5-2 favorite, Noverre (Rahy) could offer only a mild rally as he came in sixth. His jockey Frankie Dettori blamed the outside post for the loss. "I had a killer draw, post 13," he said. "It's too far too win from there if they don't run a killer pace."

Whatever the circumstances, Wonder Again gets the job done. The bay filly was bottled up on the far turn, but came home bravely to post her first Grade I success. In the process, she established herself as the East's top three-year-old turf filly and may be headed towards a confrontation with Dublino and Megahertz, the top pair in California, in Keeneland's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup Oct. 12. Wonder Again has progressed very quickly, breaking her maiden June 26 before defeating subsequent GSW Showlady in a Saratoga allowance July 24. She quickened impressively in winning the GII Lake Placid H. from Riskaverse Aug. 18 and was sent off as the favorite in this spot. Never far from the front as Euro shipper Kithira (Danehill) led, she was shuffled back on the far turn and was forced to wait for room at the top of the stretch. When a seam opened up, Wonder Again came through willingly to grab the lead before seeing off Riskaverse's challenge. "That was a huge effort," acknowledged winning trainer Jimmy Toner. "She got bottled up and I lost track of her. You see them all go by and you figure, 'that's it.' Once she saw daylight, she just exploded."

ROCKING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS Drawn widest of all, **Rock of Gibraltar** was unable to find cover as stable companion **Sahara Desert (GB)** (Green Desert) was sent into a clear lead in the early stages. Jockey Michael Kinane settled the colt in sixth while keeping track of **Banks Hill**, who was also forced wide under jockey Richard Hughes. As the rabbit backtracked, the filly was committed with a furlong remaining, but the Rock had every move covered and, without his rider needing to pick up the whip, quickened effortlessly to draw alongside his hard-driven rival with 75 yards remaining. Always in control from there, he was coaxed past to secure the historical score. The three-year-old started his unprecedented streak on a rain-soaked Arc day last October, where he blew away his opponents in the G1 Grand Criterium. He came back 13 days later to beat Landseer (GB) by a short head in the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket and entered winter quarters as a major Classic contender. His 2002 campaign kicked off with a gallant neck victory over Hawk Wing in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 and a facile success in the Irish version at The Curragh May 26. He followed with impressive victories in the G1 St James' Palace S. June 18 and the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood July 31. "It doesn't matter whether they go fast or slow, he can quicken up off any pace," O'Brien said. "He's a truly great horse. The aim is the Breeders' Cup Mile [G1, Arlington, Oct. 26], but the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Sept. 28] is also a possibility beforehand." Coral Eurobet quoted the Rock as the 6-4 favourite for the Mile yesterday, down from 11-4.

Banks Hills Also Breeders' Cup Bound...

While the Rock will be heading stateside for the first time, runner-up Banks Hill will be looking to revisit her glory of last year in the G1 Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. Teddy Beckett, racing manager to her owner, Khalid Abdullah, said, "She's run her race and Richard Hughes was very happy with her. She will probably go straight to Arlington now to try and win the G1 Breeders' Cup Fillies and Mares Turf again." Third-place finisher Gosamer will head for the Queen Elizabeth II. "It was her first run since June and the first time she tackled older horses," trainer Luca Cumani said. "She will go to Ascot later this month."

ZAFONIC DEAD Zafonic (Gone West--Zaizafon, by The Minstrel), who arrived at Arrowfield's Hunter Valley farm in Australia Aug. 31, died as a result of injuries incurred in an accident on Saturday, Sept. 7. Arrowfield Chairman John Messara said the 12-year-old, who had 75 mares booked to him this spring, ran into his paddock gate. He told the *Sydney Morning Herald*, "I was at Randwick races on Saturday when I received the call from [stud manager Peter] Keating and I just couldn't believe my ears. Apparently Zafonic ran at his paddock gate and kept going, flipping over and crashing to the ground. The horse broke his neck as well as suffering internal bleeding." Messara added, "Obviously, we're deeply shocked at this loss. We had been thrilled to be given the care of this stallion by Juddmonte Farms for the Southern Hemisphere breeding season." A champion in Europe at two and three, Zafonic won five of his seven career starts, including the the G1 Dewhurst S. and G1 2000 Guineas. He had just begun his first Southern Hemisphere stud season and had covered only a handful of mares. From six crops to race, Zafonic had produced 26 stakes winners and 13 group/graded winners, headed by two-time champion Xaar (GB), G1SW Count Dubois (GB), this year's G2 Italian 2000 Guineas and G2 German 2000 Guineas winner Dupont (GB) and Ibn al Haitham (GB), who earned his first graded win in the GIII Saranac S. on closing day at Saratoga. His progeny earnings have topped \$10.8 million. His death comes as a major blow for Arrowfield, which lost Australian stalwart Snippets (Aus) and End Sweep in the past season.

Voodoo Dancer had made one previous sojourn to Del Mar, finishing fourth as the favorite last year in the GI Del Mar Oaks, but left that memory long behind her with a smooth success in the Palomar. In retrospect, her fourth to Golden Apples (Ire) and Affluent doesn't seem so bad. This year, the blaze-faced bay has sandwiched her third to Astra and Starine (Fr) in the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. with a pair of graded-stakes victories and, most recently, missed by just a nose in the GII Diana H. at Saratoga July 27. Settling into a steady rhythm in fifth, the crowd's choice knifed her way between horses turning for home, hit the front in midstretch and easily pulled away. "She put me in a perfect spot going into the first turn, then it was a matter of biding my time from there," said winning rider Kent Desormeaux. "She's an old pro. It was a pleasurable ride. I was just the lucky pilot." Second choice Janet (Emperor Jones) was caught in traffic on the far turn and never fired, finishing sixth. "She was kind of mad today," said her trainer Darrell Vienna. "She had a little trouble getting in the gate. I think she just started off wrong."

Lismore Knight outbattled Wando in a thrilling stretch run to claim his first stakes victory. The bay colt debuted with an impressive nine-length victory on the turf at Belmont July 20 and was sent off as the 3-5 favorite in the Continental Mile S. at Monmouth Aug. 18. But with that event forced to the main track, Lismore Knight weakened to be a distant fifth. The Woodbine bettors were confident that the colt would reverse that form, however, and sent him postward as the 3-2 favorite in an 11-horse affair. Allowed to settle inside in fifth, he made his challenge between rivals and collared previously unbeaten Wando nearing the eighth pole, getting the best of that runner in the final strides. "We kind of had to bide our time till we found a seam," explained winning rider Pat Day. "When we did and I called on him, he responded very gamely. That horse [Wando] made a real race of it down inside the sixteenth pole, then he [Lismore Knight] was starting to get away from him a bit at the wire. He's got a great future."

Favored Calista just got the better of second-choice Diadella to earn her first graded-stakes victory. Previously campaigned in France, the bay filly had taken the Listed Prix d'Angerville and the Listed Prix de la Cochere as well as running second in the G3 Prix de Psyche. She came to the U.S. in the autumn of her three-year-old season, missing by just a head in the GIII Pebbles H. last October. After winning a Belmont allowance May 30 to kick off 2002, she ran third in the New Castle H. at Delaware before bouncing back to take the the Spicy Living H. at Rockingham Aug. 4. Calista and Diadella brought up the rear as Ghazirella led up front, but the favorite began to advance as the field swept into the turn. She angled out at the head of the lane, gained command in midstretch and had enough left to hold off Diadella's late surge. "She's very special," remarked winning rider Corey Nakatani. "I was really patient with her. When I called on her, she quickened and held on."

An Overview

As in years past, the Keeneland September Yearling Sale promises to be filled with both quality and quantity. Going into this year's event, Keeneland cataloged 4,367 horses, which includes 2,259 colts, 2,106 fillies and two geldings. The 12-day auction will run through Saturday, Sept. 21. Each session will begin at 10 a.m. For the first time, Keeneland will take a day off in the middle of the sale. On Friday, Sept. 13, Keeneland will close the sales pavilion and allow buyers an opportunity to examine and inspect the next group of horses that will be sold.

New Kids on the Block

First-crop sires will be well represented. Kentucky Derby and Preakness hero **Charismatic** (Summer Squall) has 48 sons and daughters listed in the sale. **Artax** (Marquetry) will have 14, while **Exploit** (Storm Cat) will be represented by 45, **Forestry** (Storm Cat) 44, **Horse Chestnut (SAf)** (Fort Wood) 16, **Old Trieste** (A.P. Indy) 23, **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) 36, **Stravinsky** (Nureyev) 40 and **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) 43.

Can September Rebound From the Summer?

"We've got tons, tons of good horses," said Tom Van Meter. "I think one of the knocks on the summer sales is that the quality was down. Well, if that was the case, that isn't the case here and now. These are good-looking horses with a lot of pedigree. I just hope that we get the buyers. If the buyers show up and are ready to buy some horses, then I think we could have a good sale. If they don't, we won't." Van Meter said that everyone in the industry would have to work together. "We'll get our horses sold," he said. "I think they are that good. But the breeders and the owners have to do their part, too. We have to tighten our belts. If the prices are down, then, concurrently, we need to see a realistic reduction in the stud fees. We have to adjust this thing up and down the ladder. That's the only way we can continue."

Market Worries

Van Meter explained the down market. "It just appears to me that the horses that were bringing \$500,000 a year ago, aren't bringing half of that this year," he said. "There hasn't been any depth to the buyers market at all. The top of the market has been soft, and it has impacted everybody right on down. I'm hoping that we can turn this thing around. We've got some very, very nice horses. I just hope that people are here and ready to buy. Quite honestly, if you were in the market to buy and race horses, now is the right time to buy. You can get some high quality at prices that we haven't seen in years.

"We've got a lot of good looking horses out here. The quality is right here, but if we don't get them sold, I'm going to have the world's largest racing stable," said Van Meter. "I'm going to be just like John Franks. I'll be racing all over the world. To be honest, I'm a little fearful and, as you know, that's not like me. To be honest, I don't know what to expect."

Padua Opts Out...

The worry became even bigger when Satish Sanan, who owns Padua Stables with his wife Anne, announced just a few days ago that he and his connections would not be traveling to Lexington for the upcoming September yearling auction. A year ago, Padua was the eighth-leading buyer at the Keeneland September Sales, spending over \$3.9 million on seven yearlings. It's even more startling news considering that Sanan had eased some of the pain at the top end of the market. He was the leading buyer at this year's Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July Yearling Sale and the Fasig-Tipton sale at Saratoga. In addition, Padua was the leading buyer at the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company yearling select sales earlier this year, as well. Already this year, Padua has spent \$4,686,000 on yearling purchases.

What Will Tomorrow Bring?

Last year's September topper was a \$6.4 million son of Storm Cat--Halory (Halo). Now named Van Nistelrooy, the flashy chestnut is unbeaten in three starts in Ireland and most recently won a Group 2 event. He epitomizes what buyers are looking for, but how will the market hold up? "For the first time in a long time, I think I'm more nervous and lathered up than the horses," Van Meter said with a chuckle. "We've been busy showing horses. That's a good sign. Now, I hope we can be busy selling them, too."

TBA URGES PRECAUTIONS AGAINST EHV

Thoroughbred Breeders' Australia President Richard Turnley has urged breeders to take precautions to curtail a serious outbreak of equine herpes viral abortion caused by the Equine Rhinopneumonitis virus. Turnley said it was possible the high number of cases--more than 30 to date--was a result of diligent diagnosis and reporting by breeders, and it was also possible some mares were under stress as a result of severe drought conditions in Eastern Australia at present. "We ask that all breeders consider foaling their mares on their home stud and moving the mares and foals later to be mated," Turnley said in a statement. "Although this may not be an option for breeders who have to float their mares long distances, it certainly would assist in making certain that the effect of the virus is limited." Dr Michael Studdart, who heads the centre for equine virology at Melbourne University, said the outbreak was the worst ever experienced in New South Wales and Victoria. "There are six properties in NSW and six properties in Victoria that have experienced abortion since the 18th July," he told ABC Radio. He said that a significant number of horses carried the virus without displaying symptoms. "We know that 50 per cent thereabout--it varies from place to place--of the Thoroughbred horses in the country are latent carriers of the virus, so it can reactivate anywhere, anytime," he said.
